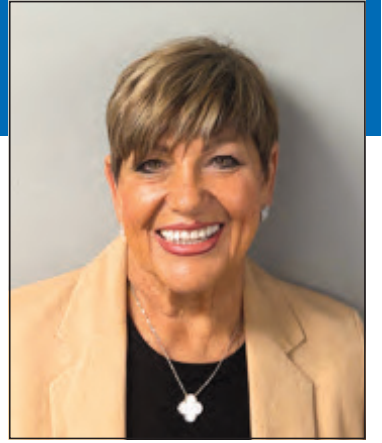

A judge dismissed the City’s initial complaint challenging the project, which would widen the Turnpike and bring it closer to residential neighborhoods, raising concerns about increased noise, air pollution, traffic congestion, and potential impacts on property values. In response, the City has already filed an amended complaint, refining its legal arguments to address the court’s concerns and continue its challenge to the expansion. Wynmoor and other Creek communities remain actively engaged, supporting the City’s efforts through advocacy and resident participation in public meetings, while also urging state agencies, including the Florida Department of Transportation and Turnpike Enterprise, to consider alternatives that minimize the impact on neighborhoods. This united, ongoing effort emphasizes that protecting the quality of life for Wynmoor residents—

Transforming Your Relationship to Pain With Mindfulness

Pain is felt not only by the body but also by the mind or more accurately put, by your relationship to the pain. We can deal with pain better when we shift our perspective on it.

Physical pain is the response of the body and the nervous system to a huge range of stimuli that are perceived as damaging, noxious or dangerous. There are three dimensions to pain: the sensory component which is the physical, the affective component or emotional aspect which is how we feel about the pain and the cognitive component which is the meaning we attribute to the pain.

For example, if you experience back pain and can't work or have difficulty moving or can't lift you are experiencing the physical component of pain. You may have to give up a lot when in pain, so maybe you are angry or frustrated about that. This is your emotional response to the pain. Then you may also have thoughts about the pain, like what caused it. You may have expectations, projections or fears about it which compound the stress of pain and erode your quality of life.

The affective (emotions) and cognitive (thoughts) regarding pain can be lessened once you realize that you have control over these aspects of pain. You can shift your feelings about it. As in the example of back pain, instead of getting angry or frustrated, you could choose to focus on loving the body more, accepting this time as a healing time in your life - allowing your body to naturally improve. You can also shift your thoughts about the pain, letting go of any story, fears or ideas you are telling yourself about it. Focus instead on proper nutrition, sleep and following doctors' orders, while setting aside your worries.

When we resist pain or hold onto our negative responses to pain, we suffer.

When we accept that our bodies will go through changes and inevitably be challenged as we live our lives, we can stop resisting the pain. Pain is unavoidable, suffering however is optional!

So, how can we make that shift? Studies show that distraction can be useful when dealing with pain, for example keeping our minds occupied by focusing on pleasant activities (reading, watching a good movie, working on a creative project). But, if the pain is prolonged, this helps only at the onset. After time, mindfulness or the practice of staying in the present moment and releasing the feelings and thoughts about the pain will help ease our perceptions of it. Not only that, medications and other therapies become more effective and can even be lowered in dosage and frequency.

Developing a neutral stance to our pain can be achieved by practicing mindfulness, a technique borrowed from Buddhism and used in the hospital setting since the mid-1990s.

With mindfulness, we become aware of what is (the physical pain) and distinguish what is created in the mind (the story or emotional response). When you see that distinction, you begin to develop intimacy with the body, accepting all parts of the body not just the area of pain.

When we practice mindfulness, we are not goal oriented. Mindfulness is just being with things as they are in this moment. You simply observe. You see the pain as it is - a sensation. The interpretation that the pain is killing me or ruining my life and all the stories that go with that, are seen for what they are. In that seeing, your perception of pain changes.

It is, however, important to practice mindfulness daily in order to cultivate a neutral attitude. Should the pain become acute, these principles will be easier to put into practice.

If you pay attention to the little episodes of pain in your life, you will learn to work with the bigger ones.

When you look deeply into the nature of pain, then you make use of it in

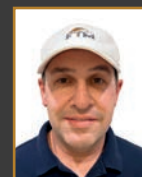

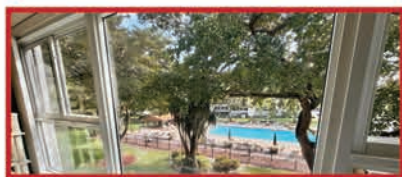

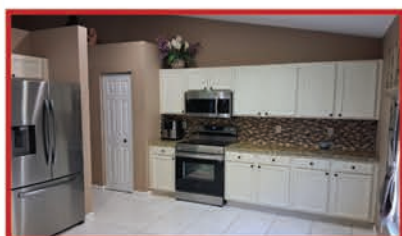

man would talk to a solid stone wall causing a doorway to appear and open!

Anyway, we did have a throw rug in the hallway of our house and when Mom wasn't looking all that carefully I took it out back on the lawn and sat down on it and told it to fly me over town. I sat there for a while not getting anywhere before putting that foolish carpet back in the hallway where it belonged. I did read the book again but decided that I wouldn't toss any commands at nearby stone walls. There were, however, some quarries up on the top of the nearby hills with high stone walls. They were a good piece from our house, and my brother Michael would need to take me there as I was too young to go that far away alone. Michael, my four years older brother, would sometimes take me along on one of his adventures, but he was rather strait laced and when I was with him, I needed to toe the line. So, it stood to reason that he would likely not have had any interest in taking me over a mile up on the hill to talk to rocks. The whole thing was sketchy, very sketchy!

On some weekends we would travel to what we called the "Big Lake" where my father fished and we swam. The lake was so big that I couldn't see the opposite shore and, of course, I questioned Dad as to what was there. Dad would just gruffly answer saying, "More lake." My books had pictures of where the edge of the ocean was and the water just spilling over. I never figured out where that water went, hopefully not into someone's kitchen. Maybe this lake was near there and ended up with the ocean's water going down toward someone's kitchen. Now if that wasn't enough to think about for a small shaver my age, I'd see boats.

I would see tugboats shoving barges across the lake. Some would come out of the canal on our end of the lake and then disappear into that distant horizon while others would appear on that horizon and come across the water, disappearing into the canal. If the lake did end out there somewhere with the water spilling over the edge, "Where did those barges come from, and go, DAD?" His reply was direct, and to the point, "I don't know; maybe Syracuse." Syracuse was a very long way away from our home and a place where we seldom went. It was a city with streets and stores and doctors had offices there. Why and how would a tugboat and barge go there, I wondered. The next answer was more of a statement than a reply telling me that my dad was trying to fish!

Though the "Big Lake" was big, twenty-two miles long, it wasn't the ocean, but still... On those rare occasions that I got to go out with Dad in the boat, I'd have a wonderful time but still ask questions. One day I queried Dad about what was under the water. I thought maybe sunken pirate ships or gold like I had read about in my little books. Then, despite the warm sun, I shivered at the thought of a giant sea serpent that might make us his next meal. I'd read about them, too. Dad put the kibosh to those ideas straightway, telling me not to be silly! I had read and seen pictures of these things in books. What's so silly? While Dad and his friends fished, I kept out a close watch but, of course,

saw nothing. There were fish down there and those men did catch their share.

It took us something over an hour to reach that big lake from home, and for me it was forever far away. Always my dad would fish with his friends and my mother would prepare a BBQ. Dad would come in around noon and we'd eat and then go swimming. After we would go into a small amusement park there and ride a ride or two before getting a candied apple. Then it was "home again, home again jiggety jog."

So many important questions back then that somehow never got answered, and by today I have lost that pressing need for an answer. Many years for what they refer to as those simpler times, way back then. Different, yes, those times were different, but simpler, easier, NO! Those were the times when there were monsters under your bed, dragons lived in old castles guarding their pile of stolen treasures, and huge sea serpents roamed the briny looking for a likely ship! All of these things were out there in sight of "The End of World" and waiting for me!

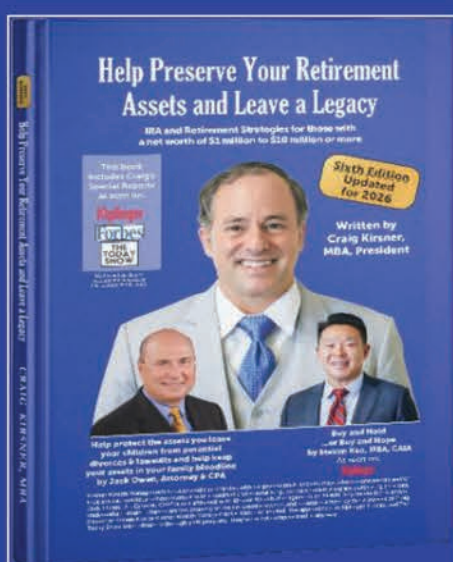

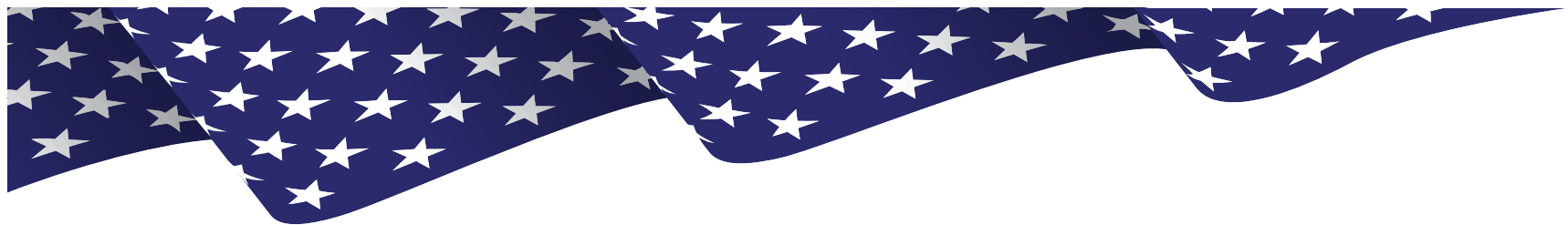

1- How many of my students did I fail?

Legal Surveys – Property Boundaries

Owners are not required to file surveys with our office -- unless they are seeking to split or combine parcels -- so we very rarely see copies of legal property surveys. Property owners should have a copy of their legal property survey in the closing documents when they purchased the property. This survey defines the property’s boundaries, legal description and any easements or restrictions to help resolve any property line disputes and can be used for any permitting requirements.

Copies of Deeds are Public Records and Available For FREE Online

We often hear of mailings aimed at Broward County property owners offering to provide the owner with a copy of their deed or previously recorded document. The company will provide this service for a fee; however, most documents are available online for free.

Deeds and many other important documents are available online on Broward County’s Records’ website and linked from the property record page. To search for a recorded deed on our website, simply search for the property record and click on the blue “Book/Page or CIN” number located under “Sales History for this Parcel” on the property record page. This will link you to the recorded document in Broward County Records where you can print a copy

of the document at no cost.

Deeds recorded prior to January 1, 1978 and recorded deeds utilizing social security numbers must be ordered in person or by written request to County Records. To search for documents recorded with Broward County Records, please visit County Records’ website and select your search criteria. Documents matching these criteria will be displayed and you can print a copy of the selected document. Broward County Records Division may be reached at 954-831-4000 should you need additional assistance.

The Liberal Jewish Temple of Coconut Creek A Reform Jewish Congregation Welcoming Everyone

- The area in its city where Jewish people lived, often under restrictions imposed by non-Jewish authorities.

- A poor urban area is occupied primarily by a minority group or groups. The earliest form of the Jewish ghetto can be traced back to medieval Europe, with the term “ghetto” most famously originating in Venice, Italy, in the early 16th century. However, the practice of confining Jewish communities to specific neighborhoods or quarters existed long before the word itself entered common use. In many medieval European cities, Jews were required to live in designated areas, often walled and locked at night. These early ghettos were established by local authorities who were influenced by religious, economic, and social factors.

In some cases, Church authorities insisted on the separation of Jews to prevent interaction with Christians, especially during periods of heightened religious fervor or during the Crusades. Economic restrictions were also imposed, limiting the professions Jews could pursue and confining their economic activities to within the ghetto walls. For example, Jews were often barred from owning land or joining craft guilds, pushing many into occupations such as moneylending or trade.

The first official “ghetto” was established in Venice in 1516. The Venetian authorities confined the city’s Jewish population to an island, the “Ghetto Nuovo,” which was surrounded by canals and accessible only by two bridges that were locked at night. The term “ghetto” itself is believed to derive from the Venetian word “geto,” meaning foundry, as the area where Jews were forced to live had previously housed a foundry. The Venetian ghetto became a model for other European cities, and the practice of confining Jews to specific neighborhoods spread throughout Italy and beyond.

Over the next two centuries, ghettos were established in cities such as Rome, Florence, and Prague. Each ghetto had its own characteristics, but they shared common features: physical barriers, restrictions on movement, and regulations governing daily life. In many cases, the walls of the ghetto symbolize not only physical separation but also social and cultural isolation. Jewish residents often faced overcrowding, poor sanitation, and limited opportunities. Despite these hardships, the ghettos also became centers of Jewish life, fostering vibrant communities with their own synagogues, schools, and communal organizations.

In Eastern Europe, while the term “ghetto” was not used as frequently until later periods, similar patterns of enforced segregation developed. Jewish quarters, known as “Jewish streets” or “Judenstrasse,” were found in cities throughout Poland, Lithuania, and Russia. These areas functioned similarly to the Western European ghettos, serving as both a refuge and a means of containment for Jewish populations.

The institution of the ghetto persisted in various forms until the 19th century, when many European countries began to grant Jews greater civil rights and dismantle the legal and physical barriers that had confined them. However, the legacy of the ghetto continued to shape Jewish life and identity, and the term would later take on new and tragic significance during World War II, when Nazi authorities established ghettos in occupied Eastern Europe as part of their campaign of persecution and genocide.

Master Gardener Speaks At Nature And Arts Club Breakfast

Master Gardener Mona Johnston spoke at the April breakfast meeting of the Nature and Arts Club. She specifically addressed small space gardening, as we at Wynmoor only have access to our lanais and elsewhere in our units for growing plants. In addition to recommending specific plants, she spoke about making use of “hardscape” items such as pots, trellises, and fountains as well as “softscape” items which include flowers, vines and other plants. Her presentation also taught us that Wynmoor used to be part of neighboring Fern Forest; that Florida has 3,000 native wildflowers, of which 448 are endangered and 118 are threatened; and that Florida has 120 native ferns, many of which are endangered. She encouraged Florida gardeners to choose Native species whenever possible, and to shop at garden centers with knowledgeable staff (hint...Home Depot and Lowes are not among them). One of Mona’s handouts included ideas for container gardening that could be appropriate for our homes here at Wynmoor, such as an herb tower, a tea pot, and a snack pot (see photo). Finally, she encouraged everyone to make use of the many ways to learn more about Florida’s plants and flowers, such as the library, bookstores and, of course, the internet.



Torah, Tradition... and Cheesecake!

Celebrate Shavuot

Ask anyone to name a Jewish holiday and chances are they will say Rosh Hashanah, Yom Kippur, Hanukkah, or Passover. But what about Shavuot? This year, the start of Shavuot falls on the eve of May 21st. We at Chabad of Coconut Creek, along with Jews all over the world, will be celebrating the holiday that commemorates perhaps the most monumental event in all of Jewish history: G_d's giving of the Torah to the Jewish people at Mount Sinai over 3000 years ago! Every year on Shavuot we renew our acceptance of G_d's great gift, as G_d "re-gifts" the Torah to us.

The word Shavuot means "weeks." It got its name because the holiday marks the end of 49 days—or 7 weeks—of counting, beginning on the second day of Passover. Just as a child might count the days until an upcoming birthday, we count days to show our excitement about receiving the Torah anew.

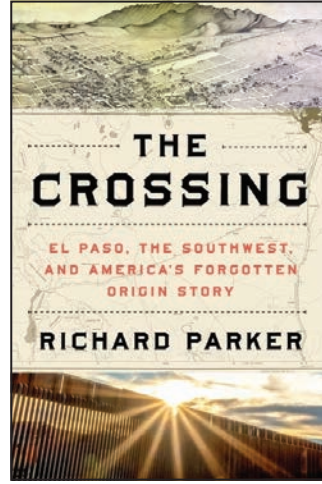
By Stephen King



Eight hundred and fifty pages is a serious commitment for any reader, I think. Stephen King is not an author I've enjoyed a lot in the past. And yet. I sank into this book, intrigued with the characters and eager to find out the next plot twist. Mr. King is known for horror, but this story involves time travel, from 2011 back to 1958 and forward to 1963. Jake Epping, a divorced teacher in a Maine high school, is asked to travel back fifty-three years and prevent the assassination of JFK, thereby erasing the Vietnam War from history. Of course, it's not that simple, and Jake needs to remember everything, including to not belt out a Rolling Stones song in 1961. Murder, love, and ill-advised gambling all ensue. And a lot more. Mr. King's knowing meta comments through the book add to the enjoyment. For example: "That's the curse of the reading class. We can be seduced by a good story even at the least opportune moments." I was seduced by his story and came up for air a week later, still thinking about his characters.

The Crossing

By Richard Parker



Richard Parker is a native of El Paso, Texas. This book is his love letter to that complex city, as well as a fascinating history of the USA's southwest, from the arrival of the first Spanish invaders in the sixteenth century up to the tragic mass killing of twenty-three people of Mexican appearance at a Walmart in 2019. Mr. Parker covers almost five hundred years of history, making a case that the history of the southwest is at least as relevant to understanding our complex national history as is the history of the eastern seaboard from colonial times to the present. Wars, development and profiteering, racial blending and racist violence; the author has many fascinating stories to tell. The scope of the book is sweeping, but I never got bored and I learned a lot. He ends with a plea for El Paso to secede from Texas and join New Mexico, because he believes that his vibrant city would fare better with Santa Fe as its capital rather than Austin.

A Source of Delight in Fort Lauderdale

A few months ago, I returned to the NSU Fort Lauderdale Art Museum in downtown Fort Lauderdale. This review is dedicated to the marvelous paintings and works of Art that I appreciated from the Goodman Collection on the Second Floor. The Goodman Collection specializes in paintings and works of Art produced by 20th Century painters and artists associated with Latin American Countries.

The Goodman Collection has delightful paintings produced by the giants of 20th Century Mexican Art including; Diego Rivera "Corn Seller," Jose Orozco "Grotesque Figures," David Alfaro Sigueros "Mother and Child," employed Duco Paint on Masonite, Rufino Tamayo "Doctor," Leonora Carrington "Artes 110," very surreal painting, she was born in England, but spent productive years in Mexico, and Carlos Merida "Fertility," born in Guatemala, but spent productive years in Mexico.

South American Paintings that I especially relished were Emilio Pettoruti's "The Poet's House, Open Door" (Argentine Abstract Painting), Joaquin Torres Garcia's "Railway Station" and "Tabac" (Uruguayan), Francisco Botero's "Self Portrait in Studio of Rembrandt" (Colombian), and Roberto Matta's "Prophet," a very Surreal Painting by this Chilean Master. I appreciated fine artistic creations by these South American Artists; Ignacio Itturia "Furniture With Giraffe and Airplane" (Uruguayan), Candido Portinari "Indians Carrying Pau," work made on Kraft Paper, (Brazilian), and Xul Solar "Mountains and Stairs," watercolor on paper, (Argentine).

In the Goodman Collection, I also saw impressive paintings by these Cuban Painters; Amelia Pelaez "Olympia" and Wilfredo Lam (untitled Abstract Paintings). As usual, I saw very impressive paintings produced by William Glackens from the NSU Art Museum's permanent collection. I especially enjoyed seeing the following paintings by Glackens again; "Cape Cod Pier" (awesome shadows), "Sledding Central Park, New York City," "Buddha and the Maidens," and "Coney Island Fruit Stand." Glackens in his younger days was associated with the Ash Can School and later on in his life with American Impressionism.

The curatorial work at the NSU Fort Lauderdale Art Museum is superb. This art museum is very aesthetically appealing.

Latest Scam Alerts, School Zone Speed Cameras Operational



A safe zone, a personal story, and speed cameras in school zones highlight this month's update:

SAFE ZONE

We put out this Scam Alert back on March 10th after someone swindled a man out of money when he tried to sell his watch:

A reminder that our lobby at 4800 West Copans Road is a Safe Zone to conduct face-to-face transactions is the basis for this Coconut Creek Police Department Scam Alert.

A man recently called us after he tried to sell a watch on Facebook Marketplace. The supposed "buyer" agreed to meet at a place that wasn't very crowded. Then buyer pulled the ole "switcheroo" with the man's family member. He switched an envelope full of the correct amount of cash to buy the watch with an envelope that contained far less. He walked away with the watch at a huge discount.

He might've tried to pull the same stunt if they had agreed to meet in our police department. But probably not. After all, it's open 24-7 and video monitored by our Real Time Crime Center.

So, the next time you're trying to buy or sell something online and need a place to meet for business, suggest our Safe Zone. If the other person makes every excuse in the world as to why he or she cannot meet in our lobby, then something's probably up.

PERSONAL STORY

This scam attempt happened to me on March 18th:

I usually write these Scam Alerts based on something that happened to one of you. This one is based off what happened to me.

I got a call on my cell phone from a number that had blocked the Caller ID. Not unusual. As the public information officer for a police department

and a fire rescue, my cell phone number is widely available. I talk to a lot of different people. I've probably given my number to many of you at a community meeting.

I answered.

The person on the other end claimed to be a sheriff's deputy. He even quoted me a badge number without me asking. He mispronounced my name, calling me "Lee-moan" instead of "Lee-mon."

Again, nothing unusual.

I asked how I could help him. He said I missed jury duty at 9 o'clock that morning and wanted to know why.

The call ended right there.

I never had jury duty. If I did, I would've been notified via mail. Not the kind that land in my email inbox. I mean the kind that I have to get out of the mailbox in front of my house.

I hung up on him.

The bad guys want to frighten you into running to the store and buying gift cards and then giving all the numbers on the cards to them. That way, they take control of the money.

No police department or sheriff's office would do anything like that.

So, if what happened to me happens to you, just hang up.

SCHOOL ZONE SPEED CAMERAS UP & RUNNING

School zone speed cameras are operational in the following locations:

- Cougar Trail (NW 15th Avenue) at Coconut Creek High School
- NW 39th Avenue at Winston Park Elementary School
- Johnson Road at Tradewinds Elementary School

A 60-day warning period at those locations ends on May 22nd. Drivers caught speeding through the school zones after that date will receive a \$100 citation in the mail. 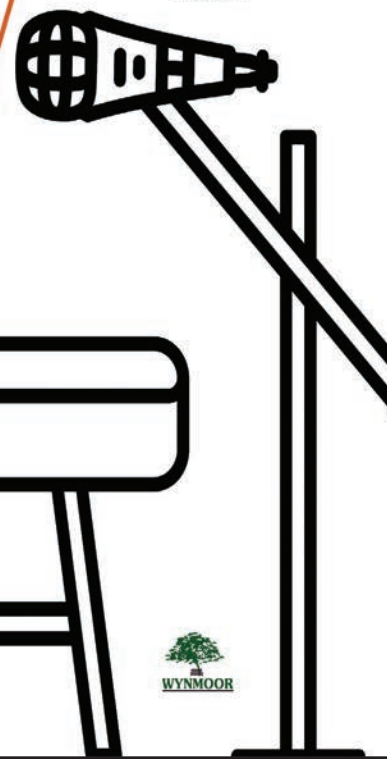

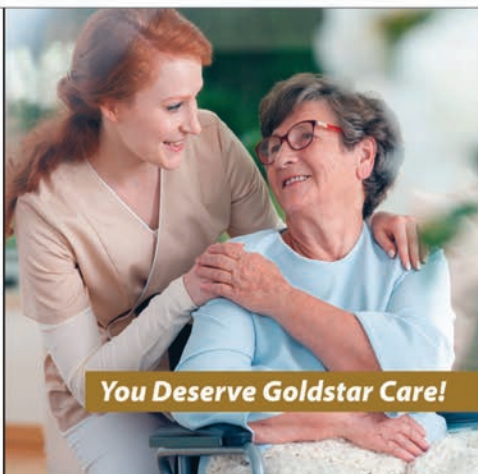

Revocable Living Trust Important For Out Of State Property

Are you a snowbird just leaving Florida? Some of my clients have their homestead in Florida; others declare their legal residence in another state.

In either case, a Revocable Living Trust is very useful to avoid probate in both states. If you are a Florida resident, you can own your homestead property via a Revocable Living Trust without losing your homestead exemption. In addition, you are eliminating the need for probate when you pass away. You can also transfer real estate owned in any other state to your Florida Trust. Generally, a Florida lawyer will prepare the Revocable Living Trust and Quit Claim Deed to transfer the Florida

property into the Trust. If you are a Florida resident, the lawyer will also prepare a new Florida Last Will and Testament called a Pourover Will. This provides for the transfer to your Trust upon your death of any other assets not in the Trust or which do not have beneficiaries already designated. It is a security blanket to cover any assets payable to your Estate. For example, if you were killed in a car accident due to the negligence of another driver, your Personal Representative would be able to settle your Estate's wrongful death claim and "pourover" the proceeds into your Trust.

If you are not a Florida resident, you can still create a Revocable Living Trust and execute a Quit Claim Deed to put your Florida property into the Trust. Your Last Will and Testament will be done by a lawyer in the state in which you have your legal residence. In addition, that lawyer can prepare a Deed to transfer the out of state property into the Florida Trust. You can also do the Trust in your state of residence and have a Florida lawyer transfer your Florida property to that Trust.

For Canadian citizens, there are possible tax aspects to be considered before you create a Florida Trust. These should be discussed with your Canadian



accountant or tax attorney. In general, you will have to weigh the tax consequences versus the money and time that your heirs would save by avoiding probate in Florida. To avoid tax issues, many Canadian citizens choose to do a Life Estate Deed (also known as Lady Bird).

Another favorable factor in creating a Revocable Living Trust is that you can always amend the Trust without having to change the Deed. In addition, once you create the Trust, you can always buy new properties in any state in the name of the Trust.

The Revocable Living Trust is recommended by most lawyers over a Deed which includes names of other persons, either as joint tenants, tenants in common or a Life Estate Deed. Once another person's name is on a Deed, there are potential risks to you and your property. These include the possibility that the other person may undergo a divorce, bankruptcy, have a judgment against that person, or die before you or with you in a common accident. It may also affect your homestead exemption. All of these risks should be discussed with your attorney before deciding to put someone else's name on your Deed. By contrast, the Revocable Living Trust eliminates those risks, since no other name is on the Deed. You simply transfer it from yourself to yourself as Trustee of your Trust.

This article covers only some basics regarding Revocable Living Trusts and Deeds. For further information, please feel free to contact me.
