## **Veterans Receiving the Full Exemption for Service-Connected** Total and Permanent Disability May be Eligible for a Refund

A recent change in Florida law allows for certain disabled veterans to receive a property tax refund. While the refund requirements are very specific, some property owners receiving the Full Veteran's Exemption for Total and Permanent Service-Connected Disability may be eligible for a refund on their new homesteaded property's taxes. Effective tax year 2021, homesteaded property owners receiving the Full Veteran's Exemption for Total and Permanent Service Connected Disability on a newly acquired Florida property - who also received the Full Exemption for Total and Permanent Service Connected Disability on another Florida property in the immediately preceding tax year - may be eligible to receive a partial refund of the ad valorem taxes paid for the newly acquired property in the year the property is acquired, prorated as of the date of transfer of ownership.

This article is basically a rerun from a few years back, but it is still relevant.

I was asked a question a while back and at that time I realized that I didn't really give an answer to the part of the question regarding spending time alone.

Not really knowing how you feel it is somewhat difficult to answer you directly so I'll do a few different scenarios. If a person is depressed and staying home and alone for days on end without having any personal contact, this is something that needs to be addressed professionally. Especially if the person is not eating well, not showering, and/or sleeping a great deal. This is obviously symptomatic of emotional decline or trauma.

If this is the case with you or anyone you know, please do not hesitate to let your primary care physician know so a mental health professional can be brought in. Medication may be appropriate, but this would be after an evaluation by a clinical psychologist or psychiatrist. Only the psychiatrist who is an M.D. can prescribe medication, but it can be at the suggestion of the psychologist.

If this is not the situation, let's look at others. There are times when, as in the original question, you just don't want to deal with the negativity or intrusiveness of others and find yourself withdrawing from contact. The issue here would be how often and for how long. If you enjoy your home and your own company and find it peaceful and relaxing that's great. If you have things to do alone that are enjoyable to you and you get real pleasure from this, once again no problem at all. If you do this part of your day or a few days a week while seeing other people at other times and find yourself having a good time with them, this is the perfect balance for you. Everyone is different. Sometimes it's problematic when you are alone all the time and on the other hand some people cannot be alone at all and that is just as problematic. A frantic obsession with needing people to eat every meal with or go shopping or having to be busy constantly with others says quite a lot about a fear of being alone. Once again, everyone has different needs and enjoyments.

You mentioned that your children think you are alone too much. Have you asked them why they think this? Perhaps they think you aren't feeling well and that's why you are not as busy. Remember they have known you all their lives and they may be seeing changes in you that concern them. Have you told them you are tired of people's negativity or problems and want to avoid listening to them speaking about them? They would probably understand that as they most likely have people like that in their own lives. I know I was so busy when I was younger between work, family, home, travel, entertainment, etc. that it was easier to avoid unpleasant people.

I see that my own daughters seem to feel better when they think I am busy and engaged. Even if I spend a lot of time alone (which I do), they know I am writing an article or another book or reading or watching something I really enjoy on TV and that I still see people at some point most days, play Mah Jongg, etc. Let your children know you are enjoying your time alone and on the lookout for more positive, interesting people to spend your time with. Only you know if there is more to your being alone than you have said. Maybe you do feel fatigued or lethargic and just can't seem to get yourself going. Maybe when people discuss their problems with you, you are too empathic and take it on yourself and this is draining. There is a difference of being compassionate and being empathic. Compassion is feeling for another person while empathy is taking it on yourself and actually feeling their pain (or pleasure, but that's pretty good). You don't want to take on someone else's pain and if the only way you can avoid doing this is to withdraw, then that is a great solution. Being a compassionate, caring person is different as long as you remember you don't have to fix anything for them and that your being there is enough. But if you find yourself taking on their burden, then that is your cue to leave, be alone and re-group.

I think what made me a good therapist during my working years was my ability to not collapse into the client's pain. Only by keeping my boundaries and perspective was I able to be of assistance to them.

There is quite a bit of information here so take from it what you find helpful and leave the rest. If you have a follow-up question, I would be happy to address it.



### **How Does Social Security Fit Into Retirement?**

Here's something to think about: You could spend two, or even three, decades in retirement. To meet your income needs for all those years, you'll generally need a sizable amount of retirement assets. How will Social Security fit into the picture?

For most people, Social Security won't be enough to cover the cost of living in retirement. Nonetheless, Social Security benefits are still valuable, so you'll want to do whatever you can to maximize them.

Your first move is to determine when you should start taking Social Security. You can begin collecting benefits when you reach 62 – but should you? If you were to turn 62 this year, your payments would only be about 71% of what you'd get if you waited until your full retirement age, which is 66 years and 10 months. ("Full retirement age" varies, depending on when you were born, but for most people today, it will be between 66 and 67.) Every month you wait between now and your full retirement age, your benefits will increase. If you still want to delay taking benefits beyond your full retirement age, your payments will increase by 8% each year, until you're 70, when they "max out." Regardless of when you file, you'll also receive an annual cost-of-living adjustment.

So, when should you start claiming your benefits? There's no one "right" answer for everyone. If you turn 62 and you need the money, your choice might be made for you. But if you have sufficient income from other sources, you're in good health and you have longevity in your family, or you're still working, it might be worthwhile to wait until your full retirement age, or perhaps even longer, to start collecting.

Another key consideration is spousal benefits. If your own full retirement

benefit is less than 50% of your spouse's full retirement benefit, you would generally be eligible to claim spousal benefits, provided you're at least 62 and your spouse has filed for Social Security benefits.


Survivor benefits are another important consideration. When you pass away, your spouse would be able to receive up to 100% of your benefit or his/her own retirement benefit, whichever is higher. Thus, delaying Social Security could not only increase your own benefit, but also the benefit for your surviving spouse.

An additional issue to think about, when planning for how Social Security fits into your retirement, is your earned income. If you're younger than full retirement age, your benefit will be reduced by \$1 for each \$2 you earn above a certain amount, which, in 2021, is \$18,960. During the year you reach full retirement age, your benefit will be reduced by \$1 for each \$3 you earn above a set amount (\$50,520 in 2021). But once you hit the month at which you attain full retirement age, and from that point on, you can keep all of your benefits, no matter how much you earn (although your benefits could still be taxed).

One final point to keep in mind: The more you accumulate in your other retirement accounts, such as your IRA and 401(k) or similar employer-sponsored plan, the more flexibility you'll have in managing your Social Security benefits. So, throughout your working years, try to contribute as much as you can afford to these plans.

# Gift Cards Are A Deal Breaker

In reviewing a lot of the scams involving Wynmoor residents lately, I've noticed that some folks are still buying gift cards and then giving all the numbers on the front and back of those cards to the bad guys. When someone asks you to buy gift cards it's always a scam. As I write this, I've seen reports of this happening at least two times in the past couple of weeks in

Wynmoor, with both scams involving Amazon.

I remember when Amazon used to only sell books. Boy how that has changed! Now I could make a convincing argument that Amazon has brought about the biggest changes in market structure and buying habits since Walmart's initial rise during the 1980s.

As more and more people use Amazon to simply order what they used to pick up at the store and have it delivered to their doorstep, more and more of these fraudsters will make a scam out of it. In both cases I mentioned earlier, the scammers posed as Amazon employees. They called up the victims out of the blue and insisted that someone was doing something nefarious with their Amazon accounts, like supposedly buying something they shouldn't be buying.

The bad guys basically then tell the victims that everything can be

made nice by going to a store, buying gift cards, and then giving them the numbers on all those gift cards. In many cases, the scammers will stay on the phone with the victim the entire time. They'll direct them to a nearby store that they know sells the type of gift cards they want, and then be on the phone with them as they're paying for them at the register.

Once the victims' give them the numbers on each card, they immediately drain the card of all the money. I can't write this enough times: When someone asks you to buy gift cards to pay for something, it's always a scam.

And I hear all the time: "I can't believe these people still fall for this!"

Well, I can. It must work or all of these crooks wouldn't keep using it. We are familiar with these types of scams because they work so well. The scammers prey off the fear they create in the minds of their victims. Anxiety is an uncomfortable thing and a lot of times we'll make choices we wouldn't ordinarily make in order to relieve that very disagreeable feeling.

The bad guys know this and they'll use it against you.

The best thing we can do is get the word out that if you are ever asked to buy gift cards, it's a scam. Just hang up. End the conversation. In the scam prevention context, gift cards are a deal breaker. Legitimate businesses would never ask you to buy them. The bad guys do because it's the fastest way for them to get their hands on your hard-earned money.

We are coming out of a difficult and almost unbelievable time, but remember, we are not there yet. For some the transition has been an easy one but for most not so. I am no longer glued to the TV set and the news. I am not constantly debating politics with friends and realize more clearly that no matter how I feel they feel equally strongly and we both can back up our opinions. I have tried to put aside my outrage and horror over some of the social unrest and racism and begun to think more clearly about what small part I can play to help make some positive change. When I started going outside again the colors seemed brighter and the birds songs more melodious. I had taken so much for granted and perhaps needed a pause. I have learned from this last year to take nothing for granted.







### **Appreciating Quality Art** *In Ohio's Capital City, Columbus*

On a hot late May day, I returned to Columbus and the Columbus Museum of Art. The last time I was in the Columbus Museum of Art was fifteen years ago. This art museum has a fine collection of 19th and 20th Century paintings and works of Art, primarily by French and American Artists. Its collection of Old Master Paintings on display was very small. I saw a delightful temporary exhibit, pertaining to the paintings and artistic creations of Aminah Robinson, a native Columbus Artist.

In spite of its limited collection of Old Master Paintings on display, I saw fine Renaissance Period paintings with devotional subject matter by Jan Van Oostansen ("Lamentation"), Jan Joost Von Kalkar ("Virgin and Child With Saint Anne"), and Barthel Bruyn the Elder ("Saint Sebastian"). Their earlier paintings from the Late Medieval Period were not on display (paintings by Caterino Veneziano, Jacopo dei Casentino, etcetera). I saw fine Baroque Period Paintings by Peter Paul Rubens and Studio ("Christ triumphant over Sin and Death"), Jacob Jordaens ("Saint John the Baptist"), fine Tenebrism, Cornelis de Man ("Church Interior, Oude Kerk, Delft"), Abraham Willemsens ("Peasants by Country Inn"), Christyn Lucykx ("Stillife"), Joseph Marie Vien ("Venus attacked by Diomedes And Helped by Iris, the Rainbow Goddess"), and Francois Boucher ("Vertumus and Pomona"), among others.


I appreciated splendid 19th Century French Paintings by Camille Corot ("View of St. Lo"), Charles Daubigny, Francois de Neuville ("Samuel Annointing David"), an exemplar of the French Academy Style), Eugene Boudin ("Bordeaux") Claude Monet ("Mediterranean", awesome French Impressionist work), Pierre Renoir ("Mrs. Lerolle Embroidering"), Camille Pissarro ("StoneBridge and Barges On River") and Mary Casatt (American, "Portrait of Lady"), among others. I also saw fine sculpture by Auguste Rodin ("Age of Bronze").

I relished delightful 20th Century Paintings by Andre Derain ("Portrait of Etienne Terrus, splendid Pointillism"), Maurice de Vlaminck ("In the Forest"), Pablo Picasso ("Stillife With Compote and Glass"), Juan Gris, Georges Braque, Paula Modersohn-Becker, Ernst Ludwig Kirschner ("Landscape with Fehmann Mountains With Nudes"), the epitome of German Expressionism), Alexei Jawlensky ("Portrait of Shokko"), and James Ensor ("Assassination"), among others.

I was especially fascinated with their paintings by the following 20th Century American Painters; Thomas Cole ("Cascatelli Falls, Tivoli"), Marsden Hartley ("Cosmos"), Lyonel Feininger ("Cathedral"), Charles Demuth (Splendid American Precisionism), George Tooker ("Cornice"), George Bellows ("Summer Night, Riverside Drive"), Rockwell Kent ("Men and Mountains"), Jacob Lawrence ("Street Scene"), Archibald Motley ("African American Girl Looking in Mirror," Harlem Renaissance), Ernest Lawson ("Hills of Inwood"), Joe Jones ("Threshing") Frank Stella ("Vecchia Dell Orto"), Benny Andrews ("Watchers"), and Kehinde Wiley, among others. I also saw quality glass creations by Dale Chihuly, Lino Tagliapietra, Christopher Ries ("Sunflower"), and Emily Brock ("50's Diner"), among others.

The Columbus Museum of Art's temporary exhibit relating to Columbus Artist, Aminah Robinson was very special. I enjoyed her paintings

depicting African American life in Columbus, Ohio such as "Franklin Park Sunday Outing," "Christmas Day in the Poindexter Homes,"



### **Avoiding Probate on Your Home!**

There are several ways to avoid probate on your home when you die. If you are single, there will be probate when you die unless you choose one of the following options. If you are married and own your home together, your surviving spouse will not have probate; however, there will be probate when the second of you passes away, unless one of these options is done.

Let us assume that you own your home jointly with your spouse and that you have two children. Both of you desire to have your two children inherit your home equally when you both pass away.

The first option would be to add the names of your two

children to the Deed as joint tenants with right of survivorship. This is not a good idea. It would affect your ability to claim your full homestead exemption. In addition, you lose control of your property and can only sell it if your children both agree and sign all closing documents. If you wanted to take one of the children off the Deed, you would be unable to do so. If one of your children files for bankruptcy, has an adverse judgment or files for divorce, your property could be subject to liens or other legal action. Therefore, I recommend against a Deed with your children as joint tenants with right of survivorship.

The second option is a Life Estate Deed. There are two types of Life Estate Deeds: regular and Enhanced (also referred to as Lady Bird). The regular Life Estate Deed requires that your children join in any sale or other changes on the Deed; therefore, you have lost control and cannot take your child's name off the Deed if you choose to do so. The Enhanced Life Estate Deed gives you the sole right to sell the property during your lifetime or make any other changes to the Deed without the permission of your child. The Enhanced Life Estate Deed has very specific legal language in order to be effective; therefore, do not attempt to do this on your own. Even with the Enhanced Life Estate Deed, there are risks, particularly



if your child has a bankruptcy, outstanding judgment or undergoes divorce. The worst risk, however, is if, God forbid, your child dies before you or with you in a common accident. Your child's estate would then become the owner of the property once you died, which would result in probate being required. Thus, the main purpose of the Life Estate Deed is not accomplished.

The best way to avoid probate on your home is to do a Revocable Living Trust. When you sign the Revocable Living Trust Agreement, you also sign a Deed transferring the property to you as Trustees of your Trust. You are able to keep your homestead exemption,

maintain complete control of the property during your lifetime and make amendments to your Trust without changing the Deed. There are no risks involved, since your children's names do not appear on the Deed. The only disadvantage of the Revocable Living Trust is that it will cost more money in attorney's fees. When you discuss the options with your attorney, you should discuss the difference in fees between the Revocable Living Trust and the Enhanced Life Estate Deed. You can then determine whether it is worth saving the money and taking the risks involved in the Enhanced Life Estate Deed.

Since the Dwight Eisenhower administration and the end of World War II in 1945, the day has been celebrated as a national holiday, called Memorial Day.

### **A Nutter Putter**

Years ago, the industry standard was a soft cover golf ball and had a soft feel off the putter. I remember the balata ball as the softest. At some point possibly because the balls would cut and abrade so easily, the golf manufacturers started selling a two piece and harder golf ball.

After some inquiring, the word was the tour players did not like the feel and action

the harder ball had when putting. The club manufacturers then started making an insert of some plastic or polymer to get back that "butter" feel of the ball coming off the face. The first company I can remember selling that new insert was Odyssey by Calloway. Currently, all companies are making the putters with various inserts to retain that old "soft" feel.

The two pictures displayed in the photo show the older style and the other photo has the new insert from Odyssey.

Either putter requires proper alignment and feel for the distance of the putt to be successful. Make more putts this summer!
