



Market Decline Offers Buying Opportunities

The financial markets have gotten off to a rocky start this year. What's caused this volatility? And does it present opportunities for patient investors?

First of all, several factors are behind the market volatility, including the war in Ukraine, higher inflation, rising interest rates and the lingering effects of the COVID-19 pandemic. However, while these factors may be specific to the recent market decline, volatility itself is a common feature of the investment environment. In fact, history shows that corrections of 10% or more happen about every year, and declines of 15% or more have happened every other year, on average. Furthermore, while 2022 has thus far been challenging for investors, it was preceded by a long period of strong markets, with the S&P 500 averaging more than a 20% return over the past three years.

Knowing the typical frequency of market volatility and reviewing the results of the past few years may make the current situation seem less shocking. But you don't have to simply "ride out" the downturn – because a down market may give you the opportunity to buy more investment shares at good prices. Specifically, you can expand your holdings in companies that have good growth prospects due to strong management and products or services that provide sustainable competitive advantages. And this type of opportunity is important, because one of the keys to building wealth is to increase the number of shares you own in your various investments and hold them for the long term. While the market will always fluctuate, the long-term trend has been positive, particularly for well-diversified portfolios built with quality investments.

Of course, while it is a good idea to boost your share ownership at favorable prices, you still want to be strategic about it, rather than just buying whatever seems to be the biggest bargain. In reviewing your existing portfolio, can you identify any gaps that could be filled with new investments? Are there

opportunities to further diversify your holdings? By owning different types of stocks, bonds, government securities and other investments, you can help reduce the impact of volatility on your portfolio. (Keep in mind, though, that diversification can't guarantee profits or prevent losses in declining markets.) Or, if your portfolio has become "unbalanced" in some way, you could also use this time to rebalance it back to its original long-term targets. You might also consider setting up a systematic investing program in which you invest the same amounts in the same investments on a regular basis, such as monthly. When prices go down, you'll automatically buy more shares, and when prices rise, you'll buy fewer shares. (However, systematic investing does not guarantee a profit or protect against loss, and you'll need to be willing to keep investing when share prices are declining.)

Before this year, average annual returns have been solid for about a decade, which makes it somewhat easy to forget about normal market volatility and may have led to overly optimistic performance expectations. So, it would not be surprising if your initial reaction to the current downturn is one of concern. But by viewing the current investment environment as a chance to add quality investments at attractive prices, you can help yourself develop a behavior that can serve you well throughout your life as an investor.

Ethical Will: What Legacy Will You Leave?

"David, remember this: you are a unique being. Find what is special about you, what you really love, and make it the top priority in your life. Follow your heart, not your mind. Remember the magic message from The Little Prince: "It is only with the heart that one can see rightly; what is essential is invisible to the eye."

I wrote that in 1988 to my ten-year-old son as part of my first Ethical Will. I had been a lawyer for fifteen years and had prepared many Wills for clients. But it wasn't until I read an article by my Rabbi in the Temple newsletter that I discovered the concept of preparing a legacy not of our material estate but of our spiritual one.

You don't need a lawyer for an Ethical Will. But the best advice I can give to a client (if he or she is open to it) is this: examine your own life. What are your values? What have you lived for? Has your life made a difference? What are your hopes for your loved ones? What mistakes did you make that, with God's grace, resulted in your becoming a better person? What good deeds did you do that made the world a better place?

In 2016, I wrote Part Two of my Ethical Will. It begins like this: "I just read my Ethical Will, which I wrote 28 years ago. I should have been reading it regularly, to remind me of my highest self and motivate me to be a better man. I have made so many mistakes since then. I have hurt and disappointed Dotty (and therefore David) so many times. I can only ask for forgiveness from Dotty and David and anyone else that I have hurt. I wrote to David: 'Follow your heart, not your mind.' If I had listened to that advice myself for all these years, so much pain and sorrow could have been avoided. So, to my loved ones, I ask you to remember me for those times when I did follow my heart."



Then I wrote about the most painful mistakes I made when I closed off my heart. I recalled the good deeds that made a difference in the lives of two people, my "Little Brothers" for whom I was a mentor.

It wasn't easy for me to write an Ethical Will, especially the second one. I had to remember the times when I looked at the Man in the Mirror and didn't like who I saw.

I am proud to say that my son has followed his heart, both in his profession (film editor) and in his

personal life (giving of himself completely and unconditionally to those he loves).

So much of what I have written in my two Ethical Wills, David has already expressed by living his life. But just the writing of my Ethical Wills, and re-reading them regularly, has given me a peace of mind that no regular Will ever could. The essence of who we are is the greatest and most lasting gift that we can give to our loved ones.

Here is how I end my second Ethical Will: "I feel complete in what I have expressed. I feel so grateful for my life. Every day that I wake up, I thank God. So, I leave these two things to those who read this: LOVE and GRATITUDE. May each of your days be filled with both."

Balance and Aging

Before I get into this month's exercises I wanted to share something with you. I have been a Personal Trainer for 30 years, the first 10 years I worked mostly with younger clients, but when I moved into Wynmoor my clients became mostly seniors. I can't tell you how much more gratifying it is for me to help and see results for the senior population. Thank you. If you didn't read last month's article I stressed safe ways of doing the balance exercises. Feel free to call me at 954-673-6700 and I can go over them with you.

Here are a few. Walk forward for 10 to 20 steps, when you pick up one foot hold it up off the ground for 2 seconds before putting it down then repeat with the other foot. Stand with the toes of one foot against the heel of the other foot and rock back and forth 12 times, then reverse your feet and repeat. This strengthens the ankles. March in place lifting the knees as high as you can, then try it moving forward. I wanted to include some upper body exercises this month, but I wanted to give more balance exercises using legs.

Next month I'll devote to upper body. You may need some small weights or exercise tubing to do upper body exercises. I will include some photos or diagrams. Stay well and don't quit.





Safety Solutions

Introducing Park, Walk, and Talk



Starting on June 15th and going through the end of that same month, Coconut Creek police officers spent more than 170 hours out of their cars, walking through neighborhoods, and just being friendly by talking to whomever they encountered. It's called Park, Walk, and Talk, and it's the newest important initiative for our

patrol officers. It's also an integral part of the City of Coconut Creek's Vision 2030 Plan, which outlines the City's improvement and performance goals through the next eight years.

The aim is as simple as its name. Officers will spend at least one hour per work week parking their cars, walking through neighborhoods, and talking to people; that's residents and business owners, managers, and employees. As Captain Fred Shelton put it in his letter to patrol officers introducing the program: "This effort to engage the public will help build relationships and trust within the community we serve."

In the first two weeks of the initiative, officers spent nearly two-and-a-half hours walking through Wynmoor Village alone. "[The Coconut Creek Police Department] should not be an agency that only shows up to arrest someone in a neighborhood or business," Captain Shelton wrote in his letter. "The expectation is for officers to talk to people and go into neighborhoods and businesses on a routine basis. The residents and business owners should get to know officers by name, and eventually feel comfortable enough to offer

tips and information about crime and other issues within the community." Thankfully, Wynmoor doesn't see a lot of crime. But the aforementioned relationships could, for example, help officers identify neighbors going through a rough time mentally. We have equipped officers with knowledge and information to help those who may be in some sort of mental or emotional crisis. Park, Walk, and Talks could also help officers identify residents who may be in the beginning stages of cognitive decline and get them the assistance that they need.

The program is not confined to just neighborhoods. You will find officers doing Park, Walk, and Talks at places you might frequent on a regular basis such as the Community Center, Windmill Park, Promenade at Coconut Creek, and the Coconut Creek Plaza. The plaza is home to the Publix where so many of you shop for groceries and other important items.

An officer doing a Park, Walk, and Talk has already prevented a potential suicide at an apartment complex on the north end of the city. A woman whose adult daughter was distraught after a relationship break-up stopped one of our officers who just happened to be in the neighborhood taking part in this initiative. Officers found the daughter and she agreed to get the help she so desperately needed.

Park, Walk, and Talks will be an important part of our commitment to meeting and exceeding your customer service expectations in the future. Rest assured that when you meet an officer on one of these Park, Walk, and Talks, that officer will have a friendly ear, ready to help in any way he or she can.

The Broward County Property Appraiser's Office mails the TRIM (proposed tax) Notices in August of each year. This is NOT a tax bill but a notice showing your property's 2022 just value, exemptions and proposed taxes as set by the various taxing authorities. The TRIM Notice is your opportunity to review your 2022 just value and ensure you are receiving all the tax-saving exemptions you are eligible for.

Florida Statutes require our office use January 1 as the date of assessment each year. The 2022 just values are based on the market data from 2021. Our office must consider changes in market conditions – up or down – when developing the just/market values each year. The 2022 just values will reflect the significant changes in the 2021 market data. As the real estate market trends upward, most property owners will see increases in their just/market values.

Our office does not set nor collect property taxes. If you have questions about the proposed tax rates, the contact information and public hearing dates for the individual taxing authorities are listed to the right of each agency name on the TRIM Notice.

I Recently Applied for Homestead Exemption—Why Is It Not Showing on my TRIM Notice?

Florida Statutes require our office use January 1 as the date of assessment and to determine exemption eligibility each year. If you purchased your home after January 1, 2022, you are eligible for 2023 Homestead Exemption. The

2023 exemptions will show online in December and be included for the 2023 tax year.

I Had Homestead Exemption Last Year - Where Did My Exemptions Go This Year?

If you purchased your home in 2021, you may have "inherited" the previous owner's exemptions last year. These 2021 exemptions would have been removed at the end of last year, so they are no longer showing on your TRIM Notice for tax year 2022. Fortunately, you can still late file for 2022 Homestead and any other exemptions you may qualify for until September 19, 2022. To apply online, please visit our website at https://web.bcpa.net/

I Am a Senior Citizen – Why Isn't the Senior Exemption Showing?


The Senior Exemption is both an age and income-based exemption that is not automatically applied to a property because of the income requirement. To be eligible for this exemption, an applicant must be age 65 or older as of January 1, 2022 and have an adjusted household gross income for 2021 not exceeding \$32,561. If you believe you qualify for this additional exemption, you can still late file until September 19, 2022. And now some more for our fun facts. On July 8, 1654, Jacob Barsimson left the Netherlands on a ship to New Amsterdam, where he became the first known Jew to settle in what would become New York. Barsimson, and the Sephardi Jewish settlers who would soon join him, pushed back against New Amsterdam's anti-Semitic governor, Peter Stuyvesant, to earn rights in the Dutch colony.

Are you familiar with the names of these Black Jews?

Rabbi Sandra Lawson: She was born in 1970, and became the first black, and openly gay, female rabbi in the world upon receiving rabbinic ordination from the Reconstructionist Rabbinic College in 2018. Through her active social media presence, Lawson has become known worldwide as an advocate for racial equity and social justice.

Aaron Samuels: Mr. Samuels is a poet and entrepreneur. He is the cofounder of a digital publication for black millennials that was launched in 2014. His first book of poetry Yarmulkes and Fitted Caps was published in 2013. Many of his poems touch on his black and Jewish identity.

Tiffany Haddish: Tiffany Haddish did not know about her Jewish roots until adulthood. She first met her father, an Eritrean Jew, when she was 27, and began reclaiming Judaism shortly afterward. Haddish released a comedy special in 2019 called, Black Mitzvah, and celebrated by having an actual bat mitzvah ceremony off screen, which was officiated by comedian Sarah Silverman's sister, Rabbi Susan Silverman.

Josh Ho-Sang: Born and raised in the Toronto suburbs, Josh Ho-Sang is a professional ice hockey player. After being drafted by the New York Islanders in 2014, Ho-Sang spent several years in their farm system before moving to the American Hockey League. Ho-Sang is Jamaican and Chinese on his father's side and Russian Jewish and Swedish on his mother's side.

Julius Lester: Julius Lester converted to Judaism in 1982 at age 43, an experience he wrote about in the book, Love Song on Becoming a Jew. His interest in Judaism began as a young child, after discovering that his great grandfather was a German Jewish immigrant. Throughout his career as a writer, Lester penned 8 nonfiction books, 31 children's books, one book of poetry, and more than 200 essays. Lester also enjoyed a successful 32-year career in academia as a faculty member in the Judaic and Near Eastern Studies department at the University of Massachusetts, Amherst.

Sammy Davis, Jr: While entertainer Sammy Davis, Jr was raised in a Christian home, his interest in Judaism was sparked by comedian Eddie Cantor, who gave Davis a mezuzah in 1953. Davis completed the conversion process in 1961. During press interviews he often drew parallels between the African American and Jewish communities.




How Acupuncture Became Included in Modern Western Medicine

In 1971, an article appeared in the New York Times by James Reston, a member of the US Press Corp. Mr. Reston had been in Peking (now Beijing) helping to prepare for President Nixon's historic visit to China when he began to have severe abdominal pain. He was examined by local doctors, diagnosed with acute appendicitis, admitted to a hospital and scheduled for surgery. He reported that the surgery went well and without complications but on second day after surgery he was having very uncomfortable stomach

pain and bloating. Here is his own account of what happened next:

"Li Chang Yuan, doctor of acupuncture at the hospital, with my approval, inserted three long, thin needles into the outer part of my right elbow and below my knees and manipulated them in order to stimulate the intestine and relieve the pressure and distension of the stomach... Meanwhile, Doctor Li lit two pieces of an herb called ai, which looked like the burning stumps of a broken cheap cigar, and held them close to my abdomen while occasionally twirling the needles into action. All this took about 20 minutes, during which I remember thinking that it was rather a complicated way to get rid of gas on the stomach, but there was a noticeable relaxation of the pressure and distension within an hour and no recurrence of the problem thereafter."

Now this rather short article generated considerable buzz among the Western medical community as well allot of scrutiny by detractors who were not fans of the Nixon administration and called the whole affair a publicity stunt. Nonetheless, the event began an exchange between China and the west, with China inviting American MDs to visit Chinese hospitals and not only observe



first-hand, but be trained in the use of acupuncture for pain-relief.

I had the good fortune to meet one of those first doctors trained in China. He was Chief of Neurological and Spinal Surgery at the University of Texas John Sealy Medical Branch in Galveston, Texas. In my conversation with him, he described how he had been trained to use a few acupuncture needles on the surface of the patient's outer ear to control their pain DURING surgery, which allowed the patient to remain awake and to communicate with the doctor during the procedure! He said that for him, he was willing to use whatever is necessary to minimize the inherent risk for the patient with such invasive surgery and that acupuncture used in this manner had literally transformed his practice.

Though it has been a long, arduous road since that first article appeared for acupuncture's acceptance as a safe and viable addition to modern western medicine, it is now taught to medical students at many US medical schools and is covered by Medicare for the treatment of chronic lower back pain as well as for many other medical conditions by numerous health insurance companies.

In nearly 30 years of clinical practice, I have witnessed the effectiveness of acupuncture in addressing acute and chronic pain, neurological disorders, digestive and respiratory problems as well as high blood pressure, insomnia, anxiety and depression. 



The Myth of the Straight Lead Arm

Over the years of instruction, it us still common to hear the tip of keeping your lead arm straight. Granted, there are players able to maintain that arm straight. It becomes a matter of the strength and suppleness of the player. No one is advocating purposely bending the arm rather allow your physical makeup

to determine whether it remains straight or flexes a bit at the elbow. Take note most all players do have and maintain a much straighter arm on their downswings because of the proper path and lead arm control.

As a senior golfer the straight arm idea generally forces the swing to vertically cutting off any turn or rotation of the body. In addition, I have seen many players injuring themselves at the elbow.

The list of great players with that flex as I remember started with Tom Watson, Curtis Strange, Phil Michelson, Fred Couples, John Daly, Jordon Spieth and Colin Morikawa to name just a few notables.

The photos attached are some illustrations of this softer arm position.

The best senior pros have remarked their career longevity is because they maintained the length of their backswings. As I teach senior golfers the stiff arm reduces speed in your swing and a full range of motion needed to carry your shots sufficiently.







ASK DR. JOY

The Mind-Body Connection



Do any of the following sound like you? It runs in the family.

It's flu season again.

I was just on a plane (or in a crowd) that's why I have a cold.

God uses disease to teach us something. It's 'going around'.

Disease builds character.

When you reach a certain age, bodies just start falling apart.

Everyone will eventually get Covid.

I can probably go on and on with this, but you get the idea. See if you have some

of your own pet ideas that I didn't think to put on my list.

It's not only your beliefs and attitudes that have an effect on your health. Your physician's beliefs also matter. Dr. Larry Dossey, who writes extensively about this, says that your doctor can influence you and your outcomes in both positive and negative ways. He says that physicians can exert powerful effects through their beliefs. If they strongly favor a certain medication or therapy and talk up the effects in a cheerleader manner a patient will "catch" their enthusiasm and even a placebo will work. On the other hand, Dr. Dossey speaks of a patient of another doctor who was seriously ill and wrote to him. In part, this is what she wrote. "I began to realize that my doctor doesn't believe I'm going to live. It takes me two weeks to recover from a visit to him. He leaves me depressed and feeling sicker. After a while I begin to feel more positive and physically healthier and then the cycle begins again when it's time for my next appointment. Why do I feel like my own physician is killing me?" Why indeed??

As I've mentioned in previous articles, thoughts are vibrations that go out into the universe and attract like thoughts and then physical manifestations to themselves. We rendezvous with these thoughts and people constantly pick up their vibrations as they pick up ours. Especially if we believe that the person, like your physician, has the credibility to know the 'truth'. We then believe it and our own thoughts can create our health or illness.

There is a book out by Dr. Bruce Lipton in which he says that our thoughts can actually change our DNA. How about that? I find that remarkable and it should eliminate the 'it runs in the family' excuse.

We all know and agree that stress and constant negativity and negative expectations can change our health as can depression and anger. But how about opposite feelings? Can extreme positivity and joy also affect your health? Of course, it can. Along with feelings of peace, love and serenity. Those will lead to a sense of well-being and your body will get the message and transform itself and manifest that well-being physically.

When Dr. Dean Ornish was all the rage, maybe in the 80s and 90s, he had a three-step program for people with heart disease. The first step was to become a whole, unprocessed food vegan, the second was mild-moderate exercise and the third, which to me summed it all up, was to meditate and share in a support group that stressed wellness rather than regurgitation of fears and complaints. All his participating patients improved but the ones who consistently meditated and attended group meetings did remarkably better.

I can write so much more on this subject especially the power or prayer, which I will briefly touch on here. There was a study done regarding in vitro fertilization where the success rate was about 20% on the first attempt. A group of prayers got together and anonymously prayed for the women getting the procedure. The patients were not told about this at all and had no idea they were being prayed for. So, what happened? The success rate for the women who were prayed for by strangers and didn't even know it, jumped to over 50%. So, what do we define prayer as? The act of praying is actually the clear focus of intentional thoughts with the expectance of a favorable outcome through tapping into a power greater than we are. That power can take the form of a religious icon or the vibrations or quantum energy of the universe. However you define it, use it.

Health is our natural state and through negative beliefs, our own and those we have adopted and bought into, we add or attach disease into our being. Our goal is to eliminate, to the best of our current ability, these add-ons and picture ourselves in our natural state of wellness. It's all mind work. We have a powerful tool at our disposal if we just learn to channel and direct it. It takes commitment and practice. Good luck with this. It gets easier and is very effective.
