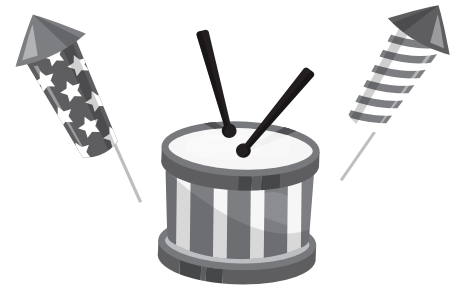

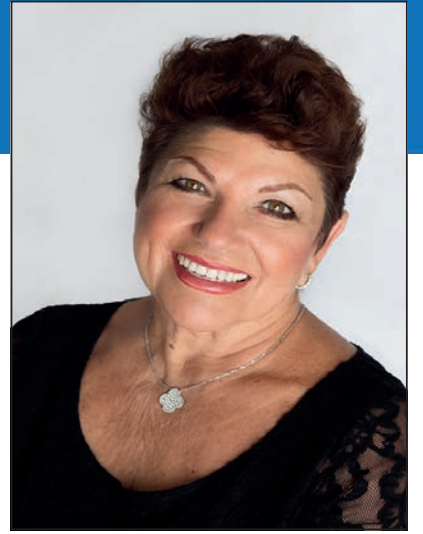

Also, let me tell you about the Agency on Aging of Broward County. This program offers a variety of services including Food Assistance, Health & Wellness Classes, Home Assistance, Medicare Counseling/Shine Centers, Transportation Services, Connecting withU, and Senior Technology Programs. The Senior Technology program provides products such as the Ring Doorbell and the Emergency Alert System (EARS). These products can be accessed at [www.adrchbroward.com](http://www.adrchbroward.com). Coconut Creek Grants are available for projects such as Surveillance Cameras, Perimeter of village landscaping and permanent signs, or structures. Several Condominium buildings in Wynmoor have applied for a matching grant program (up to \$10,000) for the installation of surveillance cameras. To apply for this grant, contact the City of Coconut Creek’s Department of Sustainable Development, ATTN: Neighborhood Enhancement Grant Program, 4800 West Copans Road, Coconut Creek, FL, or email Dan Nelson at [Dnelson@coconutcreek.net](mailto:Dnelson@coconutcreek.net).

On April 24, 2024, Florida’s Governor Ron DeSantis sanctioned House Bill 1029, thereby initiating the My Safe Florida Condominium Pilot program.

This program is designed to aid eligible condominium associations by providing hurricane mitigation inspections to identify ways to lessen a property’s susceptibility to hurricane damage, and by offering mitigation grants. The Florida legislature has allocated \$30 million to the Department of Financial Services for the establishment of this program. These funds will be

assigned to them on July 1, 2024. It will be expected that the applications will not be accessible to the public until fall 2024. More information will be provided as the team prepares for the program’s launch at: [www.mysafeflorida.com](http://www.mysafeflorida.com)

Please don’t forget about Creek Armor, it is a phone app launched by the Coconut Creek Police Department and it can be found in the iPhone App Store, and in Google Play. All you have to do to find it is type “Creek Armor” (all one word) wherever you download new apps on your phone. This includes Android phones. And it’s free! It is designed to be a direct, one-to-one, line of communication between you and your police department. This app allows you to report suspicious activity to the Real Time Crime Center. You can also share your location with a friend so that person can monitor you while go you for a walk or run. There are direct links to Crime Prevention Tips and Scam Alerts. Also, and most important, you can activate a panic button that will alert the Real Time Crime Center as to your location so officers can assist you quickly during an emergency.

The time has come to get out and to, once again, begin to enjoy all that we have to offer here. Check out our ever-expanding list of events and activities and join your friends and neighbors for a good time!

# A Paean To An Encyclopedic Collection of American Paintings

In early April, I returned to Denver and the American Western Art Museum, Anschutz Collection across the street from the iconic Brown Palace Hotel in the historic Navarre Building. The American Western Art Museum has an encyclopedic collection of Western American Theme Paintings starting with the oil paintings of George Catlin and Alfred Jacob Miller, a very early painter of the

Western Rocky Mountains.

I was very impressed with their paintings by Thomas Hill “Yosemite,” Christian Schussele “Hetty Reading The Scripture To Native Americans,” William de Leftwich Dodge “Death of Minnehaha,” shows influence of French Academy Painters, Charles Nahl “Vaqueros Roping Steer,” California Painter, James Walker “California Vaqueros,” British Painter, depicted cowboys roping bear, Frederic Remington “Cold Morning On The Range,” N.C. Wyeth “Lady Wars,” William Leigh “Grand Canyon,” Ernest Blumenschein “Sangre De Christo Mountains,” my favorite painting in this art museum, associated with Taos, New Mexico “Peacemakers,” Victor Higgins “Pueblo of Taos,” Maynard Dixon “Desert Journey,” Nicolai Fechin “Corn Dancer,” Walter Ufer “Paint and Indians,” George Bellows “Springtime in Santa Fe,” Gerald Cassidy “Indians Outside Taos Pueblo,” Georgia

O’Keefe “Red Hills, Grey Sky,” she was associated with the state of New Mexico, but not the Taos School of Art, Marsden Hartley “New Mexico Recollections,” Emil Bistram “Comadre Rafaelita,” Birger Sandzen “Glimpse of the Rockies,” the paragon of excellent American Expressionism, Thomas Hart Benton “Shepherd,” Gerard Delano “Navajos on Way To Laguna Fiesta,” and Kim Wiggins “Merging Cultures” with its plethora of details.

The American Western Art Museum has very knowledgeable staff members who added to the joy being at this fine art museum which is open on Mondays, Wednesdays, and Fridays. At this art museum, photography, and the use of cellphones in this art museum is forbidden. So come early, take your time studying quality Western American Paintings, and enhance your knowledge of the American West.

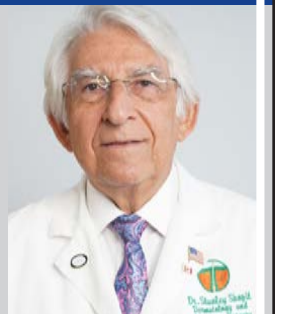

Throughout my early years of life, I was just an ordinary looking guy who could not compete with the handsome debonair type one would see in the movies nor was I another Frankenstein monster. Yet for the first 21 years of my life, I never had a true girlfriend or anyone I could call my own. So, I figured this would be my lot in life except mother nature and life itself had other plans for this ordinary looking male.

In May 1964, a friend of the family warned me that the draft would soon be tapping on my shoulder. So, if I didn't want the draft to assign me a branch of the service, I had better enlist and choose a branch that would meet my needs. So, I happily enlisted into the Air Force. After basic training and military tech school, I was assigned as a journalist in the Public Information Office at Griffiss AFB outside Rome, New York, then transferred to Sondrestrom AB, Greenland and finally to Forbes AFB outside Topeka, Kansas.

These 3 assignments were great and taught me a good deal about the Air Force and how to make a living outside a B4 bag and constantly on TDY assignments. These assignments though great in themselves left me with little time to form any kind of relationship with the opposite sex. Being bored and needed something to lighten my mood I took a chance and went to a USO dance being held in Topeka on the first Saturday in May 1967.

As usual I sat in a chair on one side of the dance floor and watched as others danced and I sat there like a dummy getting bored and lonely. It was then I noticed a young lady sitting on a bench on the opposite side of the dance looking as bored and tired as I felt. So, I took a chance and went over to her and asked her if she would like to dance with me. To my utter delight and surprise, she said yes and in that moment a feeling of absolute joy filled my very soul.

As we were about to dance the music stopped, but then it started with a new song from the musical "South Pacific" called Some Enchanted Evening. That song was most appropriate for the way I felt that evening. We danced to that song and several others before we sat at a table to eat cake and drink coke and spent the evening talking about our lives and family. It was during this conversation that I learned that she was an orphan and had a long and rough childhood. I listened as she bared her soul about how she felt about things and how she longed to be part of a family. More importantly for me I saw how she responded and treated others. This young lady Barbara Ellen Morris had

a warm heart and cared for others more than herself.

This truly was an enchanted evening, because the lyrics of the song stated, "You will meet a stranger across a crowded room and then you will find that you're not alone." Here was a person who touched my soul with her concern for me and how I felt about things in this world.

After the USO dance concluded we exchanged phone numbers I asked her for a date for next week, which she happily agreed. The next day I was called to the CO's office and Captain Carter wanted to know who this Barbara Morris was because it seems that her counselor wanted to know if you had honorable intention toward this young lady. Captain Carter said I already vouched for you, so your intentions better be honorable, or you will answer to me. With this warning, you can believe I was on my best behavior not only for that date but throughout our entire dating year.

We continued to date and be with each other for a year until June 1968 when my enlistment ended and I was sent home to New Bedford, Massachusetts to be with my family. From May until June, I applied and was accepted to Southeastern Massachusetts University. In August Barbara came to see me and my family. My father wanted to see this young lady who captured my heart and decided to treat her to a typical New England dinner, baked lobster. When Barbara saw the lobster she said, 'I can't eat.' I asked her why she couldn't eat it. She replied, "It's looking at me." Everyone in this family restaurant broke up in laughter. To those who were laughing I said, "Barbara is from the far west, like Montana, Wyoming, Kansas, Nebraska where most people have never even seen a lobster never mind eaten one. So, I turned the lobster on its backside and said now Barbara, you can eat it which she did and thoroughly enjoyed eating lobster the rest of her life.

It is on this day, that I proposed marriage. My parents and eight siblings continued to make her a part of our family to provide one that she never had.

That August Barbara and I were married and for the next three years she worked in a factory while I went to college. When I graduated it was my time to return the task by teaching while Barbara went to college to get her degree in nursing. In this way we both worked to support each other and became a team. That lasted 29 years until her passing from this life with cancer. Her soul, spirit and love still fill my heart with the love and memories we had shared.

# What To Do When Your Spouse or Partner Dies

Losing your spouse, partner or significant other is a very traumatic event. It is most important for your physical and emotional health to give yourself time for the grieving process. Once you feel mentally and emotionally able to do so, you should schedule an appointment with an attorney to review all legal documents.

You should bring your Will and/or Revocable Living Trust, Deed to your home and any other real estate, certified copy of the death certificate and, if married, date of your marriage. If you have advanced care directives such as a Living Will, Durable Power of Attorney and Designation of Health Care Surrogate, you should bring those as well.

If your spouse or partner owned something in their name alone with no designated beneficiary, probate may be necessary. Bring details of such assets to the appointment.

If everything you owned was in both names, it is not necessary to probate the Will. However, regarding your home, and any other real estate, it is important to "Clear the Title." The lawyer will prepare and have you sign a "Continuous Marriage Affidavit," which is why you need the date of your marriage. The Affidavit will state that you were married on a certain date and remained continuously married without divorce until the date of death. It will provide the legal description of your home and other real estate and indicate your intention to clear title. This document will be recorded, along with an Affidavit of No Florida Estate Tax Due and the Death Certificate without the cause of death. Recording these documents will clear title and allow you the option to do a new Deed to avoid probate when you die. If you were not married but owned your home (or any other property) jointly, it is still important to clear title. Of course, a Continuous Marriage Affidavit will not be necessary.

If you do not have a Revocable Living Trust, this appointment will be a



good opportunity to discuss the creation of a Trust and preparation of a Deed in order to avoid probate on your home and other real estate. You can also discuss the option of a Life Estate Deed to avoid probate.

If you do have a Trust, this may be an appropriate time to consider doing an Amendment to the Trust based on new circumstances. Your home and other real estate (in Florida and out-of-state) should be owned by you as Trustee of the Trust. You may wish to name one of your children as Co-Trustee to make it easier to manage the assets in your Trust if you

become incapacitated. You may also wish to make changes in your Living Will, Durable Power of Attorney and Designation of Health Care Surrogate or create those documents if you do not have them.

In most cases, there is no urgency to contact an attorney. It is much better to have peace of mind and clarity. Some lawyers, including myself, will offer a free consultation. This consultation should include your options and give you the opportunity to sleep on it before finalizing any new legal documents.

In addition, when you are ready, there are actions you should take for which you do not need an attorney. This includes rolling over your spouse's IRA to yours, claiming life insurance benefits and naming beneficiaries on any joint accounts. If you have individual accounts or life insurance and your spouse is beneficiary, be sure to change it. However, your lawyer can advise you on these matters. If you are going through the loss of a loved one, my prayers are with you.

# WOODSHOP

The Woodshop has had a very busy June filling special requests for residents and shop members. We hope you enjoy looking at the exquisite craftsmanship put into the treasures displayed in the following photos as we did producing each one!



Dave Norcross was asked to make a "Breakfast in Bed" table for a temporary bedridden member, and now he has two more orders from residents. The table is made from light weight alder wood, with a detachable tabletop and collapsible table legs, and weighs less than 4 lb. The salad bowl is for Ernie's wife. It contains 7 rings with 12 individual segments in each. The rings are sculptured from Baltic birch plywood providing the banner stripe effect, and Brazilian Cherry, rock maple, and ash provide the alternating hardwood components. The top ring was intentionally turned to create a soft 3-dimensional effect that flows through the other rings.



Dave also created three marble games for a resident using solid white oak for the background with a weathered ash accent down the center adding dimension and functionality to this game of skill. All board games are covered with 6 coats gloss finish and the reverse side is covered with verdant red felt. Everett Yankie's swan in the middle of the photo is still looking as majestic as ever waiting to be somebody's



charcuterie board. The last 2 items cannot be duplicated. Each piece in each strip is individually matched acacia wood to produce an earthy glow. Black cherry wood is used to encase the whole mosaic.



Folks from the Club House Card Room have asked us to provide wood card holders for the popular game called SAMBA. Each board is 1" x 6" x 12" with 5 individual rows, and bottom covered with felt. The 2 multi-colored woodcraft next to them are "trivets" to help cool hot items.

This isn't an optical illusion! Two of Yank's folks back north did have triplets. These rocking chairs are made from solid wild black cherry from back home. Jeanette DaRosa added the three teddy bears as a finishing touch. These precious gifts will be heirlooms for the Yankie family for generations to come. With the wood that was left, Yank produced these two bowls for the kids.

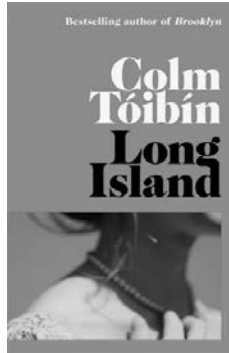

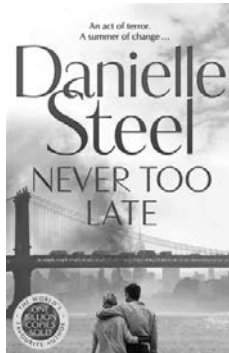
# BOOK Review

## Never Too Late by Danielle Steel



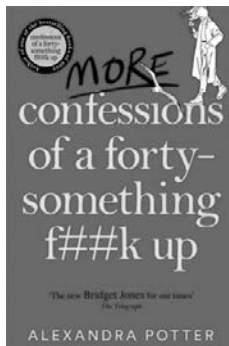

## A Vision of Success

I've always kept a vision board listing my goals. Even as a boy living in a tiny rowhouse in the Philadelphia projects, I was preparing to achieve my dreams. I knew I didn't need to do everything; I only needed to do the next thing. Through planning and preparation, I became the first member of my family to graduate high school and then college. I soon joined law enforcement and, with greater planning, rose through the ranks to become the Coral Springs Police Department's first black sergeant. During my time with the department, I served in various capacities and received more than a dozen awards and letters of commendation.

Recognizing societal needs, I briefly stepped away from police work. I founded a company that trained the private and public sectors in preventative strategies and response for active shooter and mass casualty incidents. When the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) needed someone to correct deficiencies following the tragic events at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, I accepted the opportunity to lead BSO, putting my expertise in active shooter training and readiness to work. In doing so, I also became the first black sheriff in the organization's 109-year history – a privilege I don't take lightly.

Each achievement, each step forward, was fueled by my commitment to excellence. Today, my vision board is filled with initiatives to enhance every aspect of BSO, from training and accountability to community relations and technology. These initiatives are reinforced by every member of our organization and serve to foster unity, encourage progression and uphold our core mission of protecting Broward County.

One of our most impactful initiatives is leveraging technology to proactively combat crime. The Threat Management Unit (TMU) and Real Time Crime Center (RTCC) detect and prevent potential threats from harming our community. Since its inception, the TMU has investigated more than 4,230 potentially violent incidents, resulting in more than 300 arrests. In addition, the RTCC has provided



live surveillance during more than 5,600 investigations. As the RTCC undergoes expansion, it reinforces our commitment to providing excellence in service.

Transparency and accountability are fundamental to building trust with the people we serve. I've reorganized the Professional Standards Committee to include diverse voices and established the Use of Force Review Board to ensure fair evaluation and compliance with BSO policies. In addition, our annual report demonstrates our commitment to transparency, showcasing how taxpayer dollars are allocated for public safety.

Our efforts to enhance relationships and build trust in our communities are proving successful. Programs like our Neighborhood Support Team (NST) and Park, Walk and Talk (PWT) facilitate personal interactions beyond routine calls for service to enhance understanding and address community needs. Since the inception of the PWT in 2019, we've had more than 130,000 interactions with residents across Broward County.

Encouraging diversity has been one of the primary goals of my administration. We have looked to reinforce our agency with recruitment and promotional opportunities for those most qualified. The result has been an organization that better reflects the diverse communities we serve. As sheriff, I've had the honor of promoting more than 1,300 employees, and we have filled nearly 2,100 positions throughout the organization. This commitment has been a critical factor in our operational success as valuable institutional knowledge has been applied to the development of various programs and initiatives.

Every step we take, however big, creates a significant, lasting imprint on this community. I'm proud of our progress in strengthening public safety, yet I am mindful of the work still to come. Just as my vision board is ever-evolving, so is BSO's.

We have been hearing a lot of "noise" about which of our two main candidates for President are "better" for "The Jews."

A number of years ago PJ Grisar researched the "Yiddishkeit" of all our Presidents. I have taken the liberty to paraphrase some of her work. Some I have quoted directly, which is noted. Some of the information she provided references Mordecai Manuel Noah. So, first a bit about him.

Mordecai Manuel Noah was a Jew-born of what was then a mixed marriage- an Ashkenazic Father and a Sephardic mother- in 1785. He loved both journalism and politics. When he was 26, he asked the then Secretary of State, Robert Smith, to appoint him to a post in the diplomatic corps. He wanted the world to see that a Jew in this new nation was fully accepted. He was appointed a consul, later served as a judge, sheriff, and editor of six New York newspapers.

His vision was to create a Jewish State which would take its place among all the nations of the world. To that end, he bought Grand Island, between Buffalo and Canada, in the Niagara River, for Jews to settle until they could regain possession of their ancient holy land in Palestine.

Well, to make a long story short, his attempt was a failure. He failed to attract many settlers. After all, Jews were comfortable in America. Some thought it was a fraud, and some thought he was trying to be the Messiah. Others believed that the Jewish home could only be in Palestine.

All that remains of what Noah called "Ararat" is a pedestal at Grand Island Town Hall engraved with the Shema and "Ararat, a City of Refuge, Founded by Mordecai Manuel Noah in the month of Tizri 5586, September 1825 and in the 50th Year of American Independence.

The Presidents and their Jewish connections:

- George Washington: The father of our country was way ahead of his time with the letter he sent to the Hebrew Congregation at Newport, Rhode Island. He gave his word that Jews would be considered full citizens of the USA.

- John Adams: "Adams, fluent in Hebrew, was a Philo Semite, once railing against Voltaire's portrayals of Jews and insisting that Jews, "are the most glorious nation that ever inhabited this earth. The Romans and their empire were but a Bauble in comparison to the Jews." In a letter to Mordecai Manual Noah, Adams wrote of his support of a Jewish state-wow! He did mention that some of the practices of Jews were a bit strange, but...

- Thomas Jefferson: He was all for full citizenship for Jews but told them to push education to get more respect. He didn't like religious hate of any kind. But slaves...Jefferson often wrote to Noah mentioning that the suffering of the Jews, and religious intolerance would recur under the laws of America.

- James Madison: On the consecration of Shearith Israel in New York in 1818, Madison wrote to Noah that he glad to see the Jews partake in all the blessings of the Government and its law, and all that is offered by our country. He didn't seem to take much interest in anything else Jewish.

- James Monroe: Here we have a case where actions speak louder than words. As Secretary of State under Madison, Monroe recalled Noah from his Consular position. The reason given was that the Ottomans found out he was Jewish. He did listen to Noah when he became President.

- John Quincy Adams: The son picked up where the father left off-writing to Noah talking about "rebuilding of Judea as an independent nation." He was remarkably familiar with the Torah and believed that the Jews belonged in Palestine.

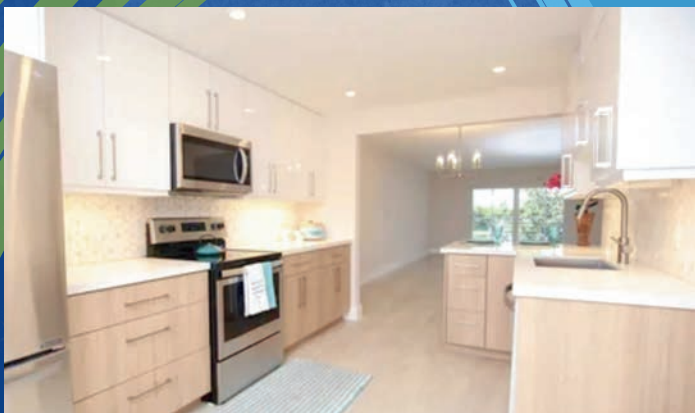

# Safety Solutions

## Summer Scam Lookout

It's summer and here are a few scams in which you should be on the lookout so you won't get fooled:

### FAKE SELLER SCAM

"See before you send" is the big lesson in from one popular scam in which we unfortunately see a little too much. A man recently sent a large sum of money

to someone he had only communicated with over Facebook Messenger. He thought he was buying a car. After he sent the "down payment," the person he was messaging disappeared. A good way to avoid this scam is to insist on seeing the item you want to buy in-person before you send any type of payment. Our lobby at 4800 West Copans Road is open 24-7 for just such an occasion. If the seller refuses to meet you in person, it's probably a scam.

### SOCIAL SECURITY SCAM

The Social Security Phone Scam is another that happens all too often here in Coconut Creek. In these particular cases, someone claiming to be from the IRS [Internal Revenue Service] called the victims. The phony IRS agent told them their social security numbers were comprised, and they needed to go to the store and buy gift cards for him or else they would be arrested. Both victims bought the gift cards and gave the numbers and pin numbers on them to the scam artist. Remember that the IRS would never call you up out of the blue and threaten to arrest you. Any time someone asks you to buy gift cards for any reason, remember that's a huge red flag that it's a scam.

### THE MICROSOFT TECH SUPPORT SCAM

The Microsoft Tech Support Scam is frequent tactic the fraudsters use. In one case, a 69-year-old woman clicked on an email claiming to be from

Microsoft Support. It asked her to call a phone number, which she did. A man answered claiming to be from Microsoft Support, explaining that her computer was infected with a virus. To make matters supposedly worse, he said that her computer was connected to a vast child pornography and money laundering scheme, which of course shocked and frightened the woman, as the bad guys intended. In order to avoid arrest, they told her, she had to send them thousands of dollars in gold bullion. Luckily, an actual legit representative from the gold bullion company intervened before she could send it to the scammers. The bottom line here is to remember never to click on any strange emails and if someone is using scare tactics to get you to pay them, it's always a scam. Just hang up.

### GRANDPARENTS SCAM

It's called the "Grandparents Scam" because that's exactly the people the bad guys target. In one case we investigated, a woman received a phone call from someone posing as her grandson. He told her that he had just been involved in a car crash and was about to be charged with DUI. He then provided her with a phone number to his "attorney" and told her to call him. The phony attorney said she needed to send \$8,000 right then or else her grandson would be officially charged with DUI. To the victim's credit, she tried to call her grandson and his father, her son, but neither answered. The scammers kept the pressure on until she sent the money. The so-called "attorney" was on the phone with her the whole time at an ATM coaching her on how to send it. It's important to remember that the legal process doesn't work this way. No attorney will demand a bunch of money in order to prevent a loved one from being charged with a crime. If you get a similar phone call, don't do anything until you've talked to the family member who is supposedly in trouble.

### Important News for Homeowners

When buying/acquiring real estate, do **not** assume the property taxes will remain the same as the current owner's taxes. Under Florida law, a change in ownership requires the property to be reassessed at current full market value the year following the change of ownership OR if a Homestead Exemption is added/removed from the property. This reassessment could result in higher property taxes for the new owner than what the seller was paying. Please use the Tax Estimator on our website at [web.bcpa.net](http://web.bcpa.net) and click on "Online Tools" to approximate **your** new property taxes **based on the reassessed value**.

The Property Appraiser **does not** set or collect taxes. Tax rates/fees are set by individual taxing authorities each year based on their budgetary needs. All property tax billing and collecting is handled by the Broward County Tax Collector's Office. ## The Death Of Printed Newspapers Has Been Greatly Exaggerated



### Newspapers Are Dead: Long Live Newspapers!

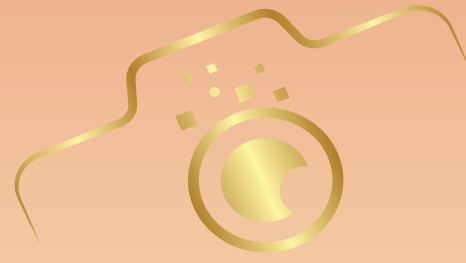

## Italian Sausage, Peppers, and Onions

### Ingredients:

- 4 Italian sausages
- 2 red bell peppers, sliced
- 2 green bell peppers, sliced
- 1 large onion, sliced
- 3 cloves garlic, minced
- 1 teaspoon dried oregano
- 1 teaspoon dried basil
- 1/2 teaspoon crushed red pepper flakes (optional)
- Salt and pepper to taste
- 2 tablespoons olive oil
- Fresh parsley, chopped (for garnish)

### Directions:

Heat olive oil in a large skillet over medium-high heat.

Add the Italian sausages to the skillet and cook until browned on all sides, about 5 minutes.

Remove the sausages from the skillet and set aside.

In the same skillet, add the sliced peppers, onions, and minced garlic.

Cook, stirring occasionally, until the vegetables are tender and slightly caramelized, about 10 minutes.

Add the dried oregano, dried basil, crushed red pepper flakes (if using), salt, and pepper to the skillet. Stir to combine.

Return the sausages to the skillet, nestling them among the peppers and onions.

Cover the skillet and let everything simmer together for another 5-10 minutes, until the sausages are cooked through.

Remove the lid and let any excess liquid cook off.

Garnish with fresh chopped parsley before serving.

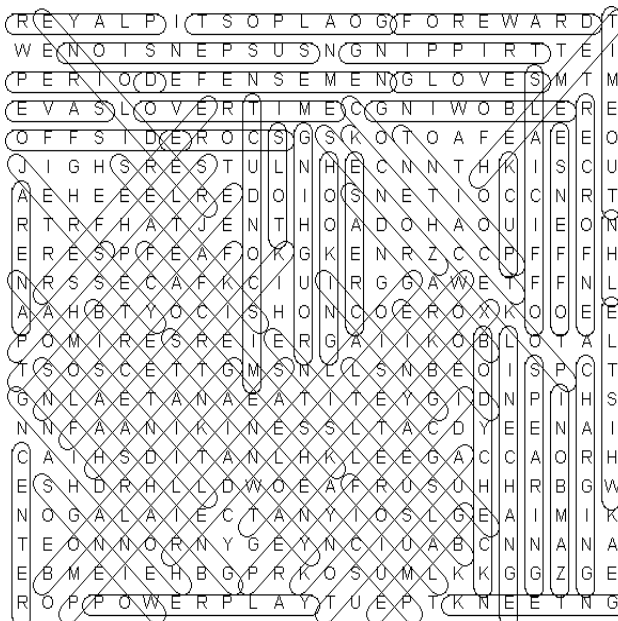
