# Wynmoor President, Jackie Railey Wins Commission Seat

On March 9, 2021, Coconut Creek held its elections for three different City Commission seats. With the retirement of Commissioner Mikkie Belvedere, Wynmoor Council President Jackie Railey received 82% of the vote beating her opponent Nikitress Vachon Lewis. The second seat saw voters re-elect Commissioner Josh Rydell who beat Lauren Linville with 66% of the vote. In the third race, incumbent Sandra Welch received 73% of the vote beating her two opponents Patricia Duaybes and Wesner St.Vil. All three individuals were sworn in as Commissioners on March 25th.

The three winning candidates, Railey, Rydell and Welch all shared the same position on two issues. First, all three Commissioners opposed the expansion of the landfill, which is called Mt. Trashmore. The second issue that all three Commissioners shared was the opposition to the expansion of the turnpike.



# This little bit of history is quite fantastic


A grandson of slaves, a boy was born in a poor neighborhood of New Orleans known as the "Back of Town." His father abandoned the family when the child was an infant. His mother became a prostitute and the boy and his sister had to live with their grandmother. Early in life he proved to be gifted for music and with three other kids he sang in the streets of New Orleans. His first gains were coins that were thrown to them. A Jewish family, Karnofsky, who had emigrated from Lithuania to the USA, had pity for the 7-year-old boy and brought him into their home. Initially giving "work" in the house, to feed this hungry child. There he remained and slept in this Jewish family's home where, for one of the first times in his life, he was treated with kindness and tenderness. When he went to bed, Mrs. Karnovsky sang him a Russian lullaby that he would sing with her. Later, he learned to sing and play several Russian and Jewish songs. Over time, this boy became like an adopted son of this family. The Karnofskys gave him money to buy his first musical instrument, as was the custom in the Jewish families. They sincerely admired his musical talent. Later, when he became a professional musician and composer, he used Jewish melodies in some of his compositions. The young black boy grew up and wrote a book about this Jewish family who had adopted him in 1907. In memory of this family, and until the end of his life, he wore a Star of David and said that in this family he had learned "how to live real life and determination." You might recognize his name. This little boy was called Louis "Satchmo" Armstrong. Louis Armstrong proudly spoke fluent Yiddish and "Satchmo" is Yiddish for "big cheeks," a nickname some say was given to him by Mrs. Karnofsky!

# A Joyful Day Savoring 20th Century Art At The Baker Art Museum

In early January, I visited the Baker Art Museum in Naples, Florida. Covid 19 Protocol was strictly enforced. Facial masks were mandatory, as well as social distancing. Advance reservations were required. At the Baker, I saw a fine group of oil paintings by Surreal Painter, Rene Magritte. I especially liked Magritte's "Summer Holiday," "Monumental Shadow," and "Ivory Tower." I also liked their delightful group of Rodin Sculpture which is temporarily on display. The following Rodin Sculptural works made of bronze, especially fascinated me; "Saint John the Baptist Preaching," modeled in 1880, cast in 1925, "Metamorphosis of Ovid," modeled in 1885, cast in 1897 "Heroic Bust of Victor Hugo," and "Balzac in Dominican Robe."

From the Baker Art Museum's permanent collection, I enjoyed the following paintings by 20th Century American Painters; George Ault, "Ault Family House, Hillside, New Jersey," Vincent Canade, "White Farmhouse With Red Barns," John Briggs, "Downtown Tallahassee, 1971," wonderful shadows, Hugh Breckenridge, "City Hall Tower, Philadelphia," Herman Maril, "Easel," Robert



Cottingham, "Corona," awesome Photorealistic depiction of a typewriter, and John Wesley, "Hats Off to Japan," among others. I also relished the following paintings by 20th Century painters associated with Mexico," including Rufino Tamayo, "2 Women At Window," Gabriel Ledesma, "Family," Olga Costa, "Stillife With Mexican Objects," and Jesus Guerrero Galvan, "Lament," among a few others.

The Dale Chihuly Exhibit closed at the end of February, however there is a delightful, mammoth chandelier produced by Dale Chihuly and associates as part of the permanent collection. Parking at the Baker is free and quite abundant. Even though, the Norton Art Museum in West Palm Beach, Florida and the Lowe Art Museum in Coral Gables, Florida have broader ranges of Art, I still feel my visits to the Baker Art Museum have been very productive.

# Jesse James



Jesse James was born in 1847 and shot in the back and killed in 1881 by a friend and colleague, Frank Ford. Jesse's father was a Baptist minister, and many thought he would follow in his father's footsteps. However, the Civil War altered many lives including that of Jesse James. The family lived in northwest Missouri, which was a Union state with very strong southern sympathizers, including the James family.

Frank James, Jesse's older brother, joined a Confederate guerilla band that raided homes and farms of Union sympathizers. Atrocities were committed by both Union and Confederate supporters. Jesse was shot in the chest during one of raids but recuperated and rejoined his brother and the guerrilla raiders. "In Centralia, Missouri, led by 'Bloody Bill', the guerrillas terrorized the town and murdered twenty-two unarmed Union soldiers. Hours later, the guerrillas killed and horribly mutilated over a hundred soldiers in the Thirty-ninth Missouri Infantry. James took credit for killing their Union commander."

After the war, Jesse began his life of crime, attempting to justify it because of the ill treatment of Southerners by Union forces in the south.

The James-Younger Gang gained notoriety through newspaper articles that publicized their robberies of banks and stagecoaches. Jesse came to thrive on the publicity and would write articles back to the newspaper correcting their stories and giving them the latest update, which they then published. It was a quid-pro-quo that worked for both sides.

Jesse found time in his busy activities to marry Zerelda Mimms and have four children. In an attempt to catch Jesse, Pinkerton detectives killed James's half-brother and injured Zerelda. From this time on, Jesse changed his name and attempted to live under the radar while still robbing trains and banks. Governor Crittenden of Missouri issued a reward for Jesse James. It was an opportunity that was too good to pass up. Frank Ford, one of Jesse's men, made a deal with the governor to bring Jesse in for the reward and a pardon of Ford's past crimes. Bob Ford shot Jesse in the back as Jesse was straightening a picture in his family home.

Through it all, Jesse James became a "folk hero." Frank and Bob Ford made a living acting in plays about the killing. Even though Jesse never gave any of his stolen loot to the poor, a myth was perpetrated that he was the western rendition of Robin Hood, who stole from the rich to give to the poor.

When I was ten years old, my father took me on a business trip with him to St. Joseph, Missouri. We visited the house where Jesse James was killed. The tour guide showed us the turned over chair Jesse was standing on as he tried to straighten the needle point picture on the wall. The picture was positioned off-center as it was when Jesse tried to straighten it. The needle point canvas read, "God Bless Our Home."

## What Can Investors Learn From 2020?

Now that we're a few weeks removed from 2020, it's a good time to reflect on such a momentous year. We can think about developments in the social and political spheres, but we also learned – or perhaps re-learned – some valuable lessons about investing.

Here are four of them:


- A long-term perspective is essential. Volatility in the financial markets is nothing new, but, even so, 2020 was one for the books. Of course, the COVID-19 outbreak was the driving force behind most of the wild price swings. Soon after the pandemic's effects were first felt, the S&P 500, a common index of U.S. large-cap stocks, fell 34% but gained 67% by the end of the year. Consequently, investors who stuck with their investment portfolios and kept their eyes on their long-term goals, rather than on shocking headlines, ended up doing well. And while 2020 was obviously an unusual year, the long-term approach will always be valuable to investors.
- Investment opportunities are always available. The pandemic drove down the prices of many stocks but it didn't necessarily harm the long-term fundamentals of these companies. In other words, they may still have had strong management, still produced desirable products and services, and still had good prospects for growth. In short, they may still have been good investment opportunities and when their prices were depressed, they may also have been "bargains" for smart investors. And this is the case with virtually any market downturn some high-quality stocks will be available at favorable prices.
- Diversification pays off. Bond prices often move in a different direction from stocks. So, during a period of volatility when stock

prices are falling, such as we saw in the weeks after the pandemic hit in March, the presence of bonds in your portfolio can lessen the impact of the downturn and stabilize your overall returns. And this, in essence, is the value of maintaining a balanced and diversified portfolio. (Keep in mind, though, that diversification can't guarantee profits or prevent all losses.)

• The market looks ahead. The pandemic-driven market plunge may have been stunning, but it made a kind of intrinsic sense – after all, the sudden arrival of a pandemic that threatened lives, closed businesses and cost millions of jobs doesn't sound like a positive event for the financial markets. But the strong rally that followed the initial drop and continued into 2021 has surprised many people. After all, the pandemic's effects were felt throughout the rest of 2020, and are still being felt now, so why did stock prices rise? The answer is pretty straightforward: The financial markets always look ahead, not behind. And for a variety of reasons – including widespread vaccinations, anticipated economic stimulus measures from Congress and the Biden administration, and the Federal Reserve's continued steps to keep interest rates low – the markets are anticipating much stronger economic growth, possibly starting in the second half of 2021.

All of us are probably glad to have 2020 behind us. Yet, the year taught us some investment lessons that we can put to work in 2021 – and beyond.

Now, I only see her peripherally via technology. She is playing with toy cars, or toy trains (she is mad for transportation), or magnetic blocks while I chat with other family members. During our Sunday family Zoom sessions, she bounces in and out of the computer screen, sometimes uttering a word or two, sometimes making a request, or asking a question, always distant. She only notices me when told to say hello or to wave goodbye. There are no interchanges – certainly, none she initiates.

Relationships with my great grandchildren are nothing like what I experienced with their parents: sharing games, shopping, eating out, travelling together. Granddaughter Robin and I spent a weekend at the University of Wisconsin in "Grandparents University," studying engineering (her idea). We built a bridge out of toothpicks. I accompanied young grandson Gregory to Barcelona when he played with a junior soccer league. Later, as an adult, he took me on a weekend tour to Frank Lloyd Wright's architectural treasure, Falling Water, in Pennsylvania followed by a Pittsburgh Pirates game. Now, he is Nellie's daddy.

Margaux and once had a shopping spree in New York. On another occasion, I took Michelle to a Science Fiction feminist convention in Madison. (Their parents had enjoyed many SF conventions with me in the US and even one in Yugoslavia.) I remember sharing a motel room with Robin and Michelle, then about 12 years old, when the entire family took me on a surprise birthday party downstate to enjoy a high school band competition. The girls and I shared midnight revelations about "boys!"

I realize that I am much older now and the newest relatives are babies and toddlers. We will have less time to construct the fragile temporary bridges spanning generations. Sadly, even this time is being stolen by the Pandemic.

Bevyn and I cannot even go for a walk. Where are our movies? Baseball games? Explorations of zoos? Butterfly World? Museums? Trips to Ravinia? Days at the beach? Where are our long car rides and the intimate conversations that ensued? Where are the late night or early morning cuddles in bed? Where

is the chat over our breakfast cereal? Where are the beloved TV shows and the little jokes that heighten the enjoyment of otherwise prosaic days?

Now, I send toys from Amazon and seldom see them opened or enjoyed. Parents report their responses – second hand -- not at all satisfying.

What makes this especially painful is that these great-grandchildren: my namesake (Bevyn to reflect my name Beverly), and both her little cousins Nellie and her imminently expected baby brother, might only have memory of a shadowy figure their parents will someday tell them about – perhaps they will be interested, perhaps not. I must pray to live as long as my centenarian Mother, and like her, keep most of my senses and memory intact in order to build memories.

Right now, I treasure Bevyn's evening story request, honing memories for enticing material as I relate fairy tales, family history, or tap our mutual imaginations to set her at the center of new superhero adventures.

Not complaining -I am grateful for even this while I (perhaps greedily) still hold out hope for even more. It may be sinful - not to be grateful for skype and zoom and our own survival-- but I am just feeling sad about getting older, less able to do what we formerly did, and now just wanting seemingly so little - to hug my babies.







There is only one road and it is up to bicyclists and motorists to treat each other with care and respect.



Safety Tips for Cycling in the Dark



Below are a few tips that will help you stay safe while riding in the dark.

**Lights:** Having lights on your bike is vitally important to night riding - to see where you're going, of course, but more importantly, to be seen by others. Having lights on your bike is the law. At a minimum, you should have a white constant light in the front and a blinking red light at the rear.

**Reflectives:** While lights are obviously critical for riding at night, don't discount the value of reflective clothing or tape. The idea is to make yourself as visible as possible. Adding reflective tape to your bike frame can also be an option.

**Plan your route:** Depending on what you want to get out of your ride, whether it's a structured training session or just a case of getting the miles in, plan ahead and have a route in your head or on a computer. Try to choose routes you're very familiar with when biking at night.

**Ride with a partner or group:** Riding with a friend or a group is a good way to approach night rides. Having a group of friends is a good incentive and just the motivation you might need to head out into the dark. There is also safety in numbers.

# Stimulus Check Scams To Watch For



Millions of Americans have either already gotten, or will soon receive, the latest round of stimulus checks from the federal government. It's certainly big news! And you can always count on scammers to take advantage of what they see on the news - good and bad.

For example, the Federal Trade Commission reported receiving more than 14,000 complaints about COVID-19-related fraud schemes

back in April of 2020, about a month into the pandemic. I've written in previous columns about testing-related scams, and vaccine-related frauds. This warning is about stimulus check-related schemes.

Since the scammers know about anyone they call or email will have an extra \$1,400 in their bank accounts, they will use a myriad of different methods to try and separate the potential victim from that money. The most obvious tactic is to pretend to be from the Internal Revenue Service, or IRS, since it is the federal department in charge of issuing the checks.

It's very important to remember that no one from the IRS will ever call you or email you. They only send letters through the mail. So, if you get a call from someone claiming to work for the IRS then you should automatically connect that to a scam. Because it is. They may call you with phony promises such as getting your money faster, receiving more of a stimulus payment, or

claiming there is something afoul with the payment you received, and they can magically "fix" it.

Keep in mind that they can also "spoof" phone numbers, meaning they can make it look like they're calling from the IRS on your caller ID. Unfortunately, you can't trust caller ID anymore. Tech-savvy bad guys can also spoof the phone numbers of your utility company or local government.

Another good rule to remember is that you should "never have to spend money in order to get money." In other words, if you get a call or an email from someone wanting you to pay a small "fee" in order to get your stimulus money, you know it's a scam. Most of these payments will likely be direct deposited into the individual's bank account. But the scammers could still send you a fake check through the mail. They would explain that it was a mistake, but to go ahead and cash the check at your bank, keep some of the money for your troubles, and send them the rest.

Scammers will also use social media to try and get to you. Be very suspicious of any social media messages or contacts claiming they can get you your money faster, even if it's from a friend. The bad guys can hack your friend's account and claim to be them. I even saw this scam myself last year when a "friend" direct messaged me on Facebook claiming to know how to get stimulus money before anyone else. My friend's account had been hacked.

The bottom line is to be very wary of anyone calling, emailing, or reaching out to you via social media involving anything related to the stimulus. Trust your instincts. If it doesn't feel right that means, it's probably not. And if you're just not sure, you can always reach out to me via email at sleamon@coconutcreek.net. # If You Have Equity In Your Home Consider Doing A Trust

In 2012, I wrote an article recommending against doing a Revocable Living Trust if you were "underwater" with your mortgage. Many of my clients had bought or refinanced from 2004 to 2006 at the top of the market.

However, the last nine years have seen significant increases in property values. This has resulted in many homeowners now having positive equity. If prices continue to rise, many more homeowners will have some positive equity.

In the article I wrote in 2012, I advised clients to live long enough to see their properties increase in

value to exceed the amount of the mortgage; at that time, they could come back to me to discuss a Revocable Living Trust. That time is now here.

Without equity in your home, it does not make sense to pay an attorney the fee and costs involved in creating a Trust, since you would be burdening your heirs with a property that has a negative equity. However, once that equity turns positive, you are doing your heirs a favor by eliminating the time and money involved in going through probate. Probate can take a year and cost thousands of dollars in fees and costs.

Remember also that the Trust is called a "Revocable Living Trust." This means that, as long as you are alive, the Trust remains with you.



You can always sell your home and buy a new home as Trustee of your Trust. You do not need to change the Trust unless you want to change the beneficiaries for the new property. You can also buy additional properties, in Florida or out of state, as Trustee of your Trust.

Therefore, if you now have equity in your home, you should seriously consider creating a Trust. Transferring your home to the Trust will not change your homestead or your real estate taxes.


In addition, regardless of the equity in your home, it is extremely important to have current advance

care directives to protect you if you are incapacitated. These include the Durable Power of Attorney (which must specifically include the address of your property) as well as the Designation of Health Care Surrogate and Living Will. New Florida laws could mean that your current documents need to be revised.

# Service Equals Reward

Every Sunday morning, when Pompano Beach District Captain Martin Hedelund's twin boys were young, he would take them on drives around Broward County, showing them various landmarks and sights. Captain Hedelund would do all the talking; Dalton and Martin Jr. sat and listened. They were four years old and nonverbal - a developmental delay caused by autism.

Today, Captain Hedelund's boys are 14. Both can speak and express themselves in different ways. They remember those trips with dad, sometimes down to the date on which they happened. "It has been cataloged in their minds all these years," Captain Hedelund says.

"While the twins are aware of what is going on, sometimes they just can't tell us that they know. We have faced challenges as a family, but with the blessings of early diagnosis, curriculum-based learning and having two caring parents, Dalton and Martin Jr. have exceeded expectations."

As a veteran law enforcement officer, Captain Hedelund became better at his job from his personal experiences with autism. He learned how to read body language better and pick up on important social cues. His wife, Margi, has dedicated her life to spreading awareness about autism. She is a board member of the Autism Society of Florida. She travels across the state, sometimes with her sons, to teach first responders about autism awareness and how to communicate more effectively with individuals on the spectrum.

At the Broward Sheriff's Office, we understand the importance of autism awareness in public safety. We have instituted proactive programs and initiatives and continue to provide specialized training



to assist our first responders in serving this population better.

Our most progressive initiative is the implementation of the BSO Cares program. The program provides first responders with important information about persons with disabilities so we can respond more appropriately to calls for service. Participation in the program is voluntary and available to anyone who resides in or frequently visits Broward County with a special needs diagnosis. To learn more about the program, or to register yourself or a loved one, please visit www. sheriff.org/BSOCares.

We also continue to ensure more first responders receive Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training. This unique training enhances the understanding of the signs and symptoms of someone with behavioral health issues. It also helps provide a more prepared and aware approach when interacting with an individual on the spectrum.

BSO is honored to have some incredible community partnerships with organizations such as Surfers for Autism and Autism in Flight with JetBlue. Surfers for Autism is a community event that gives individuals with autism a chance to learn to surf. Autism in Flight provides a full airport experience for children with autism and their families. They go through check-in and ticketing, security, boarding and a taxiway ride on the tarmac. The program aims to make the prospect of a commercial flight less intimidating.

At BSO, we will continue to work hard to further develop these essential programs and partnerships. Our goal is to ensure all persons are served with respect and protected in the safest possible manner.

# WYNMOOR Golf and Tips


# **Control Your Speed - Make More Putts**

Last month's tip on alignment of your putter is followed up this month by tips on the speed of your putts and distance.

There is an optimum distance the ball would have in speed and distance to give you the highest chance of making your putt. Dave Pelz, putting guru, did an extensive study and his research and found the ball would travel 18 inches past the hole to have the greatest chance of going in. Pelz put a cover over the hole and rolled some 10,000 balls over the cup. Pelz found the distance of 18 inches past the hole accounted for the subtle breaks and any imperfections in the green. I believe because Wynmoor greens aren't lightning fast like the bent grass greens up north, this is a safe strategy to reduce the strokes you take on the green. Next time you're on the practice green locate an old cup and you can test the speed of your putt by rolling it over the replaced cup.

Keep in mind to control the distance of your putts you must regulate the size of your stroke and allow the putter to accelerate naturally relative to the distance you took the putter in your backswing. Make more putts this Spring!

# with the Medicare Lady

Welcome to the monthly Editorial from Darlene Swaffar aka The Medicare Lady and Owner of Sunshine Insurance Associates located in Deerfield Beach, FL for Wynmoor Residents.

Each month I will choose between one or two questions to answer.

Here is this month's question regarding Cost of Medications on Medicare Prescription Drug Plans:

**Question:** What is the Coverage Gap and why are my prescriptions higher when I reach this stage?

**Answer:** Medicare has a guideline created that **ALL** Medicare Prescription Plans have to follow. There are 4 different stages that your Prescription Drug Coverage goes through. To understand the Coverage Gap stage, let's go through all the stages so that you will understand more clearly. They are as follows for the year 2021:

**Stage 1:** Deductible Stage: \$445. Usually, on many Medicare Advantage Plans, the Deductible applies for brand name drugs.

**Stage 2:** Initial Coverage Limit Stage: \$4,130. This is a budget set aside to pay for your prescription drugs throughout the year. Your copay, and what the plan pays for your drugs **together** get deducted from this amount. When you have spent this much money in the cost of medications, then you move to the next stage which is Stage 3.

**Stage 3:** "Coverage Gap" Stage - **25% of generic** drug costs and **25% of brand name** drugs. You will receive a 70-75% <u>Donut Hole discount</u> on the total cost of their **brand-name in this stage**. Many Medicare Advantage HMO Plans will provide Generic Coverage at zero co-pay during this stage. Check your Summary of Benefits and Evidence of Coverage for details.

**Stage 4:** Catastrophic Stage: When your Maximum Out of Pocket Limit **reaches \$6,550**, you will pay \$3.70 for Generics, \$9.20 for Brand Name Drugs or 5% whichever is greater.

By law, Part D plans are not permitted to include the following under their Part D covered benefits:

- Drugs for weight loss or gain, fertility, cosmetic purposes, symptomatic relief of cough and colds
- Vitamins
- Medical foods formulated to be consumed or administered enterally under the supervision of a physician that are not regulated as drugs under section 505 of the Federal Food, Drug, and Cosmetic Act.
  - Erectile dysfunction drugs (when used for sexual dysfunction)
  - Non-prescription drugs
  - Some off label use drugs
  - Part B covered drugs

Part D plans are permitted to offer supplemental benefits that cover certain drugs not covered under Part D such as erectile dysfunction drugs.

community, threatening what hard-won normalcy they've regained. "The Mercies" is infuriating, baleful, but full of stubborn hope.


