Starting Saturday night, June 4th, we will be celebrating our third Pilgrimage Holiday- Shavuot (weeks). The holiday occurs on the 50th day, or seven weeks, after Passover. The holiday is also called Pentecost from the Greek for 50.

In most Reform Synagogues, and in some Conservative Congregations, Confirmation Services are held. In the liturgy for the holiday, the young adults stand before the Torah scroll(s) and agree to accept the covenant between God and Israel.

As with most Jewish holidays there are special foods. Often, dairy foods are eaten. When God told the Israelites that they would enter a "land of milk and honey" people believed that they had permission to eat both. Sephardic Jews eat a special bread called siete cielos-seven heavens. Cheesecake, blintzes, and kugel are popular additions to the menu.

Mmmm. What about an Egg Cream? Remember them? Fox's U-Bet chocolate syrup, cold milk, and seltzer-preferable from a spritz bottle-stirred well-and you have it. I remember my grandfather serving these famous drinks at the Grand Sweet Shop in Englewood, New Jersey. What memories. In New York in the mid 1950's, you could get them almost everywhere. So, how did this become a Jewish drink?

The egg cream came out of the Jewish communities of the Lower East Side and Brooklyn. Barry Joseph, author of "Seltzertopia," says a Jewish immigrant by the name of Louis Auster created the egg cream around 1930. It was cheap and satisfying. The seltzer trade in New York was heavily Jewish, and Jews loved to drink seltzer-and egg creams!

Herman Fox, a Jewish man, invented his chocolate syrup in his tenement home about 1910. People loved it.

The egg cream has no egg and no cream but denotes richness. It is possible that Mr. Auster was trying to emulate some drinks sold uptown in the fancier neighborhoods.



"Daddy" By Linda R. Teicher

Father's Day - 2022 Daddy, Daddy, Daddy

I recently wrote a story entitled, "Mommy" which you may have read. Well, Daddy was in many ways so different, yet just as wonderful a parent, and unqualifiedly loved and cherished by me, his youngest child, Linda Rose.

As the youngest of four much older siblings, Daddy had already reached the age of forty-five, by the time I appeared on the scene. As an adult, my sister Gail informed me that I was an accident. Perhaps this is true, but I told both my parents that I was the best mistake they ever made!

The following are words I would use to describe my Daddy; sweet, loving, gentle, silly, devoted, caring, just to name a few.

Daddy was a dentist, Dr. Samuel L. Mantel, to be exact. Both Mommy and Daddy were born on the Lower East Side of Manhattan and met on the stoop. When Daddy asked Mom to marry her, she said that she would accept the proposal if he promised to take her to the St. George swimming pool, so she could dive off the high diving board. He did, and so they got married. The marriage lasted for sixty-three years. They slept in that four poster bed in which they both died six weeks apart to the day.

When Daddy was growing up he wanted to be a professional gymnast, attending a school called Savages, to pursue this career. Daddy's older brother, a doctor as well, insisted he follow suit. For whatever reason, Dad decided that this was not for him, so his brother said that he could become a dentist instead.

After fifty-three years of practice and eighty years of age, he retired from dentistry. Interestingly, Dad's office on President Street in Brooklyn, was where we lived. The office was one of the rooms in the apartment. The living room doubled as the waiting room, which I loved. There was a constant flow

of patients sitting there waiting to see the dentist.


As a little girl I was taught how to speak with the patients to make them feel relaxed. When Herby and I got married, a number of them gave us wedding gifts. Remembering this experience now, leaves me with a warm feeling. To this day, I find it easy to converse with people. They all loved Dr. Mantel and came to him for many years.

When I went to college 400 miles away, Herby was already my boyfriend, but our parents had not yet met. Herby told me that he had taken his mother for an appointment with my Dad. He then made her a set of uppers and lowers - Oh my!!!

I attended PS 241, right across the street and up the block from where we lived. Lunchtime, I was the only student who could go home, which prided me endlessly. So every day at noon when the other kids filed into the lunchroom, I simply ran down the street to have lunch with Mommy and Daddy. None of my other siblings were home, so it was just the three of us. I was in heaven and so were they.

I always was prepared with a joke, which put us all in a great mood. Either Mom or Dad would make me lunch, and we would listen to the radio; either Arthur Godfrey, Carlton Fredrick's, or some other funny soap opera type show, which I do not specifically recall. This was so special to me that I still can muster up the feelings.

Daddy liked to sing and dance, and had a really good tenor voice. He had an array of silly songs! After dinner we often took a neighborhood walk to walk off the dinner. More often than not we ended up at one of several Candy Stores. We would share a candy bar or sit at the counter and Daddy would buy me an ice cream sundae. This was a real treat; still is! During a hot summer's day I would call upstairs for money to buy an ice cream cone. It got to the point when I yelled upstairs, Daddy would answer by saying, "How much?"

Momma said that you asked her for a glass of orange juice. As she handed it to you, you closed your eyes and died. In retrospect, you died a hero; sacrificing your

That fleeting, vivid image was enough for me to forever remember your strength and goodness. This was the greatest gift I ever received. Thank you for your selflessness. You did well in your short stay on earth!

Karl Dickey: Promoting "Smart Friendships" in Boca Raton

Are you...

- New to South Florida?
- Between the ages of 55 and 75?
- Recently retired?
- In need of more destinations and routine in your life?
- Missing intelligent conversations about national or world situations?
- Hoping to meet different people outside of your immediate neighborhood?
- Longing to discuss current events in a group without screaming, cursing, and, inevitably, hearing the T---p word?



If you answered YES to any of the above, then you can greatly benefit from several meet-up groups under the heading *Boca Raton Coffee and Conversations* in Meet-Ups.com. Originally founded by Marty Bogrow, a dual resident of Florida and Colorado, the format of the group is simple, but interesting enough to hold everyone's attention for two hours. The venue is usually a casual restaurant, and the host comes prepared with several current topics. Attendance is capped at 10 or 15 so that all can voice their opinions, getting two minutes apiece. In the event of extra time, topics come from one of two bags marked *Serious and Not Serious*. Members put their own topics into each. Attendance has steadily increased, and Marty asked Karl Dickey to be a co-host in 2008.

Later Karl agreed to organize the meet-up, which had grown to two social breakfasts and four current events groups. Luckily Susan Brender, retired from a career in the news industry, volunteered to host another topical meeting. Then came the pandemic, when some members still wanted to meet in person, others online. Karl met the needs of both by creating a new Zoom group. That virtual meeting became so popular that now another co-host is needed. Marty and Karl deserve kudos for keeping the support of members for more than a decade. Over this time some have become close friends, sharing meals, holidays, and games together outside of the regular meetings.

Karl's main goal as a meet-up organizer is to facilitate discussions where participants, most professionals, feel safe and respect opposing viewpoints. In fact, he had originally joined Marty Bogrow's group to learn more about opposing political parties himself.

As a chairperson, he never touts his own accomplishments, which are many. During the 1990's he became annoyed with both political parties when he noticed that campaign promises were often shelved after candidates won elections. Since by the age of sixteen he already had a storefront business, leaving to attend college would have been a financial loss. Instead, he educated himself by reading hundreds of books about different parties and systems of government. Meanwhile, he sustained financially through buying and selling franchises, mostly dry-cleaning stores.

By chance, Karl heard the 1996 Libertarian Party nominee, Harry Browne, on C-Span and felt strong parallels to his own thinking. Soon after Karl changed his voter registration to the Libertarian Party. He has since chaired both the Libertarian Party of Palm Beach County as well as the Libertarian Party of Florida.

Although Karl lost a 2006 Senate run to Ted Deutch, his groups kept growing. He founded the Palm Beach Naturist Group as another meetup. That group later became active in a strong attempt to designate one Boca Raton beach as "clothing optional," modeled after Haulover Beach in Miami and Blind Creek Beach in St. Lucie County. Naturists argued that a special beach would result in a financial gain for the city, but the plan was eventually voted down.

The *Boca Raton Coffee and Conversation Group* has been a welcome outlet for retired people to voice their opinions. and learn from each other. Some are self-admitted "news junkies" that spend hours daily keeping up with cable news, radio broadcasts, podcasts, and other abstruse sources. They may even arrive with notes on research they have done. Others "wing it" with only what they hear from television or car radios.

Between the meetups he organizes and those he attends, Karl guesstimates his time output is twenty hours per week. It is no exaggeration to say that Karl Dickey's contributions to the residents of both Broward and Palm Beach Counties continue to yield only positive results. Should he ever run for office again, he'll be the rare politician who has already listened to voters for more than a decade.

PREPARE FOR HURRICANE SEASON

STORM PREPARATION

DOCUMENTATION

- Take pictures of EVERYTHING inside and outside of your house, vehicles, and any business equipment or crops.
- Gather all important documents including passports, birth certificates, medical records, receipts, etc.

TAKE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Shut off water and gas line, main break, and unplug items.
- Secure any loose items outside of your home (trash cans, etc).

- Check on your homeowners or renters insurance
- Protect valuables from flooding and rain by raising items off the ground, packing in plastic, and moving from windows.
- Sandbag doorways for flooding.
- Prepare plywood for windows.

COLLECT SUPPLIES

- Focus on the essentials and plan to have no power or water.
- Collect enough food/water/ medicine for 3-7 days.
- Gas, batteries, radios, chargers
- Supplies for pets including carriers and rabies records.
- · Basic tool-kit.

PREPARE FOR A COMMUTE

- Current roads and markets are not designed for 80-100% of the population to use them, so gas up your cars and know your route.
- Plan on the trip taking 3-4x
- Bring snacks & games for the trip.

STEPS AFTER THE STORM



After the storm, roads may be closed and power could be out for days if not weeks. Make sure to document all damage, keep all receipts, and be wary of predatory contractors. Review your insurance coverage and utilize the recovery websites and agencies.

Items Especially For Seniors

In addition to the standard recommendations for a preparedness kit, there are a number of items specific to seniors that you should probably include in your kit as well. These include:

Medications

You will probably want to include an additional weeks' supply of medications in your kit. To get that extra supply, inform your doctor or other health care provider of the fact that you're putting together an emergency supply.

Medical Equipment

You will also want to have supplies for your essential medical equipment. This can include:

- Batteries for hearing aids
- Spare pairs of glasses
- Spare dentures
- Equipment for monitoring blood sugar and blood pressure, if needed
- Spare oxygen tanks

Having spares of all these items in your kit will save you time searching the house to make sure you haven't forgotten anything.

Medical Documents

Just as with all the other essential documents you'll want to have on hand, you'll also want to have information about any medical needs you have. This should include:


- Basic information like your blood type, any allergies you have, and a list of any conditions you're dealing with.
- An outline of the treatment you're receiving and any other essential care or comfort information
 - Information about your medical equipment needs
 - A list of prescriptions you receive along with the dosages you take
 - A list of contact information for your physicians
- Copies of your Medicare, Medicaid, and other types of insurance information.

Finally, if you have a service animal, it might be useful to include their documentation in your kit as well; for all pets, you may want to include immunization information among your documents in case you have to bring them to a shelter or board them somewhere.

Special Plans

To prepare for hurricane season, the best strategy is to go all out—do the most you can to prepare for the worst. This includes:

- Take an inventory of valuables in case the storm damages the home. This can be as simple as taking a video or pictures of your home's interior using the camera on your phone.
- Make your home as weather-proof as possible, including cleaning out gutters and downspouts and making sure sump pumps and other anti-flooding measures are in good condition. You may also want to make sure that valuable items and important documents are out of the range of any floodwaters.
- Be ready to evacuate. Try to make your emergency preparedness kit is as portable as possible, and, if you have a car, always leave it with at least half a tank of gas during hurricane season to facilitate a quick getaway.

Commentary On The Practice Of Medicine

It is believed that the information presented below never received the typical media (TV, radio, newspaper etc.) attention it deserved. The facts are derived from an article published in the Journal American Medical **Association, July 26, 2000, 284(4) 483-485** titled "Is US Health Really the Best in the World?" This is the first time such an article appeared in a prestigious publication. It documents the tragedy of the traditional medical paradigm and indicates that doctors are the third leading cause of deaths in the US, killing 225,000 people every year.

The author is Dr. Barbara Starfield of the Johns Hopkins School of Hygiene and Public Health, and she describes how the US health care system may contribute to poor health. She enumerates the following **deaths per year:**

- 12,000 unnecessary surgery
- 7,000 medication errors in hospitals
- 20,000 other errors in hospitals
- 80,000 infections in hospitals
- 106,000 non error, negative effects of drugs

These total 225,000 deaths per year from iatrogenic causes!! What does the word iatrogenic mean? This term is defined as induced in a patient by a physician's activity, manner, therapy, or a complication of treatment. Dr. Starfield offers several warnings in interpreting these numbers. First, most

of the data is derived from studies of hospitalized patients. Second, these estimates are for deaths only and do not include negative effects that are associated with disability or discomfort. Evidence from a few studies indicates that as many as 20% to 30% of patients receive inappropriate care, and an estimated 44,000 to 98,000 die each year as a result of medical errors. According to the Institute of Medicine (part of the National Academy of Science), the total cost of medical mistakes, lost income and production, cost of disability and health care, totals \$17 to 29 billion a year.

Above is a summary of an article that appeared in the prestigious Journal American Medical Association. Ask yourself do you think anything has changed in the last twenty years? So now that you know is there anything you can do to protect yourself? Yes, become an expert. First, know what ails you. Ask your doctor all about it. Research it on the internet. Patients should feel entitled to inquire about their care no matter how sick they are. Second, know about your drugs. The study shows more than 7,000 die each year because of medication errors. Lastly, adopt a healthy lifestyle to avoid or minimize the affects of any disease so you can stay out of the doctor's office.


**Ironically Dr. Barbara Starfield, the author of the article, died 10 years after her article appeared from a medical error.



Common Questions About ACUPUNCTURE

What is Acupuncture?

Acupuncture is a complete system of diagnosis and treatment which supports and maximizes our body's innate self-healing abilities.

How does it work?

In acupuncture treatment for pain, for example, very thin needles about the size of kitten's whisker are inserted at specific points on the surface of the

body. These points are called neural nodes. These nodes then trigger the brain, through the peripheral nervous system, to release naturally occurring endorphins and enkephalins, both of which have pain-relieving properties which reduce inflammation and increase blood circulation.

What does it treat?

Although acupuncture is most commonly used to treat pain (back pain, neck pain, knee pain, headaches, arthritis pain), ongoing research shows it is effective in treating numerous internal disorders such as respiratory, immune system and digestive problems, insomnia, anxiety, and high blood pressure, as well as symptoms associated with cancer and chemo-therapy.

Does it hurt?

When administered by an experienced acupuncturist these treatments are very comfortable for the patient and many actually fall asleep on the treatment table. The sensations felt by the patient can range from a sense of mild pressure to a gentle electrical tingling sensation. Most patients express surprise at how comfortable and pain-free the treatments are.

Hurricane Season Expected To Be "More Active Than Usual"



Hurricane season started June 1st. Most storm experts are expecting another season that will be "more active than usual." So it's time to get prepared now so you don't have to be so worried later.

It all starts with getting together a hurricane kit. It should include essentials

such as water, non-perishable food items, a place to keep your valuable papers, money and credit cards, and a first-aid kit. Keep it some place where you will remember it, and it's easy to get to. You also want to make it portable, in the sense that you can grab it and go if you need to.

Speaking of supplies, it is strongly recommended that you have seven days of supplies built up before the storm hits. Among the valuable lessons we learned back in 2005, from Hurricane Wilma, is that we need a lot more supplies than the nationally recommended three days' worth in case of a storm. For those of you who were around for the aftermath of Wilma, you may well remember that the lights did not come back on for well over three days.

If we get in the area of a Hurricane Watch, your preparations should begin. Fill the car up with gas. Make sure your hurricane kit is ready to go. Refill any prescription medications. Listen to City officials on if and when to put up shutters. Make sure your generator is working and you have enough gas to run it.

If a Hurricane Warning is issued, fill up your bath tub and jugs with water.

Optimally, you want to have at least a gallon of water per person per day. Get ready in case the power goes out. Think about which room in your home is the safest and stay there when the storm hits.

After the storm hits, it's important to remember to stay inside until the "all clear" is given. Never touch any low-hanging wires or downed power lines. Report those downed lines to your utility company and the police. When driving after the hurricane hits, allow yourself extra time to get to your destination in case you encounter obstacles such as damaged roadways or debris. Also, never run your generator indoors.

The City will keep you up-to-date on all watches and warnings through social media and our CocoAlerts, which you can sign up for by visiting the "hurricane information" page on the City's website, which is www. coconutcreek.net. You can also type in "hurricane" in the search engine at the top right of our page and it will allow you to easily navigate to the hurricane information page. You will be able to easily find shelter information on our hurricane page, including shelter information for people with special needs.

The City also activates and updates a Hurricane Hotline when we are facing the possibility of a storm. The number is 954-973-6771. It is also a good idea to write important phone numbers, like that one, on a sheet of paper and hang it up where you can see it, say on your refrigerator, in case you need it.

We have been fortunate that Coconut Creek has not taken any major hits from any named storms over the years. Let's hope it stays that way during this hurricane season.

Uninsured Motorist Coverage: Get It Now!

Yogi Berra used to say in a commercial: "That's the insurance when you don't have it, that's when you need it." He was definitely right when it comes to uninsured motorist car insurance coverage.

In Florida, only two types of coverage are required: personal injury protection (PIP) and property damage liability. It is estimated that one out of three drivers in Florida only have the minimum required coverage. It is important that you be fully protected in the event one of those drivers injures you due to a rear-end collision or other accident which is not your fault.

Therefore, it is extremely important that you properly protect yourself by carrying a maximum amount of uninsured motorist coverage (U.M.). I recommend at least \$100,000 per person/\$300,000 per occurrence for each vehicle in your household. If you have more than one vehicle, I

strongly recommend "stacking," which allows you to combine your coverage on each of your cars. Stacking is well worth the small additional premium.

Your U.M. coverage also stands for underinsured motorist coverage. This means that you can make a claim against the other driver's insurance and get the total amount available under that policy and still make an additional claim under your U.M. coverage if your injury justifies it.

During my forty years of handling personal injury

cases, I have often had to turn people away who were seriously injured through no fault of their own but did not have U.M. coverage and where the negligent party did not have bodily injury liability coverage. Trying to go after an individual driver in Florida is an exercise in futility since it will be virtually impossible to collect even if you go to trial and get a judgment against that person. If you do make an uninsured motorist claim with your own company, this should not affect your premium since you were not at fault.

Your uninsured motorist coverage follows you wherever you go. You can make an uninsured motorist claim if you are driving a rental car, driving someone else's car, a passenger, a pedestrian, a bicyclist, or injured in another state. This coverage provides you the maximum protection to insure that

you will be compensated fully for your injuries if someone else is at fault.







Balance and Aging By Ron Molino, Certified Personal Trainer

As a long time Wynmoor resident and trainer in the Wynmoor Fitness Center, I've had the opportunity to observe people through the eyes of a fitness professional. I've observed how they exercise, sit and stand, how they walk, and move in daily activities. I've lived here for more than twenty years and watched the population age, and sadly most have not aged well.

Unfortunately the aging process takes its toll on balance, due to various reasons which often lead to falling, which many times leads to serious injury or worse.

The most common causes are:

- 1. Inner ear and or vision problems.
- 2. Peripheral neuropathy or the slowing down of messages being sent to the brain.
- 3. Weakness.
- 4. Slower reflexibility.
- 5. Prior injuries or surgeries.
- 6. Medical issues such as Parkinson's, Diabetes, High or Low Blood Pressure.

- 7. Medications, chemotherapy, antibiotics and others.
- 8. Arthritis.
- 9. Joint problems.
- 10. Poor flexibility.

The percentage of people falling increases from 40% at age 65 to 65% at age 75 to 82% at age 85. Some of the highest risk factors for falls are: if you have fallen in the last year, you have a 5x greater risk of falling. If you have weakness the risk is 4.4x greater. If you have peripheral neuropathy the risk is 3.0x greater and if you have a balance problem the risk factor is 2.9x greater. These are the greater risks, but there are more, such as medications, cognitive decline and age.

Can you lower the risk of falling? Yes. There are some things you have control of. Next month I will cover some of them.

I will close for now with a quote from a pioneer in the fitness world. Author of the book *Fit or Fat*, written in 1978. His name is Covert Bailey and he is now 91 years old. I tell this to everyone I train, especially seniors.

"You don't stop moving when you get old, you get old when you stop moving"



A Joyful Return To An Enriching Art Musuem

Minneapolis is renowned for its picturesque lakes such as; Lake Harriet, Lake Calhoun, and Diamond Lake. Minneapolis also has a tip top art museum, the Minneapolis Institute of Art. Recently, I spent three and a half days at the Minneapolis Institute of Art enhancing my knowledge of Art. I especially appreciated its awesome collection of Old Master European Paintings from 14th Century to the end of the 18th Century.


"Late Medieval Italian Paintings" I saw fine paintings produced, during the Italian Trecento, 14th Century by Segna Buonaventura, Bernardo Daddi, Lippo

Vanni, and Nardo Di Cione. These fine paintings were produced, during the Babyllonian Captivity of the Papacy. It refers to the time that the Papacy left Rome and was based in Avignon, France and the popes were French. The paintings that I relished by Segna Buonaventura, Bernardo Daddi, Lippo Vanni, and Nardo Di Cione utilized egg tempera and gold leaf on wood panel.

I saw fine later Medieval Italian Paintings by Benedetto di Bindo Zoppo, "Saint Lucy" and Marrioto Di Nardo, produced by the time the Papacy returned to Rome. The paintings by Benedetto di Bindo Zoppo and Marrioto Di Nardo also employed egg tempera and gold leaf on wood panel.

"Renaissance Period Paintings" I saw fine Renaissance Period Italian Paintings from the 15th Century by Fra Angelico, "Nativity," Giovanni Dal Ponte, "Resurrectioin of Christ," and Bartolomeo Di Tommaso, "Pentecost" which employed landscapes in the background, instead of gold leaf. I also saw fine Renaissance Period Italian Paintings by Vincenzo Foppa and Cima de Conigliano.

I saw fine Northern European Renaissance Period Paintings of a devotional nature by Master of the Legend of Saint Lucy, Netherlandish, Jacob Jansz (Netherlandish), and Lucas Cranach the Elder (German), plus an awesome sculptural creation by the German Sculptor, Hans Schnatterpeck,



"Lamentation of Christ." I also saw impressive Renaissance Period Portraits by Georg Pencz (German), Jean Clouet (French), and Benedetto Ghirlandaio (Italian).

"Baroque Period, Mannerist Paintings" I saw many splendid paradigms of Chiaroscuro, Mannerism which involved exaggerated darkness and light. Painters with fine examples of Mannerism included the Italian Mannerists, Cavalliere d'Arpino, Titian, Onario Marinari, Guercino, and Giovan Gioseffo Dal Sole, "Judith With Head of Holofernes," Judaic theme, among

others.

Other Painters with impressive Mannerist-style Paintings included El Greco, Luis de Morales, Bartolome Murillo, Nicholas Mignard, Simon Vouet, Claude Vignon, "Saint Ambrose," Gerrit Honthorst, and Hendrick Terbruggen, "Gamblers," among others.

"Baroque Period Dutch Masters" The Minneapolis Institute of Art has a fine amalgam of Dutch Master paintings, including fine works by Rembrandt, "Lucretia," Jan Van Goyen, Bartolomeus Vander Helst, Paulus Potter, Ludolf Backhuysen, Pieter de Hooch, "Asparagus Seller" Jan Van Os, and Gabriel Metsu, among others.

"18th Century" I saw impressive French Paintings by Francois Boucher, "Saint John the Baptist," Elizabeth Vigee-Lebrun, Antoine Felix Boisselier with a fine Neoclassical Theme Painting, Hubert Robert, and Michel Garnier, among others. I saw fine punctilious Italian Paintings by Canaletto, Francesco Guardi, and Pompeo Batoni. I saw fine oil paintings by these British Painters; Sir Joshua Reynolds, Thomas Gainesborough, Joseph Wright of Derby, William Hogarth, and George Morland.

I highly recommend the Minneapolis Institute of Art, a true Upper Midwestern gem.

WYNMOOR Golf and Tips

Alignment... Get on the Right Track

Alignment in golf is not easy. This month's tip will give you the proper routine to align yourself to the target for a straight shot with no curve.

The most important factor is to aim your clubface first at the target. In the illustration this would be the

right track on this train track. After aligning your clubface, on the right track, you would set your feet and body to the clubface forming the left track. Most of my students who struggle with alignment are trying to aim their body first. Remember, your body is what is called "parallel left" by some instructors which again is the left track aligned after the club. For putts and shorter shots this is not as important (the left track) as your longer shots from the fairway or driving. In previous tips I suggested an intermediate point for you to pick on the target line or the right track. The idea behind an intermediate point is that it is easier to align to a point approximately 5 to 10 feet on the target line than the flagstick much further away. Get on the right track to Alignment!






Fred Funk - Illustrating the two tracks for alignment-Club on the right track body on the left track



Service Equals Reward

A United Front In Our Fight Against Fentanyl

Broward County is the statewide epicenter of a fentanyl epidemic ravaging the nation. During Spring Break, the deadly effects of the problem were made even more evident when thousands of college students flocked to the county, resulting in growing overdoses and hospitalizations. In one terrifying incident, six spring breakers from New York, including five West Point cadets, suffered severe fentanyl overdoses. The incident put faces and names on a crisis affecting every level of our society.

Fentanyl is a synthetic opioid up to 100 times more potent than morphine which mirrors the effects of heroin. Just a few salt-sized grains can lead to rapid death. Whether used as a cheap filler in illicit drugs or sold as a counterfeit pill made to look like prescription opioids, fentanyl is the leading contributor to overdose deaths in the United States.

The statistics are striking. Last year, more than 100,000 Americans died of drug overdoses, with about

100,000 Americans died of drug overdoses, with about two-thirds of the deaths linked to fentanyl and other synthetic drugs. In Florida, Broward County leads the state in fentanyl-related deaths. In 2020, 798 people died due to accidental overdoses, with 611 cases involving fentanyl. That's a staggering 72 percent increase in overdose deaths involving fentanyl from the year prior. Though cases for 2021 and 2022 are still being analyzed, they, unfortunately, appear on track to set new records.

While this public health emergency is historic, the Broward Sheriff's Office and community partners are committed to ending the deadly drug plague through a three-pronged approach of enforcement, intervention and education.

BSO detectives and deputies continue to track down the dealers and distributors of this poison and put them behind bars. Earlier this year, our Strategic Investigations Division (SID) and our law enforcement partners



took down members of the criminal street gang, Alwoods Gang. Detectives seized large quantities of illegal drugs during the operation, including more than 20 kilos of heroin and fentanyl.

The Broward Sheriff's Office also assists those who are struggling with addiction. For example, we have been instrumental in getting professional peer specialists deployed to Broward Health hospitals, so patients discharged after an overdose can be guided into appropriate treatment. In addition, BSO provides its deputies with the anti-opioid overdose drug, Narcan. BSO also coordinates a federal grant that facilitates the availability of Narcan to law enforcement agencies in Broward County.

Offering ongoing education to the community on the impact of illicit drugs is paramount to our efforts. As a member of the county's Community

Response Team, BSO conducts community education programs and advises the public about the dangers of fentanyl. In addition, to unify drug mitigation efforts between private and public sector organizations, I serve as the co-chair of Project Opioid Broward. The statewide initiative is a collaborative action by the Greater Fort Lauderdale Alliance Foundation and Florida Blue Foundation to address the opioid crisis.

Stopping this epidemic is a community effort, and we all need to work together to find solutions and save lives. 



Senior Touchline is a free service that offers a daily telephone call for people over 60 years of age who live alone. The purpose of the program is to ensure that older adults can maintain their sense of well-being while remaining in their homes.

Touchline calls also provide social and emotional support. The 2-1-1 counselor establishes a relationship with the senior and provides them with a sense of security and safety. One simple phone call can help give a client peace of mind knowing that a volunteer will be checking in with them at the same time each day.

How Does Touchline Work?

Each day, within a pre-determined period, a 2-1-1 counselor calls registered seniors to make sure they are safe and well. If the 2-1-1 counselor is unsuccessful in reaching the senior after one hour of repeated attempts, the designated emergency contacts will be called and asked to check on the senior's well-being. If we cannot reach anyone, we contact the local police department to perform a senior wellness check to confirm their safety.




