

Is Our Relationship Platonic Or What Do You Want?

At sixty plus years in age it becomes more difficult to start a relationship with another person, especially someone in your age group. Whenever two people socialize or hang out together very often, there is a silent expectation or assumption that they are in a romantic relationship, which may not be true.

What Legal Documents Are Most Important Now?

The pandemic changed almost everything. But certain legal documents are more important than ever.

If you need to be hospitalized in Florida, it is imperative that you have a Designation of Health Care Surrogate and Living Will with proper wording so there will be no problems. Do not rely on generic forms obtained online. Florida hospitals are requiring specific HIPAA compliant language not found on generic forms. Your Surrogate will be able to make medical decisions for you if you are unable to communicate. Even if the

hospital does not allow any visitors, your Surrogate will be able to talk to the doctors and make decisions on the phone or e-mail. Your Surrogate does not need to be present in the hospital. All your Surrogate needs to do is e-mail or fax a copy of your document to the hospital. If there is no hope to save you, that Surrogate would be authorized to "pull the plug" based on the Living Will.

The Durable Power of Attorney is also important to allow someone to take over your legal and financial affairs. The Florida law changed in 2011. If you have an old Durable Power of Attorney, it should be redone. Again, do not rely on generic forms. Our current Power of Attorney is 26 pages to conform to Florida law.

If you should die, your Will or Revocable Living Trust will determine who inherits your assets. The Trust is important to consider if you own



your home or other real estate, because it avoids Probate. Probate can tie up your property for many months and prevent your heirs from selling without a Court Order. They would have to continue to pay taxes, maintenance, mortgage, utilities etc. in addition to thousands of dollars in attorney fees and court costs. A Life Estate Deed is another option to consider to avoid probate. Your attorney can discuss the different options and the benefits of each one.


Balance, Strength, and Flexibility

Hello everyone. Year-round residents and seasonal. Last year I wrote monthly articles mostly on balance. I will continue with that and add strength and flexibility. A favorite new balance exercise that I do with my clients is called the clock. It works on balance, strength, and flexibility. As my clients get better at it, I make it progressively harder. First, I have them doing the exercise holding on with one hand to the back of the chair, then when they can do that, I have them do it without holding on, then I have them doing it with their eyes closed and finally with a small weight, two or three pounds. The exercise goes like this. The movement is the same with all the progressions. Standing on your left foot bring your right knee up, hold back of chair with left hand and put your right hand straight out in front of you at 12 o'clock, hold for five seconds then move your arm to 3 o'clock and hold for five seconds then move to 6 o'clock hold for five seconds and move back to 12 o'clock and hold for five seconds. Repeat with the left foot up and the left hand out going from 12 o'clock to 9 o'clock to 6 o'clock and back to 9 o'clock, then to 12 o'clock.

The progression will be as I mentioned before. I will be demonstrating

this at the Health and Wellness Club the third Tuesday of the month in West Wing 2. As always you can call me at 954-673-6700 if you have any questions or need any help. Hope to see you at the meeting.

Does My Homestead Exemption Automatically Renew?

After your initial application for Homestead Exemption has been approved, it automatically renews each year unless there is a change of ownership or eligible use of your homesteaded property. Each January, our office mails a Homestead Renewal Notice and "Change Card" to all Homesteaded properties. Florida law requires the property owner to notify the Property Appraiser of any change which may affect homestead eligibility. This Change Order Card provides an efficient way to communicate these important changes to our office.

If there are NO changes to the use and/or ownership of your property, simply keep the card as your receipt verifying that your Homestead Exemption has automatically renewed for another year. However, if there are changes, please mark the Change Card accordingly and return it to our office.

If your name is not printed above the mailing address section on this card, it means you are not protected by Homestead Exemption at this property. You may be on title to the property, but you are not receiving Homestead Exemption. If you are eligible for Homestead Exemption on this property, you must complete your own Homestead Exemption application. You can apply online at https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/HomesteadExemption

If you are a co-owner, surviving spouse, trust beneficiary or otherwise believe you are eligible for this exemption, you must file your own Homestead Exemption application to receive the benefit. If you have any questions relating to the death of the owner, the Change Card or need assistance in filing for Homestead or other tax-saving exemptions, please visit our website at web.bcpa.net or contact our Customer Service Department at 954-357-6830.

Where Did My Portability Savings Go?

A portability deduction is only posted to your property record page in the first year you receive your new Homestead Exemption. The portability savings from the first year form the basis of your new Save Our Homes value on a going forward basis and -- in subsequent years -- will rise or fall based upon market just value changes and the 3% cap, as your new Save Our Homes value has incorporated your portability savings. When our website is updated to display subsequent year property values, your portability deduction is no longer shown independently because it is already factored into your new Assessed/Save Our Homes value.



Acupuncture and "Bone-on-Bone" Knee Pain

In a previous article ("I Haven't Got Time for the Pain") I stated that for many of the patients I see in my office for chronic pain, the cause of their pain is not what they may have been told by their doctors. And

this is the primary reason that the treatment they are offered, and eventually choose, seldom helps their pain.

On my last visit to my dentist, the doctor came out into the waiting room and said "I really need to talk to you. Can acupuncture help knee pain? My orthopedist said, it's bone-on-bone and that replacement is the only option. He gave me a cortisone shot and it only helped for a day or two. I'm not expecting a miracle, but I'd like to postpone the surgery for as long as possible."

I told him that in my experience the only knee pain patients who have true "bone-on-bone" degeneration typically arrive in a wheelchair or on crutches because they are unable to tolerate any weight on the affected knee. Although he was walking with a slight limp and said he had been unable to play golf for weeks due to the pain, I suggested he come in and we see how he responds. I told him that although acupuncture can't repair damaged cartilage, it can

often reduce the pain to a manageable level. If it was going to work for him, I'd expect a noticeable degree of improvement after 3 sessions. If not, then I would probably not recommend more but we needed to give it at least 3 to see. He scheduled the appointments.

After evaluating him it appeared that his knee pain was being caused not so much by inflammation in the joint itself, but rather by muscular and postural imbalances in his lower back and legs which had adversely affected his gait. Treatment was then aimed at correcting these imbalances by using a combination of acupuncture, electrical muscle stimulation, manual therapy, and exercise. He reported improvement after the very first session and after the third appointment was able to play a morning of golf without pain.

He then asked, "Where do we go from here?" I told him that as long as he is improving, we keep treating him until it is no longer helping. I frankly have no idea how much time we are talking about but for now he is able to work and to play golf and keep up with his very young grandson without knee pain.

Happy New Year to everyone!!! The past year was a very difficult year not only worldwide with major wars in the Ukraine and







WOODSHOP

The Woodshop would like to thank the Wynmoor residents who have donated not only usable wood, buts also the tools and miscellaneous items that can be used by the shop. Both of the shop's display windows are now showing off holiday items made by some members for their families. We are located across from the doctor's office at the east end of the Clubhouse.

The Shop is averaging 3 wood furniture repairs a week, table legs, chair seats, cane shortening, picture frames and more. "If it's wood we could." If a resident can bring the item to us, we can usually repair it, unfortunately we have no one to go to the resident's home. The shop phone number is 954-969-7645, 9:00 a.m. - 4:00 p.m. 7 days a week.

The following photos present examples of what some of our highly skilled members are capable of. Ernie and Yank created the an official size chess board (16"x16") with a built-in segmented felt-lined drawer providing access for both players. The woods used are African Tiger Wood and North American hard rock maple, total size 8"x18"x18." Second is a 6-bottle wine tote made from imported Italian and French wood shipping boxes complete with a matching wood top.

Steve Gleimer, the Shop's Treasurer and Dave Norcross have been employing an ancient type of wood inlay called "Intarsia" (Latin for insert), where each wood piece of wood is fashioned to the exact size of an established pattern. The following 2 photos display a unique expression of skill and patience. Look real close to see 2 pieces of perfection!

Howard Lepolstat shows what can be done with genuine African Mahogany (that he and I salvaged from wood sculptures that were once displayed in local museums) with African Limba for the background of the cabinet. Howard made this unique curio cabinet to display the various treasures that he has created here in the shop over his many years as a member here. It also has a locked glass door.

Have you attended a sporting event, the Coconut Creek Multicultural Club Holiday Party, a Wynmoor Dance, or any of a host of other events where the song "Hava Nagila" (Let us Rejoice) was played? Have you heard it at a restaurant? What's going on?

As Alison Krueger wrote in the New York Times, this song was traditionally played at Jewish life events, including weddings, and bar and bat mitzvahs. How come we hear it now at almost every event where dance music is played? Yes, it does get people out of their seats and on the dance floor, but so do lots of other songs.

James Loeffer, who teaches Jewish history at the University of Virginia, has studied the song. He isn't surprised that "Hava Nagila" gets so much airtime today. "It is song that is about transformation and reinvention, so that it is destined to keep happening."

It is one of the first modern Jewish folk songs in the Hebrew language. The melody is based on a Hasidic niggun (melodious chant). It was composed in 1918 to celebrate the Balfour Declaration and the British victory over the Ottomans in 1917. It was first performed in a mixed choir concert in Jerusalem.

Abraham Idelsohn (1882-1938), a professor at Hebrew University was cataloging all known Jewish music and teaching classes in musical composition. One of his students, Moishe Nathanson, presented the rest of the class with a slow 19th century melodious chant (niggun) and added rhythm and words to make a modern Hebrew song.


Harry Belafonte recorded the song for his album "Belafonte at Carnegie Hall" in 1959. He said it was one of the two standout songs of his career. He claimed that most Jews in America learned the song from him.

If you ever go to a game of the Dutch Association Football Club AFC Ajax, you might hear Nava Nagila. The English club, Tottenham Hotspur, has used Hava Nagila as an anthem. The song is heard from Catholic High School gyms to Jewish Day Schools.

It has become a symbol of inclusivity and diversity. People from all levels of society can get together and celebrate a common interest. Despite our differences, we all share a common humanity and hope and joy.

Happy New Year! We hope that all of us may experience hope and peace in the year 2024. Remember-kindness and respect are contagious.

Crime Prevention New Year's Resolutions to Start 2024

Overall crime slightly increased in 2023, up by about 3-percent compared to 2022. Shoplifting and simple assaults were the primary crimes that drove that increase, while property crimes, such as theft from vehicle cases, continued a

downward trend. Coconut Creek is still among the safest cities in which to live in all of Broward County and South Florida. It's something we attribute to you and your attention to detail, such as locking your cars at night and reporting any suspicious activity you see in your neighborhoods.

The beginning of the year is always a great time to start a more healthy diet, maybe begin an exercise routine, or take up a new hobby. What I'm going to encourage you to do is to set some "crime prevention resolutions" for the next year. What might "crime prevention resolutions" look like you say? I'm glad you asked! Here are a few examples:

- You can make a resolution to always lock your car doors, and put anything valuable out of sight, whenever and wherever you leave your car. Theft from vehicle cases, or vehicle burglaries, are one of the most common types of crime here in Coconut Creek. These are crimes we call "crimes of opportunity," meaning that if a potential thief sees that your car is unlocked, or the door opens when they try the door handle, then they will take advantage of that opportunity to go into your car and steal anything inside.
- You can make it a goal to become very skeptical any time and every time someone contacts you out of the blue claiming they have exactly what

you need to fix your computer. This is one scam that we're still seeing a little too often in Wynmoor and the Township. You have to train yourself to become very wary when this happens. How did they know there was something wrong with your computer? Why are they asking you to pay with gift cards instead of by any other means? If they actually work for the company they claim to work for, why don't they know some of these simple things they're asking you? Wouldn't they already have some of that information in their system? The more skeptical you become, the less likely you'll be the victim of a scam.

• You can strive to check your bank and credit card statements more often. Banks and credit cards are set up on-line nowadays so you can look at them daily using your computer or smart phone. I personally am in the habit of perusing my bank and credit card statements every Monday morning, so I can see what happened over the weekend. I take a look again every Friday morning, that way I can look for any fraudulent activity during the week. A lot of people make the mistake of assuming that, once the bad guys get ahold of your credit card information, they'll drain you dry all at once. Folks tend to notice when all of their money is missing. They see the big charges for the big items they didn't buy. But \$10 here, or \$30 there, if they don't get into the habit of checking, they might not notice those smaller amounts. That is why it's so important to always keep an eye on your finances.







Consider Family Meeting To Discuss Estate Plans

At some point, you'll want to share your estate plans with your loved ones — and the first step in this process may be to hold a family meeting.

The best time to hold this meeting is when you're still in good mental and physical shape, and the enactment of your estate plans may well be years away. But what topics should you cover?

Consider these main areas:

- Your wishes and those of your family. Use this meeting to introduce your estate plans and, in a basic sense, what you hope to accomplish with them leave money to your family, support charitable groups and so on. You'll want to emphasize that you want to be equitable in what you leave behind, but there may be issues that affect this decision, such as disparities in income between grown children or an allowance for a special-needs child. - Estate planning documents At the time of your family meeting, you may or may not have already created your estate planning documents, but in either case, this would be a good time to discuss them. These documents may include a will, a living trust, financial power of attorney, health care power of attorney and possibly other arrangements. At a minimum, you'd like to give a general overview of what these documents mean, but at an initial family meeting, you don't necessarily have to get too detailed. For example, you might not want to talk about specific inheritances. This is also an opportunity to inform your loved ones of the professionals involved in your estate plans,

such as your attorney and your tax advisor.

• Roles of everyone involved – Not only does a comprehensive estate plan involve moving parts, such as the necessary documents, but it also includes actual human beings who may need to take on different roles. You will need an executor for your will and, if you have a living trust, you'll need a trustee. Even if you choose to serve as the initial trustee, you'll still need to identify one or more successor trustees to take your place if you become incapacitated, or upon your death. Plus, you'll need to name people to act as your power of attorney for health care and finances. Choosing the right people for these roles involves thought and sensitivity. Obviously, you want individuals who are competent and reliable, but you also need to be aware that some family members could feel slighted if others are assigned roles they feel they could do. By being aware of these possible conflicts, you can be better prepared to address them.

Here's one more suggestion: Let your family know that this initial meeting doesn't mean the end of communications about your estate plans. Encourage your loved ones to contact you with questions whenever they want. You may need to hold additional family meetings in the future, but by laying the initial groundwork, you will have taken a big first step in establishing the legacy you'd like to leave.



ASK DR. JOY

This month's article is based on a couple of different excerpts from previous ones and my 2010 book on narcissism. It's on what I call emotional currency or EC. Everyone has ways in which they want to 'get paid' emotionally or intimately. These are the behaviors, gestures, etc. that lead to a person feeling loved, valued, appreciated and a host of other psychological necessities. Different people use different currencies to give and receive

closeness and impart feelings of caring and love.

For example, service. Both men and women use service to show their love. I don't want to be sexist, and these examples are meant to be merely illustrative. A woman may pick up her husband's shirts at the cleaners and he may wash her car. Of course, these behaviors can be reversed (must be very careful these days not to offend anyone). If both people view service in the same way, they both will feel loved and cared for when these things are done for them. However, if one of them just regards doing these things as part of running a household, that person will not feel 'paid' by the gesture. Oftentimes the other will point this out and say he or she was met with a mere 'thanks' because the partner on the receiving end thought it was not particularly special.

Another example is money or gifts. Sometimes one partner believes that buying an extravagant gift is a wonderful way of showing love. If the person on the receiving end thinks the same way, then both partners will feel loved and appreciated and their emotional banks will have a deposit. If, however, you have one person believing that gifts are a show of love and the other thinking that picking up the dry cleaning is, we're going to have two unfulfilled people. The one who didn't receive the gift and the one whose trip to the cleaners was not appreciated. Neither partner here is going to feel emotionally paid.

One very important difference is in what constitutes emotional intimacy. I'll use myself as an example. To me, closeness comes from intimate conversation. These conversations can be intellectual as well as emotionally revealing. They come from sharing ideas, philosophies, theories, experiences, and opinions as well as intimate and personal feelings. This would be true for me in any relationship whether with friends, my daughters, spouse, etc. This was also true when I ran groups and watched people blossom because they were able to share their deepest selves and their ideas and learn to accept the revelations of others. For me, this is what it means to be 'in relationship' with another person and this is what fosters intimacy and caring for another. When I don't have that I can only reach a certain level of relationship which may be fine in casual friendships and acquaintanceships, but those relations cannot and will not deepen. Of course, I also tend to pay in that same currency and although I can and do pay in all forms of emotional currency, they are not primary for me.

Another important currency is time. Some people require spending a great deal of time with the other and some need much less. If you believe that the amount of time spent together should be a primary factor of the relationship, being with someone with many other interests who doesn't have the same time requirements you do will make you both unhappy. You will see time spent doing other things as a rejection of you and the other will find your demands suffocating and neither of you will be filling your emotional bank.

Time spent together is definitely an important factor in relationships. It is difficult to feel loved and cared for when the person you want to be with hasn't the time to spend with you. The important thing to look at here is desire. If the other person has a time-consuming job or other necessary demands but you know you are valued and the desire to spend the time with you is there, it is quite different than being with someone who is fitting you in to a whimsical schedule, seeing you when he/she feels like it or when it is convenient. Trying to receive something from someone who is unable to give it is a major effort in frustration and futility for both people involved.

Another example and method of payment is paying with physical affection and/or compliments. This comes naturally to some people and is very difficult for others both to give and to receive. Again, if the balance of desire and need does not match you will be in for a rough ride.

To be paid in your own currency is to experience yourself as loved, valuable, important, cared for, psychologically visible and a real part of a relationship. To be paid in a way that is less important to you or even in a way you might not even notice leads to feeling invisible as your deepest self and when you feel invisible you cannot feel loved and cared for. Imagine having your emotional currency bank depleted and then imagine it overflowing. Quite a difference.

Due to space constraints, I have shortened this extensively but hopefully you got the idea and can come up with your own currencies and listen to the important people in your life about theirs.





The Battle of Brooklyn

The Battle of Brooklyn, the largest battle of the American Revolutionary War, takes place just 1 ½ months after the signing of the Declaration of Independence. It includes about 37,000 combatants on both sides. The result is a crushing defeat for the Continental Army. They fight at the Gowanus Road and Flatbush, and finally at the Continental stronghold at Fort

Greene and the other forts at Brooklyn Heights.

The main battle on August 27, 1776, takes only nine hours but encompasses about half the area of today's Brooklyn. An all-night march through the undefended Jamaica Pass enables the British to encircle and defeat the Continental defenders. After the main battle, Washington and the Continental Army are trapped at Brooklyn Heights. The American Revolution could have ended there, but General Howe's caution and favorable weather allow Washington, under the cover of night, to safely evacuate his 9,500 soldiers.

The story of this fight is the story of inexperience vs experience in battle, mistakes, bad luck, good luck, and eventual salvation. The British generals present have an average military experience of more than thirty years while the Continental generals have an average experience of only two years. Congress wants New York City defended. Washington goes along, and decides to defend three islands (Manhattan, Staten Island and Long Island) against the mightiest naval armada ever assembled in history to that time, without having any warships of his own. This single decision foretells the outcome.

The Continentals fortify Brooklyn Heights, the Battery, Governors Island and Fort Washington (in Manhattan opposite today's Fort Lee NJ) and wait. The fortifications are new, as New York City had never needed fortifications before. Britain, its long-time defender, had become its enemy.

By July 12th most of the British armada has arrived. The total force will include 400 ships and 32,000 troops. That day the frigates Phoenix and Rose sail up the Hudson River towards the Tappan Zee Bridge. The Continental

batteries fire on them with little effect. An ominous breach, it spells trouble ahead. If two ships could so easily slip through the defenses, why not twenty or forty ships, turning lower Manhattan and Brooklyn into a trap.

Washington dismisses his only cavalry, the 500 strong Connecticut Light Horse. Concerned about feeding the horses, and not knowing the terrain in Brooklyn, he does not yet know he will have to defend a ten-mile-long ridge (Heights of Guan).

On August 22nd, the British land 24,000 troops at Graves End Bay, near present day Fort Hamilton, staging a precision joint naval and

army landing. Feinting at Gowanus and Flatbush, General Howe leads the main army on an all-night march through the undefended Jamaica Pass, the furthest of the four passes through the Heights of Guan.

On August 27th, the British surprise, surround, and defeat the Continental Army, killing many and taking more than 1,000 prisoners. At the Gowanus Road, William Alexander (Lord Stirling), although surrounded, leads the "Maryland 400" in an attack on an overwhelmingly superior British position. This delaying action allows the bulk of his troops to escape over the marshy Gowanus Canal to the safety of the Brooklyn Heights fortifications. Five times they attack the British and five times they are repulsed with heavy loss of life. At the end, 265 of the Marylanders lay dead at the old stone farm house. Washington, observing from his high ground command post at Cobble Hill, says "Good God! What brave fellows I must this day lose."

Washington and the rest of the Brooklyn defenders are now holed up in the forts at Brooklyn Heights. Although the British had crushed the outer defenses along the heights, several pieces of good luck help the Continentals:

- 1. The British ships never enter the East River opposite Brooklyn Heights due to a strong wind from the northeast. Had the British done so, it is probable the American Revolutionary War would have ended there and then with the capture of George Washington and his army.
- 2. On hand is a regiment of Marblehead Massachusetts sailors. These same sailors will ferry Washington and his army over the Delaware only four months later, on Christmas 1776.
- 3. Howe does not press the attack on the inner fortifications of Brooklyn Heights.

On August 29th, the Continental Army begins the overnight evacuation from Brooklyn Heights to Lower Manhattan. The Marblehead sailors make eleven round trips through swift and dangerous currents. They get all 9,500 troops, the horses, the canon and supplies to Manhattan without a single loss of life, thus ending the Battle of Brooklyn. The British see the empty forts in the morning and are astounded. Later, military historians see this evacuation to be an extraordinary feat of military maneuver.

Crucially, despite the loss of 90% of his army, Washington never gives up. From the ashes of this defeat arises the determination of George Washington and the Continental Army. They persevere through great difficulties ahead and turn the tide only four months later. Crossing the Delaware in a Nor'easter

on Christmas 1776, they surprise and defeat the Hessians at Trenton. In the following Ten Crucial Days, the Continental Army wins battles in Trenton and Princeton (January 3rd, 1777), changing the course of history and enabling the birth of our free nation.

A Joyful Day At Antwerp's Mayer Van Den Berghe Art Museum

In late November, I returned to Antwerp, Belgium, a city with a renowned tradition in the Fine Arts. The last time that I visited Antwerp and its fine art museums was in 1989.

On my recent visit, I spent one fine day at the Mayer Van Den Berghe Art Museum which houses the art collection of Fritz Mayer Van Berghe, a connoisseur and important art collector. This art museum specializes in paintings produced by Netherlandish Renaissance and Flemish Baroque Period Painters. Many of the paintings on display were made by painters associated with the city of Antwerp. The following painters associated with the city of Antwerp that had paintings on display were Quentin Massys "Christ On Cross With Donors," Netherlandish Renaissance, Master of Amiens "Death of Virgin," Netherlandish Renaissance, Cornelis Massys, David Teniers the Younger "Temptation of Saint Anthony," Flemish Baroque, Joachim Beukelaer "Vegetable Seller, Flemish Baroque," Daniel Seghers "Flemish Baroque," Jacob Jordaens "Adoration of Shepherds," this painting is associated with the Counter Reformation, Flemish Baroque, Cornelis de Vos, Flemish Baroque, "Vekemans Family," Pieter Breughel The Elder, Flemish Baroque, "Dulles Griet," its most famous painting with its abundance of details, Pieter Breughel the Younger, Flemish Baroque, "Census of Bethlehem," another very punctilious painting, and Clara Peeters.

Favorite 15th and 16th Century Netherlandish Paintings were Jan Gossart's


Pieter Breughel the Elder "Mad Meg Dulles Griet

"Mary Magdalene," Vranke Vander Stockt's "Lamentation," Ambrosius Benson's "Saint Jerome," Juan de Flandes' "Feast of Herod," Jacob Cornelisz Oostansen's "Man of Sorrows," and Henri Met Bles," "Landscape With Christ and Men of Emmaus." All of these paintings related the prevalent Catholicism of the Netherlands at that time.


Favorite 17th Century Flemish paintings included Jacob Jordaens' "Adoration of the Shepherds," a quintessential example of Counter Reformation Art, Gerard de Lairesse's "Venus Giving Weapons to Aeneas," the paradigm of splendid Flemish Mannerism, Jan Wildens' "Landscape With Dead Oak," and Pieter Breughel the Elder's "Mad Meg, Dulles Griet," a very punctilious surreal-type of painting.

Other paintings that captivated me were Simeone and Machilone Da Spoleto's 13th Century painting, "Scenes from the Life of the Virgin," Angelo Di Puccinelli's "Saints Leonard and Sebastian, Late Medieval Italian Painting, Italian Trecento, Alesandro Allori's "Francesco D'Medici quality Italian Mannerism, and 18th Dutch Master, Jacob Octervelt's "Fruit Seller." I also appreciated fine sculptural works by Master Heinrich Von Konstanz "Christ and Saint John Evangelist, 13th Century and 15th Century South Netherlands Sculpture, "Burial of Saint Andrew" made of wood.

I especially relished the comfortable atmosphere of the Mayer Van Den Berghe Art Museum and its helpful devoted staff.
