# From the President



This year, 2026, marks the 50th anniversary of the founding of Wynmoor Condominium in Coconut Creek. Wynmoor was a unique endeavor from the very beginning, and it has truly stood the test of time — not only because of its founding documents, but because of the people who chose to make this community their home.

Living successfully in any community, especially a condominium community, requires respect, courtesy, and consideration for one another. We encourage all residents to respect shared spaces by keeping common areas clean and using them thoughtfully. Residents should communicate openly and address concerns politely and directly to help avoid misunderstandings. It is also important to follow rules and regulations regarding noise, parking, service and support animals, and other shared policies.

Practicing courtesy is essential. Residents should be mindful of noise levels, especially during early morning and late evenings. Participation in community activities, meetings, and social events helps build rapport and strengthen community spirit. Public meetings should always remain respectful places where differences of opinion and complaints can be expressed without name-calling or inappropriate rhetoric.

Conflicts should be approached calmly, respectfully, and with a solution-oriented mindset. Residents are encouraged to respect privacy by avoiding intrusive behavior and honoring their neighbors' personal space. Everyone should share responsibility whenever possible for the upkeep, cleanliness, and security of common areas.

All council employees and volunteers deserve to be treated with dignity, courtesy, and respect at all times. Residents should also be considerate with parking and deliveries, avoiding blocked access or unnecessary inconvenience to others. Contractors and repair personnel should be advised of association rules, including permit requirements and approved working hours.

Finally, we encourage all residents to help create a friendly environment. Simple greetings, kindness, and neighborly consideration go a long way toward fostering a welcoming and positive community atmosphere.

At the May 18, 2026 FDOT virtual public meeting, and in person meeting

on May 19th, engineers presented the final design for the Florida's Turnpike interchange at Coconut Creek Parkway / MLK Jr. Blvd near Milepost 67, the area that directly serves traffic around Wynmoor in Coconut Creek. The project involves a full reconstruction of the interchange ramps to modernize an older, tightly spaced design that has become congested and crash-prone. The new design replaces the existing ramps with longer, smoother curves and wider roadways to improve how vehicles enter and exit the Turnpike. A key focus is extending acceleration and deceleration lanes so drivers have more distance to safely match highway speeds before merging or slowing down, which reduces sudden braking and weaving near the mainline. FDOT also adjusted the ramp alignment at the points where they connect to Coconut Creek Parkway, improving visibility, turning radius, and signal operations at the surface intersections. In addition to the interchange rebuild, the project is coordinated with a broader Turnpike widening effort between Atlantic Boulevard and Sample Road, which adds capacity through the corridor and includes auxiliary lanes to help separate entering and exiting traffic from through traffic. Safety improvements are a major part of the design, targeting known crash points by reducing conflict areas where vehicles cross paths and improving lighting, signage, and lane guidance at ramp terminals. Overall, the project is intended to improve traffic flow through this heavily traveled section of central Broward County while reducing congestion backups that currently spill onto nearby roads like Coconut Creek Parkway, Lyons Road, and Atlantic Boulevard, which directly affects residents and traffic patterns around Wynmoor.

I don't know how many times I can say this, but it is so important: please stay vigilant and aware of the many scams that exist today.

If you ever receive a phone call, email, text message, or any request for personal or financial information, do not act immediately. Contact a trusted family member, friend, neighbor, or advisor if you are unsure, or contact the Coconut Creek Police Department before taking any action.

Scams come in many shapes and forms, and criminals are constantly

developing new ways to target unsuspecting individuals. They may impersonate government agencies, financial institutions, utility companies, family members, or even law enforcement officers in an attempt to gain access to your personal information or money.

Remember, if something seems suspicious, unexpected, or too good to be true, it usually is. Please take a moment to verify the information through a trusted source before responding. Never feel pressured to provide personal information, send money, purchase gift cards, or click on unfamiliar links.

A few minutes of caution can help prevent financial loss, identity theft, and other serious consequences.

## Please also be aware of Deed Fraud It's Real, don't be a Victim.

Please note that deed fraud is a very real and growing concern. Don't become a victim. Deed fraud occurs when a property deed or title transfer is executed and recorded illegally without the authorization or knowledge of the rightful property owner. Criminals may record fraudulent deeds transferring ownership of a property and then attempt to mortgage, sell, or rent it.

To help protect property owners, the Broward County Property Appraiser offers a free service called Owner Alert. This service notifies you if a deed or other document affecting ownership of your property has been received for recording. For more information, please visit: <https://web.bcpa.net/owneralert>

Please share this reminder with your family, friends, and neighbors. The more informed we are, the better protected our community will be.

Stay informed, stay alert, and help protect yourself and others from becoming victims of fraud.

Don't let your favorite moments get lost in the digital clutter. Use this summer's heatwave as an excuse to preserve your legacy—one album at a time.

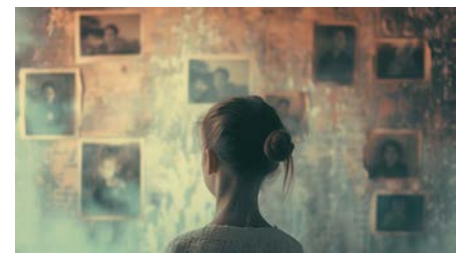
Once you have mastered this, invite some friends over and share your knowledge, share your photos, have some fun and chase those summer blues away.

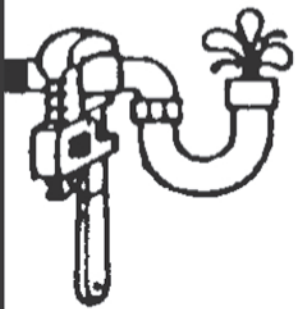

Gus facilitated in the off season and I during season. We were a great team. Gus died a few years later and I was the leader. Next Patrick O'Brien, our friend, offered to co-facilitate with me. We have become special friends, sharing our thoughts, words, heart, and style of leadership. Each Saturday is so enjoyable.

A few months ago, Pat discovered the archives highlighting many pieces

from earlier times. We decided to end this practice as many of the members began writing digitally. We're saving trees and others holding onto copies that they wouldn't read again.

I offered to organize this project. If a member is still present in group, we'll return their work. For those that aren't here, we'll destroy them by shredding or cutting them into little pieces. As I began the process, I'd look at the names. Immediately, memories flooded my mind. I could picture these authors and see them reading their work. I decided to reread some of them, amazed to see the talent and diversity of the creators, I kept a few and will use them as prompts for my future work.

During COVID, we kept the group active by having zoom sessions each Saturday. This created a very intimate group and encouraged our creative minds to not let this interruption effect our meetings. Some have moved; others have died or not returned to Wynmoor bringing us to our present group. New members bring new energy, and the writing just keeps getting better and better. In fact, we have included once a month zoom sessions because our snowbirds didn't want to miss anything while away. Some technology is a good thing.

Writers' Workshop is enhanced by all of our participants. Some have gone on to publish their work, while, others like to submit their copy to THE INSIDER, and the third just likes writing for the group. This club has existed long before I came, and we hope to have it do so for many more years. Whether you are new to writing or an author forever, we're here for you. 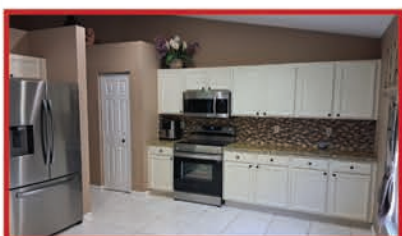

# An Illuminating Visit To The Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural Site in Buffalo

A few months ago, I visited Buffalo, New York, the “City of Light.” I spent 2 delightful hours at the Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural Historic Site on Delaware Avenue. This building was originally the home and mansion of Buffalo Lawyer, Ansley Wilcox and his wife, Grace. Wilcox also was a pioneer in Civil Service Reform.

In 1901, Buffalo held the Pan American Exposition in Delaware Park which showcased the use of Hydroelectric Power and the use of that power to produce electric light in our American Cities, especially in Buffalo. President William McKinley attended the Pan American Exposition and supported this international exposition. President William McKinley was shot by an anarchist and eventually died from the wounds at a reception, during this exposition.

Upon President McKinley’s death, Theodore Roosevelt arrived in Buffalo from an Adirondack Holiday to be inaugurated as the 26th President of the United States, in the library of Ansley Wilcox. Wilcox was a close friend of Theodore Roosevelt and the inaugural ceremony was serene and very simple. Theodore Roosevelt believed “in speaking softly and carrying a big stick,” that was his motto.

During my visit at this nationally historic site, I had an excellent guide who disseminated a plethora of pertinent information about the city of Buffalo in the early 20th Century and its prosperous economy in that period of time. I also learned about the Pan American Exposition and I saw numerous photographs of the Pan American Exposition at this site and of the resplendent electric evening lights at this exposition. The only building that remains from this exposition is currently used as the Museum of Buffalo History which I have visited twice.

To add a bit of levity to this review, I posed for a picture in the Wilcox Library with a few fellow visitors from the Cleveland area and the museum staff. I was portrayed as President Isaac in the “Buffalo News.”

After I left the Theodore Roosevelt Inaugural Historic Site, I walked over to the Anchor Sports Bar on Main Street to enjoy Buffalo Boneless Chicken Wings with chipotle barbecued sauce, celery, and blue cheese sauce. The Anchor Sports Bar in Buffalo was the birthplace of buffalo chicken wings.

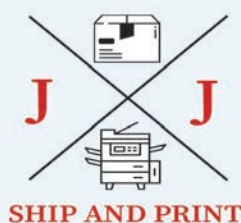

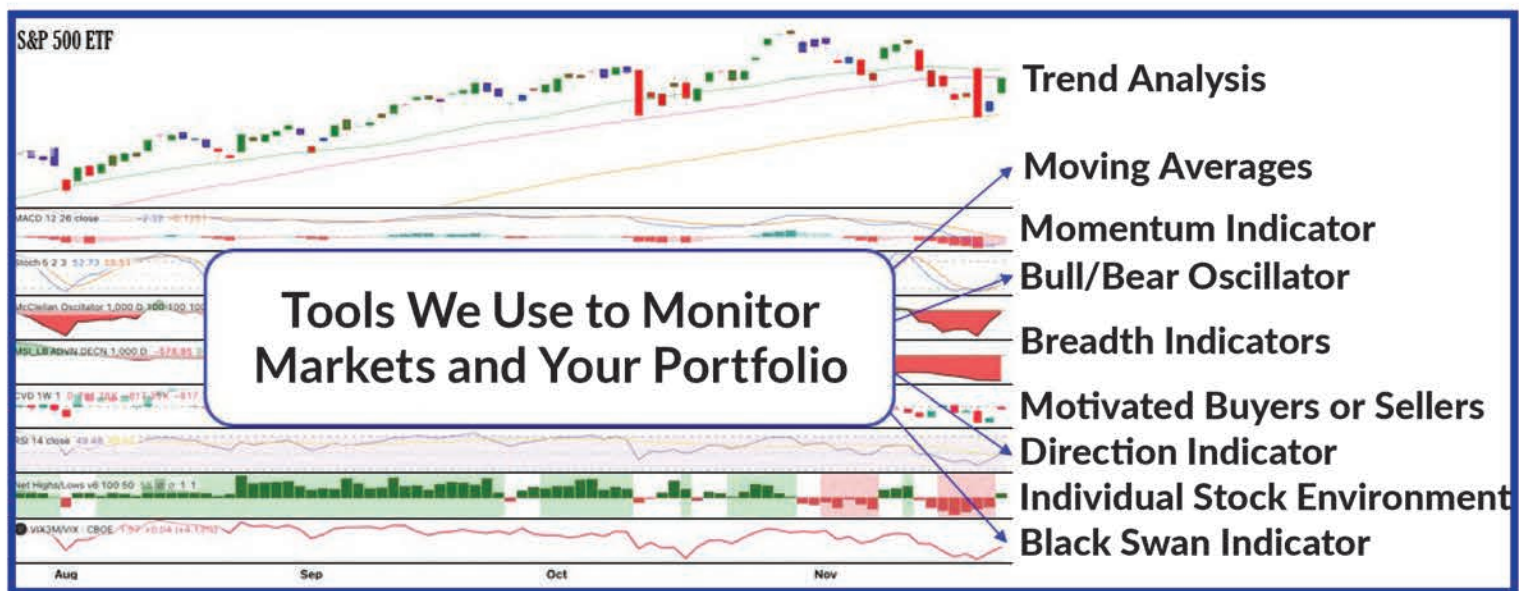

# Wynmoor's Plants of the month

## Society Garlic

Society Garlic (*Tulbaghia violacea*) is a fast-growing, highly durable perennial herb native to the rocky grasslands of South Africa. The plant is actually edible and will give off a noticeable garlic scent especially when the leaves are crushed. It earned the name "Society Garlic" from the historical belief that it offers a mild garlic flavor without causing long-lasting bad breath. It has attractive lavender flowers and that loves full sun and while it can tolerate some shade, the flower production will significantly decrease if the conditions are too shady. It is highly drought tolerant as well and may yellow out a bit if the soil is too soggy. Perhaps the best attribute of the plant is that the garlic odor repels pests including Iguanas that do not like the taste of it at all!



## Dwarf Yellow Mussaenda



Dwarf Yellow Mussaenda, (*Mussaenda glabra*) is a delicate tropical evergreen shrub belonging to the coffee family (Rubiaceae) native to India and southeast Asia. It is highly prized in subtropical landscaping for its unique, luminous floral display where small, star-shaped yellow flowers are beautifully contrasted by enlarged, pale yellow leaf-like sepals. While it is a dwarf variety it can reach up to 5-6 feet if left unpruned. The best practice to keep it pruned tight to 3-4' which will encourage more of the showy yellow blooms. A great addition to a full sun area for nice pop of color!

## Green Island Ficus



Green Island Ficus (*Ficus microcarpa* 'Green Island') originally native to the tropics of Asia and the west Pacific islands, is a highly popular, low-maintenance evergreen shrub celebrated for its thick, glossy, rounded leaves and extremely well-behaved growth habit. Unlike traditional Ficus varieties known for aggressive, destructive root systems, the Green Island variety features "friendly" non-invasive roots, making it safe for walkways, foundations, and modern residential landscaping. Like all Ficus it has a milky sap but has few pests and makes a great intermediate border. It naturally wants to grow wider than taller so that can be kept at varying heights, usually around 3 feet. It is exceptionally versatile, thriving in full direct sun to partial shade, though brighter light produces denser foliage. This is a great plant for uses in many bed areas that has become a staple of the South Florida landscape.

# The Art of Argument in Jewish Tradition

July 2, or the 17th of the Hebrew month of Tammuz, is a minor fast day that marks the start of The Three Weeks of mourning for Jews around the world. The climax and culmination of this mourning period is the fast day of Tisha B'Av, falling this year on the eve of July 22nd through sundown July 23rd. Tisha B'Av is the saddest day on the Jewish calendar—and rightly so. In 1313 BCE, the spies returned from the Promised Land with frightening reports and predictions filled with doom and gloom. When the Israelites were hesitant to enter the land, G-d decreed that they would wander in the desert for the next 40 years. The Bar Kochba revolt against the Romans ended on Tisha B'Av; the Jews of Betar were murdered on that day. It was on Tisha B'Av in 1290, that Jews were expelled from England; in 1492, they were expelled from Spain. The mass deportation of Jews from the Warsaw Ghetto to Treblinka occurred on Tisha B'Av in 1942. While these are all terrible tragedies that befell Jews, by far the most painful and impactful loss on Tisha B'Av was the destruction of both Holy Temples—the first at the hands of the Babylonians in 423 BCE; the second, by the Romans, in 69 CE.

On Tisha B'Av we don't eat or drink, wear leather shoes or bright, festive clothing. We don't bathe, apply lotions or perfumes, greet each other, send gifts, or sit on regular-height chairs. It is a day where we sit (on low seats) with our grief. We feel the sadness and the pain of our exile and long-suffering of our people, as we listen to the mournful melodies of the Book of Lamentations.

Yet, it is not in our nature—or our best interest—to linger in that sadness. Within our mourning there is a great opportunity we must not squander. It is true we feel deeply the loss of the Temples, but it is exactly on Tisha B'Av that the construction of the third Temple can begin. When we cry over the loss of a tangible relationship with G-d, we can use that potent energy of longing to help bring about redemption. That is why Rabbi Akiva laughed when he walked by the lost Temple. He was able to see the seeds of rebuilding planted within the destruction—and rejoice.

The only ones forestalling the completion this Divine project is us. Tisha B'Av presents the perfect moment to move beyond everything that has been holding back our growth and closeness to Hashem. This Tisha B'Av, let's use the promise lying deep within our sadness to reach towards our own potential—and towards the joyous goal of ending our exile.

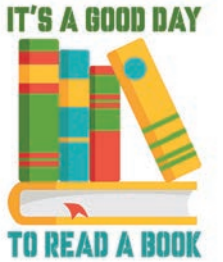

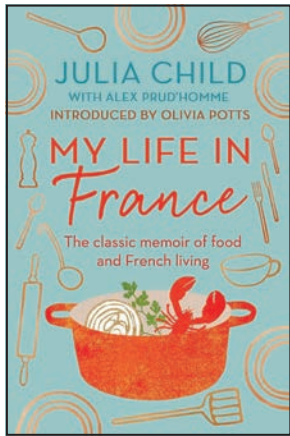
# book review

Julia Child

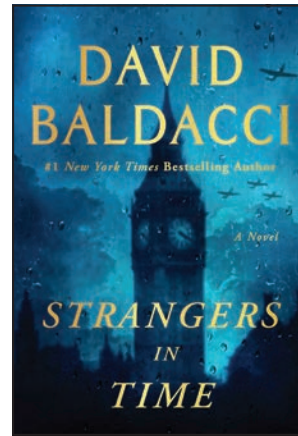


Halfway through reading this book I decided to order my own copy of Mastering the Art of French Cooking from Amazon and try some recipes. By the end of the book, I had changed my mind. Not that I didn't enjoy it all the way through the epilogue. I just got a little worn out with the sheer number of rich, exquisite meals described and consumed. The amount of meat eaten took my breath away. At the same time, Ms. Child's descriptions of the development of her passion for French cuisine and her passionate efforts to learn the techniques of creating it were inspiring. I just won't be bothering anytime soon to make a veal stock, stuff the veal with foie gras, Cognac, mushroom duxelles, and chard leaves, wrap it, refrigerate it, poach it and serve it with a truffled Madeira sauce.

## Strangers in Time

David Baldacci



I didn't understand the meaning of this book's title. I did think that it was an awfully good story about characters caught in the second London Blitz of 1944. Ignatius Ollvier owns a bookstore that he inherited from his wife. He becomes involved with Molly, recently returned from the country after her departure in 1939 as part of Operation Pied Piper, and with Charlie Matters (that's a name I love.) Molly is just sixteen and a resident of upper-class Chelsea. Charley is from the East End, not yet fourteen, orphaned and living by his wits in war-torn London. Not everyone was patriotic or even

law abiding in the city at that time, and all three characters suffered from this fact. And then there is the Blitz. The author's vivid descriptions of life under bombardment and survival in the destroyed landscape between the attacks ring true. The plot twists about, fooling the reader a few times but staying believable in its depictions of human motivation. There's just that title: if you read this book by the prolific Mr. Baldacci and figure it out, please let me know.

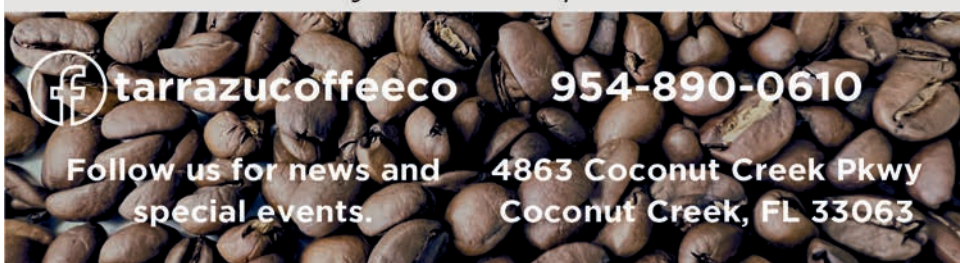

# What To Do When Your Spouse Or Partner Dies

Losing your spouse, partner or significant other is a very traumatic event. It is most important for your physical and emotional health to give yourself time for the grieving process.

Once you feel mentally and emotionally able to do so, you should schedule an appointment with an attorney to review all legal documents.

You should bring your Will and/or Revocable Living Trust, Deed to your home and any other real estate, certified copy of the death certificate and, if married, date of your marriage. If you have advanced care directives such as a Living Will, Durable Power of Attorney and Designation of Health Care Surrogate, you should bring those as well.

If your spouse or partner owned something in their name alone with no designated beneficiary, probate may be necessary. Bring details of such assets to the appointment.

If everything you owned was in both names, it is not necessary to probate the Will. However, regarding your home, and any other real estate, it is important to "Clear the Title." The lawyer will prepare and have you sign a "Continuous Marriage Affidavit," which is why you need the date of your marriage. The Affidavit will state that you were married on a certain date and remained continuously married without divorce until the date of death. It will provide the legal description of your home and other real estate and indicate your intention to clear title. This document will be recorded, along with an Affidavit of No Florida Estate Tax Due and the Death Certificate without the cause of death. Recording these documents will clear title and allow you the option to do a new Deed to avoid probate when you die. If you were not married but owned your home (or any other property) jointly, it is still important to clear title. Of course, a Continuous Marriage Affidavit will not be necessary.

If you do not have a Revocable Living Trust, this appointment will be



a good opportunity to discuss the creation of a Trust and preparation of a Deed in order to avoid probate on your home and other real estate. You can also discuss the option of a Life Estate Deed (also known as Lady Bird) to avoid probate.

If you do have a Trust, this may be an appropriate time to consider doing an Amendment to the Trust based on new circumstances. Your home and other real estate (in Florida and out-of-state) should be owned by you as Trustee of the Trust. You may wish to name one of your children as Co-Trustee to make it easier to manage the assets in your Trust if you become incapacitated. You may also wish to make changes in your Living Will, Durable Power of Attorney and Designation of Health

Care Surrogate or create those documents if you do not have them.

In most cases, there is no urgency to contact an attorney. It is much better to have peace of mind and clarity. Some lawyers, including myself, will offer a free consultation. This consultation should include your options and give you the opportunity to sleep on it before finalizing any new legal documents. In addition, when you are ready, there are actions you should take for which you do not need an attorney. This includes rolling over your spouse's IRA to yours, claiming life insurance benefits and naming beneficiaries on any joint accounts. If you have individual accounts or life insurance and your spouse is beneficiary, be sure to change it. However, your lawyer can advise you on these matters.

If you are going through the loss of a loved one, my prayers are with you.

When I was growing up, I don't think I ever saw a pomegranate, except in books. I certainly never tasted one. Olive oil was used in salad dressing, not for cooking. Fast forward to today and these are staples in my kitchen.

The Torah and the Bible are rich with symbolism and stories that frequently feature fruits, reflecting the agrarian lifestyles and spiritual significance of food in ancient times. Many of these fruits, described thousands of years ago, remain staples of diets worldwide today, connecting us to the past in tangible ways. In this article, we explore some of the most prominent fruits mentioned in these sacred texts and their availability in the modern era.

One of the most emblematic fruits in the Bible is the olive. The olive tree is often mentioned as a symbol of peace, prosperity, and divine blessing. Though apples are not explicitly named as the fruit in the Garden of Eden, they have often been associated with the story of the forbidden fruit. Apples are mentioned in the Song of Solomon as a symbol of love and beauty.

In the modern world, apples are universally available, with thousands of varieties grown globally. They are a staple in lunches, desserts, and beverages, and their symbolism continues to resonate, making them an enduring favorite. It is a tradition to dip apples into honey on Rosh Hashanah to ensure a sweet year.

# The Psychology Behind Scams

*"How could anyone fall for that?!"*

That's often our first reaction when we hear about the latest scam. Yet every year, millions of people worldwide lose billions of dollars to fraud. Scams can happen to anyone, regardless of age, education, income, or background. Intelligence and education do not provide immunity against scams.

Young adults are frequently targeted through social media platforms with fraudulent cryptocurrency investments, fake online stores, and work-from-home job scams. Busy professionals, including physicians and executives, are often targeted with investment fraud because scammers know they may have limited time to thoroughly investigate opportunities.

Individuals seeking companionship or lacking strong social support networks are particularly vulnerable to romance scams. Those facing financial hardship may be targeted with fraudulent debt relief, loan forgiveness, or get-rich-quick schemes. Seniors and their life savings are frequently targeted through government impersonation scams, fake sweepstakes, lottery fraud, and bogus charities.

Families trying to buy a pet can be deceived into paying for pets that don't even exist. Phony veterinary clinics falsely claim to have found a lost pet and then demand immediate payment for emergency life-saving surgery.

Scammers succeed not because victims are foolish, but because fraudsters are experts at psychological manipulation. They understand human nature and exploit normal emotions such as fear, trust, empathy, hope, and the desire for social connection. They also target people experiencing loneliness, grief, relationship breakdowns, job loss, financial stress, or other major life transitions.

## Romance Scams and the Loneliness Crisis

Among the many forms of fraud, romance scams are particularly devastating because they exploit one of our most fundamental human needs: connection.

A scammer creates a fake online identity and develops what appears to be a genuine relationship with the target. Over weeks, months, or even years, they build trust, intimacy, and emotional dependence. Eventually, they introduce a crisis, emergency, or investment opportunity and ask for money.

The emotional damage often exceeds the financial loss. Victims lose not only money but also what they believed was a meaningful relationship.

The growth of romance scams parallels society's loneliness crisis. Despite being digitally connected, many people report feeling increasingly isolated. Widowhood, divorce, remote work, and declining community engagement have left many searching for companionship.

Scammers offer attention, affection, validation, and understanding. The relationship feels real because the victim genuinely experiences attachment, trust, and hope. This helps explain why some victims continue to believe the scammer even when family members present evidence of fraud. Victims are not simply evaluating facts; they are protecting an emotional bond. Breaking free often requires overcoming grief as well as deception.

## Why Smart People Fall for Scams

One of the greatest misconceptions about scams is that victims lack intelligence. In reality, intelligence alone offers limited protection against manipulation.

Scammers rarely rely on logic. Instead, they bypass critical thinking by triggering emotions and exploiting mental shortcuts known as cognitive biases. In everyday life, mental shortcuts help us make timely decisions, but skilled scammers know how to turn these shortcuts against us.

## Psychological Tactics Scammers Use

**Fear and Urgency.** A scammer may claim your computer, phone or bank account have been compromised, police have a warrant for your arrest, or a loved one is in danger. Fear narrows attention and triggers quick decision-making. Scammers try to create panic before you have time to verify the facts.

**Truth Bias.** Most people assume others are telling the truth. Society depends on this trust. Scammers exploit this tendency by posing as trustworthy professionals, government officials, customer service representatives, or romantic partners.

**Authority Bias.** People are more likely to comply with requests from perceived authority figures. A scammer posing as a police officer, IRS agent, Social Security representative, banker, or company executive gains instant credibility simply through the appearance of authority.

**Reciprocity Bias.** Humans naturally want to return favors. Scammers often provide emotional support, advice, or apparent kindness before asking for money or assistance. Romance scammers are particularly skilled at creating a sense of obligation.

**Cognitive Dissonance.** When people invest significant time, money, or emotion into a relationship or opportunity, it becomes psychologically painful to accept that it may be fraudulent. To reduce this discomfort, victims may unconsciously rationalize warning signs rather than confront them.

**Social Proof.** People often look to others when deciding what to trust. Scammers exploit this tendency through fake testimonials, fabricated reviews, and invented success stories designed to create the illusion that others have benefited.

**Fear of Missing Out (FOMO).** Investment and cryptocurrency scams frequently use scarcity and exclusivity. Victims are told that a rare opportunity is about to disappear or that while they hesitate, others are becoming wealthy. The fear of missing out can override caution and encourage impulsive decisions.

## Biases That Make Us Vulnerable

**Overconfidence Bias.** Many people believe they are too smart to be scammed. Ironically, this confidence can reduce vigilance and make warning signs easier to overlook.

**Loss Aversion.** People feel losses more intensely than gains. Once victims have invested money, time, or emotion, they often continue investing in hopes of recovering what has already been lost.

**Illusion of Control.** People frequently overestimate their ability to control situations. Victims may believe they can manage the relationship, monitor the investment, or detect fraud before serious harm occurs.

**The Ostrich Effect.** When evidence suggests a scam, some victims avoid confronting unpleasant information. They may ignore warnings, avoid reviewing financial records, or dismiss contradictory evidence because the truth feels emotionally overwhelming.

# Important News For New Homeowners

When buying/acquiring real estate, do **not** assume the property taxes will remain the same as the current owner's taxes. Under Florida law, a change in ownership requires the property to be reassessed at current full market value the year following the change of ownership OR if a Homestead Exemption is added/removed from the property. This reassessment could result in higher property taxes for the new owner than what the seller was paying. Please use our Tax Estimator available online to approximate **your** new property taxes **based on the reassessed value**.

If you are moving to a new home and have held a Homestead Exemption anywhere within Florida during the past three tax years, you may be eligible to transfer your Save Our Homes (SOH) benefit to your new home to help lower the property's assessed value and subsequent taxes. The Portability Estimator available online helps you approximate what your new property taxes will be using any portability you may be transferring from another property.

The Property Appraiser **does not** set or collect taxes. Tax rates/fees are set by individual taxing authorities each year based on their budgetary needs. 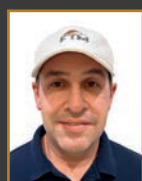

# Safety Solutions

## Scammers Will Meet You Face-To-Face



Gone are the days when crime prevention guys like me only worried about scam phone calls from overseas.

We're starting to see more and more cases of victims meeting their scammers face-to-face.

The bad guys try to get their hooks into you using a variety of different methods.

We've seen fraudsters pretend to be from the victim's bank. They tell them their bank card is compromised and that they're sending a representative from the bank to the victim's door to pick up the "bad" card. Of course, there's nothing actually wrong with the victim's bank card. Until they had it over to the scammer face-to-face of course.

We've seen prize winner scams where you're all the sudden the "grand prize winner" of some contest you don't even remember entering. In order to get your money, you have to come up with a few thousand dollars up front. "Taxes" or "fees" the bad guys might say. They'll arrange for courier to meet you at your bank, or in some parking lot, after you withdraw the money.

The face-to-face meeting with scam artists is starting to become more prevalent and it's both worrying, and an opportunity.

Since the scammer is not sitting in a condo near the beach in South America, there are better opportunities to crack these fraud networks and make arrests.

At the same time, it's concerning because, face-to-face, these con artists are even more apt to gain the victim's trust. Plus, what happens if this in-

person meeting goes bad? Is potential violence a possibility? It's something to consider if you're thinking about meeting a complete stranger somewhere face-to-face.

The best crime prevention tool to use in these cases is patience.

If the fraudster is posing as a bank agent and trying to get you to hand your card over to them, why not buy some time? Stop and think. Have I noticed anything weird with my card? Why don't I drive to my closest branch and ask them? Could this be a good time to call my son, or daughter, or trusted friend and go over what's happening with them?

If you're suddenly the winner of some lottery you can't remember entering. Take a moment and ask yourself, "Is this too good to be true?"

The bad guys want you to act immediately. Whether it be out of fear, excitement, or some other emotion, they don't want you to stop and think. They want you to go.

Sometimes the best thing to do in those moments is slow yourself down. What's going on here? Could they be taking advantage of me? Is there more to this than meets the eye?

The bottom line is that if a fraudster has convinced you into taking an in-person meeting then we've already lost.

To win more of these battles against the scam artists we need your help to be aware. Slow down. Don't let them scare you. Don't fall for promises of big money or prizes. Stop the rollercoaster ride before it starts.

The best way to avoid a face-to-face meeting with a scammer is to never show up.

# The Psychology Behind Scams

## Recognizing the Red Flags

**High Pressure and Secrecy.** Claims such as “Act now,” “Your account will be suspended,” or “You will be arrested” are designed to create panic. Requests to keep transactions secret from family members, banks, or financial advisors are major warning signs.

**Unusual Payment Requests.** Legitimate businesses and government agencies never demand payment through gift cards or cryptocurrency. Requests for wire transfers, cash deliveries, or other difficult-to-trace payments are classic indicators of fraud.

**Too Good to Be True.** Winning a Lottery you don’t recall entering. Guaranteed high investment returns with little or no risk. Unclaimed inheritance or forgotten funds. If it sounds too good to be true, it usually is.

## Protecting Yourself

Artificial Intelligence technology, deep fakes, voice cloning, and spoofed caller-ids and e-mail addresses have given scammers powerful tools to steal your money. Not answering unknown phone calls and not clicking links or unsolicited e-mails and texts, are proven protections. Also, three simple habits can dramatically reduce your risk.

**1. Pause.** If someone says you MUST act immediately, DON’T! Ask them to call back later or take their number. Use the time to think clearly and consult with relatives, friends, or one of the numbers below.

**2. Investigate.** Verify claims independently. Contact organizations using official phone numbers and website.

**3. Protect Your Information.** Never share passwords, Social Security numbers, banking information, or verification codes with unverified individuals.

## If Someone You Know Is Being Scammed

Avoid shaming, ridiculing or criticizing them. You don’t want to make the victim defensive and more attached to the scammer.

Instead, ask open-ended questions: “How did you verify this person’s identity?”, “What would convince you that something is wrong?” Acknowledge that the relationship, trust, or hope they experienced felt real to them, which increases the likelihood that they will listen to you.

Focus on behaviors rather than beliefs. Rather than merely declaring that the scammer is fake, discuss specific actions such as requests for money, secrecy, urgency, or repeated emergencies. This approach helps victims evaluate evidence independently.

## Recovering from the Trauma of Being Scammed

Being scammed is not merely a financial loss; it can be a profound emotional trauma. Victims often experience shame, anger, grief, anxiety, depression, and loss of trust.

Recovery begins by recognizing that manipulation, not stupidity, made the scam possible. Seeking support from trusted friends, family members, support groups, or mental health professionals can help people process the experience.

Perhaps most importantly, victims should talk about what happened. Shame keeps people silent, while open discussion helps others recognize warning signs and protects future victims.

It is not true that only naïve people get scammed. Nobody is immune. All human beings possess psychological vulnerabilities that can be exploited under the right circumstances. Being deceived by a skilled manipulator is not a sign of low intelligence, competence, or worth.

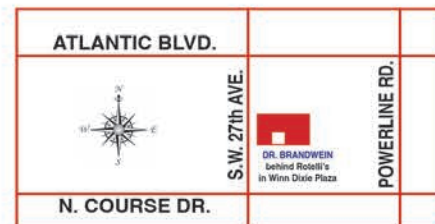

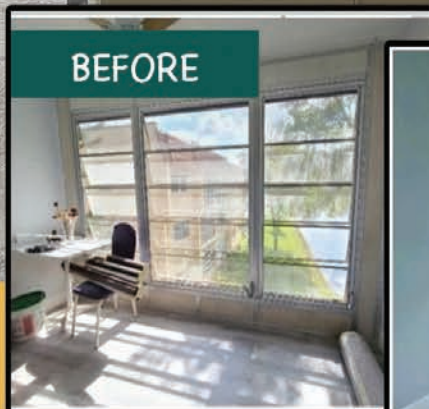

## BSO: Protecting the County's Critical Infrastructure

The Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) mission extends far beyond any single jurisdiction, municipality or neighborhood. For decades, BSO has safeguarded some of Broward County's most critical facilities. From Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport and Port Everglades to the Broward County Courthouse, our highly trained professionals protect the infrastructure that millions of residents, visitors and businesses rely on every day.

At Fort Lauderdale-Hollywood International Airport (FLL), BSO personnel operate around the clock to protect one of the busiest airports in the nation. Managing the safety of more than 37 million annual passengers requires precision, readiness and excellent coordination. Aside from routine patrols, five specialized units work together to respond to threats, investigate criminal activity and ensure the safe flow of people in and out of the airport. These units include Criminal Investigations, the Airport Community Team, Traffic Unit, Explosive Detection Canine Unit and the Incident Containment Team.

At Port Everglades, the nation's 3rd busiest port in the world, BSO plays a vital role in protecting this hub for international trade, energy distribution and the global cruise industry. Deputies conduct high-visibility maritime harbor patrols and respond to emergencies. They also manage the Port Security Operations Center and Port Identification Office, issuing and monitoring more than 8,000 port credentials each year while supporting the movement of more than four million cruise passengers.

BSO's Court Services ensures the safe and uninterrupted operation of the



county's judicial system across the main Central Courthouse and three regional courthouses. While ensuring a safe and secure operation for thousands of employees and visitors each day, our deputies also support the movement of inmates while protecting court personnel and maintaining order throughout daily proceedings. BSO courthouse staff serve as a bridge between law enforcement operations, detention facilities and the judiciary.

Across each facility, BSO personnel assigned to these locations participate in specialized training, including full-scale active assailant, threat response and emergency exercises tailored to the unique needs and challenges of the respective locations. In addition, BSO deploys Threat

Intervention Tactics Analytics Network (TITAN) personnel to these critical infrastructure sites. This highly trained team provides rapid operational support during critical incidents and emergency situations while maintaining a visible tactical presence in areas identified as vulnerable.

The airport, seaport and courthouses are not simply buildings or facilities, they are essential components of Broward County's transportation, economy and government operations network. From protecting vital transportation hubs to supporting the administration of justice, we are committed to delivering exceptional service while focusing on safeguarding all of Broward County.

# Sargasso Seaweed, The Good, The Bad and The Stinky

The seaweed that is invading our SoFlo beaches this summer will be one for the record books due to increasing ocean surface temperatures and favorable currents.

This seaweed gets its name from the Sargasso Sea where it originates and moves across the Atlantic driven by the currents and wind.

An aerial view of Sargasso seaweed looks like a brown mat or raft as it travels to our shores. It is so large and dense that it forms its own ecosystem,



benefiting many species of fish and birds. Sports fishing vessels follow the weed line as they know it holds many game fish.

However, as this seaweed makes its way to shore, it is bad news for swimming and surf fishing as it makes for difficult swimming and fishing.

Once the seaweed piles up on the beach, it begins to rot, giving off an obnoxious odor.

Most beaches along the SoFlo coastline have a plan in place that requires heavy equipment to pile up and then bury the seaweed in the sand. This process allows the seaweed to rot without the stink and helps prevent beach erosion.

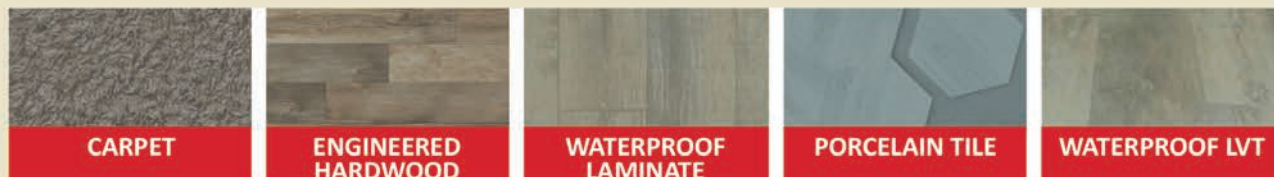

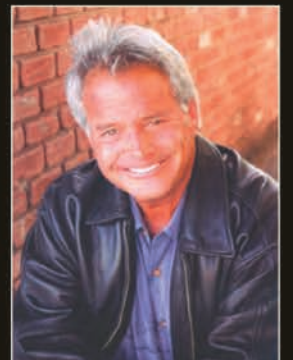
