

### From the President

#### **Update on Monarch Hill Landfill Settlement**

After decades of frustration, community concern, and countless debates, Coconut Creek and its residents have achieved a truly historic victory regarding the future of the Monarch Hill Landfill—long known to many as "Mount Trashmore." The City of Coconut Creek by a unanimous vote of the Commissioners, together with our neighbors in Deerfield Beach, has reached a **final and groundbreaking settlement** with Waste Management and Broward County. This agreement marks the end of years of legal battles and secures, for the first time ever, a clear and enforceable path toward closing the landfill once and for all.

For more than half a century, Monarch Hill has loomed over our community, serving as a constant reminder of the environmental challenges we have faced. The residents of Coconut Creek have long lived with the odors, traffic, and unsightly presence of the landfill, and when a proposal came forward to expand it—making it 10 stories higher and 24 acres wider—the opposition from Coconut Creek was strong and unwavering. Despite these objections, the Broward County Commission approved the expansion earlier this year. That decision led Coconut Creek and Deerfield Beach to step into a legal battle to protect the health and quality of life of our residents.

Now, with this final settlement in place, we can proudly say that our persistence and determination have paid off. Waste Management has agreed that there will be **no more expansions beyond this one, ever again.** More importantly, the company is now bound to **permanently close Monarch Hill within 25 years or sooner if it reaches capacity.** This is an unprecedented achievement in landfill negotiations—something rarely, if ever, accomplished in similar cases across the country. For the first time in history, there is a legally binding agreement to end operations at Monarch Hill and begin planning for its future use in a way that benefits our community.

Waste Management has also committed to **renaming the landfill**, helping to close one chapter and open a new one. Just as importantly, the company has pledged to work with our city leaders on future plans to transform the site once it is closed—envisioning possibilities such as recreational or green space that could one day serve as a benefit rather than a burden to our residents. Stronger environmental protections will also be put in place immediately to help reduce odor, litter, truck traffic, groundwater risks, and the bird activity that has long affected our neighborhoods.

With this settlement granted and finalized, the City of Coconut Creek can now move forward with confidence, knowing that the long struggle with Monarch Hill is finally on a path toward resolution. For our community, for our children, and for generations yet to come, this marks a turning point.

Also, Wynmoor has joined forces with the City of Coconut Creek to challenge state plans to widen Florida's Turnpike and the Sawgrass Expressway through parts of Broward County. Last week, Wynmoor Community Council, Inc. and Coconut Creek filed a lawsuit in Leon County Circuit Court against the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), seeking to stop or modify the project.

The FDOT plan calls for expanding the Turnpike from six to ten lanes, with all of the widening occurring on the west side of the existing roadway—directly adjacent to our community. Wynmoor and Coconut Creek leaders say this design unfairly impacts our residents and neighboring communities.

According to the lawsuit, the expansion would bring more noise, air pollution, traffic congestion, vibrations, less natural light, physical encroachment into nearby neighborhoods, and a potential decrease in property values. The suit also argues that the project violates due-process and equal-protection rights.

"Our top priority is protecting our residents," the Council emphasized. "We will continue to take every step necessary to safeguard the quality of life, safety, and property values that our community expects and deserves."

#### **Wynmoor Community Management**

Wynmoor Community Council was created as an association to oversee and coordinate all the common elements. In addition, the Council has individual Management Agreement contracts with each of the 44 associations to provide services. For the past 50 years, this management agreement has proven to be highly effective, it provides a range of services that directly benefit both the community and its residents. It ensures professional oversight of day-to-day operations, from administrative support and resident communications to financial management, including budgeting, assessments, and transparent reporting. The agreement also supervises maintenance, vendor contracts, and common-area upkeep, keeping the community safe, attractive, and well-

maintained. By supporting the board in governance, policy enforcement, and legal compliance, it promotes consistent standards and accountability. Additionally, it addresses resident concerns promptly and fairly, fostering a harmonious and well-run environment. The agreement enhances the quality of life, efficiency, and overall well-being of Wynmoor and its residents.

I know I've spoken about this before, but it's worth repeating for everyone's safety. Please pay close attention to the traffic light at the entrance on Lyons Road into Wynmoor. Understanding and following the signals protects not only you but also your neighbors.

Violating these signals can result in the same ticket as running a red light—and more importantly, careful driving can save lives.

- **Solid Red Arrow: STOP.** This is the same as a red light. Do not proceed until it flashes or turns green.
  - Green Arrow: It is safe to proceed.
- Flashing Yellow Arrow: You may make a left turn only after yielding to oncoming traffic and pedestrians. This is not a protected turn.
- **Flashing Red Arrow:** Treat it as a stop sign. Come to a complete stop, then turn **only when it's safe**, yielding to traffic and pedestrians.

If you're unsure, remember: a flashing red signal acts like a stop sign—stop first, then proceed safely following right-of-way rules.

For more details, visit the Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) website for official guidelines and explanations of traffic signals.

Take a look around and take time to truly enjoy your surroundings. Gratitude opens the door to joy, it shifts our perspective to the abundance that already surrounds us. We are sure there are aspiring filmmakers here at Wynmoor just waiting to share their work on the big screen!



#### **Mindfulness Activities to Relieve Stress**

Mindfulness refers to a popular form of meditation that can help maintain healthy physical, mental, and emotional balance. Practicing mindfulness increases your awareness of the present moment where thoughts of the past, worry about the future, and negative thoughts fade into the background. It may take some regular practice but it's well worth the effort. Just 20 minutes daily can bring peace of mind and relaxation to the body.

#### Some health benefits of Mindfulness practice include:

- Improved brain function and cognition
- Emotional balance
- Improved relationships
- Reduced stress and blood pressure
- Improved digestion
- Improved sleep patterns
- Better mood and a positive outlook on life

If you want to begin your healthy journey now, here are some mindfulness activities you can include in your daily routine.

#### **Breathing Exercises**

Mindful breathing is a popular form of meditation because you can do it anytime and anywhere. Breathe into the belly deeply and slowly, while repeating the words clam and relaxed in your mind. When thoughts intrude, just refocus your attention on the breath and the words calm and relaxed.

#### **Body Scan**

The body scan is done lying on your back in a relaxed position. Begin by systematically bringing attention to different parts of your body, starting with your toes and slowly working your way up to your head. Notice any sensations—pleasant, unpleasant, or neutral—without judgment. The goal is to develop a non-judgmental awareness of your body and cultivates a

greater sense of presence and well-being. Many people use this technique to fall asleep.

#### Walking

Some people find it easier to relax while moving or doing something. Try practicing mindful walking. Here's how you can do it:

- Find a quiet and peaceful place where you can walk or move around freely.
- As you walk, focus on your surroundings. Take note of what you hear, see, smell, or even feel beneath your feet.
- If your mind wanders, just gently bring your attention back to your feet and your other senses.

#### **Journaling**

Expressing your thoughts, feelings, and emotions through writing allows you to examine your present self. Moreover, it helps you process your feelings, your past, and your relationships which allows you to put things into perspective. You can release your worries as you write which frees you to be more present to your day. Journaling can also help you set goals, list things you are grateful for, and work out communications to others.

#### **Therapeutic Coloring**

Adult coloring books have become a trend over the past few years because they're therapeutic!



itself. Being in the presence of the natural world and seeing its beauty can immediately bring you peace and happiness. There's plenty of ways to practice mindfulness by connecting with nature, including:







At the Broward Sheriff's Office, we are redefining public safety. Our proactive strategy is simple: we work with our community to prevent crime, build stronger neighborhoods and foster trust with residents throughout Broward County.

One of our most impactful initiatives is the *Park, Walk and Talk* program. Our deputies step out of their patrol cars and into neighborhoods, connecting directly with residents they serve. Last year alone, these face-to-face interactions resulted in over 40,000 valuable conversations across Broward County. This is our chance to listen to your concerns, learn about the issues that matter to you and build the trust that allows us to work together to solve problems.

During many of these interactions, we empower our residents with the tools to protect their family and property. Through our *While You Were Sleeping* program, deputies patrol your neighborhoods, spotting simple security issues like an unlocked car or an open garage door. We will leave a notice with a few actionable tips to inform you of important steps you can take to avoid becoming a victim and prevent crimes of opportunity.

For those planning a trip, our *Vacation Home Watch* program provides peace of mind by ensuring a deputy or BSO representative regularly checks on your home and reports any unusual activity. It's these kinds of simple, proactive measures have proven invaluable in preventing burglaries and other crime, keeping our communities secure.

Our commitment to public safety goes far beyond daily patrols. BSO's Community/Neighborhood Events & Logistics Unit plays a critical role



in crime prevention by building strong partnerships with residents and businesses. Through initiatives such as Shred-A-Thons and Operation Medicine Cabinet, we directly target threats like identity theft and prescription drug abuse. To date, we have safely destroyed more than 113,000 pounds of sensitive documents and collected over 1,000 pounds of unused medications. These proactive programs remove opportunities for crime, reduce risk, strengthen community trust and reinforce our shared responsibility of keeping Broward County safe.

One program I am most proud of is our investment in crime prevention through the Law Enforcement Trust Fund (LETF). Last year, BSO awarded over \$1.12 million to more

than 100 community nonprofit organizations. These grants support programs that mentor our youth, protect vulnerable populations and provide critical services that reduce risk and prevent crime before it occurs. By redirecting these resources into prevention and community partnerships, we are not only strengthening public safety today but also creating lasting, positive change for the future of Broward County.



### Augmenting My Knowledge of Pre-Raphaelite Painting at the Delaware Museum of Art

In Wilmington, Delaware, there is a delightful art museum which specializes in Pre-Raphaelite Paintings produced by middle and late 19th Century British and Scottish Painters. These paintings were produced during the 62-year reign of Queen Victoria. The early Pre-Raphaelite Painters such as; John Millais, Dante Gabriel Rossetti, and William Holman Hunt admired and were greatly influenced by Italian Quatrocento (1500's) Painters. The Pre-Raphaelite Painters sought a return to the copious detail, intense colors, and complex compositions produced by the Italian Painters of that period. The original founders of the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood, especially John Everett Millais and William Holman Hunt developed a technique of painting thin glazes of pigment over a wet white ground in hopes the colors would retain a jewel-like transparency and clearness. At the Delaware

Museum of Art, I saw splendid oil paintings by the giants of Pre-Raphaelite Art such as John Everett Millais "Waterfall," Ford Madox Brown "Romeo and Juliet," Dante Gabriel Rossetti "Water Willow," Edward Bourne-Jones "Hymenaus," mythological theme, Frederick Sandys "Mary Magdalene," and Simeon Solomon "Mother of Moses." I also appreciated fine paintings by later Pre-Raphaelite Painters such as; Scottish Painter, George Wilson "Spring Witch," mythological theme, George Frederick Watts "Portrait of Eveleen Tennant," Alice Boyd "Saint Columba's Farewell to White House," Christian theme, Aelfred Fahey "Within the Beguinage," and John Brett "Chagford," a fine landscape painting. The Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood was established at the home of Painter, John Millais in 1841 Members of the Pre-Raphaelite Brotherhood included painters, poets, and Art Critics such as John Ruskin. The Delaware Museum of Art has the most extensive collection of Pre-Raphael Paintings of any art museum in the United States.

Another strength of Delaware Museum of Art is its collection of 20th Century American Paintings. I saw very impressive paintings such as; John Sloan's "Path Through The Rocks and Bushes" and "Spring Rain," Robert Henri's "Little Girl of the Southwest," Marsden Hartley's "Landscape, New Mexico," Abraham Baylinson's "Reclining Nude," John Henry Twachtman's "Sea Scene," Edward Hopper's "Summertime," John McCoy's "4 O'Clock Train," Joseph Stella's "Lotus," and Andrew Wyeth's "Tenant Farmer," among others.

I also appreciated the delightful ambience of this art museum, as well as the fine curatorial work of its staff.

#### World Class Fishing in Wynmoor!

On July 8th the wired2fish.com angler news reported that the IGFA (International Game Fish Association) certified that Ryan Alvarez set a new world record for the species Channa marulius, or bullseye snakehead. The fish was taken from a canal in Pompano Beach in late April 2025 and weighed in at 17 lbs 1 oz and measured 37 inches long.

The ponds surrounding Wynmoor get their water from the C14 canal system also known as the Cypress Creek Canal in Broward County. The canals were dug in the early 1900's to control flooding.

The bullseye snakehead gets its name from a distinctive marking on its tail. The snakehead is considered an invasive species

by the Florida Fish and Wildlife.

Over the years people have released these exotic aquarium pets into the canals when they got too big for their fish tanks. With no known predators the populations of these invasive fish have taken over our fresh water lakes and ponds, competing with native largemouth bass, blue gills, crappie, bowfin and sunfish.

On July 9, 2025 Mike Flores, a Wynmoor resident and member of our fishing club, caught a 15 lb. bullseye snakehead that measured 34 inches long in our pond near the main gate bridge.

Just 2 lbs. shy of the current world record!

### What To Do When Your Spouse Or Partner Dies

Losing your spouse, partner or significant other is a very traumatic event. It is most important for your physical and emotional health to give yourself time for the grieving process.

Once you feel mentally and emotionally able to do so, you should schedule an appointment with an attorney to review all legal documents.

You should bring your Will and/or Revocable Living Trust, Deed to your home and any other real estate, certified copy of the death certificate and, if married, date of your marriage. If you have advanced care directives such as a Living Will, Durable Power of

Attorney and Designation of Health Care Surrogate, you should bring those as well.

If your spouse or partner owned something in their name alone with no designated beneficiary, probate may be necessary. Bring details of such assets to the appointment.

If everything you owned was in both names, it is not necessary to probate the Will. However, regarding your home, and any other real estate, it is important to "Clear the Title." The lawyer will prepare and have you sign a "Continuous Marriage Affidavit," which is why you need the date of your marriage. The Affidavit will state that you were married on a certain date and remained continuously married without divorce until the date of death. It will provide the legal description of your home and other real estate and indicate your intention to clear title. This document will be recorded, along with an Affidavit of No Florida Estate Tax Due and the Death Certificate without the cause of death. Recording these documents will clear title and allow you the option to do a new Deed to avoid probate when you die. If you were not married but owned your home (or any other property) jointly, it is still important to clear title. Of course, a Continuous Marriage Affidavit will not be necessary.

If you do not have a Revocable Living Trust, this appointment will be a



good opportunity to discuss the creation of a Trust and preparation of a Deed in order to avoid probate on your home and other real estate. You can also discuss the option of a Life Estate Deed to avoid probate.

If you do have a Trust, this may be an appropriate time to consider doing an Amendment to the Trust based on new circumstances. Your home and other real estate (in Florida and out-of-state) should be owned by you as Trustee of the Trust. You may wish to name one of your children as Co-Trustee to make it easier to manage the assets in your Trust if you become incapacitated. You may also wish to make changes in

your Living Will, Durable Power of Attorney and Designation of Health Care Surrogate or create those documents if you do not have them.

In most cases, there is no urgency to contact an attorney. It is much better to have peace of mind and clarity. Some lawyers, including myself, will offer a free consultation. This consultation should include your options and give you the opportunity to sleep on it before finalizing any new legal documents.

In addition, when you are ready, there are actions you should take for which you do not need an attorney. ### book review


TO READ A BOOK

I loved this book. I didn't want it to end. By the time I was a third of the way through I was rooting for the characters as if they were my favorite friends, and I was no longer paying any attention to authorial choice or skill. I just wanted Sam and Sadie and Marx to be okay. I had stopped worrying about how I might relate to video game designers in their twenties and just kept swallowing up pages by the dozens.

Okay, let me attempt a sort of objective review. This book covers fifteen years in the lives of three game designers and their adjacent significant others, from Cambridge, Massachusetts to Los Angeles. There is a lot of


talk about game designing that I didn't understand; sometimes I googled terms, but a reader could follow the gist without doing that. The games sounded enchanting, but not enough to go out and get one for play. The writing is smooth, with lots of illusions to other worlds, like Shakespeare, the lives of minorities and immigrants, academic politics, etc.

I closed this book, already missing the characters and happy for the little bit I learned about the world of their imagination.

In less than two hundred pages this thirty-year-old book tells the dystopian story of a girl growing up and then old in a bleak and mysterious landscape that may not even be on planet Earth. She is confined with other women, then set adrift to find survival as a group and as an individual. Towards the end of her narrative she wonders, "Is it the effort of remembering that provides its own nourishment, and is what one recollects less important than the act of remembering?" Gracie, my vivacious twenty-three-year-old granddaughter, recommended this book to me. When I tried to get it from the library, I was number fifteen in line. Originally

written in French, it was translated into English two years after publication. So, who has rediscovered this bleak tale? My granddaughter's generation? If so, what does it say to them about our present world in a new century? I know what my next conversation with Gracie will be. I wonder if she'll be able to explain what this book means to her, in a way that I'll understand.

### **2026 Homestead Exemptions**

If you applied and were approved for the Homestead Exemption for tax year 2026, this exemption will show online in December. Once approved, Homestead Exemption automatically renews each year provided there is no change in the ownership or use of the property. You do not need to reapply for this exemption if the property remains your permanent residence.

### Did You Acquire or Take Ownership of Your Property in 2025?

If you acquired your home in 2025, the TRIM (proposed tax) Notice you received in August reflected the <u>previous</u> owner's exemption status which will be removed at the end of this year. If this property is your permanent residence and you believe you qualify for a 2026 Homestead Exemption, you must complete an application in your name. To be eligible for 2026 Homestead Exemption, an applicant must both own and make the property their permanent residence as of January 1, 2026.

Please note: "permanent residency" does <u>not</u> require physical occupancy of the property. If you are building or intend to build a home to be used as your permanent residence, please call our Customer Service Department at 954-357-6830 to discuss Homestead Exemption eligibility requirements.

Homestead Exemption does <u>not</u> automatically transfer from one property to another. You can easily apply for Homestead Exemption and any other tax-saving exemptions online at https://web.bcpa.net under the "Exemptions & Classifications" tab. If you previously owned another Homesteaded property within the past three tax years, you will also be applying for portability. The portability application is part of the online Homestead Exemption application.



### The Liberal Jewish Temple of Coconut Creek A Reform Jewish Congregation

### **Welcoming Everyone**

Jewish tradition, as rooted in the Torah and interpreted by rabbinic literature, approaches vengeance and retribution in war with caution, continually urging restraint, justice, and the pursuit of peace. Justice is elevated as a measured and principled response, never to be confused with revenge.

The Prophet Isaiah's vision — "nation shall not lift up sword against nation, neither shall they learn war anymore" captures Judaism's ultimate hope for universal peace. This aspiration is embedded throughout Jewish writings, which encourage acts of restoration and reconciliation in the aftermath of war, seeking to break cycles of violence rather than perpetuate them.

Central is the commandment in Leviticus 19:18: "You shall not take vengeance nor bear any grudge... but you shall love your neighbor as yourself." Here, restraint and compassion are elevated within the community, setting a foundation for how justice and warfare are approached. Even when retribution is described—for instance, in the Torah's accounts of conflicts with groups like Amalek (Deuteronomy 25:17-19) and Midian (Numbers 31)—it is framed as a response to specific threats or past atrocities, not as justification for endless cycles of payback. Rabbinic interpretation further cautions against literal or generational application, emphasizing the dangers of unchecked hatred and advocating for moderation.

Jewish law sets explicit limits on retribution, especially during times of war. Before engaging in battle, peace must first be offered (Deuteronomy 20:10), making violence a last resort and establishing the restoration of peace as the aim. The principle of bal tashchit, which prohibits needless destruction—exemplified in the command to preserve fruit trees during sieges (Deuteronomy 20:19)—extends to human life and property, forbidding retributive acts that inflict unnecessary harm or civilian suffering.

The dignity of all people, each created in the image of God (Genesis 1:27), is a cornerstone of Jewish tradition, and even enemies must not be dehumanized. Rabbinic literature, such as the Talmud (Sanhedrin 74a), insists on choosing martyrdom over the murder of innocents, rejecting the idea that collective security justifies indiscriminate violence. Maimonides (Mishneh Torah, Laws of Kings and Wars 6:7) codifies the requirement to leave an escape route for besieged foes, further highlighting the imperative to preserve life.

Treatment of captives is regulated by mandates against cruelty, torture, and humiliation. The Mishneh Torah commands mercy (rachamim) as the guiding principle in all actions, even when retribution is involved. Jewish law thus transforms war and justice into opportunities to uphold humanity.

Jewish tradition seeks restoration and reconciliation after conflict, aiming to break the cycle of vengeance and realize Isaiah's vision of peace. Justice is always tempered by restraint, dignity, and compassion, ensuring that even in the harshest moments, the pursuit of peace remains the highest calling.

### Scary Scams as Halloween Approaches



As Halloween approaches, here's a look at some of the "scary scams" we've warned you about recently. If you're not seeing these, follow us on social media – Facebook or Nextdoor – or download the Creek Armor app on your phone. You can find out more information on that by visiting www.coconutcreek.net/creekarmor

#### **BITCOIN SCAMS**

A Coconut Creek woman recently reached out to us after the fraudsters tricked her into giving them access to her coinbase account. They did it by sending her a fake text message claiming someone had changed the password to get into her account. Remember to be very wary when a stranger reaches out to you pretending to have solutions to problems you never understood you had. It's always a scam. Bitcoin account holders should also know that the bad guys are targeting them in scam emails, text messages, and phone calls more and more nowadays. Ignore any strange attempts to get your attention.

#### **IDENTITY THEFT**

Why it's a good idea to get into the habit of checking your credit report. A woman from Brevard County recently called us after she checked her credit report and found that an apartment complex here in Coconut Creek

was trying to collect money from her for a past due rental. She of course does not live here and probably wouldn't have picked up on the fraud so quickly if she had not checked her credit report. Federal law provides that you can check your credit report for free every week. The secure website, www.annualcreditreport.com, is a good way to do this. It'll help you spot a bad guy using your identity sooner rather than later.

#### SOME SCAMMERS OPERATE FACE-TO-FACE

Beware of couriers. Most of these alerts we do involve fraudsters from other states and possibly overseas collecting their monies via cash apps or those store-bought debit cards. Not this one. This case involved a courier, or someone actually picking up the money in-person from our victim.

The victim said she got a call from someone claiming to be from the fraud department at her bank. He told her that her account was "compromised" and told her to make a cash withdrawal so that a bank representative would come get the money and put it in "a new account" to keep it safe for her. Sure enough, someone met her on Lyons Road and picked it up.

A lot of you may be wondering "How could this victim fall for this?" It happens. In fact, we've seen this method of fraud before. If it never worked, why would the bad guys keep using it?

The bottom line is to remember that your bank would never call you out of the blue and tell you something was wrong with your account. If you get a similar call or text, just hang up. And never agree to meet a so-called "bank employee" and give them any money or your bank card.




