

Let's hope Mother Nature is kind to South Florida this year. Remember to regularly review and update your emergency supplies to ensure everything is in working order and not expired. Stay informed about weather updates from reliable sources and check the Wynmoor Blasts for any information being provided to our residents. Being prepared is the best way to mitigate risks and keep yourself and your loved ones safe during the hurricane season.

As our Director of Maintenance, Mr. Mike Salimbene, is retiring and embarking on his new chapter in life, we wanted to take a moment to express our heartfelt gratitude and admiration for all he has contributed to the Wynmoor community.

Mike, your dedication, hard work, and unwavering commitment have left an indelible mark on our community. Over the years, you have been more than just an employee; you have been a friend, a mentor, and a source of inspiration to many. Your efforts have made a lasting impact, and your legacy will continue to be felt long after you have left. Thank you once again for everything. Your contributions have made a significant difference, and we are deeply grateful for your years of service and commitment to make Wynmoor a better place for all of us.

We are in the midst of our annual budget season! The proposed 2025 Budget is currently in its preparation stage. On behalf of the Budget & Finance Committee, I would like to extend our heartfelt gratitude to all those who submitted their ideas and suggestions for the upcoming 2025 annual budget season. We extend our sincere appreciation to all residents and clubs who have taken the time and effort to contribute to the budgetary planning process. Your dedication and involvement are vital to the success of our community. Subsequently, the approved suggestions will be presented to the Board of Directors for final approval.

House Bill 1029 established The My Safe Florida Condominium Pilot Program (the "Program") effective July 1, 2024. This new Program aims to assist eligible condominium associations by offering **hurricane mitigation inspections** to determine how to reduce a property's vulnerability to hurricane damage, as well as **mitigation grants** that can be used towards projects for hardening the property to improve its resilience against hurricanes. The current information is that applications will be available in fall 2024.

Here is what you need to know:

• To apply for a hurricane mitigation inspection, an association must receive either approval by a majority vote of the board of directors or a majority vote of the total voting interests of the association. Within 14 days of an affirmative vote to participate in the Program, an association must provide written notice to all unit owners of the Board's decision.

• After the mitigation inspection has been conducted, to apply for a mitigation grant, an association must receive approval by either a majority vote of the board or a majority vote of the total voting interests of the association. In addition, all unit owners within the building that is the subject of the mitigation grant must approve the grant application.



- Before conducting a unit owner vote, an association must provide a clear disclosure of the Program to all unit owners on a form that will be created by the Florida Department of Financial Services. The form must be signed by the Board's President and Treasurer and kept as a part of the association's official records.
- Mitigation grants can be used by associations to fund projects for improvements recommended in a hurricane mitigation inspection report, including the following:
 - Opening protection, such as exterior doors, garage doors, windows, and skylights
 - Reinforcing roof-to-wall connections
 - Improving the strength of roof-deck attachments
 - Secondary water resistance for roofs
- Mitigation grants cannot be used to install the same type of improvement that was previously installed on the property and cannot be used to pay a deductible for a pending insurance claim that is part of the property for which grant funds are being received.
- Mitigation grants are capped at a maximum of \$175,000 per association, and are matching funds on a 2-1 basis, with 2 dollars granted for every 1 dollar provided by the association. Grant funds are limited to 50% of the cost of the project.
- Construction of the improvements and a final inspection must be completed within one year of receiving grant approval.

Stay informed and take advantage of the opportunities provided by the My Safe Florida Condominium Pilot Program.

Albert Brunn: Reflections of a Centenarian

Where were you in 1924? Many of us reading this article were not born yet. Others who are reading this were very young. Albert Brunn was born on August 22, 1924 in Berlin. On a hot day in July, I sat down with Albert, and we spoke at length about his life and I asked him to share memories and highlights of the extraordinary life he has led. An account of the above is listed below.

One of his first highlights that Albert shared with me was his becoming a bar mitzvah in 1937. His parasha (Torah portion) was Eikev which he chanted in the Pestalozi St synagogue in Berlin. It was a small and beautiful religious event followed by a party in his parents' apartment nearby. In those days, people did not make big parties like they do today, but it was very lovely, and more like a kiddush luncheon. Albert recalls the night of November 9, 1937, which became known

as Kristalnacht (Night of Broken Glass) when he was sitting with his family in their apartment and the Nazis were breaking windows of Jewish owned stores and burning synagogues throughout the city. These scenes left a lifelong lasting impression on young Albert. His parents saw that there was no future for Jews in Nazi Germany and had sent his older sister Lilly to England where the family had relatives and for her to work as a domestic. With heavy hearts they put their young son on a Kindertransport train to England for him to be out of Germany.

Young Albert's transport travelled from Berlin to Hamburg to the Harbor of the Elbe River where he boarded a ship and sailed to Southampton England. He arrived at a refugee hostel, the only kosher cap camp run by a couple who owned a hotel next door and had access to kosher food. He settled in a refugee camp in Westgate on Sea next to Margate. From there about 25 boys were sent to Croyden to a house whose director was a senior rabbi. The boys existed on meager rations and slept on the floor as there were no beds. Some months later the boys were sent to London where the Sabbath meal consisted of one short hot dog (knockwurst) and cabbage.

Another highlight of Albert's life was meeting the great love of his life, Ursula Liffmann, whose mother had left Germany to work as a domestic north of London and settled in England north of London. Later, Albert worked as an apprentice in a diamond polishing factory. Albert became acquainted with Anne, Ursula's sister, who used to bring her laundry every week to the house where Albert lived. Together in their free time Albert and Anne would go together to Bar Kochba, a youth group to dances, choir, and a variety of social events. It was through Anne that Albert met her lovely sister Ursula. It was a beautiful romance and courtship and the young couple married in December 1944. Albert says it was the smallest wedding he ever attended with only their immediate families, the two witnesses and in the apartment of Ursula's uncle. The Rabbi who performed the ceremony was not licensed by Germany, so the young couple had to go to the Town Hall to get married legally and then had a Jewish ceremony in Ursala's uncle's apartment.

During the war Albert's parents were in Germany and had to wait to go



to the US. His parents were on the last transport which was arranged by the Jewish Federation. A new US law went into effect on July 1, 1944, that stated that anyone from Germany or German occupied land could no longer receive a visa. On the evening of June 30th his parents were granted visas to leave Europe. Albert and Ursula came to the US after the war and were sponsored by his parents plus an additional sponsor. In 1946 they settled in Washington Heights in upper Manhattan in NYC where apartments were much more affordable compared to lower Manhattan. In 1952 they started a family with the birth of their daughter Miriam. Shortly afterwards Albert's job transferred him, and he relocated with Ursula and their three-month-old baby to Rochester, NY. Their second daughter Ruth was born in Rochester and a few years later the Brunn family moved again and made their new home in Buffalo, NY. Their eldest daughter Miriam

became a teacher and later worked at Camp Ramah in the Poconos where she met her future husband, Rabbi Archie Ruberg. Their middle daughter Ruth graduated from the University of Buffalo and worked as a physical therapist. Their youngest daughter Naomi became a banker for a short time and later she went to work for Hadassah where she is employed today.

The Brunns raised their family in Buffalo and lived happily there for many years before retiring to Florida in 2005 to Wynmoor in Coconut Creek. They raised their three daughters in a very traditional kosher home, observed all the Jewish holidays, were active members of the Jewish community, and instilled in them a great love for Israel. Daughters Miriam and Ruth went to Israel when they were 16 through their bat mitzvah club and United Synagogue Youth and fell in love with the country. Years later Ruth made "Aliyah" (permanent settlement) to Israel and joined her son Uriel. Albert and Ursula were blessed with three outstanding daughters and five grandchildren. Miriam and Archie have two children-Jeremy (Rebecca) and Adina (Ben). Ruth has one son, Uriel (Alice), who also lives in Israel. Naomi and Steven have two sons Joshua and Aaron. What's Better: Life Estate Deed or Revocable Living Trust?

There are several ways to avoid probate on your home when you die. If you are single, there will be probate when you die unless you choose one of the following options. If you are married and own your home together, your surviving spouse will not have probate; however, there will be probate when the second of you passes away, unless one of these options is done.

Let us assume that you own your home jointly with your spouse and that you have one child. Both of you desire to have your child inherit your home when you both pass away.

The first option would be to add the name of your child to the Deed as a joint tenant with right of survivorship. This is not a good idea. It would affect your ability to claim your full homestead exemption. In addition, you lose control of your property and can only sell it if your child agrees and signs all closing documents. If you wanted to take the child off the Deed, you would be unable to do so. If your child files for bankruptcy, has an adverse judgment or files for divorce, your property could be subject to liens or other legal action. Therefore, I recommend against a Deed with your child as a joint tenant with right of survivorship.

The second option is a Life Estate Deed. There are two types of Life Estate Deed: regular and Enhanced (also referred to as Lady Bird). The regular Life Estate Deed requires that your children join in any sale or other changes on the Deed; therefore, you have lost control and cannot take your children's names off the Deed if you choose to do so. The Enhanced Life Estate Deed gives you the sole right to sell the property during your lifetime or make any other changes to the Deed without the



permission of your children. The Enhanced Life Estate Deed has very specific legal language in order to be effective; therefore, do not attempt to do this on your own.

Even with the Enhanced Life Estate Deed, there are risks, particularly if either of your children has a bankruptcy, outstanding judgment or undergoes divorce. The worst risk, however, is if, God forbid, your children die before you or with you in a common accident. Your children's estates would then become the owners of the property once you died, which would result in

probate being required. Thus, the main purpose of the Life Estate Deed is not accomplished.

The best way to avoid probate on your home is to do a Revocable Living Trust. When you sign the Trust, you also sign a Deed transferring the property to you as Trustees of your Trust. You are able to keep your homestead exemption, maintain complete control of the property during your lifetime and make amendments to your Trust without changing the Deed. There are no risks involved, since your children's names do not appear on the Deed. The only disadvantage of the Trust is that it will cost more money in attorney's fees. When you discuss the options with your attorney, you should discuss the difference in fees between the Trust and the Life Estate Deed. You can then determine whether it is worth saving the money and taking the risks involved in the Life Estate Deed.



Expectations

Relationships are always interesting topics to write about. I began thinking about this article, in terms of friendships, which led to spouses and the like which led to family in general and then to all relationships. One thing they all had in common was the idea of expectations.

Someone put a meme on Facebook a while back that stated that the only way to never be upset

or disappointed is to never have any expectations from anyone. While that statement is true in its own way, it is meaningless since without any expectations you really don't have a relationship to be disappointed about. Relationships don't exist in a vacuum. To say you have no expectations is being dishonest. Your expectations may be misplaced or impossible but they exist nevertheless. It is looking at them appropriately that becomes the task here.

Different relationships have very different inherent expectations. And some of these expectations are silent meaning they have never been discussed or agreed upon. People hold expectations that the other person knows nothing about and may or may not have agreed to. This is what causes upset and disappointment.

You may even hold different expectations from different friends and differing ones from each of your children. If the other person has no idea what these are, there are bound to be issues. Also, there are people who take offense when their expectations aren't met even when they are not explicit or agreed upon. Assuming that someone holds the same values and rules of behavior that you do is unrealistic. And there is no right or wrong involved with this. We all live in a world that is of our own making where these values and behaviors are concerned. What is expected by one person is not necessarily expected by another.

Family members often, but not always, have implicit rules of engagement with each other that carry over into other relationships. If a particular

family always behaved in a certain way when a member was ill, as an example, then a person from that family would expect others in their lives to behave similarly. This would often be seen as a show of caring or at least of good manners. When this behavior is not elicited from a close friend disappointment is usually the outcome. When people marry partners not brought up in the same fashion and where very different actions mean very different things there is bound to be dissension, but the same thing can happen even without marrying or cohabitating. You believe if your mate or your friend really cared about you he or she would behave in certain ways. When I was doing marriage counseling cross expectations was a primary area of conflict. Everyone believes that their way is the only way to express concern and caring and if the ways are different there are many problems.

So why did I say that without expectations there would be no relationship? This addresses the definition of what it means to be in a relationship. Without any expectations you can interact with people but those interactions stay on the surface. To build a connection you must open yourself emotionally and inherent in that is the hope that you will be listened to and accepted even if not agreed with. If you get a good result then you do it again and expect the same result. If you don't get it you are disappointed and the relationship takes a different route. And then it begins. If your expectations are met the relationship deepens if they aren't, it fizzles. The catch here is that the more they are met and the deeper the relationship, the more they are expected and the worse the disappointment when they are not met. But how can you have a true relationship without any expectations? Even in a relationship that offers only a pleasurable time if that is not met there is disappointment there too. If it happens often there is no more reason to keep that relationship alive and so it ends. It ended because you had an expectation that wasn't met. I would say that most relationships end for that reason.

Do you voice your expectations to the people in your life? Do they know what they are and did they agree to them? Not everyone in your life will agree to what you need from them but it becomes more realistic if they knew about what you wanted or needed from them so they could agree or disagree.

This is a good topic to discuss with the people in your life and the clarity that comes from this is priceless.






Transforming Public Safety

Serving as your sheriff is a great honor and a tremendous responsibility. Since taking command in 2019, the over 5,500 men and women of the Broward Sheriff's Office (BSO) have worked tirelessly to bring the best public safety services to our county. We have implemented significant reforms, enhanced operational efficiency, forged stronger community connections and prioritized accountability and transparency, establishing ourselves as national leaders in public safety.

Following the tragedy at Marjory Stoneman Douglas High School, our primary goal has been to enhance training for all first responders. Today, our deputies participate in a rigorous training curriculum, including annual in-service training, patrol rifle proficiency development, active

assailant response, Tactical Combat Casualty Care, Incident Command System exercises and dedicated supervisor instruction for critical incident/scene management. Our new Research, Development and Training Center (R.D.T.C.) will further enhance these training initiatives, ensuring our first responders are well-prepared for any scenario and equipped to tackle emerging public safety challenges.

It was also imperative that we restore public trust in our organization. We implemented measures to hold employees accountable and enhance transparency in misconduct investigations and use of force incidents. We reorganized our Professional Standards Committee (PSC) to be more reflective of our community, selecting qualified individuals who are well-versed in labor law, internal affairs investigations and human resources to better evaluate incidents of wrongdoing. Additionally, we proactively engage with the community to address unique concerns through initiatives like the Social Justice Task Force (SJTF), which comprises community activists, faith leaders and stakeholders. The SJTF aims to address community concerns and enhance transparency, communication and accountability while building stronger relationships between law enforcement and the community.



Innovative outreach efforts, reminiscent of traditional community policing practices, have strengthened our relationships with the community. Programs such as the Neighborhood Support Team (NST) and Park, Walk and Talk (PWT) foster personal connections between BSO and the people we serve. We are connecting with our residents where they live and sharing important public safety messages. In 2023, NST distributed nearly 100,000 resource materials and participated in over 510 community events, while PWT facilitated nearly 38,000 personal community interactions.

Understanding that learning never stops, we've prioritized continuing education. We've teamed up with universities

to offer employees the opportunity to expand their knowledge of public safety through advanced degree programs, such as public administration. These educational programs help develop essential critical thinking and decision-making skills, leading to a more knowledgeable and responsible approach to public safety.

All these achievements, along with many other successes of my administration, were made possible by BSO's dedicated men and women. This organization is made up of hardworking individuals who are committed to making a positive impact through public service. I also want to express my gratitude to our residents. During my time at BSO, I've met many individuals who are passionate about doing what's right for the betterment of their neighbors. These interactions have deepened my understanding of neighborhood issues and the challenges facing our community, significantly shaping my leadership approach. As a result, I am better equipped to guide BSO toward a successful and progressive future.

We've made great strides toward becoming one of the best-trained, most progressive, accountable public safety organizations in the state. There's still so much to achieve, and I look forward to what we will continue to accomplish together.







Safety Solutions

We Still Need To Work On Buckling Up



We still need to work on buckling up. I saw the statistics from our annual Spring Click It or Ticket enforcement period, which was from May 20th - June 2nd. Officers issued 182 tickets during that time frame to a driver, a passenger, or both for failing to wear a seatbelt. They also wrote 100 warnings. I'd like to see that number come down in the

future. If you or a loved one is in a crash not wearing your seatbelt, it doesn't matter how much education we try to do or tickets we write, by that time it's too late. Remember that not wearing your seat belt is also a primary offense in Florida, meaning the officer can see that and use it as a reason for a traffic stop. You don't have to be speeding or otherwise driving recklessly.

Scam update:

No scam in particular has seemed to cycle up over the past month or so. It's always a good idea not to respond to emails from people you don't know, and hang up on any shady individuals who call you out of the blue claiming to be anything from the Secret Service, to the IRS, to representative from your bank. Remember that none of those people would ever call you on the phone. Also- if anyone you don't know asks you to pay for something

using gift cards, it's always a scam.

School starts early this year:

Broward County Schools start a bit early this year - on August 12th, so be alert while driving. While we encourage good driving habits all the time, it's especially important when the school kids are out and about going to and coming home from school.

If you're like me and never back your car into the driveway, make sure and pay close attention for any walkers or bicyclists who may be coming up behind you. This advice is not so much for those of you who live in Wynmoor as it is for our friends who live in the Township.

The concerns are all the same once you get out on the busier roadways and school zones. Remember the speed limit in a school zone is 15 mph. All the school zones in Coconut Creek are clearly marked and the lights will start blinking an ample amount of time before the first bell and the time for the schools to let the kids out in the afternoon.

Slow down. Don't drive distracted. And this is a chance to remind you to buckle up too.

Luckily, traffic crashes involving kids or school buses are rare here in Coconut Creek. We want to keep it that way.

We all have our roles to play when it comes to traffic safety- drivers, bicyclists, and walkers- and it all starts with staying alert. Oftentimes an alert person can prevent a tragedy from happening.

2024 TRIM Notices

The Broward County Property Appraiser's Office mails the TRIM (proposed tax) Notices in August of each year. This is NOT a tax bill but shows your property's 2024 Just/Market Value, exemptions, and proposed taxes as set by the various taxing authorities. The TRIM Notice is your opportunity to review your 2024 Just/Market Value and ensure you are receiving all the tax-saving exemptions you are eligible for. **Please note: the deadline to apply for all 2024 exemptions is September 18, 2024.**

Florida Statutes require our office to use January 1st as the date of assessment each year. The 2024 Just/Market Values are based on the market data from 2023. Our office must consider changes in market conditions – up or down – when developing the Just/Market Values each year.

The Property Appraiser's Office does <u>not</u> set or collect property taxes. If you have questions about the proposed tax rates, the contact information and public hearing dates for the individual taxing authorities are listed to the right of each agency name on your TRIM Notice.

I Recently Applied for Homestead Exemption - Why Is It Not Showing?

Florida Statutes require our office to use January 1st as the date of assessment and to determine exemption eligibility each year. If you purchased your home after January 1, 2024, you are eligible for 2025 Homestead Exemption. The 2025 exemptions will show online in December and be included for the 2025 tax year.

I Had Homestead Exemption Last Year - Where Did My Exemptions Go?

If you purchased your home in 2023, you may have "inherited" the previous owner's exemptions last year. These 2023 exemptions were removed at the

end of 2023, so are no longer showing on your TRIM Notice for tax year 2024. Fortunately, you can still late file for 2024 Homestead and any other exemptions you may qualify for until September 18, 2024. To apply online, please visit our website at https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/Homestead or scan the QR code below.

I Am a Senior Citizen – Why Isn't the Senior Exemption Showing?

The Senior Exemption is both an age and income-based exemption that is not automatically applied to a property because of the income requirement. To be eligible for this exemption, an applicant must be age 65 or older as of January 1, 2024 and have an adjusted household gross income for 2023 not exceeding \$36,614. If you believe you qualify for this additional exemption, you can still late file until September 18, 2024. To review the exemption requirements and to apply for this exemption, please go to our website at https://web.bcpa.net/bcpaclient/#/SeniorExemption



- **4. Relaxation:** Many people use this time to meditate, listen to soft music, or even take a nap. The environment is designed to promote relaxation.
- **5. Removal:** The acupuncturist will carefully remove the needles, and you can go about your day feeling refreshed and revitalized. Depending on the issues being treated, you may also receive additional modalities such as infrared lamp heat, manual therapy, cupping, or electrical stimulation.





Enjoying Medieval TreasureWith Pleasure in Boston

In June, I returned to Boston and appreciated its myriad of quality European works of art from the Medieval Period at the Museum of Fine Arts on Huntington Avenue. I carefully studied devotional theme artifacts, fine sculpture, and inspirational devotional theme paintings at this large art museum. I restricted this review to its Medieval Works of Art on display, because Boston's Museum of Fine Arts is very prodigious.

Devotional Theme Artifacts that especially captivated me were "Virgin and Child" (Italian, Romanesque, 1125 AD, Limestone in Polychromy), "Death of Saint Aemilanus" (Spanish, 1070 AD, ivory), "Reliquary Triptych With Crucifixion, Coronation of Virgin, Saints Peter and Paul, and Annunciation" (14th Century, Baisse Taille, champleve enamel and gilding on silver), "3 Worthies of the Fiery Furnaces" (Meuse Region, 1150 AD champleve, enamel and gilding on copper), "Eucharist Dove" (symbolic of body of Christ, Limoges, first half of 13th Century, champleve enamel and gilding on copper, it has fine resplendent colors), and "Baptism of Christ" (Limoges, 13th Century champleve enamel and gilding on copper). In the Medieval Period, Limoges in present day France was famous for its devotional theme enamel works of Art.

I also savored fine Medieval Period Sculpture by Unidentified French Sculptor "Saint Peter As Pope," third quarter of 14th Century, stone, limestone, Intrapante with Traces of Polychromy, Arnolfo Cambio "Caryatid Group of Deacon," 1265 AD, Stone, Marble, Tino Camaino "Head of Saint," stone,

marble, and Unidentified French Sculptor "Saint Malo," 13th Century, stone, limestone, microparite, my favorite Medieval Sculptural work in the Museum of Fine Arts in Boston.

From the Medieval Period, I especially appreciated the following paintings; Unidentified Italian Painter "Eight Scenes From Life of Christ," 1280's), Ugolino di Nerio "Virgin and Christ Child," "Mary Magdalene," 14th Century, Sienese Master, Barnaba Da Modena "Virgin and Christ Child," 1360's, Genoese Master, shows Byzantine influence with striations on robe of Virgin, Bernardo Daddi "Nativity and Annunciation To Shepherds," 1336, this painting epitomizes Late Medieval Florentine Painting, Master of Urbino Coronation "Crucifixion," Riminese Fresco transferred to canvas, 1360's, Niccolo di Pietro Gerini "Virgin and Christ Child Enthroned," Florentine very Late Gothic Italian Master, and Gherardo di Jacopo Starnina "Saint Stephan," 1410. I also appreciated Unidenfied Catalan's "Christ With Majesty With 4 Evangelist Symbols" (12th Century, Fresco Secco transferred to plaster and wood, Spanish Medieval work). Outstanding Medieval Period Italian Paintings by Duccio Buonasegna and Barna Da Siena were not on display, during my last visit.

These works that I assiduously studied improved my knowledge of Medieval Art, Medieval History, and the Catholic Religion at this well curated art museum.

Our information is also listed on Tap into Coconut Creek on Facebook. Last month we began a series on the Presidents and the Jews, using some research done by PJ Grisar. Here is the next installment.

- Andrew Jackson: Well, he did have a Jewish friend-Isaac Harby.
- Martin Van Buren: Way back in 1840, the Jews were blamed for the murder of a monk. Mordecai Manual Noah was also involved.
 - William Henry Harrison: He died soon after his inauguration.
- John Tyler: He appointed Warder Cresson, a Quaker who converted to Judaism, as the first consul to Jerusalem in 1844. And guess what? He was influenced by the writings of Mordecai Manual Noah.
 - James Polk: Nothing mentioned about Jews.

- Zachary Taylor: He died a year into office. His Jewish connection he knew Mordecai Manual Noah.
- Millard Fillmore: He actively championed the rights of Jews. He refused to sign a treaty with Switzerland which contained discriminatory language against Jews. This became L'Affaire Swiss. As an aside, Mordecai Manual Noah died on the day the treaty reached Fillmore's desk.
- Franklin Pierce: Pierce signed "An Act for the Benefit of the Hebrew Congregation" in the City of Washington and was included in the synagogues charter. He was the first President to appear in a synagogue charter.
- James Buchanan: He was known as an antisemite.
- Abraham Lincoln: Some think that he may have been Jewish. He had a strong friendship with Jews. He allowed rabbis to serve as chaplains in the military. He never referred to the USA as a "Christian Nation."
- Andrew Johnson: He goes down with Buchanan, referring to Jews as, "tribe that parted the garments of our Savior."
- Ulysses S. Grant: Grant was a mensch. As a general, he expelled Jews from the war area. He realized his error, and as President, appointed many Jews to important positions. He was the first sitting President to attend a synagogue Service.
- Rutherford B. Hayes: Not only did he respect his own religion, he respected all religions. As a general, he attended a seder with Jewish soldiers under his command.
- James A. Garfield: Garfield appointed a Jewish ambassador, Simon Wolf, to Cairo. He was pleased at "having a descendant of a people who had been enslaved by the Egyptians as a representative to that country from a free great land."
- Chester A. Arthur: He stood up to Russia about its treatment of Jews and refusing to offer visas to Jews.
- Grover Cleveland: A.M. Kiely, who was married to a Jew, was refused acceptance as an Ambassador to Austria-Hungary. Cleveland would not appoint a replacement. He also vetoed a bill that would have put a limit on non-Christian immigrants.

Yes, the more things change, the more they remain the same. Just like clothing styles which come back, but changed, so do our problems. More Presidents next month.




