

Recommendations were made that smoke alarms should be in both bedrooms of each unit and outside in the hallway. The new smoke detectors are now using a 10-year lithium battery. As well, a recommendation was made to check the functionality of the smoke alarms in your unit. Wynmoor Community Council will do our best to see that fire alarms are tested and functional in all buildings and elevators at all times. A handyman can be available to you to change your existing batteries at a fee of \$10. If you choose to install a new system, each unit owner will need to purchase them. This new system features a lithium battery with a 10-year life span. The price for installation will be the regular handyman rate.

The services provided to our residents will be; ID Bar Codes, Architectural and Sales and Leases. We are confident this will be a more resident friendly process.



I had a pleasurable and satisfying experience of hosting my younger sister, her daughter, son-in-law and three beautiful grandchildren in New York during their vacation from London, United Kingdom. I found out that most people are happy or content with few things in their lives. Nobody is completely happy because there is one or few things missing in everyone's life. Three of the men I interviewed are content and happy with their financial security in retirement but are not completely happy because they found themselves single and living alone at sixty-eight years of age. Two of them said even though they had no regret why and how their two marriages ended, nevertheless, they are still unhappy about being alone at that age. Another good friend said he would never be completely happy because he lost his only son in a car accident many years ago.

For the younger generation, live life moderately and don't do anything in extreme or recklessly. Most important, save and invest for old age. It is better to be alone and be financially secured than to be alone and be poor.

Our Amazing Self-Healing Ability

One of the primary goals of Acupuncture, and many other forms of medicine including Western pharmacological-based medicine, is to create an environment in our bodies conducive to the expression of our own self-healing ability. Antibiotics,

for example, do not heal us from bacterial infection. They are used instead to reduce the bacterial load in our bodies so that our primary innate healing mechanism, our immune system, can take over and do the actual work. But there are other, less obvious healing mechanisms which are constantly operating to repair and our bodies and keep us healthy, if not immediately, then certainly over time.

For as long as I can remember I have been physically active. As a "hyperactive" child, I was either running like Forest Gump, swimming like Johnny Weissmuller in the Tarzan movies (he was my role model) or racing down steep hills on a way-too-big bicycle which had been handed down from my older cousins. Living in New Orleans in the 1980's I became involved in distance running, specifically 10K (6.2 miles) races. These were grand events in New Orleans, attracting professional runners from all over the world as well as wannabees like myself. The race would start in the historic French Quarter and proceed down Prytania Avenue through the Garden District with jazz bands playing along the way to support the runners. The event would conclude along St. Charles Avenue in majestic Auduban Park with a Mardi-Gras style party of music, food, beer, dancing and of course, the commemorative T-shirt given to all participants.

It was during a training run preparing for one of these "Crescent City Classics" as they were called, that I fell into a pot-hole in the street, breaking a small bone in my right foot, and spraining all the lateral ligaments. I was effectively crippled and never ran another race. It was 8 weeks until I was able to remove the cast. Following rehab I was still in pain. Every step was painful. I was told I would just have to learn to

live with it.

Fast forward 10 years and I was still in pain. I had completed my acupuncture training and had been treated numerous times by the best teachers my school had to offer as well as other practicing acupuncturists and I was still in pain.

Then I had a dream. In this dream I was back in acupuncture school. I recognized all my classmates sitting around me and the school was hosting 3 Chinese acupuncturists who were renowned for their skills. They asked for a volunteer and my hand immediately shot up. I was invited to the front of the classroom and sat on a treatment table. I pointed to my right foot and described precisely where it hurt. For the next several minutes the three discussed and argued (in Chinese) about points to be used for more treatment. After much haggling they decided or 4 acupuncture points, all local, and all very nearly (but not quite) at the exact same spots I have been needled dozens of times with no improvement. I sat there for some minutes, then the needles were removed, and I returned to my seat. That was the dream.

It was some time the next day that I realized my foot and ankle pain was gone. GONE!! And it's been gone ever since. How do I explain this? Well, in acupuncture theory it is said that "Qi (energy) follows thought" and that "Qi is the leader of blood". In acupuncture terms, pain is defined as the "stagnation of qi and blood". So it follows that to eliminate pain, the goal is the promote the free flow of qi (energy) and blood. If qi actually does follow thought, then it stands to reason we can facilitate qi (and blood flow) by intention and will. I do not know what supportive factors may have been operative the night of that dream other than my long-standing desire and intention for my foot pain to be gone and almost-daily visualizing healing warmth flowing to it.



On June 5, 2022, our dear friend and fellow scribe, Frank Lemco, passed away. Following a stroke, Frank, persevered as best he could, although, he and his beloved wife, Ruth, would never return to their winter home away from home, Wynmoor. He was a long-time member of the Saturday morning, Writer's Workshop and led another group on Thursday mornings for anyone who wanted to write just for the sake of sharing their stories or poetry.

Frank was one of my mentors early on, always encouraging, making suggestions when he felt appropriate, and sharing his prolific work with all of us. Contributing to the Insider was a common occurrence.

Examples of his prolific creations became self-published books which he gave away freely to those he cared about. I feel blessed to have a number of them that chronicle his varied and interesting life On the Main, his street and neighborhood in Montreal, Quebec. My favorites are his poetry. I'm including one of them for all of you to enjoy:

I believe everyone is a poet, Though not all can easily rhyme, Nor compose metered cantos Which resist the trials of time. For bards can weave the fibres Of lives the past has spun, Create stanzas of tapestry, Of events said and done By aged see, by perceptive child, By talented milliner, or maid, By joiner, master-mason, From every craft and trade. WHAT TO DO WHEN YOUR SPOUSE OR PARTNER DIES?

Losing your spouse, partner or significant other is a very traumatic event. It is most important for your physical and emotional well-being to give yourself time for the grieving process.

Once you feel mentally and emotionally able to do so, you should schedule an appointment with an attorney to review all Estate Planning legal documents.

You should bring your Will and/or Revocable Living Trust, Deed to your home and any other real estate, certified copy of the death certificate and, if married, date of your marriage. If your marriage.

copy of the death certificate and, if married, date of your marriage. If you have advanced care directives such as a Living Will, Durable Power of Attorney and Designation of Health Care Surrogate, you should bring those as well.

If your spouse or partner owned something in their name alone with no designated beneficiary, probate may be necessary. Bring details of such assets to the appointment.

If everything you owned was in both names, it is not necessary to probate the Will. However, regarding your home, and any other real estate, it is important to "Clear the Title." The lawyer will prepare and have you sign a "Continuous Marriage Affidavit," which is why you need the date of your marriage. The Affidavit will state that you were married on a certain date and remained continuously married without divorce until the date of death. It will provide the legal description of your home and other real estate and indicate your intention to clear title. This document will be recorded, along with an Affidavit of No Florida Estate Tax Due and the Death Certificate without the cause of death. Recording these documents will clear title and allow you the option to do a new Deed to avoid probate when you die. If you were not married but owned your home (or any other property) jointly, it is still important to clear title. Of course, a Continuous Marriage Affidavit will not be necessary.

If you do not have a Revocable Living Trust, this appointment will be a good opportunity to discuss the creation of a Trust and preparation of a Deed



in order to avoid probate on your home and other real estate. You can also discuss the option of a Life Estate Deed to avoid probate.

If you do have a Trust, this may be an appropriate time to consider doing an Amendment to the Trust based on new circumstances. Your home and other real estate (in Florida and out-of-state) should be owned by you as Trustee of the Trust. You may wish to name one of your children as Co-Trustee to make it easier to manage the

assets in your Trust if you become incapacitated. You may also wish to make changes in your Living Will, Durable Power of Attorney and Designation of Health Care Surrogate or create those documents if you do not have them.

In most cases, there is no urgency to contact an attorney. It is much better to have peace of mind and clarity. Some lawyers, including myself, will offer a free consultation. This consultation should include your options and give you the opportunity to sleep on it before finalizing any new legal documents.

In addition, when you are ready, there are actions you should take for which you do not need an attorney. This includes rolling over your spouse's IRA to yours, claiming life insurance benefits and naming beneficiaries on any joint accounts. If you have individual accounts or life insurance and your spouse is beneficiary, be sure to change it. However, your lawyer can advise you on these matters.

ASK DR. JOY

Thank you...



I'd like to take this opportunity to thank all those who signed up to take my Mind-Body Connection classes. As of today, both classes are due to start soon and are filled to capacity.

This article is more technical and less personal, and I would really like some feedback as to whether you found it helpful, interesting, boring or whatever. I know not too many comment but I would hate to keep writing articles that are useless to you.

Ok. That being said, here goes. While cleaning out my files I found these notes I wrote and since they are entirely different

than anything I've written for *The Insider* I thought I'd give them a try. They are from a presentation on relationships I gave sometime in the 90s about compensating strategies that people use in relationships that don't work.

Control Strategy: In order for a person to use this strategy, they must believe that they are inherently powerless and the relationship, the world and themselves present a potential for danger (physical or emotional). Others cannot be trusted so you must protect everyone including yourself from these internal or external dangers.

These people limit input and set up rules and regulations presumably to keep them safe.

It is difficult to be yourself, open and honest on the other side of a person exhibiting this strategy. Much more can be said here and maybe I will use this particular strategy as a stand-alone article in the future. After all we all know so many controlling people that it may be an interesting topic by itself. What do you think?

"Poor Me" Strategy: These people consider themselves powerless, profoundly misunderstood and unjustly wronged. The thing they want the most is for the person or persons who they believe have wronged them to make amends and have sympathy.

These people drain the life out of others because there is never enough that

they can do and often the slights are exaggerated and/or imagined. Sometimes these people are referred to as grievance collectors.

Let Me Entertain You Strategy: This person believes that on their own they have nothing or not much to offer. They must always bring something to the table to be desirable and/or wanted. They may be the first to volunteer, the one to have the best joke, the best advice (wanted or not, they can't tell the difference). They bring or make elaborate dishes for parties, always pay if they can, be witty and charming and full of wisdom. In other words, they offer some form of redeemable service to make themselves valued and worth-while.

They seek approval like a performer to see how well they did. Again, these people are tiring as they are always looking to you to tell them they are worthy. If you take their 'gifts' in stride they will escalate to larger ones because they believe they failed you.

They have not learned that true self-esteem only grows inside them and is not bestowed upon them by outside sources.

Avoidance Strategy: These people are always part-way out of a relationship. They tell themselves that either the other person or the present situation isn't right. They believe that something outside themselves (the right person who might be right around the corner) can do it for them but because they really can't trust their own judgment and believe a mistake in choosing a relationship is dangerous, they continue to avoid being fully present. Often a person like this helps to create a control strategy in their partner. These people are very often in jobs where they feel the same way as they do in a relationship.

There are various strings we place on our relationships and then compare the person with how we need them to be as if we were searching for a 'need fulfillment' machine. Like, in the narcissistic person who needs an idealized person, the avoider also has a notion of what the other person should do for or give to them. If that person isn't fulfilling those needs, they get fired and someone else is then hired to do it.

In reality people are not interchangeable and are not here to fulfill our needs. This is where my favorite line comes in. I have used this in my book and presentations and hopefully in my own life. It is not just for couple relationships but for every relationship with every person you engage with.

Never ask another person to be the change you need to be happy.

The Liberal Jewish Temple of Coconut Creek

It is often said that spring is the time of new beginnings. For The Liberal Jewish Temple, this Jewish New Year is our time to begin anew. After 40 years at our previous location, we have moved to the beautiful Waterside Landing at 5600 Lakeside Drive in Margate (just east of the Margate Post Office and one traffic light west of Banks Road off Coconut Creek Parkway). If you haven't already purchased your High Holy Day tickets, join us for services conducted by Cantor Malcolm Arnold commencing on Sunday, September 25th and 26th for Rosh Hashana and Yom Kippur, October 4th and 5th. Shabbat services will commence on Friday, October 21st at 7:30 p.m., conducted by Rabbi Paul Offenkrantz. A free bus will be available from Wynmoor Tract 1000 at 6:45 p.m. to take people to Waterside Landing. Please call Iris at 954-532-5268 to reserve a spot.

We are often asked to define Liberal (Reform) Judaism. In short, it is individual decisions, on personal religious practice, based on knowledge. The Union for Reform Judaism and The Central Conference of American Rabbis suggest certain standards and rituals, printing prayer books with multiple choices for Services. It is up to each Congregation's members, collectively and individually, to decide on practice.

The movement, which was established in Germany in the mid-19th century, was born of an attempt to reconcile Judaism with contemporary life and harmonize it with emerging currents in western thought. The movement is mostly politically liberal, egalitarian on gender issues, active in interfaith efforts and religiously progressive - accepting patrilineal descent and ordaining women and gay people as rabbis, welcoming interfaith couples among other innovations. Historically, it has emphasized the ethical aspects of Jewish tradition over its ritual requirements, though in recent decades it has begun to re embrace some of the religious practices once dismissed. The

evolution of its prayerbooks bears this out.

Leaving the European ghetto had an enormous impact on the practice of Judaism, leading some Jews to abandon Jewish dietary laws and other religious practices in order to assimilate more easily into the broader culture. Jews wanted to look and act more like their neighbors. Men and women sat together, male worshippers prayed bareheaded, and clergy wore black clerical robes. The main Shabbat service was generally conducted in the vernacular rather than Hebrew and was held on Friday night. Saturday was a workday.

The first permanent Reform Temple was founded in 1818 in Hamburg, Germany. The movement really began to flourish in the United States, where it was embraced by German Jews who were then the dominant force in American Jewish life.

In 1846, Isaac Mayer Wise came to the United States and is credited as the reform movement's founder here. He was the main author of the first American reform prayerbook, *Minhag America* published in 1857.

In 1885 the Pittsburgh Platform was adopted. It was a formal statement of the tenets of Reform Judaism. The document declared that only Judaism's "moral laws" are binding and rejected all those "such as are not adapted to the views and habits of modern civilization."

The movement has dropped its opposition to the tallit and kipa, leaving the wearing of either one to the individual. In 1999 the movement affirmed the importance of Hebrew, called for the observance of mitzvot, and encouraged some form of Shabbat observance, including Torah study.

Most of all, Reform Judaism welcomes you! If you were born Jewish, want to associate with the Jewish people, or just want to learn about Judaism, there is a place for you at The Liberal Reform Temple. Come join us in our new home. See our ads on page 14.







Safety Solutions

October Is Crime Prevention Month

When you look at crime statistics in Coconut Creek, you find that, much like other similar-sized cities around the nation, shoplifting, car burglaries, and fraud are really the prime drivers of crime. October is Crime Prevention Month, a time when we really hone in on how not to be a victim.

While overall crime is flat so far this year compared to last year, meaning that it's down 0.3-percent, motor vehicle theft and vehicle burglaries are up in 2022. There had been 91 reported stolen vehicles in Coconut Creek through the end of September, up from 73 compared to the same time last year. If you look at that same time frame (January 1 – September 30) for vehicle burglaries, it's up from 91 in 2021 to 131 in 2022. Since we never have a whole lot of violent crime here in Coconut Creek [i.e. rapes and murders], stolen cars and thefts from vehicles are two of those prime drivers of crime that, if we could reduce, would make a real impact statistically.

The best ways to avoid being the victim of a crime are to lock your car doors at night, shut your garage door, and never give out any personal information to anyone you don't know. If you do those three things, it will greatly reduce your chances of being the victim of a crime. One of the reasons our car thefts are up is because people have the habit of leaving their spare key fobs in the

car, with it unlocked, meaning all the bad guys need to do is push the start button and the car's engine will turn.

When we really look at the statistics from our theft from vehicle cases, or car burglaries, we see that as many as eight out of every ten incidents involve either an unlocked door or no sign of forced entry. We also firmly believe that the thieves like to talk to each other and tell each other. The bad guys notice which neighborhoods had the most unlocked cars and were happy to tell their friends. We often see thieves hit the same neighborhoods time and time again.

Identity thieves will target based not on location but demographic. While it is true that they view senior citizens as potentially easy prey, they also look to a much younger population as a probable victim pool. The fastest growing age group reporting that they were victims of identity scams is ages 18-25. Among the bright spots in our crime statistics through three-quarters of 2022 is the fact that fraud cases are down by more than 44-percent compared to last year.

The bottom line when it comes to crime prevention is we need to get into good habits. Always locking your car door, always be suspicious when a stranger calls you on the phone, always remember the "red flags" of a scam, such as when you're asked to buy gift cards in order to take care of a so-called "debt." These are all good habits to practice, and good habits make it harder for the bad guys to get you.







DOCUMENTATION

- Take pictures of EVERYTHING inside and outside of your house, vehicles, and any business equipment or crops.
- Gather all important documents including passports, birth certificates, medical records, receipts, etc.

SECURE YOUR PROPERTY

- Check on your homeowners or renters insurance.
- Protect valuables from flooding and rain by raising items off the ground, packing in plastic, and moving from windows.
- · Sandbag doorways for flooding.
- Prepare plywood for windows.

TAKE SAFETY PRECAUTIONS

- Shut off water and gas line, main break, and unplug items.
- Secure any loose items outside of your home (trash cans, etc).
- Get refills on any necessary prescriptions.
- · Restock your first aid kit.

COLLECT SUPPLIES

- Focus on the essentials and plan to have no power or water.
- Collect enough food/water/ medicine for 3-7 days.
- Gas, batteries, radios, chargers
- Supplies for pets including carriers and rabies records.
- · Basic tool-kit.

MAKE A PLAN FOR STAYING & GOING

- Evaluate the risks for your own situation (type of house, trees near your house, flooding, etc.)
- Check the storm surge maps for your area.
- How long are you willing to stay in your house w/o power?

PREPARE FOR A COMMUTE

- Current roads and markets are not designed for 80-100% of the population to use them, so gas up your cars and know your route.
- Plan on the trip taking 3-4x longer.
- Bring snacks & games for the trip.

STEPS AFTER THE STORM



After the storm, roads may be closed and power could be out for days if not weeks. Make sure to document all damage, keep all receipts, and be wary of predatory contractors. Review your insurance coverage and utilize the recovery websites and agencies.

Items Especially For Seniors

In addition to the standard recommendations for a preparedness kit, there are a number of items specific to seniors that you should probably include in your kit as well. These include:

Medications

You will probably want to include an additional weeks' supply of medications in your kit. To get that extra supply, inform your doctor or other health care provider of the fact that you're putting together an emergency supply.

Medical Equipment

You will also want to have supplies for your essential medical equipment. This can include:

- Batteries for hearing aids
- Spare pairs of glasses
- Spare dentures
- Equipment for monitoring blood sugar and blood pressure, if needed
- Spare oxygen tanks

Having spares of all these items in your kit will save you time searching the house to make sure you haven't forgotten anything.

Medical Documents

Just as with all the other essential documents you'll want to have on hand, you'll also want to have information about any medical needs you have. This should include:

- Basic information like your blood type, any allergies you have, and a list of any conditions you're dealing with.
- An outline of the treatment you're receiving and any other essential care or comfort information
 - Information about your medical equipment needs
 - A list of prescriptions you receive along with the dosages you take
 - A list of contact information for your physicians
- Copies of your Medicare, Medicaid, and other types of insurance information.

Finally, if you have a service animal, it might be useful to include their documentation in your kit as well; for all pets, you may want to include immunization information among your documents in case you have to bring them to a shelter or board them somewhere.

Special Plans

To prepare for hurricane season, the best strategy is to go all out—do the most you can to prepare for the worst. This includes:

- Take an inventory of valuables in case the storm damages the home. This can be as simple as taking a video or pictures of your home's interior using the camera on your phone.
- Make your home as weather-proof as possible, including cleaning out gutters and downspouts and making sure sump pumps and other anti-flooding measures are in good condition. You may also want to make sure that valuable items and important documents are out of the range of any floodwaters.
- Be ready to evacuate. Try to make your emergency preparedness kit is as portable as possible, and, if you have a car, always leave it with at least half a tank of gas during hurricane season to facilitate a quick getaway.







Service Equals Reward

Open and Unsolved

Cold cases, by their very name, are crimes that remain unsolved. Investigating these cases takes patience, tenacity and innovative thinking. At the Broward Sheriff's Office, unsolved crimes will never be placed on the shelf or forgotten, and the passage of time will not delay our quest for justice.

In 2019, BSO created a full-time Cold Case Unit, whose primary function is to investigate unsolved homicides and sex crimes. The cases date back to 1963; today, about 350 remain open.

The trails of these investigations might have gone cold, but the pain for the families never goes away. The detectives investigating these crimes work tirelessly for the victim's loved ones, never giving up the search for that one clue that could help lead us to solve these crimes.

Making progress on these cases can be challenging; however, significant technological advances have helped immensely. Thirty years ago, DNA testing was in its infancy. Today, we can retest physical evidence to identify potential suspects and link them to a crime. Progress in fingerprint identification has also come a long way. Even minute, unique details of an individual fingerprint can be discerned by new programs, leading to faster and more accurate identification.

Last year, the BSO Cold Case Unit, working with the Miami Police Department, Brazilian National Police and U.S. federal agencies, tracked down the man responsible for the brutal murders of three South Florida women decades ago through DNA and fingerprint technology.



The resolution of the case received worldwide attention. However, it is only one of the eight cases the BSO Cold Case Unit has solved since its inception.

To bring more exposure to these investigations, we launched a cold case video series to uncover possible new leads. The first episode details a North Lauderdale mother and daughter who were shot and killed in their bed in 2017. In another, a Pompano Beach-based American Airlines pilot was shot nine times at his front door in 2011. The latest episode explores the brutal murder of Jerri Emken in 1985, who was found dead at the Pompano Beach bar where she worked. While the murders remain unsolved, detectives hope the series will jog a memory and result in new leads bringing

resolution to these cases. I encourage you to take some time to view this series on the Broward Sheriff's Office YouTube: https://www.youtube.com/c/BrowardSheriffsOffice.

You, too, can help bring a critical clue to one of our cold cases. Broward Crime Stoppers is a vital resource for submitting tips resulting in successful outcomes. Even the most minor clues, something someone saw, heard or remembered, can result in a new lead. Anyone with information on unsolved cases is asked to contact the Broward Sheriff's Office Criminal Investigations Division at 954-321-4200 or Broward Crime Stoppers at 954-493-TIPS (8477) to report a tip anonymously.

Balance and Aging

Hello again. Hope everyone is well. Last month I said I would go over some upper body exercises that could be of importance in the issue of balance. As I mentioned you will need some equipment, some small dumbells, 2s, 3s, 5s, 8s, 10s depending on your strength. I mentioned tubing with handles also. If you don't have any of these items, I would suggest going to the Fitness Center here since it is well equipped. Unfortunately, there is no instructor there to help you.


The lower body exercises we went over were easier to perform using thighs, calves, ankles and feet. With equipment and unfamiliar movements, it takes a little more knowledge of the body and how to use the different muscle groups. I will try to explain some simple movements without getting too technical. Again, feel free to call me with any questions at 954-673-6700. These upper body exercises will help you with posture, strength, flexibility, and reflexes. Improving these areas will not only help with balance, but in the event of a fall it will help by having the ability of possibly grabbing a chair or table or a parked car or anything that would stop


or slow the fall. Having strong arms, shoulders, chest and back muscles will give you the ability to break the fall. More times than often the head or the face hits the ground first and that leads to more serious problems.

Try doing standing pushups against a wall with hands slightly wider than your shoulders. Do twelve repetitions twice. This will strengthen arms, shoulders, chest and back muscles. Next are shoulder shrugs. This will strengthen neck and trapezius muscles which will help with holding the head upright and help with posture. Hold dumbbells at your sides and raise and lower your shoulders without pulling with your arms. Do them slowly keeping your arms straight, twelve repetitions twice. Standing or sitting rows, here you will need the tubing or machines in the Fitness Center. Dumbbell curls holding weights at your sides with palms facing up, curl weights up to your shoulders and lower back down slowly.

In addition to help with breaking the fall these strengthening exercises can also help you to get up from a fall if you are alone. I think this is probably enough for this month. Next month I'll cover flexibility and reflexes. Good luck and don't quit.





Should You Consolidate Retirement Accounts?

Chicken Soup and Veggie Chicken Soup

The Rosh Hashanah recipes chosen are quite the classic-chicken soup. Meredith Jacobs shares her recipe for the Jewish penicillin. But have no fear, vegetarians-we've also got a great recipe for vegetarian chicken soup from Leah Koenig that's just as yummy.

Chicken Soup Meredith Jacobs

YOU'LL NEED:

- 1 chicken (whole, but take out the junk inside)
- 2 turnips, cut into cubes
- 1 bag of parsnips cleaned, cut off ends, cut into chunks
- 6-8 stalks celery cleaned, cut into chunks
- 6-8 carrots cleaned, cut into chunks
- 3 yellow onions, cut and leave the skin on (it colors the soup)
- 1 bunch of dill kosher salt, white pepper



DIRECTIONS:

- 1. Put everything EXCEPT THE DILL AND SEASONINGS into a large stockpot. Put cold water over it, filling the pot full.
- 2. Bring to a boil, then simmer.
- **3. Simmer** until the chicken is falling off the bone (about 2 to 3 hours).
- **4. Line a colander** with paper towels or cheesecloth and put the colander over another
- **5. Slowly pour** the soup through it, changing the towels as necessary. You should, in the new stockpot, have a nice broth.
- **6. Bring the new broth** up to a boil, then simmer another hour (this intensifies the flavor)
- 7. Float dill in it for 15 minutes and remove. Season with kosher salt and white pepper and serve.

Vegetarian Chicken Soup

Leah Koenig Serves 4-6.

YOU'LL NEED:


- 2 Tablespoons olive oil
- 1 large onion, roughly chopped
- 2 large carrots, peeled and roughly chopped
- 2 large celery stalks (with leaves), roughly chopped
- 1 parsnip, peeled and roughly chopped
- 5 large garlic cloves, smashed
- 1 leek, cleaned well and roughly chopped
- 9 cups water
- 2 bay leaves
- A handful of flat-leaf parsley, roughly chopped
- 1 stalk lemongrass, split into four small pieces
- 2 Tablespoons coarse kosher salt (or to taste)

DIRECTIONS:

In a large stockpot, heat oil and sauté onions for about 5 minutes over medium heat. Add carrots, celery, parsnip, garlic, and leeks and sauté for another 3 minutes, until fragrant. Add water and bay leaves and bring to a boil. Reduce heat and let simmer for about one hour uncovered.

After one hour, add lemongrass, parsley, and salt, and simmer for another thirty minutes. Let soup cool a bit, then strain into a large bowl using a cheesecloth or mesh strainer. If desired, add some of the vegetables back (discard the rest). Serve hot as is or with matzah balls, noodles, kreplach, etc.



How is the \$50,000 Homestead Exemption Applied?

The history of Homestead Exemption dates to 1934 when Florida voters approved a \$5,000 exemption to help ease the burden of property taxes. This exemption amount was increased to \$10,000 in the 1960's by the Florida Legislature but was not yet incorporated into the Florida Constitution. A constitutional amendment adopted in 1980 increased the Homestead Exemption amount to \$25,000. In 2008, Florida voters adopted a constitutional amendment increasing the Homestead Exemption amount to \$50,000 based on the property's assessed value.

This amendment increasing the Homestead Exemption to \$50,000 is a bit complicated for a few reasons:

- 1. The first \$25,000 of the exemption is applied by all taxing authorities to the first \$25,000 of your property's assessed value.
- 2. The second \$25,000 exemption is NOT applied to the school portion of your tax bill. The school board budget at roughly 37% of the entire tax bill makes up the single largest portion of your property tax bill.
- 3. The second \$25,000 of the exemption is applied to the portion of assessed value between \$50,000 \$75,000. This means you will not receive the full benefit of the second \$25,000 if your property's assessed value is less than \$75,000. If your property's assessed value is less than \$50,000, you will not receive any additional savings from this second \$25,000 exemption.

Appreciating a "Cathedral of Learning" in Historic Baltimore

On two sunny late summer days, I returned to Baltimore's historic Mount Vernon District to enjoy wonderful Italian Art at the

Walters Art Museum. This review describes its fine Italian Art on display from the Gothic Period up to the end of the Baroque Period. From the 11th Century, I appreciated a horn with animals in vine scrolls used as a reliquary which was made of ivory and a head of a crozier produced in the 12th Century also made of ivory from an elephant. Both of these relics came from Southern Italy.

From the 14th Century, these Italian paintings made with egg tempera and gold leaf on wood panel especially captivated me; Pietro Lorenzetti's "Virgin and Child With Saints Augustine, Nicholas, Catherine, and Lucy," made in Siena, Niccolo de Segna's "Saint Lucy," Francesco Da Rimini's "Virgin Adoration," a fresco, Tommaso Da Modena's "Wing of Reliquary Diptych With Crucifixion and Saints," Workshop of Agnolo Gaddi's "Saint Peter and Saint James The Greater," and Workshop of Bernardo Daddi's "Virgin and Christ Child." All of these paintings were produced, during the Babyllonian Captivity of the Papacy when the Papacy left Rome and was based in Avignon, France. Tommaso Da Modena's painting also employed marble ceramic verre eglomise insets on gilded wood frame.

The following paintings produced, during the Medieval Period in the 14th Century and very early 15th Century also fascinated me; Master of Panzano's "Virgin and Child with Enthroned With Saints," Master of Saint Verdiana's "Archangel Michael Slaying Dragon," Andea di Bartolo's "Virgin and Child With 4 Evangelists," and Olivuccio di Ciccarello Da Camerino's "Altarpiece With Virgin and Child With Saints." All of these paintings employed egg tempera and gold leaf on wood panel. These works were produced when the Papacy returned to Rome. Very Early Renaissance Paintings that especially interested me were Sienese Master Giovanni Dei Paolo's "Virgin and Child With Saints" and Bartolomeo de Tommaso's "Funeral of Saint Francis."

From the 15th Century, I saw fine Renaissance Period Paintings by Marco Zoppo, "Saint Francis Receiving Stigmata,"

Bartolomeo de Giovanni's "Myth of Io," Fra Bartolomeo's "Ideal City," Christofo Caselli's "Saints Louis of Toulouse, Francis, and Blessed John of Capistrano "Antonio Da Fabriano's "Saint Jerome In His Study," and Michele Da Luca Coltellini's "Madonna Enthroned With Saints," among others which employed landscapes in its background. I also savored Raphael's "Madonna of the Candelabra" for its marvelous light effects.

16th Century favorites some of which were produced, during the Catholic Reformation, a response to growing Protestantism in Northern European Countries were Paris Bordone's "David and Bathsheba," Lorenzo Lotto's "Portrait of Fra Lorenzo Da Bergamo," Giulio Romano's "Madonna and Child With John The Baptist," El Greco's "Stigmata of Saint Francis," and Francesco Morandini's "Saint Helen," among others. All of these works utilized Chiaroscuro, exaggerated light and darkness.

From the 17th Century, paintings produced, during the Catholic Reformation that inspired me were; Genoese Master Bernardo Strozzi's "Adoration of the Shepherds," Domenico Fetti's "Christ And Tribute Money," Guido Reni's "Mary Magdalene," and Spanish Painter, Jiusepe De Ribera's "Saint Paul The Hermit" inspired which employed superb Tenebrism

I relished fine 18th Century Paintings with secular subject matter by Francesco Guardi. "Venetian Courtyard," Giovanni Pannini's "Roman Colisseum," and Giovanni B. Tiepolo, "Africanus Freeing Massara." I also liked the fine sculptural works of Antonio Gai with mythological themes.

The Walters Art Museum is a delightful art museum for those who appreciate Old Master European Paintings, Sculpture, and Religious Antiquities. The city of Baltimore is blessed with this enriching art museum.





What is the best grip for you?



Choosing the best grip for your game may come down to size of your hands or desired shot pattern. The pattern is your preference to draw or fade the ball. Outlined below are some pictures to illustrate the choices you may choose.

Overlap grip - or Vardon grip, sometimes referred to as nine

finger grip because the pinky finger of the trail hand rides on the last finger of the lead hand. A very popular grip amongst touring pros. Ben Hogan, Tom Watson, Sam Snead and Phil (LIV) Michelson.

Interlocking grip - most notably used by Jack Nicklaus and Tiger Woods.

The last fingers of each hand are locked employed by golfers with small hands or a desire to fade the ball.

Ten finger or baseball grip - neither locked or overlapped each finger on

Ten finger or baseball grip - neither locked or overlapped each finger on the club. Also good for smaller hands and promotes a draw or hook in shot pattern. Notable pros like Beth Daniel and Mo Norman used this grip.

Double overlap grip - two fingers of trail hand ride on the last two fingers of lead hand. Used by Jim Furyk, Trey Mullinax and Lee Elder to name a few.

If your struggling with hooking the ball or fat shots give this a try. In addition, I have seen arthritic fingered players using this grip.
