
news outlets have lost their credibility due to some inaccurate and biased articles. That makes many consumers want to circle back to newspapers because it has a long history of trustable journalism.

A Small Art Museum That Gives Me So Much Happiness

On a late May Cincinnati day, I returned to the cozy Taft Art Museum near the banks of the majestic Ohio River. I appreciated the Taft Art Museum's fine collection of Dutch Paintings from the 17th and 19th



Centuries. From the 17th Century, I saw fine Dutch Master Portraits by Rembrandt, Frans Hals, and Govaert Flinck. I saw fine Dutch Master Genre Paintings by Gerard Terborch, Pieter de Hooch, Adrien Ostade, and Jan Steen. I was enamored with Dutch Master Landscape Paintings by Meindert Hobbema, Aert Van Der Neer, and Jacob Van Ruisdael. I also saw a stellar stillife by Balthazar Van Der Ast, "Stillife With Tilted Basket."

As for the Taft's collection of 19th Century Dutch Paintings, I saw delightful paintings primarily from the Hague School. The Hague School was greatly influenced by the French Barbizon School. 19th Century Dutch favorites included; Jan Van Weissenbruch's "Grey Day," Josef Israels' "Sewing





School Katiwijck," and Anton Mauve's "Sheep Grazing," among others. The Taft Art Museum has a fine collection of French Romantic and Realist Paintings from the early and middle 19th Century including paintings by Constant Troyon, Jean Millet, Camille Corot, Charles

Daubigny, Jules Dupre, and Narcise Diaz De La Pena, among others.

I was also very impressed with its 15th Century French Renaissance Period Enamel Paintings featuring fine works by Leonard Limousin, Pierre Courteys, Pierre Reymond, and Couly Nouailler. Other favorites of mine were Francisco Goya's "Queen Maria Louisa of Spain." Richard Bonington's "View Near Mantes," James McNeil Whistler's "At The Piano," Joseph Mallord William Turner's "Rape of Europa," Frank Duveneck's "Cobbler's Apprentice," and Spanish Impressionist Painter, Joaquin Sorrolla's "William Howard Taft."

The Taft Art Museum that day was open from 11:00 a.m. to 4:00 p.m. That was barely enough to see all of its special works of Art. Indeed, the Taft Art Museum is a less discovered treasure.





Dear Dr. Joy...

Some people might find it odd that I'm going to be writing about change to a group of seniors. I so often hear people saying that they are too old to change whether it is behavior, habits, feelings or points of view. You may

be surprised to hear that on my first day as a

psychology undergraduate student, in my first course, Psych 101, the Professor asked us to raise our hands if we had plans to become therapists. About 1/3 of the class raised their hands. He then asked us to write down what we believed would be the most difficult part of this career we were headed for. We all wrote our answers and he asked us to read them out loud. When we had completed that task, he told us we were all wrong and that we would one day find out that the hardest thing we would be doing was attempting to separate the client from the problem. How right he was. At first, we all thought he was joking with us. After all this, was the reason the clients were coming, wasn't it? Maybe yes, maybe no, but it was often excruciatingly difficult. Admitting the need for change was the easy part. Implementing that or any other change was another story altogether. These people did not have 50, 60, 70 or more years to become set in their ways. Mostly they were people between 25 and 45. So what is the issue with change and why do so many people find it a nearly impossible task?

It appears that our basic identity and outlook sets itself concretely at a very young age. We decide early on what we can or cannot do; what our basic abilities and talents are. We see ourselves as athletic or intellectual or funny or good at math or writing or music or performing or anything else....and we do this early on. Then we follow that path, even if at some point, we realize we don't like it or prefer something entirely different. We also decide how happy we are or how successful or how worthy or deserving or lucky and we then go about fulfilling that image as well. We usually succeed to the degree we see ourselves. These scripts are not fully conscious but they are not unconscious either. We then program our lives to carry out our plans.

So, when clients would come to therapy, there was often a push/pull going on in them. At a conscious level, they knew they wanted more out of their

lives than they were getting but they didn't fully realize that they were actually living according to a default plan. Their identities were tied up with these ideas that they held and the longer they held them, the more they believed and followed them. Separating them from these concepts, no matter how much they wanted to live and feel differently, was extremely difficult. They didn't seem to know who they would become and how they would navigate life as this new person.


So, without going into my methods for working with these individuals, these couples, these families, I would just like to ask my readers if any of this applies to you? Regardless of your chronological age or your thinking, that change takes a lot of time. Is there any change you would like to make in yourself or your life?

Is there something new you would like to try or is there another way you would like to present yourself to the world? Are there ideas that you realize you still hold that are not serving you but you don't know how to replace or rethink them or even where to start? What I've noticed by living in three different senior communities, is that there are differing ways that people retire. Some people decide to jump in and do all those things that they didn't have time to do when they are younger and working. Others do the same things but don't get paid for it anymore. They just take whatever expertise they had and use it in various ways in retirement. And some people just sit down. Perhaps you want to change what you are doing. What would that mean to you?

Why not write down your fantasy changes. Let your mind wander and see what comes up for you. It may be a small thing or something you think is way beyond you. Even if you don't implement any of them, it would be a great mind-expanding exercise. Note if there are any fears or trepidation in the mix and what they might be. Do this for fun. Don't even tell anyone if you don't feel comfortable. This is just for you. Play with it. I think I'll do it with you as well. Go for it....



Data Tracking Can Help Officers Bust The Bad Guys



The days of officers driving around in their assigned zones with no real direction on how to "patrol" those neighborhoods are long gone. The Coconut Creek Police Department has been using data to guide officers on when and where to be so they can patrol smarter in order to either prevent crime or catch the bad guys in the act. The official name for it is "data-driven policing." It's where police departments really study the

numbers and hone in on any patterns in order to try and predict where and when the bad guys might strike next.

Vehicle burglaries are a prime example of how data-driven policing can help reduce crime rates. After studying the past three months of vehicle burglary cases, officers now know the most likely method of entry, the neighborhoods where this particular crime is happening the most, and the best time and day of the week to be on the lookout for vehicle thieves.

Unfortunately, folks are still not learning to lock their cars. Of the nearly 60 theft from vehicle cases we investigated over the past three months, 74-percent of them were left unlocked; that's almost three out of every four cases. Of the neighborhoods where the most vehicle burglaries happened, Wynmoor Village was not one of them. Popular neighborhoods that vehicle burglars targeted ranged from the Winston Park area in the central part of the city to neighborhoods in

the southern portion bordering the Florida Turnpike and Margate.

Our statistics showed that vehicle burglars were most likely to strike on Wednesday mornings at 2:00 a.m. Vehicle burglars also pick way more targets during the nighttime hours since it is dark. There were far fewer residential vehicle burglaries reported between the hours of 10:00 a.m. and 8:00 p.m.

This knowledge helps officers know when and where they need to be in order to impact some of this crime. If a crime doesn't happen, it's really impossible to tell why the thief did not strike. Did he see the officer in the area during the peak day of the week and at the peak time? Or did the bad guys simply take the night off to watch basketball? We don't know. But what you can see from studying the data is the increase or decrease in reported crimes.

When it comes to residential vehicle burglaries, we are seeing a substantial reduction so far this year compared to last year. By the end of June in 2020, we had investigated 96 theft from vehicle cases. By the end of June this year, that number was down to 57. The reduction is attributable not only to the hard work of our officers but also to you. It goes to show that more and more of you are locking up your cars before you go to bed at night and removing any valuables from plain view.

It's also important to remember to lock it up when you are out at your favorite Coconut Creek eatery or at the grocery store. Our commercial theft from vehicles cases have ticked up slightly so far this year, meaning more of these cases are being reported from parking lots at businesses.

The bottom line is that you help us tremendously by locking your car doors at night. It's a good habit that we encourage you to make a routine, whether you're at home or out on the town.



Medical Breakthroughs

NervGen Pharma: A"Blockbuster Drug" in the Making?



(NAPSI)—More than 6 million people in the US live with Alzheimer's, and that number continues to increase each year. In 2021, Alzheimer's and other dementias will cost the nation \$355 billion. The Alzheimer's Association predicts those costs will rise to \$1.1 trillion by 2050.

The sceptics include Dr. George Perry, the editor-in-chief of the Journal of Alzheimer's Disease, the University Chair in Neurobiology at the University of Texas, San Antonio and one of the most published and cited researchers in the Alzheimer's field.

He believes that NervGen's potential for NVG-291 is a far more "exciting" and potentially effective treatment for Alzheimer's than Biogen's controversial new drug. "NervGen's drug candidate leverages a unique and powerful multimodal mechanism of action that has been shown in preclinical studies to increase both autophagy and plasticity while also reducing microglia inflammatory expression, representing an exciting new approach to treating Alzheimer's," says Dr. Perry.

It has the potential to be one of the most disruptive pharmaceutical drug therapies of the modern era, especially for treating Alzheimer's disease. And that gives it considerable "blockbuster drug" potential—a tantalizing

opportunity that is only now just becoming apparent.

This is due to the fact that NVG- 291 is designed to heal nerve damage by unleashing the body's natural ability to repair itself. Besides treating Alzheimer's disease, this new therapy has also shown considerable promise in preclinical studies in the treatment of multiple sclerosis and spinal cord injury.

According to Paul Brennan, NervGen's CEO, "NVG-291 has the potential to redefine how nervous system damage is treated across multiple indications, whether caused by trauma or chronic disease. This is an important first step to bringing this therapy to patients, and we look forward to completing our ongoing Phase 1 study and moving quickly to treating Alzheimer's patients."

A Breakthrough Therapy: How NVG-291 Works

Any time there is damage to the nervous system - whether via trauma such as spinal cord injury or traumatic brain injury, or a neurodegenerative disease such as Alzheimer's, MS or ALS - scar tissue is formed. The body releases chemicals called CSPGs (chondroitin sulfate proteoglycans) within the scar in order to reduce the damage.

They are initially helpful and play a protective role, but there is also a down-side to these CSPGs as over time they actually go from helping to obstructing the body's ability to repair itself.

NervGen's drug, NVG-291, releases this molecular inhibition, resulting in the initiation of multiple repair mechanisms including neuron regeneration, increased plasticity and "remyelination" —the process of replacing myelin, the tissue that often surrounds and protects neurons and which is often damaged as a result of diseases such as MS.

As a revolutionary treatment for Alzheimer's disease alone, NVG-291, has the potential to make NervGen a future star of the biotech sector. For instance, consider that Wall Street analysts are now estimating peak annual sales for Biogen's new drug will range from \$10 billion to \$50 billion.

It is well worth reiterating that no drugs have been approved anywhere in the world for nerve regeneration and remyelination, as well as improved plasticity in damaged nerves. 



2021 TRIM Notices

The Broward County Property Appraiser's Office mails the TRIM (proposed tax) Notices in August of each year. This is NOT a tax bill but a notice showing your 2021 just value, exemptions and proposed taxes as set by the various taxing authorities. The TRIM Notice is your opportunity to review your property's 2021 just value and ensure you are receiving all the tax-saving exemptions you are entitled to.

Our office does not set or collect property taxes. If you have questions about the proposed tax rates, the contact information and public hearing dates for the individual taxing authorities are listed to the right of each agency name on this notice.

I Recently Applied for Homestead Exemption - Why Is It Not Showing on my TRIM?

Florida Statutes require our office use January 1st as the date of assessment and to determine exemption eligibility each year. If you purchased your home after January 1, 2021, you are eligible for 2022 Homestead Exemption. The 2022 exemptions will show online in December and be included for the 2022 tax year.

I Had Homestead Exemption Last Year - Where Did My Exemptions Go This Year?

If you purchased your home in 2020, you may have "inherited" the

previous owner's exemptions last year. These 2020 exemptions would have been removed at the end of last year, so they are no longer showing on your TRIM Notice for tax year 2021. Fortunately, you can still late file for 2021 Homestead and any other exemptions you may qualify for until September 20, 2021. To apply online, please visit our website at https://web.bcpa.net/

I Am a Senior Citizen – Why Isn't the Senior Exemption Showing?

The Senior Exemption is both an age and income-based exemption that is not automatically applied to a property because of the income requirement. To be eligible for this exemption, an applicant must be age 65 or older as of January 1, 2021 and have an adjusted household gross income for 2020 not exceeding \$31,100. If you believe you qualify for this additional exemption, you can still late file until September 20, 2021. Recipe



Grandma's Homemade Potato Soup

Ingredients

2 pounds of russet potatoes, peeled and cut into large chunks (about 1-1/2 inch)

1/2 cup of chopped sweet onion

1/2 cup chopped celery

3 tablespoons all-purpose flour

Kosher salt and cracked black pepper, to taste 1/4 to 1/2 cup (1/2 to 1 stick) salted butter

Water to cover

1 (12 ounce) can evaporated milk Shredded cheese, for garnish, optional



Instructions

Toss the potatoes with the onion, celery, flour and salt and pepper; set aside for about 10 minutes.

Meanwhile melt the butter in a Dutch oven or soup pot. Add the potato mixture to the pot; stir to coat. Add enough water to cover the potatoes and bring to a boil; stir in the milk, reduce to a simmer, and cook, uncovered, stirring occasionally about 25 to 30 minutes, or until potatoes are tender. Taste, adjust salt and pepper, and continue cooking on simmer, uncovered, until the soup reach desired consistency and thickness. Garnish each serving with shredded cheese if you like and serve immediately.

Cook's Notes: May also substitute green onion. Use an immersion blender or potato masher to pure the potatoes, if a less chunky texture is desired.

Variation: Brown several slices of bacon, set aside and crumble. Add the potato mixture and proceed with the recipe. Garnish with crumbled bacon.

Potato Soup with Cajun Sausage: Slice one pound of andouille sausage into 1-inch slices and brown in oil; remove and set aside. Add butter to pot and continue with recipe.

Cheesy Ham and Potato Soup: Add in 2 cups of smoked ham, cubed with the potatoes. Just before serving, stir in 1-1/2 cups of shredded cheddar cheese, just until melted.

Instant Pot/Electronic Pressure Cooker: Prep potatoes as above and let rest. Use sauté function to melt butter, add potato mixture, toss to coat and top with water (or chicken broth) to cover, plus an inch. Stir in half of the milk. Seal and cook on high for 10 minutes. Let pressure release naturally. Open and mash some of the potatoes, if desired.

Stir in remaining milk and any additional chicken broth or water as needed to bring to desired consistency. Add cheese if using and garnish as desired.



Bullying Awareness



Bullying is an issue that needs to be addressed. According to the National Bullying Prevention Center, one out of every five students reports being bullied. Your children have or will come in contact with bullying, either by experiencing it

These could be signs that someone is being bullied. If you notice any changes, it is crucial to step in and help. Report every incident of bullying or suspicious behavior. Ensure your children are aware of these resources and


feel safe talking to you or a teacher:

Roslyn Hoffman was born in New York in 1917. She is 103 years old and described by so many of the people who know her here in Wynmoor as amazing. That is without them knowing some of the things I too found amazing about her background. In New York Ros was a songwriter. When I asked who she worked with, she asked me if I had ever heard of Tommy Dorsey and Dina Shore. Her modesty was exceptional. She worked extensively with both Tommy Dorsey and Dina Shore and I'm sure has some great stories.

In 1942 Ros was sent to Berlin with the army ground forces. Although sent in the capacity of publicist, she soon became leader of a band of 28 enlisted men and received the rank of captain which was a special honor for a woman and aided in the recognition of the capabilities of women. Dwight Eisenhower came to the base each month and Ros was invited to dinner with him each month. She was also invited, with him, to dinner with heads of state. She laughs about teaching Eisenhower to play Chop Sticks on the piano and modestly described him as a fatherly figure. More Fascinating stories.

After the war Ros lived in Massachusetts, married, and did volunteer work


for her temple, the Boy Scouts, and other organizations. In Wynmoor she was known as an excellent golfer and has won trophies. She played Canasta, joined a synagogue, and enjoyed many other Wynmoor activities. She was modest about her adventures and achievements unless directly asked. They were amazing. Ros is the reason I often urge you to go out and meet your neighbors. You will find many wonderful surprises.






How Does Touchline Work?

If we cannot reach anyone, we contact the local police department to perform a senior wellness check to confirm their safety.

HURRICANE PREPARATION

Hurricane Watches vs. Warnings

A HURRICANE WATCH issued for your part of the coast indicates the possibility that you could experience hurricane conditions within 36 hours. This watch should trigger your family's disaster plan, and protective measures should be initiated, especially those actions that require extra time such as securing a boat, leaving a barrier island, etc.

A HURRICANE WARNING issued for your part of the coast indicates that sustained winds of at least 74 mph are expected within 24 hours or less. Once this warning has been issued, your family should be in the process of completing protective actions and deciding the safest location to be during the storm.

Tropical Storm Watches and Warnings: Takes these alerts seriously. Although Tropical Storms have lower wind speeds than Hurricanes, they often bring life-threatening flooding and dangerous winds. Take precautions!

Other Tips For Seniors

- Stock up on food and water supplies before or early in the Hurricane Season.
- Have at least a one-week supply of your medications (two-week supply is better).
- Stay aware of weather conditions.
- Make all plans in advance.
- If you need to evacuate, team up with a partner, neighbor or relative and plan together.
- Have an easy-to-carry storage container filled with basic necessities available, so in the event of an evacuation, you can grab the container and leave quickly.
- Select a room for your hurricane shelter. Make sure it has no windows, is near the center of your home and has no outside walls.
- If you need to evacuate, listen to the radio for locations of emergency shelters (610 AM, 850 AM, 97.3 FM or 100.7 FM), use travel routes specified by local officials.
- Have a list of emergency phone numbers near your phone. Also, choose one out-of-state friend or relative to contact who will let others know you are safe.
- Make sure to keep your important documents in a waterproof container.
- Turn off all switches in your fuse box but leave air-conditioning on!


Remember: The Security Emergency Number is 954-978-2663 Should Be The First Number Called For NON-911 Emergencies. For Life-Threatening Emergencies, Always Dial 911 First. (Note: Emergency Vehicles May Not Respond Until The Storm Has Passed)

As with every hurricane season regardless of forecast, knowing the essentials of how to prepare could truly be a life saver. Below is a list of items needed for this season. The season officially starts on June 1st and ends on November 30th.

Planning For Emergencies

Emergency kits are important when you no longer have access to electricity, clean water supply, or are required to evacuate:

- Supply of bottled water (at least a gallon/day, per person)
- Ready to eat nonperishable foods
- Telephone NOT requiring electricity
- Disposable plates/cups/utensils
- Flashlight with extra batteries
- Portable radio with extra batteries
- Extra set of car keys
- Credit cards/cash
- First aid kit
- Garbage bags
- Manual can opener
- Change of clothing/shoes per person
- Extra glasses/contacts
- Whistle to attract attention
- Survival blanket per person
- Special medicines/items for all persons
- Entertainment items (non-electrical, like books, puzzles, etc.)



New Durable Power Of Attorney Is Important To Protect You

A Durable Power of Attorney is an extremely important document that every adult in Florida should have. You appoint one or more Agents to act on your behalf for virtually all legal and financial matters. The Durable Power of Attorney is most often utilized if you become incapacitated; however, I have many clients who choose to allow someone trustworthy to act on their behalf just to make life less complicated. The Durable Power of Attorney can be used for such diverse jobs as paying bills, signing contracts, buying and selling real estate, making investments, collecting monies owed and most other matters of a legal or financial nature. It does not cover any medical decisions, for which Florida Law requires a Designation of Health Care Surrogate. It also does not cover "pulling the plug," for which

a Written Declaration, otherwise known as a Living Will, is required. If you have never done a Durable Power of Attorney, it is extremely important to contact a lawyer to prepare the document as soon as possible. However, if you have a Durable Power of Attorney and it was done before October 1, 2011, it is strongly advisable to prepare a new one. You may also have a document done after October 1, 2011 but in the old format. This may also need to be redone.

A comprehensive law regarding the Durable Power of Attorney became effective on October 1, 2011. The law does provide that any Durable Power of Attorney executed under Florida Law before October 1, 2011 will remain valid. However, in the last few years, many financial institutions are refusing to honor old Durable Power of Attorneys, particularly more than ten years old. There can also be substantial delays involved if your Agent attempts to use an old Durable Power of Attorney, since they are being reviewed by the legal departments of the institutions prior to being allowed. The older your Durable Power of Attorney is, the more likely it will undergo scrutiny and may be rejected.

The new law requires that you specifically initial many different types



of powers in order for your Agent to be able to perform that duty. The banks, brokers, life insurance companies and other institutions are much more comfortable with this detailed Durable Power of Attorney, since it is clear what you want your Agent to do.

Under the new law, you can choose to name two people to act as Co-Agents. You then designate whether you allow them to act independently (only one signature necessary) or require that they act together (two signatures necessary). Your designated Agents will also need to sign an acceptance agreeing to act.

The new format of the Durable Power of Attorney is much more extensive and complicated (ours is 26 pages); therefore, if you did a Power of Attorney years ago, expect to pay more for the new one.

The Durable Power of Attorney remains valid until you die. It is against the law for your Agent to use it (to withdraw funds, sell real estate, etc.) after your death. At that point, your Will or Revocable Living Trust will take effect.

It is also very important to have an updated Living Will and Designation of Health Care Surrogate which includes HIPAA compliant language.

This article summarizes a few of the basic aspects of the Durable Power of Attorney. It is recommended that you contact an attorney for review of any documents that you currently have.

Americans Ready To Vacation With A Vengeance To Make Up For Lost Time



(NAPSI)—One of the many long-lasting effects of the pandemic is a shift in the work-life balance. According to a survey by a world leader in travel deals, after a long year of sheltering at home, 92% of Americans plan to travel in 2021—and they don't plan to hold back.

Shoulda, Woulda, Coulda:
Americans Reflect on Missed Experiences
Americans traveled less in 2020, and they
have been feeling the loss in more ways than one:

- Seventy-one percent of Americans didn't travel at all or traveled less in 2020 than in a typical year.
- Only 1 in 5 used all of their paid time off (PTO) in 2020, 19 percent because their company was too busy for them to be away and 29 percent because they wanted to save their time in case they or a loved one got sick.
- More than half regret not taking more time off in 2020. They feel they "wasted" their newfound flexibility and regret not working from different places.

"We've all felt the very real burnout that happens when we don't take the time to recharge and that's exactly why travel is so important." "Traveling is invigorating—it offers a respite from the daily grind, allowing us to disconnect and look at things with fresh eyes."

A Lesson Learned: The Power of PTO

Many Americans have a renewed appreciation for how beneficial PTO can be. "Taking time off is important for both employees and companies. Employees who use their PTO are happier, healthier, and more productive," adds Dente.

• Most associate positive feelings with taking time off from work, saying it makes them feel relaxed, happy, and excited.

- Most people, especially parents, say their mental health (78% of parents, 53% of non-parents) and physical health (73% of parents, 48% of non-parents) would have benefited from taking a break.
- Two-thirds of those with a fixed number of PTO days plan on using more vacation and personal days in 2021 than in any other year—ever.
- Meanwhile, an overwhelming majority (82%) say they're likely to use their remaining 2021 vacation days before the end of the year, and one in six (16%) plan to use all their days off for one vacation.

So how are Americans traveling and where are they going?

- Sixty-two percent of those with limited PTO will be vacationing in a place they've never been before.
- Sixty-one percent of those with limited PTO will take a trip based on a personal passion.
 - One in three will embark on a road trip.
- Thirty-two percent plan to visit family or friends because the pandemic made them realize how important those moments are.
 - More than half plan to tackle destinations on their bucket lists.

Money Still Matters

As they plan these trips, however, saving money is more important than ever, with 74% agreeing that travel deals are important.

Things to Remember Before an Acupuncture Appointment

Each of us is different and not everyone responds to acupuncture in the same way or time frame. There are few hard and fast rules when it comes to preparing for an acupuncture treatment but there are some guidelines which tend to improve the treatment experience and outcome for most people. Here they are:

Schedule Wisely

Avoid scheduling acupuncture before or after something really strenuous. You don't need to be sedentary on either side of an appointment, but nor should you be going

nuts at the gym or suffering through an extremely stressful meeting. Also avoid sandwiching -- squeezing in acupuncture immediately between two other events -- as this has a tendency to make you either late for or stressed out during your treatment.

Eat

This is an important one, and it's something I get asked about a lot. Everyone metabolizes food at different rates, so adjust as you see fit, but a good guideline is to eat about two hours before an acupuncture appointment. You don't want to show up really full, or after having eaten something heavy, fried or spicy, but do not go for acupuncture on an empty stomach. It can leave you feeling lightheaded or physically depleted. If you're debating whether it's too close to your appointment to eat, eat. Better to be a little full than distracted by hunger during your appointment.

Coffee Is Not Your Friend

That is not to say that coffee is never your friend, but coffee is not your friend immediately before acupuncture. If you have a morning appointment and can't go without your morning cup, do what you have to do. But if you're going for acupuncture later in the day, avoid coffee for at least two hours before.

Coffee is a stimulant. It has been shown to increase sympathetic nerve activity, kicking your body into fight-or-flight mode. Acupuncture works to shift you away from that sympathetic (fight-or-flight) state and toward a parasympathetic (rest-and-digest) one, so coffee inhibits the process. It also makes it difficult for the acupuncturist to get accurate readings on your pulse and tongue, since coffee increases your heart rate and stains your tongue.

Neither Is Alcohol

One of acupuncture's greatest gifts is its ability to help us bring more awareness to how we feel. Impairing the senses with alcohol is not helpful.

Wear Loose Clothing

This is so the acupuncturist can easily access the points for stimulation. If possible, wear, or bring with you a pair of shorts and short-sleeved top to allow for easy access to arms and legs.

Turn Off Your Cellphone

Last but not least, please turn off your phone. Not on vibrate. Off. Do it before your appointment actually starts, to avoid forgetting and/or getting distracted by a call or message immediately before you're about to begin.

The very last thing you want is for your acupuncturist to be startled or distracted by your phone ringing in the middle of a treatment. This is your time and no one else's. Make it count.



- When you are having trouble, contact Comcast Bulk Services at 1-866-405-9365. Please advise the representative to scroll from the bottom of the screen and check the "NOTES," which will instruct them on what services WCC is entitled to.
- The representative will be able to customize your service to meet your needs, including adding HD (for an additional fee), desired TV channels beyond basic, internet at various speed levels, and phone service.
- Our agreement allows 4 TVs to connect to Comcast (2 big boxes and 2 small boxes).
- A fee for a service call will be waived when your services are not working. If something was not broken, but if you needed help anyway, there will be a fee for the service call.
- If Comcast equipment needs to be returned, you can take it to any UPS store and they will mail it back to Comcast for free, or you can go to a Comcast store.
- If your boxes are older than 2 years, it is time to exchange them for newer models.






