# From the President



# 100 Years Ago This Month: Historical events from September 1924

The month of September has been home to many historical events over the years. Here's a look at some that helped to shape the world in September 1924.

- The Dawes Plan goes into effect on September 1. The plan details a restructuring of reparations payments Germany owes to the Allied Powers in the aftermath of World War I. Charles G. Dawes, who was integral in developing the plan, would be awarded the Nobel Peace Prize in 1925 for his contributions.
- On September 2, Negro National League President Rube Foster announces the first "Negro World Series" would be played in October. Foster announces the series will feature the champion of his league and the champion of the Eastern Colored League.
- At least 300 civilians are killed during the Taif massacre in the Kingdom of Hejaz on September 3.
- The fourth annual Miss America Pageant is held in Atlantic City, New Jersey, on September 6. Miss Philadelphia, Ruth Malcomson, wins the pageant. Miss Columbus, Mary Katherine Campbell of Ohio, finishes as First Runner-Up after winning the pageant the previous two years.
- John Dillinger, who would ultimately be identified as the mastermind behind a gang accused of robbing 24 banks and four police stations, attempts to rob a grocery store in Indiana on September 6. The attempt marked Dillinger's first attempt at a major crime, but he and his accomplice are quickly apprehended and sent to jail.
- Twenty people, including four police officers, are killed during a gun battle in the American territory of Hawaii on September 9. The Hanapepe massacre stemmed from a dispute amongst striking workers at the McBryde sugar plantation on the island of Kauai.
- The sensational trial of Nathan F. Leopold, Jr. and Richard Albert Loeb ends on September 10. Each man is sentenced to life plus 99 years for the kidnapping and murder of Bobby Franks in May.
- Pengiran Ahmad Tajuddin becomes the new Sultan of Brunei on September 11. Ahmad Tajuddin serves until his death in 1950.

- Thomas Wade Landry is born in Mission, Texas, on September 11. Landry would become the first head coach of the Dallas Cowboys in the National Football League, a job he held for 29 seasons.
   General of the Armies John J. Pershing retires
  - General of the Armies John J. Pershing retires from the United States Army on September 13. The highly decorated General Pershing is the last American military officer to achieve the rank of a six-star general.
  - Horace Saks and Bernard Gimbel open the luxury department store Saks Fifth Avenue at 611 Fifth Avenue in Manhattan on September 15.
  - First baseman Jim Bottomley of the St. Louis Cardinals sets a major league record when he drives in 12 runs in a nine-inning game on September 16. The record still stands, though Bottomley now shares it with a fellow St. Louis Cardinal, Mark Whiten, who drove in 12 runs against the Cincinnati Reds in the second game of a doubleheader on September 7, 1993.
  - On September 18, the United States military occupation of the Dominican Republic ends after more than eight years.
  - Joseph Stalin orders the arrest of Alexander Krasnoshchyokov on September 19. Krasnoshchyokov is the first prominent Bolshevik to be arrested under the leadership of Stalin, who ultimately allows Krasnoshchyokov to rejoin the government in 1925. That second chance would prove somewhat brief, as Stalin would order Krasnoshchyokov's execution in 1937.
  - The American freighter SS Clifton sinks in Lake Huron on September 22. All 26 crew members perish, and the wreckage of the Clifton would not be found until 2016.
  - British racer Malcolm Campbell breaks the record for the fastest speed on land on September 24. Campbell, driving a Sunbeam 350HP with a V12 engine, reaches a speed of 146.18 miles per hour, narrowly breaking the record set by Ernest Eldridge just months earlier.
  - Controls on the German Navy are relaxed on September 30 in recognition of improved relations between the Allied Powers and Germany.





# **Questions About Your 2025 Property Assessment or E#xemptions?**

Our office mailed over 779,000 TRIM (proposed tax) Notices to Broward County property owners last month. The 2025 Just/Market Values are based on the market data from 2024 as Florida Statutes require our office to use January 1 as the date of assessment each year. Your TRIM Notice shows your property's 2025 Just/Market Value, any tax-saving exemptions you are receiving, and the proposed tax amounts as set by the various taxing authorities listed on the notice.

It is important to remember the Property Appraiser's Office does <u>not</u> set or collect taxes.

If you have questions or concerns about any of the proposed tax rates or non-ad valorem fees, including fire assessments, please contact the taxing authority listed on the TRIM Notice.

If you believe you are entitled to a Homestead Exemption or any other exemption not shown on your TRIM Notice, you may still late file for any 2025 exemption until September 17, 2025. For a list of all the available tax-saving exemptions and to apply for these exemptions online, please visit our web.bcpa.net or call us at 954-357-6830.

#### Value Adjustment Board

The Value Adjustment Board (VAB) is an independent quasi-judicial review board. If you believe your Just/Market Value is not what a buyer would have reasonably paid for your property on January 1, 2025, you should first contact our office. If after speaking with one of our appraisers, you still do not agree, you can file an appeal with the Broward County Value Adjustment Board. If you were denied an exemption, you may also file a petition with the Value Adjustment Board to appeal this denial. The deadline for any VAB petition is September 17, 2025. 



# What are the differences between a will and a revocable living trust

Many people mistakenly believe that, if they have executed a Florida Will, probate will be avoided when they pass away. This is not true.

In Florida, an Estate will go into probate when a person owns any property in his or her name alone without named beneficiaries. For example, if your spouse is deceased and the deed to your home is in both of your names, that home will have to go through the probate process in Court when you die. Likewise, if you have a brokerage account or bank account in your name alone with no one named as payable on death, that asset will also need to be probated upon your death.

The main purpose of a Will is to designate who you want to get certain assets when you die. If you die without a Will in Florida, the law will still require probate of your assets and your beneficiaries will be based on your closest living blood relatives. Florida Law provides for an order of priority of blood relatives if someone dies without a Will. If you are a Florida resident and own real estate in another state, it is likely that two probates will be required: a primary probate in Florida and a secondary probate (known as an ancillary proceeding) in the state where the property is located.

With cash assets such as bank accounts, CD's, brokerage accounts, annuities, life insurance policies, etc. you can avoid probate by designating one or more beneficiaries on the account. These beneficiaries will be entitled to the proceeds of that account upon your death, regardless of whether you have a Will or what you may have indicated in the Will; in other words, the designation of a beneficiary in a specific account takes precedence over anything stated in a Will. The Will will only apply to those assets where there are no designated beneficiaries (or if the beneficiaries have died before you).

Therefore, one of the primary reasons that many clients choose to create a



Revocable Living Trust is to avoid probate on all of their assets, particularly their home and any other real estate. I have many clients who own their primary home in Florida and a vacation home in another state. We create a Revocable Living Trust in Florida and also prepare a Quit Claim Deed to transfer the Florida property into the Trust. An attorney in the other state can then prepare a Deed transferring that property into the Florida Trust. This legal work will avoid probate in both states and allow for quick and easy sale or distribution of the properties.

The Trust which we prepare also provides that your Successor Trustee (the person or persons you

designate to administer the Trust after you pass away) can also take over managing the assets of your Trust if you become legally incapacitated. Legal incapacity is defined in the Trust document with language that requires a written statement from two medical doctors indicating that you are not able to carry on your legal affairs. The language allows your Successor Trustee to take over without a Court Order, but still provides you the protection of requiring written statements from two doctors.

In addition, it is much more difficult to contest a Revocable Living Trust than a Will. Your Successor Trustee can sell your properties and make distributions very quickly following your death, whereas the probate process required for a Will generally takes six to nine months or longer.

I leave you with the words of wisdom that my father left for me: "May you live as long as you want and never want as long as you live."






Marcus Aurelius lived from 121 to 180CE/AD and ruled the Roman Empire from 161 to 180, and wrote twelve notebooks on his thoughts about Stoicism and how to live his life. Twelve notebooks are a lot of entries, and he was writing to himself, not an audience. Diaries don't lose points for redundancy, obscurity, or muddled grammar. So, it's a slog to get through this book, but still quite amazing to read endlessly of the inner doubts and self-scoldings of perhaps the most powerful man of his day. I underlined a lot of passages that offered wisdom on navigating life with other

human beings and anticipating the inevitable end of one's own course on earth. Next time I visit him, and I'd like to, I'll choose an abridged version.






### An Enlightening Provincetown Experience

On a pleasant late June Sunday, Annette McKinney and I visited Provincetown, a very avante garde Cape Cod Community. I walked around Provincetown's Town Hall with its awesome views of the Pilgrim Monument erected between 1907 and 1910. The Pilgrim Monument is 252 feet high and made of granite. I then segued to begin my walk up to the Observation Deck of this structure. The walk up to the top was very invigorating for this energetic octogenerian. On the way to the top, I saw stones dedicated to the different municipalities in Massachusetts, including Boston, Wocester, Chelsea, and Quincy among others and the years of their establishment. From the top, I saw marvelous views of Provincetown and its scenic beaches. Provincetown in 1620 was the original Pilgrim Settlement, not Plymouth.

I then visited the Provincetown Museum which is adjacent to the Pilgrim Monument. At the Provincetown Museum, I learned about the Mayflower Compact in 1620 between the white British Settlers and the Wampanoag Native American Tribe. The architect of the Mayflower Compact was William Bradford. However, some of male members of the Wampanoag Tribe were kidnapped and sold into slavery by the white British Settlers. In 17th Century Provincetown, White Supremacy prevailed. Epanow, a Wampanoag man who escaped from his captors was regarded as a hero in the Wampanoag Tribal Society.


I also studied the Whaling Industry in this Cape Cod Community at this historic museum and the importance of Whale Oil in the 19th Century. I

learned about how Provincetown developed into a Bohemian Center for the Arts in the 1930's. Writers such as Eugene O'Neill and Norman Mailer are associated with Provincetown, as well as the painter, Oliver Chaffee. I saw a fine painting depicting Provincetown at this relatively small museum by Chaffee.

Anyway, my visit to Provincetown was very enlightening.

### WHAT'S COOKING!

### Roast Chicken with Thyme and Honey

#### **Ingredients**

3 medium parsnips, peeled, halved lengthwise and cut into 1-inch pieces

- 3 medium carrots, peeled, halved lengthwise and cut into 1-inch pieces
- 2 small onions, each cut into 8 wedges
- 2 heads garlic, cloves separated and peeled
- 6 sprigs thyme, plus 1 tablespoon finely chopped leaves
- 4 tablespoons extra-virgin olive oil

Kosher salt and freshly ground black pepper

- 4 pounds bone-in, skin-on chicken thighs and drumsticks, patted dry
- 1 tablespoon fresh lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons honey

#### **Instructions**

Heat the oven to 475 degrees.

Scatter the parsnips, carrots, onions, garlic and thyme sprigs in the bottom of a large roasting pan or baking dish. Drizzle the vegetables with 2 tablespoons of the oil and sprinkle generously with salt and pepper.

Lay the chicken pieces on top of the vegetables. Drizzle the remaining 2 tablespoons oil over the chicken, rubbing it in to coat all sides, then sprinkle with salt and pepper. Roast for 25 minutes.

Meanwhile, in a small bowl, whisk together the lemon juice, honey and chopped thyme until combined.

Reduce the oven temperature to 400 degrees. Brush the chicken evenly with the lemon-honey mixture, then continue cooking until the skin is browned, the juices run clear, and an instant-read thermometer inserted into the thickest part of a thigh registers 165 degrees, 25 to 30 minutes longer.

Let rest for 10 to 15 minutes before serving.

### Apple Crumble Cake

#### **Cake Dough and Crumble**

#### **Ingredients**

2 cups all-purpose flour

3/4 cup granulated sugar

1 teaspoon baking soda

Pinch of salt

34 cup 200 g butter or vegan butter, softened

2 eggs

3 tablespoons <u>Jamie Geller Lime and Mint Honey</u>

#### **Apple Filling**

1-34 pounds apples peeled, cored, and cubed

- 1 tablespoon lemon juice
- 2 tablespoons sugar mixed with 1 tablespoon cinnamon
- 3 tablespoons <u>Jamie Geller Lime and Mint Honey</u>

#### **Instructions**

Mix flour, sugar, baking soda, and salt in a large bowl. Add butter, eggs and honey and mix until dough begins to form. Knead with hands to form a ball. Let dough sit for 15 minutes.

Preheat oven to 180°C or 360 °F. Line a 10-inch springform pan with baking paper, lightly grease the edges and dust with flour.

Press two thirds of the dough into the pan and up the edges.

In a medium bowl combine apples, lemon juice, cinnamon and sugar, and honey. Spread over the dough in the pan. Top with remaining dough crumbled over top.

Bake for 55 minutes or until nice and golden. Remove from oven to cool before cutting and enjoying.

### The Liberal Jewish Temple of Coconut Creek A Reform Jewish Congregation Welcoming Everyone

Many of us have visited various Jewish Congregations over our lifetimes. Did you notice that you can almost always sing along - the melodies are familiar? Well, yes, and there is a reason for that.

For many, Jewish worship is most closely associated with prayer and ritual, but a profound musical and interpretive tradition lies at its core: trope and cantillation. These intricate systems, used for centuries, transform the public reading of sacred texts into a spiritual, communal, and educational experience. By exploring the origins, structure, melodic diversity, and special regional motifs of trope and cantillation—including the evocative Journeys melody—we can appreciate how these elements form an essential thread in the tapestry of Jewish liturgical life.

Trope, from the Greek word "tropos" meaning "turn" or "way," refers to a system of musical motifs, signs, and marks that guide the chanting of the Hebrew Bible. In Hebrew, cantillation is often called "ta'amei ha-mikra" (ארקמה ימעט), meaning "accents of the Scripture," or simply "trop." These marks are not vowels, but symbols written above and below the Hebrew letters of the biblical text. Their primary function is to indicate how a passage should be chanted—where to pause, how to group words, and what melodic motif to use.

#### The Purposes of Trope and Cantillation

- Interpretation and Punctuation: Trope signs clarify the syntactical structure of biblical verses by marking pauses and groupings.
- Musical Embellishment: The melodies of cantillation transform reading into a sacred, uplifting experience, infusing the text with emotional resonance.
- Preservation of Tradition: Consistent use of trope preserves both the text and the way it is presented, linking generations with a shared musical language.
- Educational Tool: Trope aids in teaching correct phrasing, pronunciation, and understanding of the text, especially for Bar/ Bat Mitzvah students.

Every section of the Hebrew Bible—Torah, Haftarah (Prophets), and the Megillot (Scrolls)—has its own system of trope. When reading from the Torah scroll, which contains no trope marks, the reader must rely on memory, study, and deep familiarity with the system. These melodies are passed down through generations and learned in advance from printed texts that contain marks and symbols.

Over twenty trope signs exist in the Torah's system, each with its unique melodic motif and grammatical purpose. They include disjunctives (which indicate a pause, like a comma or period) and conjunctives (which connect words). Common examples include:

- Etnahta (אָתְהַנְתֶא): Midpoint of a verse (semicolon).
- Sof Pasuk (קוֹסֶכּ רְוֹס): End of a verse (period).
- Munach (אַנָב): Connector, often leading into a pause.
- Mercha (אַכְרֵמ): Gentle, flowing conjunctive trope.
- Zakef Katon (נְטָק רָקוֹ): Minor pause (comma).

What makes cantillation truly remarkable is its mosaic of melodies, shaped by centuries of history and migration. Here are a few distinctive genres and where they can be found:

- Ashkenazi Melodies: Originating in Central and Eastern Europe, these are known for their stately, sometimes introspective sound. The Ashkenazi Torah trope is direct and clear, while the Haftarah trope is often more elaborate and ornamented. Within Ashkenazi communities, some melodies are reserved for special occasions, such as a mournful tune for the Book of Lamentations on Tisha B'Av or festive melodies during Simchat Torah.
- Sephardic Melodies: Rooted in the traditions of Spain, North Africa, and the Middle East, Sephardic chant is fluid, ornamented, and often incorporates local musical modes. For example, Moroccan and Syrian communities have subtle rhythmic and melodic differences, with each city or region adding its flavor to the chant.
- Mizrahi Melodies: Jews from Yemen, Iraq, Persia, and other Middle Eastern lands have their own cantillation systems. Yemenite melodies, for instance, are particularly ancient, marked by elaborate flourishes and microtonal intervals, while Iraqi Jews may integrate maqam (Arabic modal scales) into their chanting.
- Italian and Romaniote Melodies: Italian Jewish communities, as well as the Romaniotes of Greece, preserve unique and ancient tropes, sometimes blending Greek or Italian folk elements into their synagogue chant.

In some communities, the melodies of trope for Torah, Haftarah, and the Megillot are entirely separate, each set reflecting the emotional or ritual context of the text. Special melodies are often used for readings during holidays. For example, the Book of Esther on Purim is chanted with a lively and rapid melody, while the Book of Ruth is sung with a gentle, pastoral motif

Among the many unique trope motifs, the "Journeys melody" stands out for its evocative and narrative character. This melody is specifically associated with passages in the Torah that describe the travels—most famously, the list of the Israelites' encampments in the wilderness as found in Parashat Masei (Numbers 33). The Torah recounts each stop along the Israelites' forty-year journey from Egypt to the Promised Land, and tradition marks these verses with a distinctive musical phrase.

The Journeys melody is characterized by a lilting, almost wandering motif, intended to evoke a sense of movement, travel, and the passage of time. The melody often departs from the typical Torah cantillation, using a sequence that rises and falls, as if mirroring the ascent and descent of the Israelites' path through the desert. The effect is both beautiful and symbolic: the congregation hears, in the music, the footsteps and the spirit of a people on the move. This melody is seldom used outside these journeying passages, making it a cherished and special feature of the Torah reading cycle.

Learning trope is both a technical and an artistic endeavor. Many synagogues offer classes where students learn to recognize each symbol, associate it with its function, and practice its melody. This is often a rite of passage for B'nai Mitzvah, who prepare to read from the Torah or Haftarah with the proper cantillation.

Cantors and teachers use mnemonic devices, charts, recordings, and repetition to help students internalize the patterns. In recent years, digital tools, apps, and online tutorials have made the study of trope more accessible than ever, allowing individuals to connect with this ancient tradition wherever they are.

Beyond the practical and musical dimensions, trope and cantillation carry deep spiritual meaning. The melodies elevate the words, turning reading into song and routine into sacred encounters. The act of chanting, rooted in the collective memory of the Jewish people, brings ancient stories to life in the present. Each time the Torah is read, it is not only an act of remembrance but a celebration of continual renewal—a melody that echoes through generations.

The Liberal Jewish Temple of Coconut Creek and communities worldwide uphold this tradition, ensuring that every reading is not simply an act of recitation, but a vibrant, living legacy. Through trope and cantillation, the sacred texts are not only preserved but are given voice, meaning, and spirit—inviting everyone present to join in the ancient, ongoing song of the Jewish people.





### Latest Scam Alerts You Need To Know About



In case you missed it, here are some of the latest scam alerts we issued on our social media pages and our Creek Armor phone app:

Work-from-home job scams are the basis of this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert. People are attracted to the option of working from home, especially nowadays, and the bad

guys know that. A 25-year-old Coconut Creek man recently got caught up in this scam after he thought he had been hired by a company to work from home. The fraudsters sent him a check and told him to cash it, then they told him a little while later that there had been some mix-ups, so he needed to wire a portion of the money here, and then another amount there... you get the picture. It didn't take too long for the man, and his bank, to figure out he had been hoodwinked. Upfront payments are always a big sign you're dealing with a scam artist, keep that in mind if you're work-from-home job hunting. - *issued on July 8th* 

The **Apple ID Scam** is the basis for this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert. You may use Apple Pay on your iPhone to purchase items online or at the store. The bad guys pretend to be from Apple customer support. They call or text you claiming they've spotted fraud on your account. Then

they try to trick you into giving them your password and other personal information. They almost got one Coconut Creek woman recently but she talked to a friend who told her she was getting scammed and that prevented her from becoming a victim. Remember to always be very wary when someone calls you out of the blue claiming something's wrong with any of your financial accounts. It's the scammers trying to scare you. - *issued on July 23rd* 

Beating **the fake bank representative scammers** is the basis for this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert. Last week, a Coconut Creek woman dunked on the fraudsters by not falling for their shenanigans. A scammer called her pretending to be from her bank with a phony story about how her account was compromised and she needed to withdraw a bunch of money right then. It didn't sound right to her, so she hung up the phone and called her bank directly. They verified that it was a scam. So, if you ever get a similar phone call, follow this woman's blueprint: 1) Hang up. 2) Call your bank directly. They'll tell you it's a scam. – *issued on July 28th* 

If you're not on social media, or you're missing all of these scam alerts, you should download our free app, Creek Armor, on your phone. Its designers are ex-law enforcement officers so they do not use the app to sell your information to other companies, like some phone apps do.
