

Does My Homestead Exemption Automatically Renew?

After your initial application for Homestead Exemption has been approved, it automatically renews each year unless there is a change of ownership or eligible use of your homesteaded property. Each January, our office mails a Homestead Renewal Notice and "Change Card" to all Homesteaded properties. Florida law requires the property owner to notify the Property Appraiser of any change which may affect homestead eligibility. This Change Order Card provides an efficient way to communicate these important changes to our office.

If there are NO changes to the use and/or ownership of your property, simply keep the card as your receipt verifying that your Homestead Exemption has automatically renewed for another year. However, if there are changes, please mark the Change Card accordingly and return it to our office.

If your name is not printed above the mailing address section on this card, it means you are not protected by Homestead Exemption at this property. You may be on title to the property, but you are not receiving Homestead Exemption. If you are eligible for Homestead Exemption on this property, you must complete your own Homestead Exemption application. You can apply online at https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/HomesteadExemption

If you are a co-owner, surviving spouse, trust beneficiary or otherwise believe you are eligible for this exemption, you must file your own Homestead Exemption application to receive the benefit. If you have any questions relating to the death of the owner, the Change Card or need assistance in filing for Homestead or other tax-saving exemptions, please visit our website at web.bcpa.net or contact our Customer Service Department at 954-357-6830.

Where Did My Portability Savings Go?

A portability deduction is only posted to your property record page in the first year you receive your new Homestead Exemption. The portability savings from the first year form the basis of your new Save Our Homes value on a going forward basis and -- in subsequent years -- will rise or fall based upon market just value changes and the 3% cap, as your new Save Our Homes value has incorporated your portability savings. When our website is updated to display subsequent year property values, your portability deduction is no longer shown independently because it is already factored into your new Assessed/Save Our Homes value.

Safety Solutions

Overall Crime is Down Once Again in Coconut Creek

As I write this column in mid-December, and unless something really crazy happens statistically, crime will once again go down in Coconut Creek in 2022. With your help, as of the end of November

2022, we were down about 3.5 percent in overall crime compared to the same time frame in 2021.

Our biggest reduction compared to 2021 was in fraud cases, which were down by 88 incidents. It's an indication that you are becoming more aware of how to spot frauds and scams and how not fall victim to them. As usual for most years, the primary drivers of crime here in Coconut Creek in 2022 were shoplifting, theft from vehicle cases, and motor vehicle theft.

Being a gated community, Wynmoor Village doesn't get too many car burglars or thieves who drive off in the vehicle. If you're in the Township however, you can help reduce these numbers in 2023 by making sure to lock your car doors at night before you go to bed. Typically, around eight out of every ten theft from vehicle cases we investigate were either left unlocked or show no sign of forced entry.

Scam presentations in Wynmoor, along with North and South Creek

Thanks to the Wynmoor community for really turning out for a pair of fraud prevention presentations we had back in November. We also had similar presentations in South Creek and North Creek in December that didn't see quite as many participants as in Wynmoor, but we'll educate anybody willing to listen to us.

If you live in Wynmoor, I recommend that you attend the monthly Security Roundtable meetings, which are usually held the fourth Thursday of every month at 2:30 p.m. in Ballroom A. We go over all the latest frauds and scams we've been seeing at those meetings. Check with Wynmoor administration for more details.

This month's key scam prevention tip

This month's key scam prevention tip, and one that is taken straight from our fraud prevention presentations: just don't answer the phone if you don't recognize the number. If you don't answer the phone, the scammer never gets the chance to talk to you. If they never talk to you then that greatly reduces the chances they have to scam you. Sometimes, you just answering the phone confirms to them that that's your phone number, and that alone can be a step toward helping them steal your identity.

Congratulations to Coconut Creek Fire Rescue

Congratulations to our colleagues at Coconut Creek Fire Rescue from recently earning an ISO 1 rating. What that means to you is the possibility of lower insurance premiums and a stronger resume when the fire department applies for grant money. It also means that your fire department is among the elite in the nation when it comes to service, training, and fire prevention. Less than one percent of all fire departments in the country have achieved an ISO 1 rating.



Florida Law for Pedestrians and Bicyclists

If you are a pedestrian or a bicyclist and you are injured by a car, there is important information you need to know. If you own a car, your car insurance PIP (no fault) coverage will be your primary medical insurance for hospital and doctor bills. Just as you would do if you were injured driving your car, you should contact your car insurance immediately to report the accident and get a claim number for your PIP coverage. You should also obtain the driver exchange information to get the information on the driver of the vehicle that hit you, including their insurance company. Any injury claim that you have will first be



Since Florida does not require bodily injury liability coverage, it is possible that the driver will only have the basic PIP, which will not help you. Therefore, it is very important that you also have uninsured motorist coverage for your vehicle so that you can still obtain a settlement for your injuries. I recommend at least \$100,000 per person for uninsured motorist coverage. If you have more than one vehicle, I recommend stacking. Please see other articles that I have written for further details.

It is possible that the other insurance company may find you at least partially at fault if you disobeyed the rules of the road. For example, while you have the right of way as a pedestrian on a marked crosswalk, you must yield the right of way to all vehicles if you are not using a marked crosswalk. If there is a sidewalk on the street, you have to use it. If there is no sidewalk,



receive a net verdict of \$30,000.

If you are at all injured, it is important that you allow an ambulance to take you to an emergency room for immediate treatment. This is very important, not only to be sure that you are okay but also to preserve your rights under Florida's PIP laws.

family of coffee planters. At age 10 he worked with his dad Raul Velez and learned all he could about the business of how to raise and distinguish the types and quality of coffee but also the raising of animals and other crops necessary for a successful coffee farm.

At about this time his father Raul was threatened by outlaws to pay a fee or else he, his wife and son and daughter would suffer the consequences. Raul refused to pay the outlaws, but because there was little police protection in the country, he decided to move the family to the city of Medellin to protect them. To Roberto, his father was a hero for standing up to the outlaws and providing safety for the family, which included his mother, Sister Lena and himself.

In Medellin Roberto completed both his grammar and high school education and went to the Universita Pontificia Boliviana where he majored in business, yet he still desired to be a coffee producer like his father. It was here that he met his future wife, Silvia Ochoa.

During this time conditions in Columbia were not very stable, so he decided to come to the USA to visit his uncle Alvaro Tobar who lived in Florida. His uncle owned a small restaurant and put Roberto to work six days a week for eight years as an employee, with no vacation. Though this may seem like a form of slave labor, it was an in-depth training to prepare weaknesses of the restaurant business.

Alvaro taught him that the key to success is based on three important factors:

- 1. The quality of your product must be exceptional.
- 2. Your workers must be well trained and paid if they are to give excellent service.

3. Your employees must feel that they are an integral part of this family business

Because Roberto learned the business so well, his uncle made him a partner in the restaurant.

With his uncle's blessing and support Roberto opened a second restaurant near the corner of Coconut Creek Parkway and State Road 7. He used and expanded his uncle's lessons by requiring that his workers must be taught and trained to speak English. He also wanted the restaurant to not only service Spanish communities but the American public as well.

In 2010 Roberto Velez became a citizen of the United States and his sister Lena came to Florida and brought the holdings of a coffee plantation in Columbia thus allowing the Velez family to control their own coffee production. With the introduction of coffee control Lena was made another member of the partnership. A huge production facility was added to the family holdings.

Today Roberto and his family have seven restaurants that are designed to portray many different aspects of El Balcon. To do this he hired in people from Columbia, Venezuela, Brazil, Guatemala, Mexico and Puerto Rico in a multitude of professions. He is amazed that during the pandemic while many restaurants were losing employees his restaurants maintained a steady list of workers.

Today Roberto and Silvia are blessed with two beautiful children, a daughter Martina and a son Samuel. It is Roberto's hope that they will continue their family's legacy.



Time for New Year's Financial Resolutions

It's that time of year when many of us promise ourselves we'll go to the gym more, or learn a new language, or take up a musical instrument, or any number of other worthy goals. But this year, when making New Year's resolutions, why not also consider some *financial* ones?

Here are a few to consider:

- Don't let inflation derail your investment strategy. As you know, inflation was the big financial story of 2022, hitting a 40-year high. And while it may moderate somewhat this year, it will likely still be higher than what we experienced the past decade or so. Even so, it's a good idea to try not to let today's inflation harm your investment strategy for the future. That happened last year: More than half of American workers either reduced their contributions to their 401(k)s and other retirement plans or stopped contributing completely during the third quarter of 2022, according to a survey by Allianz Life Insurance of North America. Of course, focusing on your cash flow needs today is certainly understandable, but are there other ways you can free up some money, such as possibly lowering your spending, so you can continue contributing to your retirement accounts? It's worth the effort because you could spend two or three decades as a retiree.

By paying your bill each month, you can avoid the effects of rising interest rates. If you do carry a balance, you might be able to transfer it to a lower-rate card, depending on your credit score. getting a fixed-rate debt consolidation loan. In any case, the lower your debt payments, the more you can invest for your long-term goals.

- Review your investment portfolio. At least once a year, you should review your investment portfolio to determine if it's still appropriate for your goals, risk tolerance and time horizon. - *Prepare for the unexpected.* If you encountered a large, unexpected expense, such as the need for a major home repair, how would you pay for it? If you didn't have the money readily available, you might be forced to dip into your long-term investments or retirement accounts. To prevent this, you should build an emergency fund containing three to six months' worth of living expenses or a year's worth, if you're retired with the money kept in a low-risk, liquid account.

These resolutions can be useful — so try to put them to work in 2023.

Most of you have heard that Jewish Holidays are too early, too late, but never the right time. What calendars do we use, and how did we decide?

The Hebrew Calendar: This is the one we use to figure out Jewish religious observances. It is the official calendar of the state of Israel. Among its ceremonial uses, it determines the dates for the reading of Torah portions, dates to commemorate the death of a relative (yahrzeits), and daily psalm readings.

The Hebrew calendar we use today is the result of many changes throughout the years. It is a lunisolar calendar. Before 220 of the common era the calendar used a system which combined change observing the sky and natural agricultural events. In approximately 200 to 500 of the common era that system was gradually changed by using the mathematical rules of the Metonic cycle used today. The rules for this calendar were codified by Maimonides in the 12th century. He also replaced counting the years since the destruction of the Temple with the modern creation of Anno Mundi (the year the world was created).

The Metonic cycle is 19 years and brings the lunar year in line with the solar year, with the addition of a month every two or three years. AM 5783 began at sunset on September 25, 2022 and will end at sunset on September 15, 2023.

The Gregorian Calendar: The civil calendar we use today was instituted by Pope Gregory the 13th in 1582. The calendar has 365 days with an extra day every four years except for years divisible by 100 but not divisible by 400. The Gregorian calendar replaced the Julian calendar.

The Julian Calendar: Julius Caesar proposed the Roman calendar in 46 BC. It was designed with the aid of Greek mathematicians and astronomers. It was in effect until 1582, when it was replaced by the Gregorian calendar this calendar is still used by some in the Eastern Orthodox Church.

The Roman Calendar: This calendar used a complicated system of counting days, months, cycles, religious rituals, the public market, etcetera. Politics played a real part in this calendar with those who were in charge making years longer.

Building On Our Successes

The Broward Sheriff's Office is constructed intentionally with each component dependent on the next for structure, strength, and durability. The innovative programs and initiatives we have put in place are contributing to a safer Broward County and are paving a path toward continued success. Continue reading to learn more about some of these exciting new initiatives.

BSO CO-RESPONDER PROGRAM

A cornerstone of our foundation is our commitment to helping individuals suffering a mental health crisis. BSO's new **Co-Responder Program** is an innovative approach to assisting individuals in crisis by pairing a Crisis Intervention Team (CIT) trained deputy with a licensed mental health clinician to respond to calls for

service. Their collaboration provides immediate advantages as they are able to more accurately determine the needs of the person or persons in distress and connect them to the necessary community resources.

BSO TRAINING CENTER

CIT is one of the many types of training we have at BSO. In only a few years, we have raised the training standards for all our first responders and agency personnel. Soon we will be able to house all this training under one roof. Construction crews are making incredible progress on BSO's state-of-the-art **training center**. Once completed, the 103,000-square-foot facility will be the first dedicated on-site training facility in our organization's 107-year history. The training center will undoubtedly be one of the best in the state and mark a significant milestone that will bring us closer to



furthering our commitment to public safety.

ADVANCEMENTS IN TECHNOLOGY

As our training becomes increasingly proficient, so too does our technology. Recently, BSO's **Crime Lab** acquired a high-tech instrument that better sequences DNA to identify people. The machine can help determine specific information about the person the DNA came from, including hair and eye color. This valuable new tool will aid in investigations of homicides, sexual assaults, and acts of terrorism. It can also be used to identify human remains.

AWARD-WINNING SPECIALIZED UNITS

Lastly, I want to recognize our regional specialized units, which continue to grow in their accomplishments. These units work daily to assist all residents of Broward County and other local public safety

agencies. Last year, BSO's **Aviation Unit** received worldwide recognition for its excellence, winning the 2022 Leadership in Police Aviation Award from the International Association of Chiefs of Police and the Teledyne FLIR PURSUIT award. In the first ten months of 2022 alone, the unit directed deputies on the ground to make nearly 1,000 arrests. The BSO Aviation Unit, and all our specialized units, such as K-9 Unit, Bomb Squad and Hazardous Materials Unit, respond wherever needed. These units have made our county immeasurably safer, and I'm confident they will continue to make great strides in the coming year.



WYNMOOR Golf and Tips

Golf Resolutions for 2023

Putting - Strive to have enough pace or speed on your putts to have the ball roll 18 inches past the hole. This helps counteract the subtle breaks and green imperfections. This strategy works better on uphill and level putts in Florida. I believe less emphasis on this Dave Pelz's research on speed if your greens are very fast like some up north on bluegrass greens.

Stance - If your inclination is to not have a square stance where your toes are in the same line at address or "square" close your stance. The lead foot is a few inches closer to the ball and trail foot further from ball at address. This "power stance" is often used to promote a draw or hook on your shots. Your path will be more inside out to promote this right to left flight for right handed golfers. Probably best used for middle and long clubs.

Grip - Strive to have your lead hand more in the fingers so you can see two to almost knuckles on your hand as opposed to one knuckle.

In your trail hand a better error for more distance put club more in your hand. With this in mind you will see more of your fingernails on this hand again for more distance through a draw on your shots.

Backswing - Low and slow to start and allow your hands and arms to pull on your bigger muscles to create your turn and pivot. Big swing equals big turn - small swing smaller turn.

A good exercise to promote this idea is to hit balls with a narrow stance or feet closer together. You will instinctively set up the right sequence of your backswing by allowing your hands and arms to initiate your backswing and your body following. The beauty of this is that as your body moves last in your swing ie. your legs, it allows for the reverse sequence on your forward swing. Your lower body now can initiate your downswing as is common taught in most instruction manuals.



A Joyful Return To Harvard and The Fogg Art Museum

In mid-November, I returned to the Fogg Art Museum on the lively campus of Harvard University in Cambridge, Massachusetts. It had been eight years since my previous visits. I spent two quality days examining its superb Art Collections. This review emphasizes its fine, but not necessarily encyclopedic collection of Old Master European Paintings from the 13th Century up to the 19th Century.

I relished delightful Medieval Period Italian Paintings by Master of Cosmas and Damian "Virgin and Christ Child," has Byzantine Characteristic, Master of Camerino, Simone Martini, Roberto Oderisi "Christ With Instruments of Passion," Bernardo Daddi, Luca di Tomme, Taddeo Gaddi "Stigmata of Saint Francis," Ambrogio Lorenzetti "Crucifixion," Pietro Lorenzetti, Taddeo di Bartolo, and Master of Fogg Pieta, among others. I saw its impressive collection of Medieval French Relics produced in Limoges. All of the Italian Paintings that I mentioned employed egg tempera on wood panel. The Fogg's collection of Medieval Art is one its strengths.

I enjoyed its fine collection of Renaissance Period Italian Paintings, especially produced by Fra Angelico (Early Renaissance), Sandro Botticelli, Giovanni Dei Paolo "Nativity," Piero di Cosimo, Fillippo Lippi, Matteo di Giovanni "Saint Jerome In His Study," and Lorenzo Lotto. Among others in the 15th Century, Florence was the dominant city for Italian Art. During first half of the 14th Century, Siena was the dominant city for Italian Art. I was also captivated by fine Northern European Renaissance Paintings by the Master of Catholic Kings "Presentation in Temple," Jan Provoost, Aelbert Bouts "Mater Dolorosa," Lucas Cranach the Elder, and Master of



Saint Ursula Legend "Virgin and Child With Angels."

I saw fine paradigms of Mannerist Baroque Period Paintings by Orazio Gentileschi (associated with Counter Reformation Art), Scipio Pulzone, Nicholas Regnier "Self Portrait With Painter Painting," Carraciolo "Joseph and Potiphar's Wife," Judaic theme, Guisseppe Ribera "Saint Jerome," and Phillippe de Champaigne "Saint Joseph," among others Mannerist Painting employs exaggerated light and darkness.


I liked its fine room with splendid Dutch Master Paintings by Rembrandt "Old Man," Emanuel de Witte (fine interior of a Protestant Dutch Church), Jacob Van Ruisdael, Jan Steen "Gallant Old Man Courting Young Woman," and Jan Vander Heyden "The Dam and Damrak, Amsterdam," among others.

18th Century favorites included paintings by Jean Fragonard, Jean Baptiste Greuze, Jean Ingres "Odalisque," Anton Von Maron, and American John Copley with his fine use of Chiaroscuro, and Jacques Louis David, among others.

I realize the Fogg Art Museum has an outstanding collection of 19th and 20th Century European Paintings, but I decided to limit my review to its Old European Masters. If you visit Boston, I hope you enjoy the Fogg Art Museum as much as I have, especially if you enjoy the study of Art.

ASK DR. JOY

First of all Happy New Year. Have a positive and blessed year and picture every wonderful thing you want coming into existence.


What habits do you have? What is a habit anyway? The definition we will be using for this article is any behavior that is done repeatedly and automatically that is not under direction of our autonomic nervous system. So, breathing, although repeatedly and automatically is not part of what is included here today.

So, what is included? The obvious things like smoking, drinking, obsessive eating, gambling, shopping, etc., of course. But what about things like complaining, sadness, depression that is not biochemically produced, anger, worrying, anxiety, negative thinking, hypochondria, and many others that I can't think of offhand. On the other side of that are fun things to do, positiveness, smiling, loving others and yourself, exercise, creative outlets, inner peace, and an overall sense of enjoying life. These are all habits.

I was speaking to a woman this morning who told me that she worries about everything and everyone and that she was just born that way. I disagreed and said that I saw her constant worry as a habitual, automatic response to almost any situation in her life and that it could be consciously and deliberately changed if she wanted. Another person who thought as I did, joined the conversation, and said some things that I would probably not say to anyone who was not a client. She told the woman that she was fighting for and defending her limitations and making herself a victim. The conversation between them got heated and I removed myself from it. It did, however, lead me to think about the habit of worry and anxiety. Was it a default position that over time became her habitual go-to emotion and could it be changed by deliberate intent? I have a position on this, but I'd really think it would be great if you all thought about it and decided for yourself.

Another thing I experienced was attending a Guillain-Barre chapter meeting. Most people are not familiar with this rare neurological disease and its worse counterpart CIDP, but I had GBS several years ago and wanted to volunteer to help the foundation and also have some of my questions about residual issues answered. There were quite a few people present and all were eager to discuss their experiences, I had a somewhat difficult time relating on a personal level to the CIPD patients and don't really know what they were going through. But the GBS people, some of whom were 40 years past their acute stage and dealing with many issues, I did understand. However, what I found very interesting was the difference in peoples' attitudes about issues that many years later were still problematic. Some only wanted to talk about and complain about what was happening to them while others with sometimes worse symptoms were feeling blessed and appreciative that they were in better shape than they were while the disease was active. One of them even said that they refuse to give in to habitual complaining since it cannot help them feel better while appreciating how far they have come alleviated some of their pain. Of course, the complainers wanted to once again argue for their limitations and decided that the appreciators weren't really dealing with symptoms as debilitating and painful as theirs. That was the most fascinating part of the meeting for me and of course supported my belief that we create our own reality, especially our feeling reality, by the thoughts we think and the attitudes we hold.

If you think you would like to change something you do or feel automatically, give it a try and let me know what happens. It could happen very quickly or take a little time. It depends on you.
