From the President

The Wynmoor Community Council Directors' Workshop was held on June 11, 2025, and included several important updates for the year ahead. The Financial and Budget Overview covered current financials, highlights of the upcoming budget. The Security Department provided updates on security camera upgrades, and improved lighting around buildings.

Tim Renfro from Hartnett Insurance spoke about hurricane season preparation, building fire alarm requirements, and the importance of longterm maintenance planning. Building Maintenance also addressed smoke detector compliance and echoed the need for proactive planning for fire safety and facility upkeep.

The Association Affairs Department discussed Florida Statutes pertaining to association meetings and provided guidance on proper Zoom usage. The Sales and Leases Department reviewed key "Do's and Don'ts" for directors to help ensure smooth and compliant resident interactions.

The workshop also featured a Hotwire update, including the latest on cable installation, and concluded with an open Q&A session for attendees.

The "My Safe Florida Condominium Pilot Program" has undergone amendments, primarily through House Bill 393 (2025), which revises the program to enhance its effectiveness in improving condominium safety and resilience. Specifically, the bill limits participation to buildings three stories or higher, lowers the grant approval threshold to 75%, and clarifies certain grant eligibility and reimbursement. The grant does not pertain to individual expenses such as windows or doors. Associations can apply for common elements such as roof grants, meaning your Association can apply for a roof grant, if they have complied with the milestone inspection requirements and structural integrity reserve study requirements.

Of course, this is all contingent upon the Governor's approval. If approved, it will go into effect on July 1, 2025.

Community Safety Reminder for Wynmoor Residents

At Wynmoor, your safety and peace of mind are a top priority. While we're fortunate to live in a secure, gated community, it's always wise to take a few extra steps to protect your home, especially your sliding glass doors, which can be a target for break-ins if not properly secured. Make sure the windows and doors are locked. The installation of a "Ring Doorbell" is another safeguard. Please remember not to have a false sense of security, always lock your windows and doors.

One of the simplest and most effective safety measures is using a heavy-duty **wooden rod or metal bar in the track of your sliding door**. This inexpensive solution can prevent the door from being forced open.



Why This Works:

• **Physical Block**: A properly sized piece of wood placed in the bottom track acts as a physical barrier. Even if someone unlocks the door from the outside, they won't be able to slide it open.

• Easy & Inexpensive: Most hardware stores will cut a piece of wood to the exact length you need. You can also purchase adjustable metal security bars.

• **No Tools Required**: It takes just seconds to put in place and remove when you want to open the door yourself.

Please don't forget about Creek Armor, it is a phone app launched by the Coconut Creek Police Department and it can be found in the iPhone App Store, and in Google Play. All you must do to find it is type "Creek Armor" (all one word) wherever you download new apps on your phone. This includes Android phones. And It's free! It is designed to be a direct, one-to-one, line of communication between you and your police department. This app allows you to report suspicious activity to the Real Time Crime Center. You can also share your location with a friend so that person can monitor you while go you for a walk or run. There are direct links to Crime Prevention Tips and Scam Alerts. Also, and most important, you can activate a panic button that will alert the Real Time Crime Center as to your location so officers can assist you quickly during an emergency.

Hotwire Education and Support for Wynmoor Residents

To ensure residents are fully informed and supported, email blasts will be sent out with full details about upcoming events and resources. In the

Revocable Living Trust Important for Out of State Property

Are you a snowbird just returning to Florida for the winter? Some of my clients have their homestead in Florida; others declare their legal residence in another state.

In either case, a Revocable Living Trust is very useful to avoid probate in both states. If you are a Florida resident, you can own your homestead property via a Revocable Living Trust without losing your homestead exemption. In addition, you are eliminating the need for probate when you pass away.

You can also transfer real estate owned in any other state to your Florida Trust. Generally, a Florida lawyer will prepare the Revocable Living Trust and Quit Claim Deed to transfer the Florida property into the Trust. If you are a Florida resident, the lawyer will

also prepare a new Florida Last Will and Testament called a Pourover Will. This provides for the transfer to your Trust upon your death of any other assets not in the Trust or which do not have beneficiaries already designated. It is a security blanket to cover any assets payable to your Estate. For example, if you were killed in a car accident due to the negligence of another driver, your Personal Representative would be able to settle your Estate's wrongful death claim and "pourover" the proceeds into your Trust.

If you are not a Florida resident, you can still create a Revocable Living Trust and execute a Quit Claim Deed to put your Florida property into the Trust. Your Last Will and Testament will be done by a lawyer in the state in which you have your legal residence. In addition, that lawyer can prepare a Deed to transfer the out of state property into the Florida Trust. You can also do the Trust in your state of residence and have a Florida lawyer transfer your Florida property to that Trust.

For Canadian citizens, there are possible tax aspects to be considered before you create a Florida Trust. These should be discussed with your Canadian



accountant or tax attorney. In general, you will have to weigh the tax consequences versus the money and time that your heirs would save by avoiding probate in Florida.

Another favorable factor in creating a Revocable Living Trust is that you can always amend the Trust without having to change the Deed. In addition, once you create the Trust, you can always buy new properties in any state in the name of the Trust.

The Revocable Living Trust is recommended by most lawyers over a Deed which includes names of other persons, either as joint tenants, tenants in common or a Life Estate Deed. Once another person's name is on a Deed, there are potential risks to you and your property. These include the possibility

that the other person may undergo a divorce, bankruptcy, have a judgment against that person, or die before you or with you in a common accident. It may also affect your homestead exemption. All of these risks should be discussed with your attorney before deciding to put someone else's name on your Deed. By contrast, the Revocable Living Trust eliminates those risks, since no other name is on the Deed. You simply transfer it from yourself to yourself as Trustee of your Trust.



The Liberal Jewish Temple of Coconut Creek A Reform Congregation Welcoming Everyone Is It Superstition, Tradition or Law? **Iris Arlan & Lee Temares**

Throughout the centuries, Judaism has been enriched by a tapestry of traditions and superstitions and Torah law, each playing its part in shaping the cultural and spiritual identity of the Jewish people. The distinction between superstition, tradition, and law, however, often blurs. We will try to highlight some of the differences, with a particular focus on the Reform perspective.

Superstition is typically characterized by practices or beliefs that arise from irrational fears or misunderstandings, often linked to luck or supernatural forces, such as the evil eye. Traditions, on the other hand, are established customs or practices that have cultural or religious significance, passed down through generations. Traditions based on Jewish writings are often regarded as law-the wearing of a tallit for example.

Some traditions are rooted in religious texts and communal practices. These include:

• Shabbat: Observing the Sabbath is a cornerstone of Jewish tradition, involving rituals such as lighting candles, reciting prayers, and sharing meals. We "remember the Sabbath," but how we do so is usually tradition.

• Passover Seder: The Passover meal commemorates the Exodus from Egypt, incorporating symbolic foods and retelling the story of liberation. Practices vary by culture.

• Bar/Bat Mitzvah: The coming-of-age ceremony marks a young person's entry into adult religious responsibilities. Confirmation adds another layer of tradition.

• Getting married under a chupah: This tradition probably dates to tent life in early Israel. Even in the Middle Ages, when marriages took place in synagogues, a chupah was brought in. It could even date back to Talmudic times when a bride and groom wore garlands in their hair. The word itself means covered with garlands. So, who knows, but it is a tradition.

• The wedding ring: Marriage was originally a business transactionthe groom bought a bride with a coin. In ancient Rome and in Egypt, a ring was used. Yemenite Jews still use plain gold, with a coin. Why is the wedding ring plain with no stones? The value of plain gold or silver can easily be determined. Stones are not so easy to value.

Reform Judaism, known for its progressive stance, often reevaluates traditions and superstitions considering modern values and understanding. This movement seeks to balance respect for heritage with contemporary relevance.

Reform congregations commonly embrace traditions that foster community and spiritual growth:

• Shabbat Celebrations: While the observance may be less strict than in Orthodox practice, Reform Jews often gather for prayer, study, and communal meals.

• High Holy Days: Rosh Hashanah and Yom Kippur are observed with introspection, prayer, and communal services.

• Tikkun Olam: The principle of repairing the world is central to Reform Judaism, encouraging social justice and community service.

Certain practices are less emphasized in Reform Judaism due to their perceived lack of contemporary relevance or inclusivity:

• Strict Dietary Laws: While some Reform Jews observe kosher traditions, the movement generally adopts a more flexible approach. Few of us live in an area where it is even possible to "seethe a cow in its mother's milk."

• Gender-Specific Rituals: Reform Judaism promotes egalitarianism, often modifying or discarding traditions that enforce gender roles.

• Superstitions: Practices such as wearing protective amulets are often seen as superstitions rather than religious imperatives. An example of a superstition we often hear is the words "mazal-tov" and "siman-tov." Mazal was a star, or a planet. In ancient times people believed that fate was determined by the stars. Mazal-tov = good star. Siman-tov = good omen. In conclusion, understanding the delicate balance between superstition, tradition and law is crucial in appreciating the rich tapestry of Jewish culture. Reform Judaism, with its emphasis on inclusivity and modern values, provides a thoughtful approach to embracing meaningful traditions while discarding practices that no longer serve the community or the individual. Whether through the celebration of Shabbat, the observance of High Holy Days, or the commitment to social justice, Reform Jews continue to honor their heritage while forging a path forward that resonates with contemporary life and individual comfort levels. In recent years, some traditions have returned as practice today because they fit into our current lives.

Safety Solutions

Police Aware Of Uptick In Residential Burglaries

We are aware of a recent uptick in residential burglaries in Wynmoor Village.

Over the past few weeks, we have investigated three residential burglaries, and one attempt, at four different locations in Wynmoor. At this point the similarities are: 1) All of these incidents occurred at night. 2) All of the residents

burglarized were on the first floor of their buildings. 3) The burglars are using rear sliding glass doors and windows, some potentially left unlocked, to gain entry.

Detectives are working these cases diligently. While we can't say for sure if they're all related, we can't rule it out either. Officers are aware of the increase and are trying to be more attentive to the area at night. Our friends and community partners with Wynmoor Security are also aware of it and helping our officers and detectives with whatever is needed.

The best thing you can do right now is to call 911 immediately if you see or hear anything suspicious, especially at night and very early in the morning. If you hear a loud noise, go investigate it. Make sure and lock all your doors and windows as well. In some of the cases, there have been no signs of forced entry, meaning the door could have possibly been left unlocked.

When we talk about crime prevention, one of the things we talk about is "target hardening," which essentially means making something harder to steal. Or, in this case, making it harder for a would-be burglar to enter your

residence. Something as simple as cutting a wooded dowel rod to fit the bottom track of your sliding glass door can be a form of target hardening. Placing the dowel rod there would prevent a burglar from opening the door, even if they went to the trouble of prying it open.

There are various products you could buy at Lowe's or Home Depot that could target harden your doors and windows, such as u-locks, sliding glass door locks at the top of the door, or locks that can be installed on the bottom.

There are other things you can do too. And none of them cost a lot of money. You could start leaving your back patio light on at night if you have one. Burglars hate light, especially night-time burglars. You could leave a light on inside your residence. No burglar wants to go into a place where the homeowner or renter might be awake. Your bathroom light could be a good option. Leave it on at night if it doesn't disturb your sleep. Burglars know that people get up at all hours of the night to use the bathroom.

At this point we have no evidence to indicate that these burglars intend any physical harm to the people that they steal from. All of the victims have been asleep. That doesn't make these burglaries any less alarming. The best way to deal with this is to control what we can control. We can't control the potential burglar's ability and willingness to commit a crime. We can control the opportunity. Take easy targets away – by locking your doors and windows. Make it harder for them – by using devices to make it more difficult to open your doors or windows. Shine light on potential areas of entry – by leaving an outdoor light on or a light inside your residence.

All of these actions are ones we can control and can prevent burglaries.



Hurricane season has now begun. As the former Director of Florida's Division of Emergency Management, I've witnessed the power of hurricanes firsthand, and the scientists and forecasters at the National Weather Service have predicted that it will likely be an above-average hurricane season. That could mean 13-19 named storms in the Atlantic this year alone.



I met with local officials at the Palm Beach County Emergency Operations Center to discuss what it all means and how our community is getting ready for it:

What helps mitigate the damage from these natural disasters is our ability to prepare in advance of landfall. Here are a few precautions you can take now to stay safe this hurricane season:

BUILD A DISASTER SUPPLY KIT

It's never too soon for you and your family to create a disaster preparedness plan, and that starts with proactively having the tools on-hand that you may need if a hurricane strikes. It's all the more important this year in light of reported cuts at the Federal Emergency Management Agency (FEMA), which may slow the federal response to disaster events.

The Florida Division of Emergency Management (FDEM) encourages all Floridians to assemble a disaster supply kit with at least 7 days of supplies, including:

CREATE A DISASTER PREPAREDNESS PLAN

Your family's disaster preparedness plan should include where your disaster supply kit is and where you may go in case of an emergency. Every family should have their own personalized emergency plan during hurricane season. Identify potential emergency contacts, account for personal needs like medications, keep copies of important family documents, and be sure that your documentation like insurance policies and IDs are up to date. Be sure that everyone in your household knows your family's disaster preparedness plan.

Pets are family members too, and they should be incorporated into your family's disaster preparedness plan. If you evacuate your home, DO NOT LEAVE YOUR PETS OR ANIMALS BEHIND. As a last resort, both Broward and Palm Beach Counties have animal shelters that can provide emergency shelter for pets.


Business owners should also be appropriately prepared for hurricane season by identifying their risk and developing a plan. Consider how you would manage your business if access to the workplace is hampered by road closures or communication is limited. The safety of your employees should remain top of mind when there is an approaching storm.

SIGN UP FOR LOCAL ALERTS

Even if you have weathered storms before, it is always best to follow the advice of official sources. The FEMA mobile app allows you to receive real-time weather alerts, locate emergency shelters in your area, and more.

When a hurricane watch is issued, it means that hurricane conditions are possible within the watch area. The hurricane watch is issued 48 hours in advance of the anticipated onset of tropical storm-force winds. This watch should trigger your family's disaster plan, and proactive measures should be initiated, especially those actions that require extra time.

When a hurricane warning is issued, it means that tropical storm-force winds are anticipated to hit your area within 36 hours. Once this warning has been issued, your family should take proactive actions and move towards what you've determined to be the safest location during the storm.



As hurricane season continues, remember to stay updated with current information. Storm tracks can change, so please listen to your local Emergency Management Directors and the Florida Division of Emergency Management (@flsert on X) for the most up-to-date information about evacuations. These professionals–along with the law enforcement and other first responders in your area–work tirelessly to keep our communities safe, and we owe them our deepest gratitude.

KNOW YOUR ZONE - KNOW YOUR HOME

Every year, it's important for residents to take into account if you live in an evacuation zone; a low-lying, flood-prone area; a mobile home; or an unsafe structure during hurricane season. These areas and buildings are the most likely to be evacuated, and accounting for it can help Floridians prepare to evacuate and better understand orders from local officials.

It is also very important for residents to understand the strength of their homes. If an evacuation order is not issued for your area and your house is not in a flood zone, you may consider sheltering in place. If you shelter in place, knowing your home and its ability to withstand strong winds and heavy rain is important.

So, this hurricane season, don't leave anything to chance. Preparation is essential to keeping our communities safe, so be sure to take the time to make a plan and stay safe.



IT'S A GOOD DAY ook review **By Beatrice Horowitz** TO READ A BOO



But here goes: The sort of plot follows several youngish mothers in an upscale English suburb through one day, detailing in often extraordinary, sometimes obtuse language their agonies, small joys and bewilderments. The grind of caring for small children, cast against the relative daily freedom of their husbands, sends these women around the bend, until the reader isn't sure they will survive their upper middle-class existence. I have great sympathy for the boredom and tenderness

involved in raising young children, and I appreciate the writer's bald-faced presentation of the women's frustration and rage. But still. Two hundred and forty-eight pages was grinding. In the end, the author suggests that natural beauty in the form of two swans in flight and physical pleasure in the form of a husband's invitation to sex mitigate their pain/enhance these lives anyway. I'm glad.

The Elements of Marie Curie Dava Sobel




Marie Curie along with her husband famously discovered radioactive elements at the turn of the twentieth century and died from the consequences of her long experimentation with them. Two-time Nobel Prize winner, in 1903 the Physics prize with her husband and in 1911 on her own for Chemistry, she was a Polish woman who lived her adult life in France, raised two children alone after her husband's untimely death, and brought dozens of women into her laboratory to learn and contribute to the growing field of radioactivity. The author names the chapters

after some of these women. A life so fully lived can almost overwhelm a biography with its events and cast of characters. Ms. Sobel keeps the narrative flowing while doing a carful job of explaining the incredible scientific experimentation and discoveries.

Important News For New Homeowners

When buying/acquiring real estate, do not assume the property taxes will remain the same as the current owner's taxes. Under Florida law, a change in ownership requires the property to be reassessed at current full market value the year following the change of ownership OR if a Homestead Exemption is added/removed from the property. This reassessment could result in higher property taxes for the new owner than what the seller was paying. Please use our Tax Estimator to approximate your new property taxes based on the reassessed value.

If you are moving to a new home and have held a Homestead Exemption anywhere within Florida during the past three tax years, you may be eligible to transfer your Save Our Homes (SOH) benefit to your new home to help lower the property's assessed value and subsequent taxes. The Portability Estimator available online helps you approximate what your new property taxes will be using any portability you may be transferring from another property.

The Property Appraiser **does not** set or collect taxes. Tax rates/fees are set by individual taxing authorities each year based on their budgetary needs. All property tax billing and collecting is handled by the Broward County Tax Collector's Office. The deadline to apply for any 2025 exemption is September 17, 2025.

Coming up are "Dancing Queen - Egyptian Style" led by Paula Scotti and "Cowboy Hustle" led by Karen Beckman.


