PREVENTATIVE TEST Can Save Your Life

s most people are aware, insurance covers the cost for preventative tests for mammograms and colonoscopies. Recently, Broward County Commissioner Mark Bogen received approval of a \$10 million dollar preventative cardiac program that he has been spearheading. This pilot program will allow selected Broward residents to receive free preventative cardiac tests.

The leading cause of death for both men and women is cardiac disease or in other words, a heart attack. 1 in every 2 men and 1 in every 3 women will suffer from a heart attack in their lifetime. The most surprising thing is there is a technology that can prevent and/or predict most heart attacks and most people are unaware of it. The technology is called a CT-A which is a non-invasive test that uses dye and shows whether your arteries have


blockages of soft and/or hard plaque. Many people hear about a test which only gives a calcium score. This test is not a CT-A. A test that only provides a calcium score only shows hard plaque in a person's arteries and does not show soft plaque.

When Bogen's mother died from a heart attack, Bogen learned that there is a test that can show blockages in a person's arteries. If a person learns of a blockage, medical treatment can be administered to treat that person and prevent a heart attack from happening. Bogen has been working with Holy Cross hospital for the past two years developing this pilot preventative health program, which was just approved by his fellow Broward County Commissioners. "This test can save thousands of lives. I am aware of many people who never realized they had significant blockages in their arteries until they took this test. I came

to realize that I had a 60% blockage in one of my arteries that is currently being treated. If not for this test, I would never have known" said Bogen.

The pilot program will allow a minimum of 20,000 Broward residents to get free cardiac testing and will begin in early October. The tests will be administered by Holy Cross, Broward North, Memorial and Cleveland Clinic hospitals. Most of the participants will be over the age of 50 and the senior community will constitute the majority of the participants. "It is concerning to me that preventative testing for the leading cause of death is not being performed in this country" said Bogen.



Portability allows eligible property owners to pay less property taxes at their newly homesteaded property by transferring all or a portion of the Save Our Homes (SOH) savings from one Florida property to another Florida property within the strict time frame allowed by law. If you qualify, Portability will reduce your property's assessed value, resulting in tax savings this year and possible tax savings in future years depending upon the market value of your home each year.

Portability applies to both upsizing and downsizing in property value, based upon specified formulas. Portability may be used an unlimited number of times and may be used for moves to anywhere within Florida. Portability does not require you to sell your previous home, but merely that the Homestead at your prior property be fully abandoned.

Most homeowners will have already applied for Portability when completing their Homestead Exemption application. Portability is only reflected on our website's property record page the first year for which it is approved.

Effective tax year 2021, a property owner who applied and was approved for Homestead Exemption for 2021 is eligible to apply for Portability if the property owner held a Homestead Exemption at a

previous Florida home in one of the three previous tax years. Example: if you established a new Homestead in tax year 2021, you must have held Homestead at your prior residence in tax year 2020, 2019, or 2018 in order to take advantage of potential Portability savings.

PLEASE NOTE: Homesteads established in tax years 2008 through 2020 are eligible for Portability if the property owner held Homestead Exemption on a property in the previous two tax years (the law was changed in 2021 to allow three years before any Portability savings expired). Example: you established Homestead on your property in 2014 but forgot to file for Portability, you may be eligible if you held a previous Homestead at another Florida property in tax year 2013 or 2012.

You can apply this year by completing the Transfer of Assessment Difference Form found on our website https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/ Download-Forms by the September 19, 2022 exemption filing deadline. 



Did you ever hear of the Rosenwald Schools? Julius Rosenwald, the son of German Jewish immigrants, and a part owner of Sears Roebuck met Booker T. Washington in 1911, who, amongst his many accomplishments, founded the Tuskegee Institute. Rosenwald joined the Board of the Institute.

Rosenwald and Washington, now close friends, discussed the plight of black education in the Jim Crow south. Public education in the south was underfunded, nonexistent in some areas and in appalling physical condition when existing.


Rosenwald, who devoted his wealth and philanthropy to good works, started the Rosenwald Schools Initiative in 1915. This private/public effort to provide good schools for African American children in the segregated south lasted until 1937. The Initiative supplied 25% of the funding for construction, with the rest funded by local groups and governments. Almost five thousand schools in fifteen states were built. One hundred of the schools survive today.






Make Sure Your Revocable Living Trust Is Not An Empty Box

A Revocable Living Trust is a very valuable estate planning tool. If done properly, it can avoid probate, as well as protect you and your assets if you are incapacitated. However, unlike a Last Will and Testament, it does not automatically apply to all of the assets that you own. When a client comes in to discuss doing a Revocable Living Trust, I analogize the Trust to a box that we are building. Typically, the first thing that we put into the box is your home. We prepare a Quit



We then provide an instruction letter that explains what the client needs to do to transfer other assets to the Trust, such as brokerage accounts and bank accounts. You can also name the Trust as a beneficiary for IRA accounts. But it is generally up to the client (unless the attorney is hired specifically to do this administrative work) to follow-up with the banks and the brokers to be sure that the proper paperwork is completed to change the name of the account to the Trust.

Usually, the financial institution will require a copy of the first page of the Trust which indicates the name and the date that it was executed. The institution may also require copies of the last pages with the witnesses and notary. The client will then complete a form with the institution which will result in the account being changed from the individual name to the name of the Trust. Future statements will then show the client's name and the word Trustee or an abbreviation such



as TTE. At that point, you know that the account is in the name of the Trust.

If this administrative work is not done, and there are no beneficiaries listed for the particular account, then the account will need to be probated in order for the Trust to get it. This is done via the "Pourover" Will that is typically executed at the same time as the Trust. This "Pourover" Will names the Trust as the beneficiary of any asset that is only in the name of the individual with no

beneficiaries designated. Of course, if you already have beneficiaries designated on all accounts, it is not necessary to name the Trust.

If you already have a Revocable Living Trust and you want your Trust to cover all of your assets, you should contact your brokers, banks, investment advisors, etc. to be sure that your Trust is either named as the beneficiary of the account (for an IRA) or that you as the Trustee are the owner of that account. Also, be sure that you own your home and any other real estate as Trustee of your Trust. If you do not, you should see an attorney to do a Quit Claim Deed. Remember, your Trust is only an empty box until you put something into it.

Crying Is Healthy For Me

I am not a psychologist, and I did not study human nature. However, as to whether crying is healthy or not, I am an expert based on my experiences over seven decades. I have concluded that crying is healthy for me and many years ago I decided never to hold back my tears and try to be a macho man.

As you know, people cry for joy, in happy celebrations or sorrow and when in pain. People sometimes cry to celebrate the happiness or demise of other people they don't even know.

The first time I cried in public was on September 10, 1961, at the burial of my maternal grandmother - may her soul rest in peace. She was the only grandmother I grew up to really know and spent time with. On one occasion, I went to a market with her to sell kola nuts - she retailed kola nuts at a farmers' market that opened once a week. I do not remember my paternal grandmother's burial - she closed her eyes in 1956 when I was in the third grade.

I will never forget the second time I cried in pubic, on November 25, 1963, when the student-body at my High School, was informed President John F. Kennedy was assassinated the previous Friday. Two Peace Corps teachers at my school gave us the sad news at the assembly before school on that day. We were informed President Kennedy was assassinated on November 22, 1963, at 12:30 p.m. Central Standard Time in Dallas, Texas, while riding in a presidential motorcade through Dealey Plaza. He was pronounced dead about 30 minutes after the shooting.

That was one of the most memorable days not only in High School but in my whole life. I shed tears for the passing of someone I never met. Many students and I could not hold back tears when both Peace Corps teachers started to cry while they were talking about their beloved President.

Before that sad day, most students already knew President Kennedy started the Peace Corps program to help developing nations throughout the world. That program had many beautiful and intelligent teachers volunteered in many countries educating young and old. At my High School, we had three teachers that taught English, Chemistry and Biology.

March 10, 1969, was a bad day for me and my family, my hero, mentor, and paternal grandfather close his eyes forever. Everyone cried, even his first son who was perceived as a tough guy. I believed I cried more because I was the closet to him out of his grandchildren - I was fortunate I lived next door to him.

Few years ago, I started to write my biography to share information with my daughter and granddaughter. It was very difficult to write about my dear mother. I started and stopped several times because I could not hold back tears. My family lost her twenty months after I graduated from high school - she died at a very young age of forty-two. Over half of a century, since she closed her eyes, I cried numerous times publicly and privately for her loss. Some of those occasions were: when I got married in Brooklyn in 1973, the day the Registrar's Office at Baruch College told me I had completed the requirements for an undergraduate degree (B.B.A), on January 12, 1976, when my daughter was born at Down State Medical Center in Brooklyn and on December 14, 1978, when I knew I had completed a master's degree in finance, at Saint John's University. I also cried for joy whenever my daughter accomplished something in her journey in this world: graduation from kindergarten, elementary school, high school, and college. I wished my mother were here to witness those occasions.

There were many other occasions when I couldn't hold back tears - here are few of them:

- Whenever there was a mass shooting of people especially innocent small children
- Whenever a soldier or a fireman is buried
- When Lady Diana of United Kingdom was buried
- When Nelson Mandela closed his eyes forever
- At the end of the Movie "Mamma Mia" when Meryl Streep sang the song "The Winner Takes It All" by the pop group ABBA

Every time I shed tears, I felt better. Try it, don't hold back your tears anymore.

Should Inflation Affect Your Investment Moves?

As you know, inflation heated up in 2021, following years of pretty stable – and low – numbers. And now, early in 2022, we're still seeing elevated prices. As a consumer, you may need to adjust your activities somewhat, but as an investor, how should you respond to inflation?

First, it helps to know the causes of this recent inflationary spike. Essentially, it's a case of basic economics – strong demand for goods meeting inadequate supply, caused by material and labor shortages, along with shipping and delivery logjams. In other words, too many dollars chasing too few goods. Once the supply chain issues begin to ease and consumer spending moves from goods to services as the COVID-19 pandemic wanes, it's likely that inflation will moderate, but it may still stay above pre-pandemic levels throughout 2022.

Given this outlook, you may want to review your investment portfolio. First, consider stocks. Generally speaking, stocks can do well in inflationary periods because companies' revenues and earnings may increase along with inflation. But some sectors of the stock market typically do better than others during inflationary times. Companies that can pass along higher costs to consumers due to strong demand for their goods – such as firms that produce building materials or supply steel or other commodities to other businesses – can do well. Conversely, companies that sell nonessential goods and services, such as appliances, athletic apparel and entertainment, may struggle more when prices are rising.

Of course, it's still a good idea to own a variety of stocks from various industries because it can help reduce the impact of market volatility on any one sector. And to help counteract the effects of rising prices, you might also

consider investing in companies that have a long track record of paying and raising stock dividends. (Keep in mind, though, that these companies are not obligated to pay dividends and can reduce or discontinue them at any time.)

Apart from stocks, how can inflation affect other types of investments? Think about bonds. When you invest in a bond, you receive regular interest payments until the bond matures. But these payments stay the same, so, over time, rising inflation can eat into your bond's future income, which may also cause the price of your bond to drop – a concern if you decide to sell the bond before it matures. The impact of inflation is especially sharp on the price of longer-term bonds because of the cumulative loss of purchasing power.

However, Treasury Inflation-Protected Securities (TIPS) can provide some protection against inflation. The face value, or principal amount, of each TIPS is \$1,000, but this principal is adjusted based on changes in the U.S. Consumer Price Index. So, during periods of inflation, your principal will increase, also increasing your interest payments. When inflation drops, though, your principal and interest payments will decrease, but you'll never receive less than the original principal value when the TIPS mature. Talk to your financial advisor to determine if TIPS may be appropriate for you.

Ultimately, inflation may indeed be something to consider when managing your investments. But other factors – especially your risk tolerance, time horizon and long-term goals – should still be the driving force behind your investment decisions. A solid investment strategy can serve you well, regardless of whether prices move up or down.

Training To Make A Difference

"We don't rise to the level of our expectations; we fall to the level of our training." - Archilochus

Our nation has again experienced tragedy after multiple recent mass casualty shooting events in Buffalo, NY, Laguna Woods, CA and Uvalde, TX. As a community, we have learned about the value of training and preparedness after our own experiences at The Fort-Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport and Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School. Training is necessary for any profession but critical for first responders. Their safety and the lives of those they have sworn to protect depend on it.

I can tell you from experience no matter how mentally and physically prepared someone is, amid the emotion, adrenaline and urgency of the moment, the importance of training becomes immediately apparent. With more training comes increased

discipline, readiness and clarity of purpose. Speed, efficiency and accuracy are improved when we repeat actions and rehearse scenarios. You can equip people with the best tools, but they also need the knowledge and ability to use them effectively.

Today, our in-house training programs are second to none. Since accepting command of the organization, the Broward Sheriff's Office has become the first agency in Florida to have a nationally certified active shooter training unit. We continually rotate our deputies through critical incident and crisis mitigation exercises to ensure they are ready for any incident. BSO's Department of Fire Rescue and Emergency Services continues to raise the bar by introducing specialized training tactics and skills to enhance performance. One such skill includes the ability to draft, which involves gathering water from a static source should a fire hydrant not be available.



We have also prioritized Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) training for all deputies to engage more effectively with individuals experiencing a crisis or mental health issue. Currently, more than 60 percent of our Department of Law Enforcement deputies are CIT trained, which is more than double the national average, as well as 40 percent of our Department of Detention deputies. Additionally, 74 percent of all BSO employees, and 96 percent of all deputies, have completed the Racial Intelligence Training and Engagement course (RITE), which reinforces a bias-free workplace and teaches racial and cultural sensitivity and de-escalation techniques.

Tactical performance, readiness and professional development training are instrumental to preparedness in public safety and are offered at every level of our agency. We have established

partnerships with top organizations and educational institutions to provide enhanced training for our sworn personnel and executive development for our command staff, managers and directors. Our comprehensive training approach has made BSO a flagship training organization and has attracted public safety professionals locally and nationally.

Our progress will continue. The construction of our state-of-the-art training center is hitting a fevered pace. Once completed, the 103,000-square-foot facility will house all our training initiatives under one roof and usher in a new and exciting era at BSO.

ASK DR. JOY

A while back my friends thought I should write about living alone. This is something I've been doing for the past 13 years and have come to really like a lot. When I first embarked upon this new way of living I didn't know if I would like it or even get used to it. I had been living with someone my entire life. First my parents and then I got married at 20. I had spent time alone, even as much as

a month at a time, but that kind of alone is very different. I was spending time alone but I wasn't really 'alone'. A good friend at that time, told me it would become an acquired taste and I would come to love it. I thought he was crazy but as it turned out he was right. At least for me.

However, people have very different experiences of this condition. Some, like myself, enjoy it while others absolutely loathe it and are desperate to find someone to live with. My eavesdropping and observing have led me to believe that fear is the biggest reason for this. So I guess this article will be more about fear than aloneness.

Fear is different depending upon your age, financial situation, family situation, friend situation, etc. I could probably go on and on with various reasons for fear. At the ages of many Wynmoor residents, the fear is often about becoming ill or infirm and not being able to care for ourselves. That is a valid concern. If you are financially able you can hire a daily or live-in aide which alleviates that problem. If you are in financial hardship it becomes more of an issue. Some Medicare plans and Medicare advantage plans will enable you to have the help you need, at least part of the time. Here is where there will be overlap with the friends and family situation. Should this be the main reason to want to live with someone? That depends upon the state of your present health and your age. Would you want to live with another person if it were that person who needed the assistance and care? That is just as likely to occur. Something to think about.

Another fear is fear of loneliness. This is similar to the prior issue because if it falls into the fear category, it's really just about being alone if something

happens. There is a separate category which is just plain loneliness without the fear. If this is your reason for wanting to live with someone it may work out well but it also may backfire. If it's about your need to have someone can you really be discriminating or will the neediness lead to living with the first available and willing partner. And will that person stick around when you fall ill or infirm? Will you be willing to become the caregiver?

Here is where friends and family come into play. Here in Wynmoor, you really don't have to be alone unless you want to be. Unless of course, you are ill and housebound which brings us back to the beginning of this article.

But if you are youngish and able-bodied you can join so many classes, courses and social events that you will wonder how you ever had time to do those necessary tasks like buying food or doing laundry. There is so much to do that you may be happy to come home to an empty apartment, kick off your shoes and collapse on the couch without anyone asking what's for dinner. A crucial aspect of this is that Wynmoor is very much a couple community and the world is also very much couple oriented. That doesn't mean you need to live with someone on a full time basis. You can enjoy each other's company and then go home to your separate residences.

There are really so many choices that I don't know why I hear so many men and woman being so distressed over this subject. If you feel like you absolutely want to live with someone I believe that you can find someone of like mind. Does it have to be an opposite sex person? Safety Solutions

July is National Vehicle Theft Prevention Month

July is National Vehicle Theft Prevention Month. While Wynmoor Village is not among our "hot spots" of stolen car activity by any stretch of the imagination, it's still important to keep in mind these theft prevention tips when it comes to your car, truck, or SUV:

- Always park in well-lit areas.
- Roll up your windows and lock your doors when you park.
- Don't have any valuables in the car that anyone can see.
- Never leave your keys in car, or those key fobs that they have nowadays.
- Never get out and leave your vehicle running.
- Get into the habit of locking your car every time you walk away from it. Nearly all those tips are "no-brainers" but you would be surprised how many cars get stolen because the owner decided to run into the convenience store "because it would only take a minute." We call those "crimes of opportunity" and you can bet that the thieves don't miss many opportunities.

Our number of reported stolen vehicles increased by about 34 percent in 2021 compared to 2020, going from 77 in 2020 up to 103 last year. Early statistics indicate we're up slightly again this year (2022) compared to this same time period last year. The most popular days for car thieves to swipe a vehicle in Coconut Creek were Mondays, Tuesdays, and Thursdays according

to our statistical analysis. The stats also showed that you were far more likely to have your car stolen during the early morning hours, midnight to 4:00 a.m., than any other time frame.

Again, since Wynmoor is a gated community, stolen vehicle cases are very rare. But it's important to remember that you could get your car stolen from anywhere, which is why we want you to practice the prevention habits outlined above. For the most part, thieves are lazy. If your car is locked and there's nothing in it they want, nine-times-out-of-ten they're going to leave it alone.

The most common makes and models stolen in 2021 in Coconut Creek according to our numbers were: the Nissan Altima (7 thefts), the Toyota Camry (5 thefts), the Honda Accord (5 thefts), the Nissan Rogue (4 thefts), and the Dodge Challenger, the Honda CRV, the Honda Civic, the Chevy Silverado, and the Infiniti Q50 with 3 each.

Methods of entry, or how the bad guys are getting into these cars, are hard to pinpoint. Most of the time our investigators aren't going to be able to tell. But we do see that between 5-10 percent, on average, are stolen because the vehicle was left unlocked with the keys in it.

The bottom line is what we call "target hardening," or making whatever a thief wants harder to steal. The simplest way you can do that is by always locking your car doors. The main reason we don't always know how a thief got inside a car in order to steal it is because the thief makes sure it's never seen again.

Acupuncture Without Needles

The number one question I hear from prospective patients regarding acupuncture is "Does it hurt?" Indeed, this fear of needles is the most often-stated reason that people choose not to receive acupuncture treatment.

And who can blame them? Between going to the dentist or getting vaccines, boosters and routine blood draws at the doctor's office or taking necessary self-administered shots of

prescription meds, we have all been conditioned to be afraid of needles. And no matter how much I explain how acupuncture needles are entirely different than those used for injections, are as thin as a human hair and produce little-to-no discomfort for most patients, it does little to quiet the fear.

Luckily, for many conditions, there are effective methods of treatment that do not require the use of acupuncture needles but are just as effective as if needles were used. These methods include manual and micro-current electrical stimulation of acupoints, trigger point therapy, acupressure, tuina and gua-sha (Chinese physical therapies), and cupping. For those patients who prefer not to receive traditional needle-based acupuncture, I will typically use a combination of such needle-free methods as well as prescribe Chinese herbal formulas when appropriate.

Now you might ask, "Well, if you can use non-needle methods and achieve the same results, why would you choose to use needles?" And that would be a fair question. The answer is that it depends entirely on the condition being treated. Generally speaking, stress-related disorders such as insomnia, anxiety, depression, high blood pressure, digestive problems and some presentations of acute pain all respond very well to combinations of non-needle methods. Chronic pain, immune and auto-immune disease (Parkinson's, MS) and most neurological disorders such as neuropathy, sequelae of stroke, and ataxia usually require the addition of acupuncture needles.



Solid Contact is the Key


There are many articles on improving distance through club head speed. Most often this distance is illustrated with touring pros or long drive contestants. One over looked factor is the contact point on the face. The professional golfer and even long drive contestants have learned to find the center of the face more often than your amateur golfer. Hence, if you're looking to improve your distance the first order of business is to find the center of the face or very close to the center. Once achieved the higher the club head speed the more distance on your shot.

To help you find the center of the face more often here are some tips.


- 1 Choke down on your club always helps find center contact.
- 2 Consider your 3 or 5 wood as your driving club.
- 3 Narrow your stance to increase awareness of your speed muscles (ie. hands, wrists and arms).
- 4 Utilize aids to help identify where your contact point is on your club.

See attached photos! Remember speed kills! This reference reminds you if you can't control the club face at higher speeds by reducing the speed the center contact point will improve.

PREPARE FOR HURRICANE SEASON

STORM PREPARATION

DOCUMENTATION

- Take pictures of EVERYTHING inside and outside of your house, vehicles, and any business equipment or crops.
- Gather all important documents including passports, birth certificates, medical records, receipts, etc.

SECURE YOUR PROPERTY

- Check on your homeowners or renters insurance.
- Protect valuables from flooding and rain by raising items off the ground, packing in plastic, and moving from windows.
- · Sandbag doorways for flooding.
- Prepare plywood for windows.

TAKE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Shut off water and gas line, main break, and unplug items.
- Secure any loose items outside of your home (trash cans, etc).
- Get refills on any necessary prescriptions.
- · Restock your first aid kit.

COLLECT SUPPLIES

- Focus on the essentials and plan to have no power or water.
- Collect enough food/water/ medicine for 3-7 days.
- Gas, batteries, radios, chargers
- Supplies for pets including carriers and rabies records.
- Basic tool-kit.

MAKE A PLAN FOR STAYING & GOING

- Evaluate the risks for your own situation (type of house, trees near your house, flooding, etc.)
- Check the storm surge maps for your area.
- How long are you willing to stay in your house w/o power?

PREPARE FOR A COMMUTE

- Current roads and markets are not designed for 80-100% of the population to use them, so gas up your cars and know your route.
- Plan on the trip taking 3-4x
- Bring snacks & games for the trip.

STEPS AFTER THE STORM



After the storm, roads may be closed and power could be out for days if not weeks. Make sure to document all damage, keep all receipts, and be wary of predatory contractors. Review your insurance coverage and utilize the recovery websites and agencies.

Items Especially For Seniors

In addition to the standard recommendations for a preparedness kit, there are a number of items specific to seniors that you should probably include in your kit as well. These include:

Medications

You will probably want to include an additional weeks' supply of medications in your kit. To get that extra supply, inform your doctor or other health care provider of the fact that you're putting together an emergency supply.

Medical Equipment

You will also want to have supplies for your essential medical equipment. This can include:

- Batteries for hearing aids
- Spare pairs of glasses
- Spare dentures
- Equipment for monitoring blood sugar and blood pressure, if needed
- Spare oxygen tanks

Having spares of all these items in your kit will save you time searching the house to make sure you haven't forgotten anything.

Medical Documents

Just as with all the other essential documents you'll want to have on hand, you'll also want to have information about any medical needs you have. This should include:

- Basic information like your blood type, any allergies you have, and a list of any conditions you're dealing with.
- An outline of the treatment you're receiving and any other essential care or comfort information
 - Information about your medical equipment needs
 - A list of prescriptions you receive along with the dosages you take
 - A list of contact information for your physicians
- Copies of your Medicare, Medicaid, and other types of insurance information.

Finally, if you have a service animal, it might be useful to include their documentation in your kit as well; for all pets, you may want to include immunization information among your documents in case you have to bring them to a shelter or board them somewhere.

Special Plans

To prepare for hurricane season, the best strategy is to go all out—do the most you can to prepare for the worst. This includes:

- Take an inventory of valuables in case the storm damages the home. This can be as simple as taking a video or pictures of your home's interior using the camera on your phone.
- Make your home as weather-proof as possible, including cleaning out gutters and downspouts and making sure sump pumps and other anti-flooding measures are in good condition. You may also want to make sure that valuable items and important documents are out of the range of any floodwaters.
- Be ready to evacuate. Try to make your emergency preparedness kit is as portable as possible, and, if you have a car, always leave it with at least half a tank of gas during hurricane season to facilitate a quick getaway.

Balance and Aging

Last month I covered the many causes and risk factors related to balance and falling issues with seniors.

This month I want to go over some of the things you can do to improve your balance. If you do these exercises alone you will need to have something to hold on to like a counter top or a sturdy chair. You can also have someone help you, like a friend or family member, as long as they are capable of holding you. You may need a fitness instructor, at least in the beginning until your ability and confidence improve.

Most of these exercises are simple but can be made progressively more difficult. In the beginning just do the simple ones.

The first exercise is a squat. You can hold on to a counter top or a chair. Do 12 repetitions. Next do heel raises to strengthen the calf and ankles. 12-20 repetitions.

With someone helping you, try walking heel to toe for 10-20 steps. Holding on, lift one foot slightly off the ground, hold for 10-20 seconds, then repeat with the other foot. Walk normally one foot in front of the other, no shuffling, pick up your feet and no wide gait. One foot at a time raise your heel to the butt.

These are enough movements to get you started. Next month I'll give you more including some upper body exercises that will help with posture, which helps balance.

You should try to do these exercises 2-3 times a week. Everyone asks, how long before I see improvement and how much am I going to improve? The more consistent and dedicated you are the more positive results you will get. I tell everyone, especially seniors, I can't guarantee your results but I can guarantee you if you do nothing, it will get worse.

A Source of Exhilaration For A Longtime Florida Resident

A few months ago, I returned to the Lowe Art Museum on the bustling campus of the University of Miami. Once more, I was fortunate enough to enjoy these fine exemplars of Italian Old Master Paintings; Sienese Master, Lippo Vanni's "Madonna and Child Enthroned With Saints Elizabeth and Dominic With Donors," Late Medieval Period, produced during the time the Papacy was based in Avignon, France, Guidoccio Cozzarelli's Italian Renaissance Period Painting, "Annunciation With Journey To



Bethlehem," Filippo Mazzola's Renaissance Period Painting, "Portrait of Man," Pietro Dandini's fine Mannerist, Baroque Period work, "Judith With Head of Holofernes," and Giovanni Paolo Panini's splendid 18th Century, Neoclassical Theme Painting, "Capriccio of Classical Ruins With Healing Lame At Pool of Bethesda," among others.

I also saw a delightful paradigm of quality Netherlandish Renaissance Painting by Adriean Isenbrant, "Madonna and Christ Child With Member of Hillenberger Family." Typical of the Netherlandish Renaissance Period, there is a landscape in the background. From the Flemish Baroque, I saw a fine painting by Jacob Jordaens, "Judgement of Paris" with its delightful flesh tones.

As for Spanish Baroque Art, I saw fine examples of Spanish Mannerism by Bartolome Murillo, "Portrait of Gentleman," Juisepe Ribera, "Saint Onuphrias," and El Greco, "Saint Peter," "Feast In House of Simon" from the 17th Century.

The Lowe Art Museum has a wonderful collection of Glass Art produced in the 20th Century. Favorites that day were; Christine Federighi's "Globe," Emily Brock's "Hotel Lobby," Robert Arneson's "Nasal Flat," Viola Frey's ceramic creation "Artist/Mind/Studio/World," Robin Grebe's "Edifice," and Janusz Walentowicz' "Madeleine With Birds." Dale Chihuly,

Harvey Littleton, and Hank Murta Adams were also well-represented.

As for Contemporary Art, I saw fine works by Kehinde Wiley, a leading African American Contemporary Painter, "Three Field Defense," Kim Tscheng-Yeaul, "Waterdrop," Frank Stella, and Samuel Jones, "Poplar Trees" in this relatively small art museum with a wide range of Art.

The Lowe Art Museum has been a source of delectation for the past forty-two years that I have lived in South Florida. 



Salt-and-Pepper BBQ Ribs

Cooked low and slow until the meat is falling off the bone, then grilled to give it just the perfect amount of char, BBQ ribs are the perfect backyard cookout celebration food.

Ingredients

1/4 c. light or dark brown sugar 1/4 c. coarsely ground black pepper 1/4 c. kosher salt 10-1/2 lb. spareribs (about 3 racks) Canola oil, for grill grates 1-1/2 c. barbecue sauce

Directions

- 1. Preheat oven to 300°F. Combine brown sugar, pepper, and salt in a bowl. Place each rack of ribs on a large sheet of foil (it should be long enough to fold over ribs lengthwise); sprinkle ribs with rub. Wrap each rack individually and place on 2 large rimmed baking sheets.
- 2. Bake until ribs are very tender (meat will separate from bone when you wiggle it), 2 to 2 1/2 hours. Set aside until cool enough to handle.
- 3. Carefully unwrap each rack of ribs; pour off any accumulated juices into a liquid measuring cup. (Ribs can be made up to this point up to 3 days ahead. Refrigerate ribs and cooking liquid until ready to eat.)
- 4. Set up grill for direct cooking and heat to medium-high. Once hot, clean and oil grates. Remove any fat that has settled at top of cooking liquid and discard. Transfer liquid to a small saucepan and add barbecue sauce. Cook over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until smooth and combined, 4 to 6 minutes.
- 5. Brush both sides of ribs with sauce mixture. Grill ribs, turning and basting occasionally, until ribs are deeply browned and shiny, 5 to 8 minutes. Cut ribs between bones and serve with any remaining sauce.

No grill? No problem. Finish these simple yet super-flavorful ribs under a hot broiler instead.



Root Beer Baked Beans

Ingredients

1/3 c. molasses

4 slices bacon, cut into 1-inch pieces 1 large yellow onion, chopped Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

2 tbsp. whole-grain mustard

1 lb. dried navy beans, soaked overnight

1 (12-ounce) bottle root beer

2 tsp. apple cider vinegar



Directions


- 1. Preheat oven to 300°F. Cook bacon in a large Dutch oven over medium heat, stirring occasionally, until mostly crisp, 5 to 7 minutes. Add onion and season with salt and pepper. Cook, stirring occasionally, until onion begins to soften, 4 to 6 minutes. Stir in molasses and mustard.
- 2. Drain soaked beans and add to the pot, stirring to coat. Add root beer and bring to a simmer, stirring occasionally. Add 4 cups water and season with salt and pepper. Return to a simmer, stirring occasionally. Cover and transfer to the oven. Bake until liquid is reduced by half, about 2 1/2 hours. Uncover and continue to bake until the cooking liquid is reduced and a light crust has formed on the top, 1 1/2 to 2 hours. Stir in vinegar. Let cool slightly before serving.



Senior Touchline



What is Senior Touchline?
Senior Touchline is a free service that offers a daily telephone call for people over 60 years of age who live alone. The purpose of the program is to ensure that older adults can maintain their sense of well-being while remaining in their homes.

Touchline calls also provide social and emotional support. The 2-1-1 counselor establishes a relationship with the senior and provides them with a sense of security and safety. One simple phone call can help give a client peace of mind knowing that a volunteer will be checking in with them at the same time each day.

How Does Touchline Work?

Each day, within a pre-determined period, a 2-1-1 counselor calls registered seniors to make sure they are safe and well. If the 2-1-1 counselor is unsuccessful in reaching the senior after one hour of repeated attempts, the designated emergency contacts will be called and asked to check on the senior's well-being. If we cannot reach anyone, we contact the local police department to perform a senior wellness check to confirm their safety.
