

These agencies provide comprehensive support for seniors, including meals and nutrition programs, home- and community-based care, housing assistance, Alzheimer's and dementia support, caregiver services, and veterans' benefits guidance. Residents and caregivers are encouraged to reach out to these resources to ensure older adults can live with dignity, security, and connection.

In the best interest of our residents and to help ensure a safe and welcoming community, the Wynmoor Community Council (WCC) has adopted a rule prohibiting open carry of firearms, whether loaded or unloaded, on Council-owned property. This includes all WCC-sponsored or sanctioned Clubs, meetings, events, and functions, as well as all buildings, facilities, vehicles, grounds, roadways, walkways, parking lots, and other exterior areas under Council control. The rule applies to residents, guests, visitors, and business vendors, contractors, or delivery personnel. Signage reflecting this rule will be posted at all public entrances. Please note this applies only to Councilowned properties; each individual Association Board within Wynmoor will need to vote separately on whether to adopt a similar rule for its own buildings and grounds.

We are deeply grateful to our veterans, whose courage and dedication have secured the freedoms and privileges we cherish in the United States. Many of us have family members, friends, or teachers who have selflessly served, allowing us to live in peace and security. Let's take time to thank these remarkable men and women—not just on special days, but throughout the year. Their sacrifices deserve our ongoing recognition and appreciation.

Scrutinizing 14th Century Italian Paintings in the Philadelphia Museum of Art with Pleasure

Recently, I returned to Philadelphia, the city of Brotherly Love to enjoy the Philadelphia Museum of Art, after a pleasant walk along Franklin Parkway. Since I have a strong propensity for 14th Century Italian Paintings and Art, this review is devoted to the Philadelphia Museum of Art's fine collection of 14th Century Italian Paintings produced primarily by Sienese and Florentine Masters. The works that I studied were devotional in subject matter. The paintings that I am disseminating information about were produced primarily by painters who employed tempera and gold leaf on wood panel.

I started my day studying Master of Montebalate's "Crucifixion" produced in the 13th Century in the city state of Umbria. It was an auspicious start to my venture into Medieval Italian Paintings. I then studied delightful 14th Century, Italian Trecento Paintings produced by Sienese Masters. I saw fine paintings by these Sienese Masters; Ugolino di Nerio "Prophet Daniel," pinnacle of altarpiece, Niccolo di Tommaso "Triptych, Saint Bridget's Vision of Nativity," Niccolo Da Segna "Crucifixion With Virgin, Saint John The Evangelist, and Mary Magdalene," Pietro Lorenzetti "Virgin and Christ Child," Bartolomeo Bulgarini "Annunciate Virgin, Annunciate Angel, Saints: Andrew, Dominic, Lucy, Agatha, Lawrence, Bartholomew," my favorite Sienese Painting that

day, Taddeo di Bartolo (predella of altarpiece, "Saint Anthony Abbott, Saint Andrew, Mourning Virgin, Man of Sorrows, Mourning Saint John Evangelist, Archangel Raphael, Saint Lawrence" Andrea di Bartolo "Virgin and Child with Saint John Evangelist, and James Major," and Francesco Vannuccio "Crucifixion With Virgin and Saint John Evangelist" Up until 1360, Siena was the dominant city state for 14th Century Italian Art. Later on Florence became the dominant city.


Afterwards, I studied fine 14th Century Italian Medieval Paintings produced by Florentine Masters I relished delightful paintings by these Florentine Masters; Dalmasio "Virgin and Christ Child With Dog," Jacopo di Cione "Saint Peter Released From Prison," Agnolo Gaddi "Saint Silvester and The Dragon," Niccolo Di Pietro Gerini "Christ in Tomb With Virgin," Bernardo Daddi "Virgin and Child With Saint John The Baptist and Saint Giles," he employed Tempera, silver, tooled gold on wood panel with vertical grain, and Allegretto Nuzi "Virgin and Christ Child With Saints Mary Magdalene, James Major, Stephan, and Bishop Saint," my favorite 14th Century Florentine Painting that I enjoyed. Allegretti Nuzi also utilized tempera, silver and tooled gold on wood panel with vertical grain, like Daddi. Bernardo

> Daddi is considered by leading experts of Florentine Medieval Painting to be the leading Florentine Painter of the first half of the 14th Century, along with Giotto.

> I also saw fine Medieval Italian Paintings produced in other Italian City States worthy of Note by Vitale Da Bologna Bologna, "Crucifixion" and Master of Pesaro Crucifix Venice "Saint Cecilia and Her Husband, Valerian Being Crowned By Angel." In short, my study of Italian Medieval Art at the Philadelphia Museum of Art was very rewarding. I then segued to study paintings and sculpture from the Early Italian Renaissance Period at this huge art museum.


A Full-Service Approach To Public Safety

Few communities in the nation rely on one agency for as many vital public safety functions as Broward County. Among more than 3,000 sheriff's offices nationwide, the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) stands out as one of the few fullservice public safety organizations in the nation, integrating law enforcement, fire rescue, detention, 911 communications and a host of regional services under one umbrella. Serving nearly two million residents across 1,200 square miles, BSO operates one of the most comprehensive public safety systems in the country.

BSO provides law enforcement to 12 cities and all unincorporated areas of Broward County, protecting neighborhoods, businesses and key infrastructure like Fort

Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport, Port Everglades and the Broward County Courthouses. Our specialized units, including Aviation, Marine Patrol, K-9, Motors and SWAT, are among the most active in the nation. BSO's intelligence-led Threat Intervention Tactics Analytics Network (TITAN) works to prevent acts of violence and terrorism, while our Fire Rescue and Emergency Services division handles emergencies from hazardous materials, technical recue and critical, lifesaving air rescue. In 2020, we launched a unique whole blood program, which provides vital lifesaving resources to patients in a pre-hospital setting. To date, we have seen a 79.4% survival rate.

We also manage all of Broward's jail facilities, including inmate programs,



court services and the 911 Regional Communications Center, which answers nearly 2.4 million for service calls per year. Our unique Real Time Crime Center supports law enforcement countywide with real-time intelligence, while our nationally accredited Crime Lab processes over 10,000 forensic cases annually.

Behind the scenes, our Neighborhood Support Team ensures our teams stay connected to the community. Last year alone, through our Park, Walk and Talk program, we participated in more than 40,000 neighborhood conversations listening to concerns and building relationships with the people we serve. Safety Solutions

Sending Money To Strangers Continues To Be An Issue Here In Coconut Creek



While hearing and reading reports of folks getting scammed here in Coconut Creek by sending money to total strangers is nothing new, it is disheartening that it's still happening at such a high rate.

The Romance Scam for example still

pops up here every now and then. It's when someone sends money to a love interest they met using social media, only to find out they're being scammed. It's important to review prevention methods when it comes to these types of fraud schemes:

- 1) Never be too trustworthy when it comes to on-line dating. Not many people know this but one of the fastest growing populations on many of these on-line dating sites are people over the age of 60.
- 2) If your potential love interest keeps declining to meet you one-on-one then you have to ask yourself: "What is the reason for that?" In fact it's a major red flag that you could be communicating with a scam artist.
- 3) Once they start asking for money, they'll probably never stop. Again this is a big red flag that the person you may be involved with is not who they say they are. It usually starts innocently enough. They'll claim they just got in a car crash and need a little money to help pay their medical bills. They won't ask for an exorbitant amount to start. It'll just be a request for \$50 here or \$100 there. Then the amounts will just keep increasing. I've even seen victims send these fraudsters money for plane tickets because they claim they want

to come visit. Of course they never do.

4) Always practice the pause before you send someone you've never met any money. What I mean by that is to stop and think: Do I really know this person? What would my son, daughter, or other loved one think? If I asked my best friend, what would he or she tell me to do? Although the scammers might pressure you to do something "right now," remember that you don't have to. You are in control. Take a breath and think about it first.

That last point is an important one. Practicing the pause can be used to prevent other scams too. Here's what I mean:

- 1) Someone claiming to be from your utility company calls you out of the blue claiming you forgot to pay your bill. "Pay it right now or else we'll cut off your service!" they might say. You practice the pause. You think: "I know I paid my bill. This is a scam!"
- 2) Your "grandson" calls claiming he's in jail in Mexico. He needs money for a lawyer immediately! You practice the pause. You pick up the phone and call your daughter: "Hey! How's my grandson?" "Fine," she says. "He's in his dorm room in Gainesville."
- 3) An alert suddenly pops up on your computer that something is terribly wrong with it! "Call this number now," it exclaims! You practice the pause and ask: "How would they know there's something wrong with my computer? It must be a scam."

Practicing the pause is a highly recommended scam prevention tool. It should go in your "tool box" right now.



The Broward County Property Appraiser's Office is responsible for ensuring the fair assessment (value) of all properties and applying all exemptions. We make it our #1 priority to assist all Broward residents in obtaining every tax-saving exemption for which they are eligible.

The Property Appraiser's Office does not set your tax rates, collect property taxes, or determine how the tax revenue is allocated by local government. The property tax bills are sent by the Broward County Tax Collector's Office. If you have questions regarding the payment of your tax bill, the Tax Collector's Office can be reached at 954-357-4829 or you can visit their website at https://browardtax.org/.

Where Is My 2026 Homestead Exemption?

The tax bill you received this month from the Broward County Tax Collector is for the 2025 tax year. If you acquired your home in 2025 and the previous owners of your new home lawfully received Homestead Exemption or any other exemption on January 1, 2025, you may have inherited their exemptions on your 2025 property tax bill. Florida Statutes require these 2025 exemptions to be removed, and the property be reassessed at the full Just/Market Value for 2026. This may result in an increase in your 2026 property taxes. It is important that you apply for your own Homestead Exemption in your name if you believe you are eligible for 2026. Your new 2026 Homestead Exemption will be reflected next year on all 2026 property records, notices, and tax bills. You can apply for Homestead Exemption and any other exemptions you may qualify for online at https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/HomesteadExemption.

If you have questions regarding your Homestead or other tax-saving exemptions, please contact our Exemptions Department at 954-357-6830.

Quarterly Installment Payments

If you pay your property taxes through the Tax Collector's quarterly installment plan, any new 2025 exemptions will be applied to the final two quarterly 2025 installment tax bills in December 2025 and March 2026.

"Ageism-Discrimination based on age. - Is a real issue in healthcare, and the ER is no exception. Seniors are sometimes perceived as difficult patients because they may have trouble communicating systems, require extra care due to mobility issues, or arrive without clear medical histories. In some cases, ER doctors may assume that certain treatments aren't "worth it" for older patients, particularly those with multiple chronic conditions. This mindset can lead to seniors receiving less aggressive treatment than younger individuals with the same symptoms. This past summer, my husband was in the hospital and then in rehab for 2 months. I witnessed the above first hand - from doctors not believing what he said and ignoring symptoms, to aides speaking to him like he was 2 years old to social workers ignoring him and telling me I should send him to a nursing home, to PT people "assuming" things which were wrong and making them part of his chart. He would say something and I would have to be there to back him up. I started thinking about what Judaism had to say about our age group.

Jewish writings, including the Torah and later rabbinic literature, offer profound guidance on the subject of old age and the treatment of elders. At the heart of Jewish tradition is a deep respect for older adults, viewing them as repositories of wisdom, experience, and continuity. This reverence is rooted in the Torah, which frequently commands honor and care for the elderly, and is echoed throughout centuries of Jewish thought.

One of the most explicit Torah verses addressing this issue is found in Leviticus 19:32: "You shall rise before the aged and show deference to the old; you shall fear your God: I am the Lord." This commandment not only instructs the community to honor elders physically—by standing in their presence—but also links such respect to reverence for God, suggesting that

caring for the aged is a sacred duty. The Torah's consistent emphasis on honoring parents (Exodus 20:12, Deuteronomy 5:16) further extends this ethos, as the fifth commandment to "Honor your father and your mother" is interpreted by Jewish tradition as encompassing all elders, not just one's immediate family.

Rabbinic writings expand upon these Torah principles. The Talmud, for instance, considers the elderly to be especially worthy of respect regardless of their physical or mental state.

Jewish tradition also mandates practical care for the elderly. The Mishnah in Pirkei Avot (Ethics of the Fathers) teaches, "Do not look at the vessel, but at what is in it," reminding us that the true value of a person lies in their character and experience, often cultivated over many years. Communities are expected to provide for their elders, ensuring their dignity and well-being. In many Jewish communities, elders are consulted on important matters, their stories are treasured, and their presence is seen as a blessing.

In summary, Jewish writings from the Torah through the rabbinic era consistently stress the importance of honoring and caring for elders. Old age is not viewed as a burden but as a stage of life rich with opportunity for respect, learning, and connection. The Jewish view sees each elder as a living link to the past and a source of wisdom for the future, and teaches that how a community treats its elders is a measure of its moral and spiritual health.



Herman Wouk




When I asked a friend who had lived in the Virgin Islands for five years what it felt like to be there, she recommended this book.

Norman Paperman is a publicist working in the theatre world of late 1950s Manhattan. He's forty-nine, his only daughter is in college, he's had a heart attack, and he's seduced by the idea of running a resort hotel in the Caribbean. His wife likes the idea. That's enough for him to chuck his career, take off for the island of Amerigo, and buy the Gull Reef Club. Crisis after crisis predictably crashes on his head; the natives are inscrutable and

sometimes devious; his wife is delayed in New York long enough for him to fall a bit in love with an ex-pat. Mr. Wouk weaves humor, suspense and slapstick into his story, but also offers commentary on the political and social complexity of one small island. The end feels right. And I was glad to be reminded of one of the authors who introduced me to adult living when I was still a teenager.



What Legal Documents Are Most Important Now?

The pandemic changed almost everything. But certain legal documents are more important than ever.

If you need to be hospitalized in Florida, it is imperative that you have a Designation of Health Care Surrogate and Living Will with proper wording so there will be no problems. Do not rely on generic forms obtained online. Florida hospitals are requiring specific HIPAA compliant language not found on generic forms. Your Surrogate will be able to make medical decisions for you if you are unable to communicate. Even if the hospital does not allow any visitors, your Surrogate will be able to talk to

the doctors and make decisions on the phone or e-mail. Your Surrogate does not need to be present in the hospital. All your Surrogate needs to do is e-mail or fax a copy of your document to the hospital. If there is no hope to save you, that Surrogate would be authorized to "pull the plug" based on the Living Will.

The Durable Power of Attorney is also important to allow someone to take over your legal and financial affairs. The Florida law changed in 2011. If you have an old Durable Power of Attorney, it should be redone. Again, do not rely on generic forms. Our current Power of Attorney is 26 pages to conform to Florida law.

If you are married, you still need to do a Health Care Surrogate, Living Will



and Power of Attorney. You can name your spouse, child or anyone that you trust.

If you should die, your Will or Revocable Living Trust will determine who inherits your assets. The Trust is important to consider if you own your home or other real estate, because it avoids Probate. Probate can tie up your property for many months and prevent your heirs from selling without a Court Order. They would have to continue to pay taxes, maintenance, mortgage, utilities etc. in addition to thousands of dollars in attorney fees and court costs. A Life Estate Deed (Lady Bird) is another option to consider to

avoid probate. Your attorney can discuss the different options and the benefits of each one.
