CITY ELECTION Impacts Wynmoor Residents By Insider Staff

A city election will be held on March 9th, that will affect all Wynmoor residents. Voters will have the chance to elect three candidates who oppose expansion of the landfill as well as the expansion of the turnpike.

ISSUE ONE: The State of Florida has stated their interest in expanding the turnpike, which puts the turnpike wall five feet from the Wynmoor property line. During the past four years our city commissioners, including Josh Rydell and Sandra Welch, have opposed this expansion. Wynmoor President, Jackie Railey worked with city, county and state officials opposing the expansion since it will adversely affect the quality of life for Wynmoor residents.

ISSUE TWO: For more than two decades, the City of Coconut Creek has opposed the expansion of the landfill. City Commissioners Josh Rydell and Sandra Welch are two of the Commissioners who have led this opposition. Wynmoor President, Jackie Railey has also opposed this expansion.

The three candidates who have publicly announced their opposition to the expansion of the landfill and turnpike are:



JACKIE RAILEY

Jackie Railey, the President of Wynmoor Community Council will be seeking to fill the District B seat. Ms. Railey opposes the expansion of the landfill and the expansion of the turnpike. During the past 20 years, Wynmoor has had one of its residents sitting on the City Commission. Jackie has committed to fight against the expansion of the landfill as well as the expansion of the turnpike.



JOSH RYDELL

Josh Rydell has served as Coconut Creek City Commissioner for five years. Rydell has worked with Wynmoor management and County Commissioner Bogen to fight the expansion of the landfill. Rydell has also worked with county and state officials opposing the expansion of the turnpike. As Wynmoor residents



are aware, the state plans to expand the turnpike, which would put the turnpike wall only five feet from Wynmoor property. As of this date, our city, county and state elected officials have been able to hold off this expansion. Commissioner Rydell has spoken publicly about continuing the fight against the landfill and turnpike expansion.



SANDRA WELCH

Commissioner Welch has also publicly opposed the expansion of the landfill and the expansion of the turnpike and has worked with her City Commissioners and county and state representatives in this fight. During the past twenty years, the two most important issues that have affected and will likely affect the quality of life for all Wynmoor residents involves these two expansions. *Continued on page 26*

From Generation to Generation

My younger son Billy and his family make elaborate Friday night Shabbat dinners. Sometimes Billy and Ruthie, his younger daughter, bake challah. They do this more often since the onset of the pandemic. The same is true with Bev's daughter Tracy, and sometimes one of the families send a loaf over to us.

"I can do this," I thought to myself.

Bev printed out a recipe for me; I gathered materials – flour, yeast, eggs, honey, salt, sugar, etc.

I mixed everything, and the batter rose as it was supposed to. But when I put in the oven, I had trouble again. It wasn't heating. However, a friendly neighbor agreed to make it in her oven. Sadly, we took it out too soon. It wasn't baked enough but we ate it anyway – dry and hard enough to drive in nails.

Michael fixed the oven again and this week marked a second attempt with a recipe from Tracy. Now, the oven worked. I started out the same way, mixed ingredients, this time to include raisins. When I put the mixture into the bowl, I covered it with a damp cloth waiting for the dough to double in size. In addition, I called my niece Cindy (from Kentucky) who told me to heat the oven to 200 degrees, and then turn it off and put the bowl in for another minute to encourage the dough to rise even faster. This worked.

I removed the mixture, kneaded it for 10 minutes, divided into four strips, braided them and then put them all on a tray covered with parchment paper back into the 200-degree oven and turned it off. The dough rose more and after 20 minutes I took it out and egg washed it. Then I baked the challah until it was golden brown. When I tapped it with a wooden spoon, it sounded hollow. I let it cool.

I kept thinking of my mother as she prepared on Thursday nights for the

Friday night diner. She made everything by hand - no mixers - and turned out four or five challahs at time. She made the bread and her sister-in-law baked cakes – then they exchanged their products.

I can still smell her kitchen and taste her bread. Better than mine but I am just starting. However, now I have broadened my baking specialties --Mandelbread and Challah -- any customers?

You don't have to tear down walls or relocate doorways, but you might have to do other things like rearrange furniture, replace artwork and collectibles, add or take away area rugs, lamps, tables, plants, books, knick knacks, recover chairs, replace or eliminate curtains, drapes, pillows, or carpet. Even a change of paint color can be effective.

It's All In The Cards

For many years, Irv Kaplan and I played in weekly poker games at Wynmoor Country Club in Coconut Creek. I gave it up for two reasons. First,

it just wasn't exciting enough. In our minimal risk game, with bets limited to five or ten cents, there was no way to bluff. Who would not risk an extra dime to see just one more card? Everyone stayed in each and every game.

Even worse, however, was the fact that as increasingly aging seniors, we not only often forgot who was dealing, we also lost an important ability – how to distinguish between quarters and nickels. We were forced to ban quarters from our pots.

However, this was not the only card game I had once enjoyed and then abandoned.

After my husband Jim, died in 1987, I never again played Bridge.

Before marriage, I had played socially, and we continued to enjoy the game together. In fact, when we moved to a suburb, we joined the PTA Bridge Club – a delightful way to meet other parents. We played monthly at various members' homes; one month at ours, the next at another couple's (also cutting down on the cost of sitters). At the end of the school year, we all gathered in the school gym, and competed for big, glitzy trophies. (We won several and I kept the largest, from 1968, which now graces a bathroom counter). It was much fun – a festive occasion!

I cannot say the same for Duplicate Bridge – a completely different experience. The only similarity being that we met in a large, table-filled room, but this time without chatting, without laughter, without refreshments.

I had never before heard of Duplicate, but Jim was an aficionado - big time -- and took it very seriously. When we played casually, he always introduced the idea of Duplicate. After he persuaded one couple to try it, their relationship was never the same. Because she was a better player, they started attending the Duplicate evenings with other partners. The marriage ended.

I also recall playing with a couple where the wife was a novice who would never get as far as Duplicate. On any social evening, before she played any

card, the husband would say, "Now dear, I want you to think about the card you are going to play. Why have you chosen this card out of any others in your hand?" That marriage also didn't last, either. I never liked them because they trained their dog and their two-year old daughter the same way – to accept a cookie if they said the word kosher, but to refuse it if they said traif! Funny, the small things you remember.

I thought Jim was the most brilliant player possible. He could remember ALL the cards and could tell you the best possible choice -- of course, the one you hadn't made. However, I later learned that my idol had clay feet when we started playing with our next-door neighbors, Roz and Saul Haskell. Saul could also remember all the cards. Sometimes he argued with Jim. Sometimes he was right. How could that be?

However, let's get back to Duplicate games, which are played in clubs all over the world. There are even cruises devoted to the game. Imagine cruising in the Caribbean locked aboard a ship – perhaps even without windows -staring at cards while the scenery floats by unnoticed.

What is unique about Duplicate is that everyone plays the same hands. Bridge is a game of four players, seated across from each other as two sets of partners: East/West versus North/South. At the end of each game, the cards are not gathered, but are placed in slots so that they remain as they were played by each player. Rather than playing against the others at your table, you are playing against every other person in the room who played in your position. It doesn't matter which team wins any particular game, what matters is how well you play your individual hands. At the end of the evening, scores, are tallied and winners get points. Those who play frequently enough, can earn hundreds of points and become grand masters. This was far beyond my competency.

People take it very seriously. Early in our relationship, when Jim took me to play Duplicate, he winked at me during the game to make me feel more at ease, and the person playing North at our table called over the tournament director to make sure it wasn't a signal. I was trembling during the experience.

One of my closest friends used to tell two tales: the first was the day that they smelled smoke in the next room. No one was concerned, no one got up, no one called the fire department. They just played on and on.

I like her other story even better. When she was getting ready for a date, she hurriedly donned her shoes by just sticking her feet into them as they rested on the closet floor. She did not look down. During the game, she dropped a card on the floor and while bending over, realized that she was wearing one brown oxford while the other was white. She sat up, and announced, "You'll never believe this, but I am wearing one brown and one white shoe." To which the man on her left replied in a hard, cold voice, "I believe your bid was two spades."

One August day in the summer of '61 when I was almost ready to give birth to Tracy, we arrived at our regular game run by a distant cousin of Jim's. We were early and the room was completely empty except for many tables, each with four chairs. I sat down, tired, while Jim went out to get some cigarettes. A man approached me. I knew him by sight, a profoundly serious player. He looked down at me and at the three other, empty chairs, glared, and said in a booming voice, "You are sitting in my chair." Heavily pregnant, I moved more quickly than you could imagine. I never told Jim the story for fear of what he might do.

Truthfully, I found these evenings too traumatic. After Jim died, I gave about two seconds of thought to resuming Duplicate — to find another partner. But it wasn't worth it. I was happier when I was only responsible for myself in winning or losing.

Now, limited by an ever-increasing senility, there are no more Bridge and no more Poker games. Sadly, in our dotage, Irv and I are left with Gin Rummy...

might consider "intermediate" but only if beginner is not offered. "Classic Light" is another neat euphemism. I am frightened by titles such as "Boot Camp," "Boom Mind," "EnerChi" or anything else that offers a "Mix." I also refuse to meditate! Meditation is what I do during TV commercials.

As a dilettante, I am surfing SilverSneakers – free for senior citizens, zoomed live online, and have learned that you can call any of their activities by any name – and no matter what the title -- it is still the same thing -- that dreaded word: Exercise.

All the sessions have marching.... All have stepping side to side, or front to back... All have raising arms -- up, out, sideways, and back.... All have squats and lunges... All have rise and lower on tiptoes and stand on one foot like a flamingo (for balance classes)... All have us twisting around to see what is behind us... (usually a blank wall), and all start slowly (giving a false sense of accomplishment) and gather in intensity (as we begin to gasp and sit down or collapse).

All have very friendly, gorgeous instructors (mostly shapely females with an occasional brawny male), especially trained to work with seniors. You meet them casually -- on a first name basis – Damaris, Andi, Sharlyn, Jenny, Stephanie, and others -- who continually offer a barrage of words in an unending stream of description and encouragement, filled with vivid images such as "parting the horse's mane" for one of the (beginning) Tai Chi hand movements.

There is no way to do anything wrong -- only more or less effectively.

The permissions include: "You need not go at my pace, go at your own." "If you can't do this standing, sit down." "If anything hurts, stop doing it."

So – what are the differences between the variedly-named sessions? Toys – some use balls, tubing, and weights... Some have no toys... Some have chairs... Some don't have chairs... Some have music.... some operate at a breathlessly quick pace; others are agonizingly slow and measured. In any given day there are usually five to ten dazzling choices.

As far as music -- I really only enjoy three kinds: Marching Band, Latin American and Cantorial. We march in place or back and forward; we mambo and cha-cha in Zumba, but I and cannot find anything for Cantorial to enhance. Perhaps I might start my own classes in a Yeshiva and count and check for effective breathing as we sway while "davening" in prayer.

Confession: I cannot do everything the instructor introduces during the 45 minute sessions. In fact, I have a new policy: in Beginning Zumba, for example, I perform every second dance. Or – if being completely honest – about 75-85 percent of every second dance.

Second confession -- although this is SilverSneakers and they recommend wearing sneakers, I do everything (or don't do everything) barefoot because I have not donned shoes since March – unless I leave the house (rarely). It may be a Freudian slip that I often call this Silver Slippers – Oh, to be a Cinderella!

Third confession – If the telephone or doorbell rings during a session, I DO answer it and do not rush the caller to conclude the message. I regard all interruptions as divine intervention.

Fourth confession – I would NEVER do this if they could see me – donning clothes only every other day to get the mail and packages from Amazon.

For those who want information without physical involvement, SilverSneakers offers videos to watch and articles to read -- on stability, on lifting and carrying safely, on easing common pains, on building strength and flexibility. No question as to the benefits of this – all a matter of making it palatable (without adding snacks to the routines).

Stuck here in the pandemic frozen north, I am unable to swim, seldom, if ever, walk, and ride a stationery exercycle only while watching Jeopardy. Every Sunday, I examine the upcoming week, line up choices to enter on my android phone calendar and – avoiding conflicts - pick one activity for each weekday.

Weekends are for recuperation, recovery and brand-new resolutions.

However, if you ever wanted to conquer time, it is now possible to make it stand still. Do not look at the clock for at least 20 minutes of exercise. Now, look and you will see that exactly six minutes have actually passed! (Maybe less)

Each month I will choose between one or two questions to answer.

Here is this month's question regarding Dental Benefits on a Medicare Advantage Plan:

Question: "I have Dental Benefits on my Medicare Advantage Plan. Why can't I find a Dentist In Network?"

Answer: Many Medicare Beneficiaries make the mistake of calling a Dental Office and asking their staff if they are In Network for the Medicare Advantage Plan. For example, if you are on a Humana Gold Plus Plan and you ask a Dentist if they take that plan, 9 times out of 10 the answer will be a big fat NO. The <u>correct</u> way to ask for Humana Gold Plus is "Are you In Network with Careington Medicare?" Most Medicare Plans do not contract directly with individual Dentist. **Instead they contract with an Entire Network.**

Each Medicare Advantage Plan will list the Dental Network in the Summary of Benefits and Evidence of Coverage.

Here is a quick reference guide of the Dental Networks associated with some of the more popular Medicare Advantage plans in Broward County for 2021:

Many agents write Medicare business part-time and are mostly concerned with writing the application. An agent or broker who does this full time, will care more about these little details and try their best to inform their clients.

COVID-19 Don't Let Your Guard Down! And PLEASE Don't Pull Your Mask Down To Talk!

My friend was dutifully wearing his mask. He approached and said a few words in greeting. Concerned I might not have heard him clearly, he pulled down his mask and spoke again. I was dismayed! Didn't he understand that the whole purpose of the mask is to block the droplets that come out of our mouths and noses when we breathe and especially when we speak? Pulling your mask down to talk is like wearing your seatbelt in the parking-lot and unbuckling it when you pull into traffic. We don't



see the tiny, invisible droplets that can carry virus particles, but every time we breathe and talk, droplets leave our nose and mouth. That's the main way COVID-19 has spread around the world, killing hundreds of thousands and



Safety Solutions

New Scam Pops Up In Coconut Creek



It's very rare when these scam artists take me by surprise. After nearly 15 years as a TV reporter, and another 8 years as a police public information officer, I thought I had seen every scam known to man. But last week, I heard a new one.

It goes like this:

- 1) A person posing as a delivery driver shows up at your door with a package.
 - 2) The "delivery driver" claims

it's addressed to you.

- 3) You are confused. You weren't expecting this delivery driver or a package. You ask "What's going on here?"
- 4) The phony deliver driver apologies. He says the package contains alcohol. Maybe a rum, vodka, or tequila you might like? He says you can take it for free, all you need to do is let him swipe your credit or bank card to pay the very nominal "delivery fee," since it's alcohol of course.
- 5) You think: "What could it hurt to just give this guy some money and take the "free" alcohol. You ask to pay cash.
- 6) The delivery driver says "No." He claims he can't take cash. It'll have to be a card.

- 7) You hand over your card. He swipes it for a three or four dollar "fee," gives you the package, and leaves.
- 8) He's just gotten away with your credit card number, or, if you used a debit card, he has those numbers and your pin.

I had never heard of this type of scam before. And the guy who posed as the "delivery driver" looked totally legit. While he wasn't wearing any emblems or logos, he looked professional enough as far as his attire.

Now this is not happening often here in Coconut Creek. It's in the "extremely rare" category right now in fact, as we have only had only a single report of it as far as I am aware, but it's possible the bad guys will try it again. That's why I like this column. It helps us get the word out there.

If someone posing as a delivery driver shows up at your door look for emblems and logos on their uniforms. Check their vans. Does it have a FedEx or UPS logo? Is the driver in a U.S. Postal Service vehicle? If the answer is "no" on all of these questions then the chances are very good that you might be talking to a scam artist.

If that happens, politely excuse yourself from the conversation and call us. Call 911. We don't think these crooks are dangerous but they are trying to separate you from your credit card numbers, so we need your help to catch them.

As always, if you see or hear anything suspicious in your neighborhood, you can call 911. I'm also in charge of all of our social media platforms, so you can direct message me on Facebook or Nextdoor with any questions or concerns.





making millions more very, very sick. I would have been shocked if that was the first time I saw someone pull down their mask to speak. Sadly, I've seen it way too often. Even after a year of living through this pandemic, many people still don't understand the risks and the importance of wearing a mask properly and maintaining adequate social distance. In fact, now that many of us have gotten our vaccinations, it seems that some are letting their guard down even more. If you think vaccination means you can forget about masks and social distancing, you are making a big mistake – a mistake that could be fatal to your loved ones, your neighbors and even you. We're making progress, but now is not the time to lower our guard—including our masks.

Thanks to the efforts of Broward County Commissioner Mark Bogen and the dedicated Wynmoor officers and staff, Wynmoor residents age 65 or older were able to get the Pfizer vaccine quickly and efficiently. Those of us who have been vaccinated are now at much lower risk of serious illness from COVID-19 than those who have not had the shots. But there are many Wynmoor residents and staff who are younger than 65 and were not eligible. Even some over 65 didn't get the shots for a variety of reasons. That means there are still A LOT of people in our community who don't have the protection of the vaccine. And while the vaccine protection is believed to be very good, it is not 100%.

You may recall that during this pandemic a great number of people were infected, and either had mild symptoms or no symptoms at all. These people were still infectious. A great deal of what is called "community spread" came from people not showing symptoms. Early in the pandemic, a cousin of mine had a house guest with no symptoms who later tested positive. Not knowing he was positive, he passed the virus to my cousin who almost died and suffered terrible symptoms for months after. There is some evidence that people who have been vaccinated can catch the virus. Even though the vaccine will protect them from serious illness, they can still pass it to others, in the same way as unvaccinated people without symptoms have spread the virus.

Another big problem is that several new "variants" or strains of virus are now spreading around the world. A "variant" is a virus that differs (varies) somewhat from the original. Variants arise when mutations take place that change the genetic code of the virus. The COVID-19 virus is made of strands of RNA rather than DNA, and mutations in RNA viruses are very common. If the mutation makes the virus stronger or easier to transmit, then that mutation will spread faster and can even become the dominant strain. As of this writing, three major variants have been identified. They are called the UK (United Kingdom/Britain), Brazil and South African variants because they were first seen in those countries. All of them have now been found in the US and are spreading fast. The UK variant is spreading so fast, it may soon become the dominant strain here. It is believed that current vaccines give some protection from these variants, but maybe not as much as from the

original virus. Some people who recovered from COVID-19 and thought they were immune, have gotten seriously ill from a variant.

A likely reason variants showed up in Britain, Brazil and South Africa is that these three countries are among the larger countries with diverse geographic regions and where control of the virus was especially poor. The wider the virus spreads, the more chances mutations can occur. The US is larger than all of these and control of the virus here was even worse. That is why it is very likely that there is other "US variants" that are circulating in this country along with the three known variants, but have not yet been recognized. Although the US has had by far the largest number of COVID-19 cases in the world, at this writing we rank behind 31 other countries with respect to testing per 1000 cases for variants. To what extent the already known variants, let alone new ones not yet identified, are vulnerable to which vaccines will not be known for a long time.

All of this makes mask wearing, social distancing, even more important, even if we have been vaccinated. Because new variants can infect with fewer virus particles, we should try to use masks that will give better protection.

Until now, double-layer cloth masks and triple-layer nonmedical, disposable masks have been adequate for ordinary use. These masks sharply reduce the number of viral particles that get through. But with some of the new variants, fewer virus particles are needed to cause an infection. N95 masks are the kind used by hospital staff in highly contagious areas, but these are expensive and in short supply. The KN95 gives similar protection and is now more widely available, though still more expensive than the masks we've been wearing. Another way to improve protection is to wear two of the ordinary masks—one on top of the other. Since even vaccinated people can get and transmit the virus, all of us should continue to wear masks when we are out in public. We should consider using the more effective ones or doubling up when in higher risk, indoor areas like in stores or in doctors' offices.

Even the best mask won't help if it is not used properly. How many times have you seen someone wearing their mask on their chin or under their nose? That's okay when you're alone and distant from anyone else and you're just keeping it ready to put on properly when someone approaches. But when we are near someone, the mask should snugly cover both nose and mouth. And whatever you do, PLEASE don't pull your mask down to talk. Talking, like sneezing and coughing, spreads the droplets that carry the virus. The whole point of the mask is to block those droplets. You may think that because you are not sick or because you've been vaccinated, you cannot be carrying and spreading the virus. Sadly, that is just not true. Most community spread of the virus comes from people who don't know they are carrying it. If you've been vaccinated, that's great. Your risk of getting sick is much, much lower but it's not zero. Vaccinated people who get infected and don't get sick can

pass the virus to others. Properly wearing our masks, even after vaccination will reduce the chance that we will get infected and unknowingly pose a danger to the non-vaccinated people we interact with.

Don't depend on "6 feet apart" as full protection either. That distance is just an estimate of how far average size droplets will likely travel. Smaller droplets can spread further. Risk goes down with distance, but not to zero. Words with letters like "P" or "B" will send more droplets further. A cough or a hard sneeze can send droplets with virus particles as far as 25 feet or more. A mask covering the nose and mouth makes everyone safer by cutting down the number of droplets that go out and cutting the distance they travel. Indoors, droplets carrying virus can create invisible "clouds" that can linger and increase risk for those nearby.

Masks and social distancing have always been about protecting ourselves AND protecting others. We are in a race, both here and around the world, to control the virus before more mutations and variants arise that will make control even more difficult. Widespread vaccinations will reduce illness and death and may slow spread as well. However, only a very small proportion of people in the US have been vaccinated so far and other countries are even further behind elsewhere. Until almost everyone is vaccinated, the risk to our neighbors, friends and loved ones will remain high. Proper use of masks and social distancing will be needed for a long time. We are making progress, but now is not the time to let our guard down.

Protecting Yourself Legally During This Pandemic

In this past year, I have been busier than ever talking to clients who are worried about COVID19. The important thing is to be fully protected legally if you should become incapacitated or die.

If you need to be hospitalized in Florida, it is imperative that you have a Designation of Health Care Surrogate and Living Will with proper wording so there will be no problems. Your Surrogate will be able to make medical decisions for you if you are unable to communicate. Even if the hospital does not allow any visitors due to the pandemic, your Surrogate will be able to talk to the doctors and make decisions on the phone or e-mail. All your Surrogate needs to do is e-mail or fax a copy of your

document to the hospital. If there is no hope to save you, that Surrogate would be authorized to "pull the plug" based on the Living Will. If you have these documents from another state, or older Florida documents, you should review with a Florida attorney. The documents probably need to be redone.

The Durable Power of Attorney is also extremely important to allow someone to take over your legal and financial affairs. The Florida law changed in 2011. If you have an old Durable Power of Attorney, it should be redone. Our current document is 26 pages and covers everything allowable under the new law.

If you should die, your Will or Revocable Living Trust will determine who inherits your assets. The Trust is important to consider if you own



your home or other real estate, because it avoids Probate. Probate can tie up your property for many months and prevent your heirs from selling without a Court Order. They would have to continue to pay taxes, maintenance, mortgage, utilities, etc. in addition to thousands of dollars in attorney fees and court costs. A Life Estate Deed is another option to consider to avoid probate. Your attorney can discuss the different options and the benefits of each one.

Even if you believe that all of your documents are fine, it makes sense to review them with a Florida Estate Planning attorney just to be sure. During this time of social distancing, I am providing free telephone

consultations to discuss Estate Planning and protecting yourself if you are incapacitated. In these unsettling times, putting your house in order can provide peace of mind. Once you have valid documents, hopefully you won't need them. Yogi Berra used to say: "That's the insurance when you don't have it, that's when you need it." Stay well.

Protect Benefits for Children With Special Needs

If you have a child or other family member who has special needs due to physical or mental conditions, you face a variety of challenges planning for their care, including financial ones. You may also have some well-meaning relatives who want to help, but who may not realize that their moves could actually result in some serious lifestyle and monetary problems for your loved one. Fortunately, by planning ahead, you can avoid these potential traps.

As you probably already know, individuals with special needs are eligible for a variety of government benefits and local programs that provide assistance with housing, medical needs, specialized equipment, independent living, job training and other services. You may also know that some of these programs require participants to meet financial criteria to qualify for benefits. Usually, this isn't a problem if your loved one has little income and few assets.

Difficulties can arise, though, when other relatives, such as grandparents, include loved ones with special needs in their estate plans by naming them as beneficiaries of insurance policies or retirement assets, or as beneficiaries of any trusts the grandparents have established. In these situations, loved ones who receive or inherit a sizable amount of assets may then be ruled ineligible for some important services.

Hopefully, your relatives will have informed you of their plans. If so, let them know that although you appreciate their generosity, the way they've chosen to show it could have unanticipated – and harmful – effects. You could then suggest ways they could structure their gifts to be more valuable.


Specifically, they can help through a *special needs trust*, either one that's already been created or one they create for their gift. A special needs trust is

designed to help people with special needs use financial gifts or inheritances for a variety of purposes while keeping their eligibility for some government programs and other services. There are two main types of special needs trust:

- First-party special needs trust An individual with special needs, their legal guardian or the court can establish a first-party special needs trust benefiting that individual. The first-party special needs trust is funded by the individual's own assets, either through earnings or an inheritance or a personal injury award. A first-party trust contains a "payback" rule, which means that when the individual beneficiary with special needs dies, the trust must pay back the state for certain benefits received.
- Third-party special needs trust A relative or person other than the individual with special needs who wants to include that individual in their estate plan can set up a third-party special needs trust. The third-party trust is funded with assets from someone other than the individual with special needs. With a third-party trust, no "payback" provision is required.

Many issues are involved in establishing an appropriate special needs trust. Consequently, you'll need to consult with your legal advisor to determine your next steps. Afterwards, you'll want to involve everyone in your family who could contribute to a trust, so they'll all know what to expect and how they can participate. Once the arrangements are made, you can all feel like you've done your part to make things easier for the loved one in your life with special needs.

The Power of Friendship

File Now for the 2021 Senior Exemption

Property owners who are 65 years or older may qualify for an additional exemption on their Homesteaded property. This additional exemption — which applies only to the county's portion of the taxes and city taxes for residents of cities that have adopted this exemption — saves the average Broward senior nearly \$300 each year in taxes. To qualify for this valuable tax-saving exemption, an applicant must be 65 or older as of January 1, 2021 AND have a combined HOUSEHOLD adjusted gross income for 2020 not exceeding \$31,100. If you believe you qualify for the exemption, you can apply online at https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/SeniorsAppForm

Residents who received the Low-Income Senior Exemption in 2020 must renew the exemption for the 2021 tax year. You should have received a renewal card along with a return envelope from our office. If you still meet the income requirement, simply sign the renewal card, and return it to our office by May 1st so we can ensure you receive this exemption for 2021. You can also renew this exemption online at https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/SeniorsRenewalForm

The absolute filing deadline for any 2021 exemption is September 20, 2021.

2021 Homestead Exemption/Save Our Homes Cap Set by the State

The Florida Department of Revenue has set the 2021 Save Our Homes cap at 1.4%. This Save Our Homes assessment cap limits increases to the Assessed/Save Our Homes Value for properties receiving Homestead Exemption to no more than 3% per year or the increase in the Consumer Price Index (CPI) regardless of increases to the just value of the property. This cap results in considerable savings over time for properties with Homestead Exemption. It is important to remember this is not a cap on the actual taxes, but rather a cap on the assessed value of the property.

Important: The Save Our Homes cap begins the year <u>after</u> you receive Homestead Exemption and automatically renews each year. This cap does not cover new construction or construction that was not taxed before the "Save Our Homes" limit applied to a particular property. Many owners will face a significant increase in property taxes when they purchase a property as the previous owners' exemptions will be removed and the Save Our Homes (SOH) value reset. Florida law requires the SOH value be brought up to the just value of the property when Homestead Exemption is added or removed from the property. For this reason, our office offers a New Homebuyer's Tax Estimator on our website at web.bcpa.net. This estimator allows prospective buyers the ability to plan ahead when purchasing a new home.





HISTORY CORNER

Manuela Saenz

Born out of wedlock, she was ostracized from her family and sent to a convent for schooling. Her time there was cut short when she discovered she had an affair at seventeen with an army general. Manuela then lived with her father until 1817, when he married her off to an older wealthy merchant, James Thorne, from England. These types of arrangements tend not to be successful. After several years, Manuela left him to be a companion, partner, and lover with the revolutionary, Simon Bolivar.

Manuela twice saved Bolivar's life from assassins. One night she was awakened by a noise in the house. She woke Bolivar, gave him his pistol and sword, and held the bedroom door closed until he escaped through the window. In retribution for her assistance in Bolivar's escape, the assassins beat her to temper their frustrations at failing to kill Bolivar. Despite this and other hardships, she remained committed to Bolivar and the revolution until he died in 1830.

She became one of the most prominent female supporters of the revolution by writing letters, giving speeches, and enlisting others to join the cause. When the revolution failed, the president of Peru exiled her to the island of Jamaica. When she tried to return to Columbia, her passport was denied. She then moved to a small port town in Peru, where she spent her final years selling sweets and tobacco to sailors at the port. Manuela Saenz died in a diphtheria epidemic in 1856 at the age of fifty-nine.

WYNMOOR Golf and Tips

Putting Tips: Alignment



This month's tip is on putting alignment or aim. The two main fundamentals of putting are alignment of the putter and distance of the putt. Golf manufacturers have assisted in this fundamental by putting lines on the ball to help you aim your putter. For many years players put their own lines on the ball but now most companies provide the line or lines without having to do it yourself.

Putting alignment or aim is very crucial to your putt because as opposed to full

shots you can't compensate for poor aim by hooking or slicing your ball toward the target. Some golfers may push or pull their putt to compensate for poor aim. The direction the face is looking controls the starting direction more than the path of the swing.


So in addition to the lines on the ball, picking an intermediate point on your line several feet in front of your ball will assist you in rolling the ball on the line you choose.

This intermediate point has been called "spot putting" and was employed by Jack Nicklaus on all his shots, long and short. Some of my bowling students have likened this to using the arrows on the lane when picking your bowling start line.

Finally, the putters have unique alignment aids to further promote an accurate line by lining up the arrow on the top of the putter or whatever designated mark the manufacturer uses to help you. Keep in mind the speed of your putt also determines your putting line choice, but we will visit that fundamental next month. Make more putts this spring with these fundamentals.







Corned Beef and Cabbage

This recipe packs all of its delicious flavors into a one pot meal that is warm, comforting, and SO flavorful!

INGREDIENTS

- 3 Pounds corned beef brisket with spice packet
- 2 bay leaves
- 1 tablespoon coriander seed
- 2 teaspoons mustard seed
- Salt and fresh ground pepper, to taste
- 1 pound carrots
- 3 pounds small potatoes, peeled
- 2 large onions, cut into wedges
- 1 green cabbage, cut into wedges

INSTRUCTIONS

- 1. Place brisket in a large dutch oven or stock pot.
- 2. Season with spice packet, bay leaves, coriander seed, mustard seed, salt and pepper.
- 3. Cover with water. You can also use a combination of beef broth and a bottle of Guinness.
- 4. Bring to a boil; reduce heat, cover, and simmer for 2 hours.
- 5. Add potatoes and carrots and return to a boil.
- 6. Reduce heat to a simmer; cook covered for about 30 minutes, or just until beef and vegetables are tender.
- 7. Add onions and cabbage to the pot and return to a boil.
- 8. Reduce heat to a simmer, cover, and cook for about 15 minutes, or until onions and cabbage are tender.
- 9. Remove from heat and serve warm.



St. Patrick's Day Popcorn

St. Patrick's Day Popcorn is a sweet and salty popcorn treat that is so easy to make for St. Patrick's Day.

INGREDIENTS

- 10 Cups of Popped Popcorn
- Salt
- 3 tbsp. Butter (Sweet Cream, Salted)
- 3 cups Mini Marshmallows
- Regular M&Ms Green
- Pretzel M&M's Green

- Lucky Charms Shamrock Marshmallows

- 7. Allow the popcorn to cool. Break apart into pieces and serve.



The Joy of Appreciating Old Master Paintings And Art Again At The Norton

HORTOH MUSEUM OF ART

In December, I returned to West Palm Beach's Norton Art Museum. I enjoyed its excellent examples of paintings and Art from the 14th Century to the start of the 19th Century by European Artists. Covid protocol was strictly enforced - face masks were required, social distancing was enforced, and you had to purchase tickets online.

The Norton's collection of Gothic and Renaissance Period Art is very small. Nevertheless, I was captivated by Jacopo Da Firenze's "Virgin and Christ Child with Saints and Angels" produced during the Italian Trecento. Jacopo Da Firenze employed egg tempera, and gold leaf on wood panel to produce this exemplar of quality Late Gothic Italian Devotional Theme Painting.

As for the Renaissance Period, I saw fine Netherlandish Paintings by Goswin Vander Weyden, Joos Van Cleve and Studio, and the Master of Frankfurt. These devotional theme paintings employed oil on wood panel. Goswin Vander Weyden's "Triptych" had an abundance of details with a meticulous landscape. Joos Van Cleve and Studio's "Saint Jerome in his Study" and Master of Frankfurt's "Lamentation" were also very impressive.

I saw fine examples of Italian Mannerism by these Italian Painters; Marcantonio Franceshini, "Adam and Eve with Infants Cain and Abel," Giovanni Pellegrini, "Venus and Cupid," Gaetano Gandolfi. "Jacob Stealing Esau's Birthright," and Valerio Castello, "Pan, Syrinx, and Diana," a fine Mythological Theme Painting.

Even though, the Norton Art Museum's Flemish and Dutch Baroque Period Paintings on display is not comprehensive, I saw fine examples of Flemish Baroque oil paintings by Peter Paul Rubens, "Head of Saint John the Evangelist," Caspar Van Den Hoecke, "Judith Seducing Holofernes," quality painting with Judaic subject matter, David Teniers the Younger and Studio, "Gallery Painting," extremely punctilious, Jan Thomas Yperan's "Perseus and Andromeda," and Anton Van Dyck.

I was enamored by these paintings produced by 17th Century Dutch Painters; Jacob Biltius, "Stillife With Bird and Insects," Ferdinand Bol, "King Pyrrhus," Adriean Hanneman, "Boys Blowing Soap Bubbles," and Jan Van Ravensteen, "Portrait of Lady," paradigm of fine Dutch Master Portraiture, among others.

On that day, I also saw wonderful portraits by these British 18th Century Masters, George Romney, Joshua Reynolds, and Thomas Lawrence, among others. I also relished a quality exemplar of Italian Neoclassical Painting by Giovanni Paolo Pannini, "Roman Ruins," François Boucher's "Allegory of Marriage," a quintessential French Baroque Period Painting, and a fine early 19th Century Oriental Theme Painting by Eugene Fromentin.

Since I am a devoted connoisseur, I spent whole day at the Norton as usual. I didn't see everything that I wanted to see. The Norton Art Museum

has a delightful collection of 19th and 20th Century French Paintings and Sculpture, plus awesome American and Chinese Art. That will be subjects for future reviews of the Norton Art Museum. Admission for seniors like myself is fifteen dollars. There is ample free parking near the Norton Art Museum. The privilege in being at the Norton again was priceless.


