A new scam has been discovered where your property can be "stolen" without you even knowing about it. Let's assume your condo is in your name. A scammer files a fake deed with the county showing that you transferred ownership to the scammer. The fake deed is then given to the property appraiser's office and the title of your condo goes from your name to the scammer's name. Now the scammer goes to a finance company or bank and gets a

Meanwhile, you are unaware that the name of the ownership of your condo has been changed and that a mortgage has been taken out on your property. Approximately four months later when the bank or finance company begins a foreclosure on your property, you will learn about the scam and then need an attorney to defend you. We have been told that this scam has been going on for many months, however there is now a way to protect yourself. The Broward County Property Appraiser, Marty Kiar, is offering a free monitoring program for all property owners. This monitoring program will alert you if anyone is trying to change the title to your property. You can register at www.bcpa.net. If you do not have the ability to sign up online you can call the Property Appraiser's office at 954-357-5579 and ask how


account. The Amazon scammer asks you for your Amazon account number pretending that he or she wants to protect your account. Do not give anyone your account number!

**AMAZON** – A person pretending to be from Amazon calls you on the phone. This person tells you that someone is trying to order something on your

**I.R.S.** – You receive a call or email from someone pretending to be from the IRS telling you that unless you pay, they will file criminal charges against you.

**CREDIT CARD COMPANIES & BANKS** – If you receive a call or email where the goal of the call is to get you to provide any information, you most likely are being scammed.

# Wynmoor "Tea Time" A Great Place For Crime Prevention Information

What are you doing at 3 o'clock on a Wednesday afternoon?

Usually around 50 of your fellow neighbors, and some Wynmoor staff, are on the "It's Tea Time" Zoom call at 3:00 p.m., featuring members of the Wynmoor Management Team, the Wynmoor Community Council, and regular guest, Officer Mike Zombek.

As a member of the Police Department, I have worked with Officer Zombek closely since I got

here in 2018. He is one of our "go-to" officers when it comes to teaching and disseminating crime prevention. As an officer in our Community Services Unit, he often attends HOA meetings and has been a regular attendee at the "Tea Time" for quite some time now.


The "Tea Time" used to be in-person in the library at 1001 Wynmoor Circle until the pandemic. They didn't meet for several weeks and then restarted the program a few months ago via Zoom. Officer Zombek, or some other member of the Community Services Unit, regularly attends the meeting to give updates on calls for service to the community and hand out important crime and scam prevention tips that we hope will prevent you from becoming a victim.

"Wynmoor has always been one of our more active communities when it comes to wanting information about what's going on and how to avoid any scams that we currently might be seeing," Officer Zombek explained. "Being a very transparent department, we try to give a wealth of information to the residents during 'Tea Time'," he said. "We go into what detail we can about most calls for service. It really gives a lot of context as to why the officers were there and what they were doing."

There are sometimes other guest speakers from the police department on the call as well. Detective Clint Corey recently updated the group on how the department conducts elderly exploitation investigations and the signs to look for. Officer Michael Leonard, and his K9 partner, School Safety Dog Taylor, were on the call a little while ago telling the group about the important firearms detection work they are doing in four of our schools.

The call also regularly features guests like legal experts, representatives from utility companies such as Florida Power & Light (FPL), and new City of Coconut Creek Fire Chief Jeff Gary. The City will be taking over fire protection services from the Margate-Coconut Creek Fire Department starting in October. We have already began hiring firefighters and securing vehicles and equipment to ensure a seamless transition.

We highly recommend you watching the program when you can. You can find it on Channel 99 on your TV in Wynmoor Village every Wednesday at 3:00 p.m. You can also watch prior episodes on the Wynmoor Community Council's YouTube Channel (type "Wynmoor Community Television" into the search engine at the top of YouTube's page) or join the Zoom call live at 3 o'clock on Wednesdays. I enjoy all the information I can get because it helps me make more informed decisions and Wynmoor's "It's Tea Time" does just that.





# Service Equals Reward

#### The Importance of Mental Health Awareness

Mental well-being is just as important as physical well-being. Since first responders are often the first people someone in a mental health crisis interacts with, it is critical that we know what mental illness looks like and what to do when we see it.

Dr. Vincent Van Hasselt is my mentor on mental health awareness for first responders. He is a professor at Nova Southeastern University (NSU) specializing in police psychology and a certified reserve officer with the Plantation Police Department. Dr. Van Hasselt knows firsthand that many mental health issues are silent and difficult to detect. Despite our wealth of knowledge and ability to perform our jobs safely and effectively, first responders benefit greatly

from specific training dealing with mental health. As his former student, I have incorporated much of what Dr. Van Hasselt taught me into my work at the Broward Sheriff's Office.

One specific course that Dr. Van Hasselt is a big proponent of is Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training. He has been teaching it since its inception in 2002. The training educates deputies to interact appropriately with someone who has a history of mental illness and gives them a better ability to deescalate a situation when needed. CIT-trained deputies can also recognize signs of mental illness better and have an increased sensitivity to what an individual living with mental illness may be going through. I believe this training is essential for all our deputies, and I will continue to push toward a fully trained department.

CIT training alone, though, is not enough to address the mental health challenges facing today's public safety agencies. We must also confront our own mental health challenges. Many of our first responders, which includes law enforcement, fire rescue, detention and communications personnel, are



used to helping others. Yet, they have trouble knowing how to find or ask for help for themselves. In comparison to the general population, first responders are up to three times as likely to develop PTSD or related disorders. These disorders can lead to severe complications for anyone if left untreated. For first responders who interact with the public in high-stress, often traumatic situations daily, an unchecked mental health issue can be disastrous.

I needed to do something about it. When I became sheriff, Dr. Van Hasselt reached out to me. He, too, was concerned about first responders' mental health and asked BSO to partner with NSU on an important program. Together, with the aid of a Department of Justice Community Oriented

Policing Services (COPS) grant and the tremendous help of Judy Couwels from our BSO Employee Assistance Program, we started the Peer Support Team, a progressive new resource for my agency's employees.

We want to make it easier for someone who needs help to get it, and first responders are more likely to seek help from a peer. The Peer Support Team is comprised of 30 sworn and civilian BSO employees who are available at any time for fellow BSO employees. Our Peer Support Team members are trained in active listening skills and critical incident stress management. They can refer those in need to community resources, and they have access to licensed psychologists who can handle more clinically complicated cases. This vital program is entirely voluntary and provides support and help to employees who may be experiencing personal issues, distress from critical incidents or are suffering from stress. I am proud of everyone involved in its development.

When we treat everyone with the appropriate methods of care, compassion and understanding, we all benefit.

# From The Other Side Of The Couch

#### Continuing, Mens' Friendships

Two months ago, I wrote about the period we were beginning to move into. With the increased availability of the Covid vaccine,

most of us have had the vaccine and feel safer. The intensity of the political landscape has lessened although its aftershocks are still being strongly felt. It seemed to many that we were moving from the darkness of a very complicated year into the light. I proposed that it wasn't quite that simple. Rather we were moving into a time when much was not certain and the ground under our feet, for some, still felt a little shaky. What will be the after effects of this time. I know that for me living in America I had felt, in a strange way almost invulnerable to so many things. WOW, how mistaken. As we move into the new normal what will remain the same and what will be different. I asked myself, what will remain reliable and unchanged, a kind of a solid ground beneath our feet, to help get our new bearings. Let's look in on my pondering.

As I said also two months ago, when you think of therapists you may see them as calm, composed and able to solve anything. I assure you that is not always so. For instance, a few months ago I received a call - news that set my world spinning. What to do? My first thought was to get back in bed and pull the covers over my head. But I knew that wouldn't work. The second thought was to pull a dish from the shelf and smash it again the wall. I was angry. But no, that wouldn't work either and the cleanup would be a mess. So, I turned to my tried and true, always works, stop the world from spinning solutions. I called my sister and then my best friend to talk and the world slowly stopped spinning. What had happened? The power of women's friendships.

I wondered then if men felt the same. I began to look more closely at some male friends and asked them for help. What was interesting to me was that the men I talked to mostly did not want their names used while the woman did. This was a small sample so if you, the reader, have any further thoughts please let me know or write about it for the Insider.

On a whole I did not hear many men talk about one best friend. Usually they described themselves as primarily loners or having a group of male friends. These groups often went back to childhood, high school, or college and had begun centered

around a sport activity, club, profession, geographic location (hanging around outside their apartment building) or common interest and lasted for decades. Talk often centered around old memories or time spent together as well as the present. One man described how devastated he felt when one of his college friends died but he did not share his feelings with the other members of his college group even though they were close. He said he just didn't do that. He said that he handled his feelings alone and not with a friend.

When asked who they talked to about unsettled feelings during Covid time most of the men I talked to said they figured things out themselves. Some said their conversations were brief and usually centered around things to be resolved or events. There was a purpose to the calls. They couldn't understand how women could talk for long periods with much emotion and no clear problem or resolution and then say they felt better. One man said that he heard women often talk about a third woman not present. He said that if he had something to say to a male friend he just said it to his face to resolve things, not worrying about what that would do to the relationship. He said men made better friends because they were direct. What purpose was there in "just talking" about how they felt? the men would say. (Hey guys- don't try to understand. It's just a woman's thing.) Sometimes the men would talk to a male friend for a longer time, but it was usually ideas, or about concrete issues like stocks, sport teams, or effects of quarantine but rarely about feelings.

One of the men said he was also surprised when women asked a friend to go to the restroom with them. He described men's relationships as more physically private. When men hung out together there was usually a purpose, work, finances, sports recreational activities. During Covid many men here in Wynmoor were only tangentially affected and so issues of economics may not have been a major issue. Briefly, men are usually seen alone or in a group. Talk is often not as free flowing, not as personal and usually about the people present and not others. Men do not usually refer to "we" when talking about a friend. And close male friendships may last for decades as a group. Again, look around and see what you observe. Guys, let me know how you view men's friendships, particularly in Covid time. Look forward to hearing from you.

#### Jim: From the Past, With Words for the Present

This morning cleaning out files, I came across the very first of many of my late husband Jim's letters detailing his response to teaching in China 1985-86.

After his untimely death in 1987, I had transcribed the handwritten volumes of his diary kept during that time in order to create a journal for our family. However, today, as I open his early letters, reading his initial reaction to the fantastic experience of teaching in China (I believe the highlight of his professional career), I cannot resist quoting at least the two paragraphs following —realizing how ephemeral were his words (as was his life) and hoping to give them some permanency, in much the same way that I have essayed the years that followed. As I read, I can hear Jim's voice — and therefore he lives on for at least this moment.

"Unlike the heat, the sounds of China seep into your consciousness slowly. The voices, the singing, the jingling of the bicycle bells, the hum (sometimes it's a symphony as loud as Beethoven's Fifth) of the locusts in the trees, the beeps of car horns – they are all there most if not all of the time, and you are aware of them dully from the time you walk a city's streets or down a pathway in a park, or through the narrow walkways of a college campus. But somehow, they don't register at first on the sound system of the mind. And then the consciousness, like a creaky old gate, begins to rise and the sounds filter through, single file at first, and then as the height and breadth of the gate increases, they come in – in twos, then threes, and finally like soldiers charging wild to invade a city, they rampage through to you until you wonder where they all came from and why you hadn't been aware of their intensity all along. By this time, there is no point in trying to blank them out. Like an occupying army, they set up camp, and you know that they will

remain with you on not entirely unwelcomed terms for as long as you are in the country other sounds will join them in the occupation of your mind and they too will follow the process of their predecessors. Awareness becomes a military procedure in China."

"As I may have mentioned before, many of the foreign experts here begin to feel like someone somewhere between J. Alfred Prufrock and a character from a steamy Somerset Maugham novel. Here we are, all of us thousands of miles from home, in the heat and humidity of another world, and we begin to magnify all the little events of the day—all the little trips to the post office, the newsstand, the foreign experts' commissary, the dining hall, the little neighborhood shops—until what might seem a simple routine to others becomes a series of major events in our lives. It is like the shedding of an old skin and the donning of another that seems to fit more comfortably than the one we brought with us. It is not based on boredom, but on freedom, not on the trial but on the triumph of this people we are among. We have become less sophisticated, more primitive in a sense…"

As I read Jim's words, written over 36 years ago, I wonder if he might not have felt and written the same about this heightening of senses, the slowing of response while one absorbs one's surroundings, had he lived to experience the world of our Pandemic. There is a parallel between entering a new world and reentering a world which once was familiar and now is alien after over a year of quarantine.

I speculate on what he would have written had he been with me last night. -- our first entry into a restaurant after a year of absence. Ironically, this was our trip to China – at PF Chang, we were assailed by the smells, which he would have described. We ate what we had long forgotten the tastes of and reawakened them: wonton soup, lettuce wraps, shrimps in lobster sauce, and pad thai. I can merely list what Jim would have described in succulent detail.

I know because in his long China diary, he detailed every mouthful he took at every restaurant he visited.

I can echo his words: It is like the shedding of an old skin and the donning of another that seems to fit more comfortably... I like to think that we have grown into this new skin because we have been forced to stop, look, listen, and grow. We begin to appreciate what we once took for granted, the feel of air on an unmasked face, the joy of going places and accomplishing deeds, the sight of a beloved face. We have gained insight when we see old, familiar sights with new eyes – a renaissance of feeling.

While I cannot see Jim's unmasked face, I can hear his voice as I read. As memories stir, I appreciate anew the insights his words awaken. Once again, many years from the days his words were written, I learn from the way Jim saw, the way he wrote, and how these led to what he wanted inscribed on his grave: "Don't mourn my death, celebrate my life." Worth inscribing then; worth rereading now.

Jim was – and still is – my role model and inspiration.

essential. Tandems make or break a relationship! Watching beautiful scenery pass by seated on comfy cushions with back support and no longer worrying that your life partner has fallen behind out of sight (Mark, not Laurel!) and being able to carry on a conversation is cycling heaven....most of the time.



#### with the Medicare Lady

Each month I will choose between one or two questions to answer.

Here is this month's questions regarding Finding a Doctor In Network and changing plans:

**Question:** "I am having a hard time finding a doctor in network that will take new patients?"

**Answer:** Covid has really complicated the ease of which we are provided service. This unfortunately has also extended to the ability of Primary Care Physicians to see their patients on a timely or urgent basis, or to take on new patients during this time.


Typically when you have a chronic condition, your physician would schedule an appointment once a quarter for blood work and medication management. On average they see 4 patients within an hour providing 15 minutes for each appointment. More time is provided during a "new patient" appointment. Due to Covid restrictions, doctor's offices are mandated to reduce the number of patients in their waiting rooms and this reduces the number of patients they can see within an hour. This is the primary reason why it is taking longer to obtain an appointment to see your doctor, as well as, doctor's ability to bring on new patients.

To ease your frustration with this stage in obtaining access to care, remember that many Medicare Advantage Plans offer Telemedicine and Urgent Care. To find the telephone number for Telemedicine, call the customer service number on the back of your Medicare Health Insurance Card. To find in network

Urgent Care Centers, go to the insurance website and click on "Provider Search" tab, or call your Licensed Insurance Agent to help you search for locations.

**Question:** "I can't seem to find a doctor. Can I change my Medicare Advantage Plan?"

**Answer:** We are now in a Lock In Period for the rest of the year. OEP –



I hope this article is able to provide you with some guidance on obtaining access to care.

This month's article is based on a couple of different excerpts from previous ones and my 2010 book on narcissism. It's on what I call emotional currency or EC. Everyone has ways in which they want to 'get paid' emotionally or intimately. These are the behaviors, gestures, etc. that lead to a person feeling loved, valued,

appreciated and a host of other psychological necessities. Different people use different currencies to give and receive closeness and impart feelings of caring and love.

For example, service. Both men and women use service to show their love. I don't want to be sexist and these examples are meant to be merely illustrative. A woman may pick up her husband's shirts at the cleaner's and he may wash her car. Of course, these behaviors can be reversed (have to be very careful these days not to offend anyone). If both people view service in the same way, they both will feel loved and cared for when these things are done for them. However, if one of them just regards doing these things as part of running a household, that person will not feel 'paid' by the gesture. Oftentimes the other will point this out and say he or she was met with a mere 'thanks' because the partner on the receiving end thought it was not particularly special.

Another example is money or gifts. Sometimes one partner believes that buying an extravagant gift is a wonderful way of showing love. If the person on the receiving end thinks the same way, then both partners will feel loved and appreciated and their emotional banks will have a deposit. If, however, you have one person believing that gifts are a show of love and the other thinking that picking up the dry cleaning is, we're going to have two unfulfilled people. The one who didn't receive the gift and the one whose trip to the cleaners was not appreciated. Neither partner here is going to feel emotionally paid.

One very important difference is in what constitutes emotional intimacy. I'll use myself as an example. To me, closeness comes from intimate conversation. These conversations can be intellectual as well as emotionally revealing. They come from sharing ideas, philosophies, theories, experiences and opinions as well as intimate and personal feelings. This would be true for me in any relationship whether with friends, my daughters, spouse, etc. This was also true when I ran groups and watched people blossom because they were able to share their deepest selves and their ideas and learn to accept the revelations of others. For me, this is what it means to be 'in relationship'

with another person and this is what fosters intimacy and caring for another. When I don't have that I can only reach a certain level of relationship which may be fine in casual friendships and acquaintanceships but those relations cannot and will not deepen. Of course, I also tend to pay in that same currency and although I can and do pay in all forms of emotional currency, they are not primary for me.

Another important currency is time. Some people require spending a great deal of time with the other and some need much less. If you believe that the amount of time spent together should be a primary factor of the relationship, being with someone with many other interests who doesn't have the same time requirements you do will make you both unhappy. You will see time spent doing other things as a rejection of you and the other will find your demands suffocating and neither of you will be filling your emotional bank.

Time spent together is definitely an important factor in relationships. It is difficult to feel loved and cared for when the person you want to be with hasn't the time to spend with you. The important thing to look at here is desire. If the other person has a time-consuming job or other necessary demands but you know you are valued and the desire to spend the time with you is there, it is quite different than being with someone who is fitting you in to a whimsical schedule, seeing you when he/she feels like it or when it is convenient. Trying to receive something from someone who is unable to give it is a major effort in frustration and futility for both people involved.

Another example and method of payment is paying with physical affection and/or compliments. This comes naturally to some people and is very difficult for others both to give and to receive. Again if the balance of desire and need does not match you will be in for a rough ride.

To be paid in your own currency is to experience yourself as loved, valuable, important, cared for, psychologically visible and a real part of a relationship. To be paid in a way that is less important to you or even in a way you might not even notice leads to feeling invisible as your deepest self and when you feel invisible you cannot feel loved and cared for. Imagine having your emotional currency bank depleted and then imagine it overflowing. Quite a difference.

Due to space constraints I have shortened this extensively but hopefully you got the idea and can come up with your own currencies and listen to the important people in your life about theirs.

# WYNMOOR Golf and Tips

#### Tee It High, Let It Fly



After contact with ball tee is bent forward

We have all heard that expression "tee it high." With the advent of these large head drivers, 400CC and 460CC, the center of gravity and suggested contact point has changed over the years. Before the age of large heads on your driver and titanium, we had the smaller wood heads and screws in the middle of the face. The expression

was "hit in the screws" meaning the center of the face for maximum distance. This new contact point uses the "trampoline effect" to have the ball spring off the face for maximum distance. This point is above the mid-line of the face more toward the top of club.

This new trampoline effect requires a higher tee with almost half of the ball above the top line of the club so you can deliver a level to slightly upward blow on the ball. This tee height would be different for different size heads but teeing too low would require you to hit down on the ball or if you didn't you might top the ball. Raising the tee height up a bit higher provides more room for error on your tee shots. It does take some practice to get used to this tee height but in the long run you will be a better driver of the ball. After impact you will notice the pros tee would be just bent forward but not knocked out of the ground. You can't put topspin on your drives, but you can reduce the backspin and get a nice trajectory and good roll on your shots by hitting slightly upward on your driver with the higher tee height.

### Help Protect Your Family's Inheritance

You might contribute to your IRA for decades to help pay for your retirement. But if you don't need all the money, you may want to leave what's left to your children or grandchildren. However, if you want to ensure they get the most from this inheritance, you'll need to do some planning.

Here's a little background: Up until a couple of years ago, when you left the proceeds of your IRA to your beneficiaries, they could choose to "stretch" required withdrawals over a long period, based on their life expectancies. These required withdrawals were generally taxable, so this "stretch IRA" allowed your beneficiaries to greatly reduce the annual taxes due, while benefiting from longer tax-deferred growth potential. And the younger the beneficiary, the longer the life expectancy and the lower the withdrawals, so this technique would have been especially valuable for your grandchildren or even great-grandchildren.

Changes in laws affecting retirement accounts have significantly limited the stretch IRA strategy. Now, most non-spouse beneficiaries must withdraw all assets from the IRA within 10 years of the IRA owner's death. The beneficiary generally does not have to take out any money during that 10-year period, but at the end of it, the entire balance must be withdrawn – and that could result in a pretty big tax bill.

The stretch IRA strategy can still be used for surviving spouses, beneficiaries who are no more than 10 years younger than the deceased IRA owner, and beneficiaries who are chronically ill or disabled. Minor children of the original account owner are also eligible for a stretch IRA – but only until they reach the age of majority, at which time the 10-year rule applies.


So, if you want to leave your IRA to family members who don't meet any of the above exceptions, what can you do?

One possibility is a Roth IRA conversion. You could convert a traditional IRA to a Roth IRA over your lifetime, so your heirs would receive the Roth IRA. They would still be required to withdraw the assets within 10 years, but unlike with a traditional IRA, Roth IRA withdrawals are generally tax-free. These conversions are taxable, so you'll want to consult your tax professional in addition to your financial advisor, to determine if this strategy can help you achieve your legacy goals.

Another option is to purchase life insurance, which can provide a specific dollar amount to your heirs or be used to help cover additional taxes. This may be especially advantageous if you are 72 or older, in good health, and taking withdrawals – technically called required minimum distributions – from your retirement accounts, such as your traditional IRA and your 401(k). If you don't really need the money, you can use these withdrawals to pay for some or all of the insurance premiums. Life insurance can't replace an IRA as a means to save for retirement, though, so you should consult with your financial advisor to make sure you are working toward all your goals.

In any case, if you have a sizable IRA or you don't need the funds that you're required to take from your retirement accounts, you may want to start thinking about what you want to do with the money. The more thorough your legacy planning, the better your chances of meeting your legacy goals.

### Come Home To Your New Spiritual Home Temple Beth Am


