

5 2021 Hurricane Forecast **5**

Extended Range Forecast of Atlantic Seasonal Hurricane Activity and Landfall Strike Probability for 2021

The Colorado State University (SCU) anticipates that the 2021 Atlantic Basin Hurricane Season will have above-normal activity. Current weak La Niña conditions may transition to neutral ENSO by this summer/fall, but the odds of a significant El Niño seem unlikely. Sea surface temperatures averaged across the tropical Atlantic are currently near average, while subtropical Atlantic sea surface temperatures are warmer than normal. It is anticipated that an above-average probability for major hurricanes making landfall along the continental United States coastline and in the Caribbean. As is the case with all hurricane seasons, coastal residents are reminded that it only takes one hurricane making landfall to make it an active season for them. They should prepare the same for every season, regardless of how much activity is predicted.

They predict 17 named storms with the Atlantic Hurricane Season 2021. That is 40 percent (5 named storms) more than an average hurricane season.

The 2021 Hurricane names are: Ana, Bill, Claudette, Danny, Elsa, Fred, Grace, Henri, Ida, Julian, Kate, Larry, Mindy, Nicholas, Odette, Peter, Rose, Sam, Teresa, Victor, Wanda.

You won't be hearing the Greek alphabet anymore if the season produces more than 21 named storms. Since Eta, Theta and Zeta sounded so familiar, they were confusing to some, especially those that speak other languages across the Caribbean. They have been replaced by a reserve list that will remain unchanged. See Below:

Hurricane Season Expected To Be Above Average Again

Hurricane season started June 1st. Most storm experts are expecting another "above average" season. So it's time to get prepared now so you don't have to be so worried later. For those of you who were around for the aftermath of Wilma, you may well remember that the lights did not come back on for well over three days.

If we get in the area of a Hurricane Watch, your preparations should begin. Fill the car up with gas. Make sure your hurricane kit is ready to go. Refill any prescription medications. Listen to City officials on if and when to put up shutters. Make sure your roadways or debris. Also, never run your generator indoors.

The City will keep you up-to-date on all watches and warnings through social media and our CocoAlerts, which you can sign up for by visiting the "hurricane information" page on the City's website, which is www.coconutcreek.net. You can also type in "hurricane" in the search engine at the top right of our page and it will allow you to easily navigate to the hurricane information page. You will be able to easily find shelter information on our hurricane page, including shelter information for people with special needs. The City also activates and updates a Hurricane Hotline when we are facing the possibility of a storm. The number is 954-973-6771. It is also a good idea to write important phone numbers, like that one, on a sheet of paper and hang it up where you can see it, say on your refrigerator, in case you need it. We have been fortunate that Coconut Creek has not taken any major hits from any named storms over the years. Let's hope it stays that way during this hurricane season.

It all starts with getting together a hurricane kit. It should include essentials such as water, nonperishable food items, a place to keep your valuable papers, money and credit cards, and a first-aid kit. Keep it some place where you will remember it, and it's easy to get to. You also want to make it portable, in the sense that you can grab it and go if you need to.

Speaking of supplies, it is strongly recommended that you have seven days of supplies built up before the storm hits. Among the valuable lessons we learned back in 2005, from Hurricane Wilma, is that we need a lot more supplies than the nationally recommended three days' worth in case of a storm. generator is working and you have enough gas to run it.

If a Hurricane Warning is issued, fill up your bath tub and jugs with water. Optimally, you want to have at least a gallon of water per person per day. Get ready in case the power goes out. Think about which room in your home is the safest and stay there when the storm hits.

After the storm hits, it's important to remember to stay inside until the "all clear" is given. Never touch any low-hanging wires or downed power lines. Report those downed lines to your utility company and the police. When driving after the hurricane hits, allow yourself extra time to get to your destination in case you encounter obstacles such as damaged

departments within BSO. This protocol ensures if we find problems, we work toward developing viable solutions. We are designing the OIG with transparency in mind. Our focus is to work more cohesively, fiscally responsible and operationally sound.

The OIG encompasses three divisions:

• The *Division of Internal Affairs and Public Corruption* ensures we thoroughly and objectively investigate allegations of misconduct



against employees.

• The *Division of Internal Audit* identifies ways BSO can operate more efficiently and be fiscally accountable.


• The *Division of Policy and Accountability* conducts ongoing independent reviews of internal departments to ensure we exceed public safety standards.





Even "Singles" Need Estate Plans

If you don't have a spouse or children, you might think you don't need to do much estate planning. But if you have any assets, any familial connections, any interest in supporting charitable groups – not to mention a desire to control your own future – you do need to establish an estate plan.

In evaluating your needs for this type of planning, let's start with what might happen if you die intestate – that is, without a last will and testament. In this scenario, your assets will likely have to go through the probate process, which means they'll be distributed by the court according to your state's intestate succession laws, essentially without regard to your wishes. Even if you don't have children yourself, you may have nephews or nieces, or even children of cousins or friends, to whom you would like to leave some of your assets, which can include not just money but also cars, collectibles, family memorabilia and so on. But if everything you own goes through probate, there's no guarantee that these individuals will end up with what you wanted them to have.

If you want to leave something to family members or close friends, you will need to indicate this in your last will and testament or other estate planning documents. But you also may want to provide support to one or more charitable organizations. Of course, you can simply name these charities in your will, but there may be options that could provide you with more benefits.

One such possibility is a charitable remainder trust. Under this arrangement, you'd transfer appreciated assets – such as stocks, mutual funds or other securities – into an irrevocable trust. The trustee, whom you've named – in fact, you could serve as trustee yourself – can then

sell the assets at full market value, avoiding the capital gains taxes you'd have to pay if you sold them yourself, outside a trust. Plus, if you itemize, you may be able to claim a charitable deduction on your taxes. With the proceeds, the trust can purchase income-producing assets and provide you with an income stream for the rest of your life. Upon your death, the remaining trust assets will go the charities you've named.

Aside from family members and charitable groups, there's a third entity that's central to your estate plans: yourself. Everyone should make arrangements to protect their interests, but, in the absence of an immediate family, you need to be especially vigilant about your financial and health care decisions. And that's why, as part of your estate planning, you may want to include these two documents: durable power of attorney and a health care proxy.

A durable power of attorney lets you name someone to manage your finances should you become incapacitated. This arrangement is especially important for anyone who doesn't have a spouse to step in. And if you become incapacitated, your health care proxy – also known as a health care surrogate or medical power of attorney – lets you name another person to legally make health care decisions for you if you can't do so yourself.

Estate planning moves can be complex, so you'll need help from a legal professional and possibly your tax and financial advisors. You may not have an immediate family, but you still need to take steps to protect your legacy.

2021 Property Exemptions – It Is Not Too Late to Apply

While the timely deadline to apply for any 2021 exemption was March 1st, applicants can late file until September 20, 2021. If you both owned and made the property your permanent residence as of January 1, 2021, you can still apply for 2021 Homestead Exemption and any other exemptions. You can apply for Homestead Exemption online at web.bcpa.net as well as view all the other exemptions available to qualified applicants.

Portability Extended to Three Tax Years

Portability allows eligible Homesteaded property owners to pay less in property taxes on their new home by moving their "Save Our Homes" savings (up to \$500,000) from one Florida property to another Florida property when establishing Homestead Exemption on the new property. Beginning with property owners who establish a new Homestead Exemption for tax year 2021, applicants may now transfer portability savings from a Homestead Exemption held in any of the <u>three</u> immediately preceding tax years. To be eligible to move this SOH benefit, the new property must receive Homestead Exemption within three tax years – not calendar years – of the

"abandonment" of the Homestead Exemption at the previous property.

Note: Homestead Exemption and Portability do not automatically transfer. You must apply for Homestead Exemption on the new property <u>and</u> submit a Portability application. Portability does not require you sell your previous home, but merely for you to no longer receive the Homestead Exemption on it.

Disabled Veterans & Military Exemptions

Florida Statutes provide for several exemptions available to veterans with a service-connected disability, as well as the un-remarried surviving spouse of the disabled veteran. These exemptions require a Certificate of Disability from the US Government or US Department of Veterans Affairs be provided to our office. ON BREATHING - As our masks come off we are so aware that we can breathe again, both physically and psychologically.

ON LONLINESS - The last year has had lonely times. I have been so much more aware of missing friends and that phone calls did not suffice. I missed the physical closeness and the visual closeness enormously. On the positive side, I called and contacted people I hadn't seen in a long time and it felt like time had never passed. It was magical.

Perhaps equally importantly I found how much I liked having alone time. My ever-broken iPhone was often in trouble and I grew to sometimes enjoy the quiet time rather than being frustrated. I had never enjoyed just doing nothing before and discovered new meaning to taking a nap or just relaxing and doing nothing "meaningful." It was okay.

ON ANXIETY - I am increasingly surprised to hear some of the strongest people I know tell me they still feel anxiety and don't know why. I have pondered on this and wonder "Is it because "its" still not over? I wonder too, if we have grown up to feel relatively safe, whatever that means to each of us? Last year with Covid and all of the other political and social events swirling around it, we realized there was no certainty about anything.

Could this happen again? There is no longer a guarantee of safety. In this situation, low lying anxiety is not pathological. As much as it seems, things are going back to what is the new normal.

We can all try to reach out and like Mr. Rodgers be optimistic, kind and creating an even closer and better community.



On a glorious April Saturday, I returned to the Frick Art Museum in hilly, picturesque Pittsburgh. It has quality paintings from the Medieval, Renaissance, and Baroque Periods in its permanent collection.

It has a wonderful room featuring quality Medieval and Renaissance Period Paintings produced by Italian and Netherlandish Masters from the 13th, 14th, and early 15th Century. I saw 2 delightful Italian Byzantine Paintings that captivated me. Rainaldo Rainuccio Da Spoleto's "Madonna and Child Enthroned With Four Scenes of Passion" which employed egg tempera and silver leaf on wood panel and the Master of Schrovegni Chapel Presbytery's "Madonna and Child With Saints, Scenes From Life of Christ and Virgin" which employed egg tempera and gold leaf on wood panel. Both of these devotional theme paintings are very punctilious.

From the Italian Trecento,14th Century, I admired these fine paintings; Lippo Memmi's "Saint Agnes and Saint Anthony," Francesco Vannuccio's "Saint Catherine of Alexandria," Bernardo Daddi's portable triptych, "Madonna and Child With Saints Peter and Paul, Crucifixion, Annunciation," Master of San Sepolcro's "Angel With Crown of Thorns," and Biagio Goro Ghezzi's "Madonna and Child With Saints Catherine and John the Baptist." These paintings were done using egg tempera and emphatically using gold leaf on wood panel. Gold, during the Italian Trecento and Early 15th Century had an important religious significance, sacred light. There was a deadly Bubonic Plague Epidemic that ravished Italy, especially in Siena and Florence in the middle of the 14th Century. Lippo Memmi and Florentine Master, Bernardo Daddi died from the Bubonic Plague.

I appreciated its Renaissance Period Paintings by Giovanni Dei Paolo, especially his copious, "Nativity" and Sassetta's "Madonna and Child with Angels" featuring very brilliant gold leaf. I also relished some fine Netherlandish paintings from the Renaissance Period produced by Hans Vereycke, "Madonna and Child With Angel, Saints Catherine and Barbara" and Jean Bellegambe's "Virgin and Child With Rosary, Saint Bernard and Cistercian Monk." Netherlandish Renaissance Paintings depicted landscapes of Flanders in the backgrounds of the paintings on many occasions. I also saw a fine Late Italian Renaissance Period painting with marvelous light effects by Ubertini, also called Bacchiacca, "Madonna and Child With Saints Elizabeth and John the Baptist."

In another room, I relished the Frick's collection of Old Master paintings from 17th and 18th Century. I saw French Baroque Period Paintings employing oil paint by Lenain, "Blessing" Jean Pater, "Rest in Park," Nicolas Lancret, "Young Lovers in Landscape," Jean Nattier, "Queen of France," and Jean Boucher, "Peasant Boy Fishing," among others. In that room, I also saw excellent paintings by Dutch Master, Jan Steen, "Music Lesson" and Flemish Masters, Peter Paul Rubens, "Princess of Conde" and Jan Van Os, "Stillife With Fruit."

The Frick has a fine group of Flemish Tapestries from the 17th Century. I especially liked "The Musicians." I also saw fine glass creations by Contemporary Pittsburgh Artist, Vanessa German which are temporarily on display.

Admission to the Pittsburgh Frick Art Museum is free, but donations help



Revocable Living Trust Important For Out of State Prperty!

Many of my snowbird clients own a home in Florida and another state. Some of them have their homestead in Florida; others declare their legal residence in another state.

In either case, a Revocable Living Trust is very useful to avoid probate in both states. If you are a Florida resident, you can own your homestead property via a Revocable Living Trust without losing your homestead exemption. In addition, you are eliminating the need for probate when you pass away. You can also transfer real estate owned in any other state to your Florida Trust. Generally, a Florida lawyer will prepare the Revocable Living Trust and Quit Claim Deed to transfer the Florida

property into the Trust. If you are a Florida resident, the lawyer will also prepare a new Florida Last Will and Testament called a Pourover Will. This provides for the transfer to your Trust upon your death of any other assets not in the Trust or which do not have beneficiaries already designated. It is a security blanket to cover any assets payable to your Estate. For example, if you were killed in a car accident due to the negligence of another driver, your Personal Representative would be able to settle your Estate's claim and "pourover" the proceeds into your Trust.

If you are not a Florida resident, you can still create a Revocable Living Trust and execute a Quit Claim Deed to put your Florida property into the Trust. Your Last Will and Testament will be done by a lawyer in the state in which you have your legal residence. In addition, that lawyer can prepare a Deed to transfer the out of state property into the Florida Trust. You can also do the Trust in the other state and transfer your Florida property to that Trust.

For Canadian citizens, there are possible tax aspects to be considered before you create a Florida Trust. These should be discussed with your Canadian accountant or tax attorney. In general, you will have to weigh the



tax consequences versus the money and time that your heirs would save by avoiding probate in Florida.


Another favorable factor in creating a Revocable Living Trust is that you can always amend the Trust without having to change the Deed. In addition, once you create the Trust, you can always buy new properties in any state in the name of the Trust.

The Revocable Living Trust is recommended by most lawyers over a Deed which includes names of other persons, either as joint tenants, tenants in common or a Life Estate Deed. Once another person's name is on a Deed, there are potential risks to you and your property. These include the possibility that the other person may

undergo a divorce, bankruptcy, have a judgment against that person, or die before you or with you in a common accident. It may also affect your homestead exemption. All of these risks should be discussed with your attorney before deciding to put someone else's name on your Deed. By contrast, the Revocable Living Trust eliminates those risks, since no other name is on the Deed. You simply transfer it from yourself to yourself as Trustee of your Trust.

This article covers only some basics regarding Revocable Living Trusts and Deeds. For further information, please feel free to contact me. Belle was born Myra Maybelle Shirley in 1848 and grew up in a normal southern home. She was treated to good schooling where she learned Greek, Hebrew, and Latin. For the other side of her schooling, her older brother taught her how ride a horse and shoot guns. Though loved and cared for by her family, she preferred the wilder, dark side of life. She took to wearing two guns in holsters over her dress. She was known to be hot-headed and started fights with both females and males. Numerous times she wanted to settle those disagreements with a gun.

After the Civil War, her family moved from Missouri to Texas to start a new life. In 1866, she met Cole Younger who was a member of Jesse James' Gang. Belle eventually married Jim Reed who was also member of the Younger gang and she provided hideouts and provisions for the gang. James Reed was killed trying to escape authorities and after his death Belle joined the Star Gang and participated in bank robberies and rustling cattle. She eventually, married Sam Star, leader of the gang, who was later killed in a gunfight.


Bill July, an adopted son of Tom Starr, took up with Belle on her ranch, and they rented out parcels of land for income. Belle discovered one of her renters was wanted for murder in Florida, and she attempted to force him off her land. He refused at first, but finally left when she threatened to go to the authorities. Days later as she rode back to her ranch from a shopping trip in town, a blast from a shotgun in her back killed her. The murderer was never brought to trial.

WYNMOOR Golf and Tips By Kevin Battersby, PGA



Grip - Warning Sign - Danger

By far the most dangerous grip error in your lead hand is getting the club too much in your palm and not enough in your fingers which helps provide speed through your wrists at impact. A simple check of your golf glove wear pattern may warn you of this problem. If your glove tends to rip or wear too much by the heel of your hand and you have a loss of power

and speed this could be your problem. In addition to lack of power you might experience a slice or worse yet, a shank. The ball flight might be higher than normal and when playing in Florida windy conditions your losing distance on your approach and driver. The attached photo illustrates this golfers' glove and wear pattern. Yes, he had a big slice and no roll on his longer shots because of the left to right spin on the ball. The X on the glove should go more on the middle of the grip when getting the club more in your fingers. This new finger and hand grip provide for more wrist hinging and makes your release before impact sooner producing a nice draw. Take note of how much of the heel pad is on top of the grip in my left hand. From the top view you should see 2 to 2.5 knuckles on your left hand (right handed golfers) and the V between your forefinger and thumb points toward your right shoulder. A finger and hand grip in your lead hand will help create more crisp and powerful shots. Kevin Battersby - PGA





Question: "How will I be covered for an emergency by my Medicare Advantage or Supplement Plan if I am out of State?" If you have a Medicare Supplement Plan, you are covered the exact same way as your plan covers you here in South Florida. Regarding Prescription Drug Plans, there are "In Network" versus "Out of Network" Pharmacies and you may have higher co-pays if you go to an Out of Network Pharmacy. Many national Pharmacies such as Walgreens or CVS would offer In Network pricing for your prescription drug copays. If you run out of medications while you are away, your doctor may need to send a prescription to the pharmacy at your location and would need the pharmacy's address and/or store #. It is always a good idea to plan ahead and make sure you have enough medications to cover you through your trip.

If you have a **Medicare Advantage Plan** either HMO or PPO, you will be covered for emergencies nationwide as "In Network." Depending on the plan you have will determine what your copays will be. Here are some examples:

HMO – will cover you exactly how you are covered in South Florida, however, you are required to return home for any post follow up treatment and appointments to aid in your recovery. To further clarify, you will not be covered for any out of network appointments post an emergency or hospital stay. "In Network" is the "Service Area" of your HMO Plan. For many HMO Plans in our area, this usually includes your County of Residence, or depending on the Carrier, will include all of South Florida Dade, Broward and Palm Beach Counties. Most of the HMO plans in Broward County have a zero co-pay and no deductible for an inpatient hospital stay. If you have an emergency room visit, copays tend to range from \$80 to \$120. If you are moved from "observation" to inpatient, many plans will waive the emergency room fee.

PPO – will cover you exactly how you are covered in South Florida, however PPO plans provide "Out of Network" benefits for a higher co-pay. On PPO plans you can continue your recovery outside the state of Florida, but keep in mind that providers that are recommended by the hospital or emergency room may be Out of Network. To save money and find In

Network providers you can, 1) Visit the Provider Search Tool online with your Insurance Carrier, 2) Call your Insurance Agent for assistance or 3) Call Customer Service (# listed on the back of your card) for assistance. Many PPO plans in South Florida do not have a deductible, and inpatient hospital stay ranges from \$250 to \$300 per day for several days ranging



from 4 to 9 days. For more detailed explanation of benefits on your plan, please call your licensed insurance agent or customer service.

Keep in mind that these are examples only. To find the exact copay for your plan, refer to your Summary of Benefits. My best advice is to:

- 1) Find out what your benefits are in case of an emergency and prepare before heading out of town.
- 2) Bring a list of all of your physician's telephone #'s with you.
- 3) Bring enough medication supplies including future refills with you.
- 4) Bring your insurance agent's telephone # with you.

I hope this article can provide you with some guidance on obtaining access to care and understanding your benefits in case of an out of town medical emergency.

I hope everyone enjoys their summer and you get to spend time with your family and friends. When you return in early fall, we will be entering the Annual Election Period which starts October 15th through December 7th. That will be an Open Enrollment period, if you were interested in evaluating your benefits and consider making a change. All applications during that time will have an effective date of January 1, 2022.


In acupuncture terms, diseases like Covid-19, or any viral or bacterial ailment for that matter, is considered to be an external pathogen, or "evil Qi"




